Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), our preliminary review of the **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 2 CY 2025** of the **Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte** duly enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through **Ordinance No. 2025-17** with a total appropriation in the amount of **P6,742,578.57** reveals compliance with the same law and its implementing Rules and Regulations.

I. PRELIMINARY MATTERS

A. Opening Prayer, Singing of the Philippine National Anthem, and Tanauan Hymn

- The activity started with an opening prayer, followed by the Singing of the Philippine National Anthem and Tanauan Hymn through an audio-visual presentation.

B. Introduction

- Regilda M. de la Cruz, OIC-MPDC/MDC Secretary, acknowledged the members of the Council present, the MDC Chairperson Hon. Hon. Ma. Gina E. Merilo, the Punong Barangays, the presidents and representatives of various Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), SB member Hon. Jan Elmer V. Magdalaga, different Department Heads and Section Heads, and everyone present in the meeting.

C. Report on Attendance

- The Secretariat reported that in attendance, there were thirty-two (32) Punong Barangays out of fifty-four (54) Punong Barangays and ten (10) out of twenty-six (26) Leaders of Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) as Members of the Council present. There was a sufficient number of Members of the Council present to constitute a quorum.

D. Declaration of Quorum

- Based on the attendance and roll call conducted, a quorum was then declared by the MDC Chairperson, Hon. Ma. Gina E. Merilo, presiding.

D. Call to Order

- There being a quorum, the meeting of the Municipal Development Council (MDC) was called to order at 1:50 in the afternoon by the Honorable Presiding Officer, Mayor Ma. Gina E. Merilo.

F. Welcome Message/Presentation of Agenda



- MDC Chairperson Hon. Ma. Gina E. Merilo pleasingly greeted and acknowledged the present members of the council, the Punong Barangays, leaders and representatives of various Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), the SB Member, Hon Jan Elmer V. Magdalaga, and the different Department Heads and Section Heads. She conveyed her appreciation to all the MDC Members for their consistent attendance at the meetings and their wholehearted cooperation and support.
- Furthermore, she highlighted that one of the agenda of the meeting is the Supplemental Budget No.02 for Calendar Year 2025, which will be discussed later by the Municipal Budget Officer.

- MDC Secretary/OIC MPDC, Ms. de la Cruz, outlined the agenda for discussion as follows:
 1. Abandonment of the PINTADOS Festival and other related activities with an appropriation of P400,000.00 under Supplemental Budget No.01, CY 2025;
 2. Incorporation of the Construction of Multi-Purpose Building at the Tanauan Public Market Area into the Supplemental Investment Program for Calendar Year 2025;
 3. Proposed Supplemental Investment Program (SIP No.02) for CY 2025;
 4. Proposed Supplemental Budget No.02, CY 2025;
 5. Resolution expressing the Support of the Municipal Development Council for the Demolition of the Structure at the Public Market Area to facilitate the Construction of a Multi-Purpose Building; and
 6. Other Matters



AGENDA DISCUSSION:

For the first agenda, the MDC Secretary, Ms. Regilda M. de la Cruz, presented to the council the project for abandonment with the details below:

- Right after the presentation, since no further inputs or concerns were raised, the MDC Chairperson, Hon. Ma. Gina E. Merilo, asked for any motion from the council for the approval of the resolution;
- Thus, on motion of the Punong Barangay of Guindag-an, Hon. Floro B. Juanitez, Jr., and duly seconded by the President of Canramos Potters Association, Ms. Grace F. Mendiola;



- A resolution endorsing and recommending approval to the 16th Sangguniang Bayan of the abandonment of the Pintados Festival and other related activities with an appropriation of Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (P400,000.00) under Supplemental Budget No.01, CY 2025, and requesting the declaration as savings and reversion of the budgetary allocation to unappropriated balance for reappropriation for Supplemental Budget No.02, Calendar Year 2025 was carried;
- With no objections, the resolution was duly approved;
- Afterwards, the second agenda – Incorporation of the Construction of Multi-Purpose Building at the Tanauan Public Market Area into the Supplemental Investment Program for Calendar Year 2025 was presented to the council by the MDC Secretary, Regilda M. de la Cruz;
- As there were no questions or concerns from the council, the MDC Chairperson asked for a motion for the approval of the resolution for the incorporation of the Construction of a Multi-Purpose Building at the Public Market Area into the Local Development Investment Program and Annual Investment Program of the municipality.
- Thus, on motion of Ms. Grace F. Mendiola, President of Canramos Potters Association, and duly seconded by the Punong Barangay of Sto.Niño, Hon. Alex L. Miralles, a resolution recommending approval to the 16th Sangguniang Bayan of the Incorporation of the Construction of a Multi-Purpose Building at the Public Market Area into the Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) for Calendar Year 2025 with an estimated project cost of One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (P150,000,000.00) to be sourced from the General Appropriations Act (GAA) and to be implemented by DPWH-Leyte 1ST District Engineering Office, Palo, Leyte.
- After a proper endorsement and motion for approval, the resolution was carried and approved with no objection.

