

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-009**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ENSURE AN EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION TO REGULATE AND ADDRESS NOISE POLLUTION WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE.**

**INTRODUCED BY: COMMITTEE ON LAWS, RULES, PRIVILEGES AND ACCOUNTABILITY**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 2, Section 8, Article 682 of the Civil Code of the Philippines prohibits owners from committing nuisance through noise, jarring, offensive odor, smoke, heat, dust, water, glare, and other causes;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 devolves to the Local Government Units (LGUs) the authority to create and implement ordinances aimed at promoting the general welfare of their constituents. Section 447 of the same Code mandates municipalities to address and abate nuisances, including noise pollution, within their respective jurisdictions;

**WHEREAS**, the Undersecretary of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Marlo L. Ringan issued a Memorandum dated January 21, 2025 highly encouraging LGUs to address public nuisance and noise pollution, and was endorsed by the Municipal Mayor Hon. Marciano A. Batiancela, Jr. in his letter request dated March 6, 2025 for the enactment of an Ordinance;

**WHEREAS**, unnecessary, inappropriate, and unreasonable loud sound including, but not limited to, those from karaoke machines and the like; sound amplifying devices or equipment; or the sound generated by modified tailpipes or mufflers, tricycles, cars and other motor vehicles – all result to massive complaints. The same sounds from the foregoing is detrimental to the health and welfare of the general public for such is the source of discomfort, inconvenience, and annoyance to the public;

**WHEREAS**, Presidential Decree No. 984 otherwise known as the Pollution Control Law, and Republic Act No. 8749 otherwise known as the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999 includes regulation of noise pollution as part of the general environmental protection efforts by imposing ambient noise standards or guidelines, to establish acceptable noise levels for communities as well as for noise-producing equipment;

***NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of SB Member Hon. Jullian Marc A. Batiancela, duly seconded by the Majority of all the Sangguniang Bayan members present;*

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE**, in a session assembled, **THAT**:

**Section 1. Short Title.** This Ordinance shall be known as the “Noise Pollution Regulation Ordinance.”

**Section 2. Declaration of Policy.** The Municipality of Calubian shall protect and promote the right to health of the people, maintain peace and order, and promote the general welfare, as it acknowledges that noise is one of the top environmental hazards to both the physical and mental health and well-being of every person. For this purpose, it is imperative that the Municipality of Calubian undertakes to reduce the exposure of the public to noise and improve health by regulating any and all such sound which unreasonably cause injury or damage, or even endanger the comfort, repose, peace safety and health of every person.

**Section 3. Coverage.** This policy applies to all persons within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Calubian, Leyte.

**Section 4. Definition of Terms.** The words and phrases used in this Ordinance are hereby defined as follows:

- i. **Ambient Noise** – refers to the background noise in an area or environment, being a composite of sounds from many sources near and far;
- ii. **Emission** – shall primarily mean in this ordinance as "unwanted sound" generated by tailpipes or modified mufflers of motorcycles, tricycles, cars, and motor vehicles. Excessive sound generated by agricultural and industrial machineries shall also be included. It shall further include excessive, inappropriate, loud sound coming from karaoke/videoke machines, stereos, components, and sound amplifying device/equipment;
- iii. **Modified tailpipes/mufflers** - any alteration, replacement, modification, or removal of the original tailpipe, muffler, or silencer of motorcycles and tricycles including cars and other motor vehicles;
- iv. **Noise** – refers to any excessive, undesirable sound including that produced by persons, pets, and livestock, industrial equipment and construction; motor vehicles such as motorcycles, tricycles, cars, and trucks; home appliances which include videoke, karaoke, stereo, component, and sound amplifying device/equipment; electric motors, combustion engines, and any other noise producing objects;



- v. **Noise Pollution** – any form of unwanted or offensive sound that unreasonably intrudes into our daily activities. It is also known as noise disturbance which is the disturbing excessive noise level that can still be heard after a distance of at least 50 meters from the source with a sound level exceeding 60 decibels;
- vi. **Public disturbance noise** – refers to any noise or sound which unreasonably disturbs the comfort or peace of another person or persons;
- vii. **Sound amplifying equipment or device** – refers to any machine or device that is used for the amplification of the human voice, music or any other sound;
- viii. **Unwanted, Excessive, Disturbing Sound** - Any sound that either interferes with normal activities such as but not limited to relaxing, sleeping, studying, or disrupts or diminishes the inhabitant's quality of life.
- ix. **Videoke/ Karaoke** – refers to any audio-video equipment operated and built to produce images and/or lyrics of a song on a television screen to afford a person to sing along using any electronic device;
- x. **Videoke/Karaoke Bars, Restaurants or Establishments** – a place where the audio-visual systems are set for musical accompaniment. It shall also include restaurants and places that serve as venue for performances of live bands, guest performers, and other live acts.

**Section 5. Determination of Public Disturbance Noise.** - In determining whether a sound is a public disturbance noise, the following factors incident to such noise are to be considered:

- i. Time of the day;
- ii. Proximity to residential areas, schools or place of worship;
- iii. Whether the noise is recurrent, intermittent, or constant;
- iv. The volume and intensity;
- v. Whether the noise has been enhanced in volume of range by any types of electronic or mechanical means;
- vi. The character and zoning area; and
- vii. Whether or not the noise is subject to being controlled without unreasonable effort on the part of the creator thereof.