For the third agenda, MDC Secretary Regilda M. de la Cruz continued by presenting to the council the next agenda – Supplemental Investment Program No. 02, Calendar Year 2025. She explained that the plan typically covers four sectors. However, for this SIP No. 02, the projects, programs, and activities will be covered only under three sectors, namely: (1) General Public Services Sector, (2) Social Services Sector, and (3) Economic Services Sector. A breakdown of PPAs and their funding requirement summary was presented to the council.



- In response, Ms. de la Cruz stated that the project should supposedly be included in the Supplemental Investment Program, but subject to further discussion, though the council already approved it;
- MDC Chair Merilo asked the council if there were further questions. Hearing none, she then asked for a motion from the council for the approval of the resolution;
- MDC Chair Merilo asked the council if there were further questions. Hearing none, she then asked for a motion from the council for the approval of the resolution;
- Upon motion of the President of Sto. Niño Aquatic Integrated Fisherfolk Association, Mr. Cipriano B. Luna, Jr., and duly seconded by the Punong Barangay of Guindag-an, Hon.

- Hon. Flores recalled they had passed a resolution last year requesting funding along with a list of their total number of additional barangay volunteer workers and tanods;
- Mr. Villegas inquired whether they had submitted the resolution before the deadline for the Annual Budget submission in October 2024;
- Hon. Flores, confirmed that they had submitted the resolution before the deadline;
- On behalf of the LGU, Mr. Villegas reiterated his apologies to the Punong Barangays for the miscommunication, as no information had been relayed to them. He assured them that the funding would be prioritized for next year and expressed hope that the resolution would be provided to the Budget Office for inclusion in the planning process;
- MDC Chair Hon. Ma. Gina E. Merilo inquired if there were any further concerns from the council. With no additional issues raised, she proceeded to make a motion for the approval of the resolution; asked the council if there were further concerns. Since none, she then made a motion for the approval of the resolution;
- The motion was made by Mr. Cipriano B. Luna, Jr., President of Sto.Niño Aquatic Integrated Fisherfolk Association, and was duly seconded by Hon. Floro B. Juanitez, Jr., Punong Barangay of Guindag-an;
- A resolution endorsing and recommending approval to the 16th Sangguniang Bayan of the municipality the Proposed Supplemental Investment Program No.02, Calendar Year 2025 with budgetary requirement amounting to Six Million Seven Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Eight Pesos and Fifty-Seven Centavos (P6,742,578.57) to be sourced from the General Fund of the municipality and One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (P150,000,000.00) from the General Appropriations Act (GAA).

The next presenter was introduced to the council by the MDC Secretary, Regilda M. de la Cruz. A detailed presentation of the Proposed Supplemental Budget No.02 for Calendar Year 2025, having the amount of **Six Million Seven Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Eight Pesos and Fifty-Seven Centavos (Php 6,742,578.57)**, was discussed with the council by the Municipal Budget Officer, Mr. Ermel Milo A. Pilola.

Municipal Budget Officer, Mr. Pilola, greeted everyone in the meeting and proceeded with his presentation, the proposed Supplemental Budget No. 02, for Calendar Year 2025.

- Immediately following the presentation, and with no further inputs or concerns raised, MDC Chairperson Hon. Ma. Gina E. Merilo, inquired if there were any motions from the council for the approval of the resolution;
- Consequently, a motion was made by Hon. Jeffrey B. Dandan, and duly seconded by the other members of the council. With no objections, the resolution was approved.
- A resolution endorsing and recommending approval of the 16th Sangguniang Bayan of the municipality the proposed Supplemental Budget No. 02, Calendar Year 2025 with a total obligation of Six Million Seven Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Eight Pesos and Fifty-Seven Centavos (P6,742,578.57), subject to the declaration as savings of the Personal Services (Current Year 2025), and Capital Outlay (continuing) Appropriations, and abandonment of the Pintados Festival and other related activities under Supplemental Budget No.01, CY 2025, and reverting therefore its respective amount to unappropriated balance amounting to a total of P6,742,578.57, to be made available for reappropriation for Supplemental Budget No.02, Calendar Year 2025.



- Afterward, MDC Chair Hon. Merilo recognized the Municipal Engineer, Engr. Raul S. Soliva to provide a rationale for the next agenda item: the demolition of structures in the Public Market Area to facilitate the Construction of a Multi-Purpose Building;
- Municipal Engineer Soliva greeted the members of the Municipal Development Council warmly. He noted that the project would significantly contribute to the development of the Local Government Unit of Tanauan. He emphasized the need for a concerted decision within the community, as compliance with the requirements of the Commission on Audit (COA) is essential. Part of the COA's requirements includes an appraisal of the structures to be demolished and a resolution from the Sangguniang Bayan authorizing the demolition;
- Engr. Soliva mentioned that he had received documentation from the appraisal committee; however, the current value of the building is low due to depreciation. If the necessary documents can be finalized, they will be submitted to the COA for final approval of the demolition, paving the way for the implementation of the project, which has an estimated cost of One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (₱150,000,000.00). According to the appraisal prepared by the Inventory and Appraisal Committee, supported by the authorized appraiser of the LGU, the current value of the project is approximately Eight Million Pesos (₱8,000,000.00);
- He concluded by stating that this project represents a significant opportunity for the Local Government of Tanauan, and he believes that the approval of the resolution is necessary for its decision from the local government and community organizations and expressed hope that the resolution would receive favorable consideration from the Municipal Development Council;
- MDC Chair Hon. Merilo thanked Engr. Soliva for his informative discussion on the project, affirming that the Local Government Unit of Tanauan would greatly benefit from this development. She noted a correction on the resolution raised by the Municipal Accountant and requested a motion from the council for the approval of the corrected resolution;
- The resolution expresses the full support of the Municipal Development Council (MDC) of Tanauan, Leyte, for the construction of a Multi-Purpose Building within the Tanauan Public Market and the demolition of existing structures that may impede the implementation of the project, with an estimated cost of One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (₱150,000,00.00), to be sourced from the General Appropriations Act (GAA) and implemented by the DPWH-Leyte 1st District Engineering Office, Palo, Leyte;
- The motion was made by Hon. Alex L. Miralles, Punong Barangay of Sto. Niño, and duly seconded by Hon. Romulo C. Vertudes, Punong Barangay of Solano. After proper endorsement and a motion for approval, the resolution was carried and approved with no objections.



OTHER MATTERS:

- Hon. Rossarie Ann E. Flores, Punong Barangay of Camire, expressed her strong hope that the Local Government Unit of Tanauan would allocate sufficient funds to each barangay, emphasizing that such funding is crucial for the successful implementation of their community programs and projects.
- MDC Chairperson Hon. Merilo expressed sympathy for their situation but noted that due to budgetary constraints, the LGU currently lacks the financial resources to allocate funds to every barangay in the municipality. However, she mentioned that there is a program under the Barangay Support Fund aimed at providing due to budgetary constraints, the LGU currently lacks the financial resources to allocate funds to every

Additionally, the LGU is actively exploring strategies to optimize budget allocation and secure additional funding to better support all barangays in the future.



A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE FULL SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (MDC) OF TANAUAN, LEYTE, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING WITHIN THE TANAUAN PUBLIC MARKET AND THE DEMOLITION OF EXISTING STRUCTURES THAT WILL IMPEDE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECT, WITH AN ESTIMATED PROJECT COST OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY MILLION PESOS (₱150,000,000.00) TO BE SOURCED FROM THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT (GAA) AND TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE DPWH-LEYTE 1ST DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE, PALO, LEYTE

WHEREAS, the Municipal Development Council (MDC) recognizes the urgent need to modernize and improve public infrastructures within the Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte, to ensure efficient delivery of services, stimulate local economic growth, and promote general welfare;

WHEREAS, the proposed construction of a Multi-Purpose Building within the Tanauan Public area is envisioned to address the growing demand for accessible and functional public spaces that can accommodate a range of municipal services and commercial activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Alex L. Miralles, Punong Barangay of Sto. Niño, duly seconded by Hon. Romulo C. Vertudes, Punong Barangay of Solano, be it;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Municipal Development Council of Tanauan, Leyte, expresses its full support for the Construction of a Multi-Purpose Building within the Tanauan Public Market and the demolition of existing structures that will impede the implementation of