**Section 6. Public Disturbance Noise.** The following acts are hereby declared to be causing public disturbance noise, which contributes to noise pollution, and shall therefore be prohibited for purposes of this Ordinance:

- a) The operation, playing or permitting the operation or playing of any loud sound generated from videoke, karaoke system, radio, CD Player, television set or sound amplifying equipment or device such as, but not limited to, musical instrument, drums, loudspeakers, or other sound producing device within areas and along public streets or road sides which either annoy, disturb, injure or endanger the health, comfort, peace, and safety of the public. In the use of the above-mentioned audio systems in the said periods, no person shall make or cause the production of any excessive, disturbing, unreasonable, and unnecessary sound in such manner or with such volume so as to annoy the quiet and comfort of a reasonable person of normal sensitivities in any dwelling or residence; or with the louder volume than is necessary for the convenient hearing of the persons who are within the place in which such device or system is operated.
  - a. No video/karaoke bars and restaurants featuring live band shows and acts shall be allowed to operate within the 50-meter radius from educational, religious, and public institutions such as schools, hospitals, clinics, churches, or chapels.



b. Videoke/Karaoke bars, restaurants, and venues featuring live band show and act shall be allowed to operate up to 1:00 a.m. The same applies to families and individuals hosting a drinking party, merry making, gathering, or an event that causes loud and unnecessary sound. Violators shall suffer the corresponding fines and penalties imposed in this Ordinance.

- b) The frequent, repetitive or continuous sounding of a horn or siren attached to a motor vehicle, except if necessary, or is a warning of danger, or as specifically permitted or required by law;
- c) Sound from motor vehicles audio systems, such as radio and compact disc players, operated at a volume so as to be audible greater than twenty (20) feet from the vehicle itself. Owners of motorcycles, owners/operators of tricycles, and owners of cars and vehicles installed with sound system shall be prohibited from playing excessively loud, ear-splitting music;
- d) Noise from motor vehicle as a result of the customization and/ or modification of its mufflers/ exhaust pipe or horn exceeding the 90 decibel (dB) limit at an engine speed of 2,000 to 2,500 rpm set by the Land Transportation Office (LTO) Memorandum Circular No. 2020-2240.

*Provided, however,* That the foregoing enumeration of acts or noise shall not be construed as excluding other acts and noises which may offend the public peace.

*Provided, further,* That existing businesses or establishments that are engaged in entertainment and located in dense mixed-use zones (commercial-institutional-residential) are required to provide effective soundproofing of their venues to maintain the tolerable noise level outside their establishments.

**Section 7. Exemptions.** The following acts are hereby exemptions for purposes of this Ordinance:

1. The use of karaoke/videoke machine and sound amplifying equipment shall be allowed up to 2:00 a.m. during barangay and town fiesta, graduation ceremonies, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, birthday celebrations, and any anniversary celebration or commemoration by any civic or religious organization. Any and all religious events shall be exempted from observing the prohibition imposed in this Ordinance including, but not limited to, Annual Fiesta Traditions, the Lenten Season or during the Christmas celebrations.
2. The use of firecrackers during celebration or party shall only be allowed up to 10:00 p.m., except during Christmas Eve, Christmas Day countdown, and New Year's Eve, New Year's Day countdown in which case it shall be allowed up to 1:00 a.m., upon securing the relevant permits thereto.
3. The use of sound amplifying device/equipment such as megaphone, showboat, and campaign jingle shall be allowed of use starting from 7:00 a.m. up to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. exclusively.

**Section 8. Enforcement.** The Punong Barangay, to be assisted by barangay tanods, and Calubian Philippine National Police (PNP), shall be tasked to enforce and implement this Ordinance. On-duty Barangay Police (Tanod) members shall monitor the use of videoke or karaoke and other audio/sound systems in their area of responsibility by courteously approaching and telling the concerned parties to soften, lower the volume or eventually turn off the sound system whenever warranted. One (1) hour before 10:00 in the evening, the members of the barangay tanod on-duty shall courteously approach and remind the concerned parties to soften or lower the volume and eventually turn off the videoke or sound system at 10:00 P.M. However, if such reminders had been obviously ignored or disregarded

by the concerned parties, the member of the Barangay Police (Tanod) shall call the Calubian Police Station to intercede for and on behalf of the Barangay.

**Section 9. Penalties.** - Any person(s) who is found creating or causing public disturbance noise as provided in section 6 hereof, or in any manner found violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be imposed a compromised penalty of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 2,500.00).

Any person who violates this Ordinance after the payment of the compromised penalty shall be charged a penalty of:

- First Offense     Php 1, 000.00
- Second Offense    Php 1, 500.00
- Third Offense     Php 2, 500.00

Failure to pay the compromised penalty shall give rise to the filing of a case in court, for the conviction wherein a fine of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 2,500.00), or Thirty (30) Days as maximum period of imprisonment, shall be imposed upon the violator at the discretion of the court.

If the offender is charged for using modified tailpipe/muffler, he shall be required to restore the original muffler of his motorcycle, tricycle, car, or motor vehicle at the impounding center, which is the Calubian PNP headquarters. Subject vehicle shall remain impounded up to such time that the original muffler has been installed or restored. Removed modified muffler shall be confiscated and destroyed by the apprehending officer, or in his absence, by any duly designated Calubian PNP official in the presence of the owner.

If the offender is a videoke/ karaoke bar, restaurant, establishment, car parts/motorcycle parts or shop and has been penalized thrice already, the establishment shall be closed for 1 month with the Business Permit revoked plus imprisonment of not more than 30 days, and a fine of P2,500.00 shall be imposed on succeeding offenses as may be determined by the court.

**Section 10. Separability Clause.** If for any reason, a part of this Ordinance is declared illegal or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain valid in full force and effect.

**Section 11. Repealing Clause.** All ordinances, rules, and regulations, other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

**Section 12. Separability Clause.** If any part of this Ordinance is declared invalid, unconstitutional or unlawful, sections or parts thereof which are not affected shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

**Section 13. Effectivity.** This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days from posting and publication, immediately upon approval of the Municipal Mayor and the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte.


