



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### EXPLANATORY NOTE

The establishment and operation of a municipal infirmary with qualified/trained personnel as well as the provision of primary care facilities with 24-hours emergency and observational care, including diagnostics services, laboratory services and medicine dispensary under the PhilHealth e-Konsulta, are part of the improvement of the health services and local revenue measures of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Jaro, Leyte.

Records from the Rural Health Unit (RHU) of Jaro indicate that an average of 80 to 100 patients are referred monthly to hospitals outside the municipality. Many of these patients come from indigent families, and some have tragically died in transit due to the long travel time of 15 minutes to an hour. The lack of an accessible health facility within Jaro has not only caused physical and emotional strain on families but has also left many residents feeling alienated as they seek medical help in unfamiliar places, often with limited means.

To address this gap in health services and to prevent further loss of lives, the establishment of a local infirmary is necessary and urgent. Such a facility will significantly reduce referrals to distant hospitals and ensure that patients receive timely and adequate medical attention within their own community.

Section 16 of Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7610) provides that, "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants".

Furthermore, Section 76 of R.A. 7160 provides that "Every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission".

In view of the foregoing, the undersigned strongly believes that the enactment of this ordinance is vital for the general welfare of the constituents of Jaro, especially the underprivileged. The promotion of public health and safety must remain a priority of the LGU. Hence, the passage of this measure is respectfully sought.

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**ORDINANCE NO. 01**  
**SERIES OF 2025**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN INFIRMARY IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF JARO, LEYTE, TO BE NAMED AS “JARO MUNICIPAL INFIRMARY” AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE.

**Be it enacted** by the Sangguniang Bayan of Jaro, Leyte assembled:

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE** - This Ordinance shall be known as “An Ordinance Establishing the Jaro Municipal Infirmary”.

**SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE JARO MUNICIPAL INFIRMARY** - There shall be established a government-owned Infirmary of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Jaro, Leyte, classified as Other Health Facility, particularly as a Category A: Primary Care Facility - Infirmary with in-patient beds for Infirmary/Dispensary and Birthing Home and without beds for medical out-patient clinics, OFW clinics and Dental Clinics, as well as Category B: Diagnostic/Therapeutic Facility with a laboratory and ionizing machines, pursuant to the Department of Health (DOH) Administrative Order No. 2012-0012, known as the “Rules and Regulations Governing the New Classification of Hospitals and Other Health Facilities in the Philippines and the DOH-Food and Drug Administration Guidelines on the License To Operate”.

**SECTION 3. INFIRMARY PERSONNEL** - The Jaro Municipal Infirmary shall have an adequate number of qualified, trained, and competent staff, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Commission and Republic Act No. 1080, to ensure efficient and effective delivery of quality health care services; hence, the following various Plantilla positions are hereby created to operate the infirmary, as follows:

Provided, that the formulation and recommendation of the duties and functions for the newly created plantilla positions under Section 3 shall be delegated to the Municipal Health Office (MHO), in coordination with the Human Resource Management Office (HRMO), consistent with and subject to the standards and guidelines set by the Civil Service Commission (CSC) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM).

**SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS** - Funding shall be appropriated by the LGU of Jaro, Leyte, as follows:

Medical Equipment/Supplies, Dental Equipment/Supplies, Laboratory Equipment/Supplies, Office Equipment/Supplies, Utilities (Water, Electricity, Telephone, Internet and Cable) and other expenses required for the establishment/operation of the Jaro Municipal Infirmary	Annual general Fund Budget beginning CY 2025 and every budget year thereafter

**SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** – If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a competent court, such judgment or provision found to be invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect or impair the other provisions therefore.

**SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE** – All local Ordinance, rules and regulations or parts thereof, inconsistent with, or in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed or amended accordingly.

**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY** – This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after a copy hereof is posted in accordance with the provision of R.A. 7160, in at least four (4) conspicuous places in the municipality.



The Chair recognizes Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja to offer the motion.




Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja moves the proposed resolution and it was seconded by Hon. Francisco R. Altres, Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., and Hon. Raul A. Macanda, and then the Chair declared the plenary discussion.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello speaks out that on his observations the LGU has only two (2) garbage truck used for the collections of garbage in the Poblacion, which is not sufficient in numbers to collect the volume of waste for the entire Poblacion proper alone.


Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello suggest further that for the program to be effective on his opinion there is a need for the LGU to purchase additional garbage truck.











Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja speaks out that the concerns of Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello, is noted, and as such will be communicated to the Chief Executive's Office.

The Chair opines and said that on his incumbency as the ABC Federated President, during one of the LIGA meeting Mr. Zoilo S. Trota-MSWMO has the occasion to attend, and he has presented to the LIGA the waste collections and for its disposal involving the 16 pilot barangays, and also the plan of the LGU to purchase additional garbage truck.

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala opines and said the as far as she can remember, the LGU has an allocated amount in the LGU budget to purchase garbage truck.



Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala, took the floor and then move the above proposed resolution and it was duly seconded en masse.




And with no further inquiries/clarifications, the Chair request Hon. Alma A. Tamayo to offer the final motion, and it was duly seconded en masse.

And then the Chair declared that for Item No. 4, under the business for the day it has been moved, carried and approved en masse by the August Body.

The Chair give the floor to Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello to offer the motion, duly seconded by Hon. Rey P. Aure, Hon. Francisco R. Altres, Hon. Raul A. Macanda and Hon. Alma A. Tamayo, and then the Chair declared the plenary discussion of the above proposed resolution.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello opines that the Executive Agenda is requesting the Sangguniang Bayan for enactment of a resolution for the temporary road closure within the vicinity of the Sports Complex, Cultural Center in preparation of the Medical Mission and the 174<sup>th</sup> Jaro Town Fiesta.

 Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., inquire from the proponent on whether or not Real Street will be closed to vehicles.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello reply that not the entire Real Street will be closed, for the Medical Mission on August 6-8, 2025, only the portion from the corner of Concepcion and Real Streets, and corners of Real and Del Carmen Street will be closed to be used as parking areas.


 At this juncture through the Chair Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello request to recognized the presence of Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo-MPDO, to discuss more further the temporary road closure of specific municipal streets.

The Chair give the floor to Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo, to discuss in detail the proposed temporary road closures, for the SB members consumptions.

  
  
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Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo-MPDC took the floor and firstly extends her greetings to the Body and continue to apprise the Body as to the temporary closure as follows:

A. For the Medical Mission on August 6-8, 2025.

a. Temporary Road Closure for Vehicular Traffic

- From corners of Concepcion and San Francisco streets going to corner Real Street;
- From corners of Concepcion and Real streets, and corners of Real and Del Carmen streets (for parking areas);
- From corners of Real and Del Carmen streets going corners of Del Carmen and San Antonio streets; and
- From corner of Concepcion Street going to corners of Del Carmen and San Isidro streets which could be used as exit point of patients.

 Hon. Raul A. Macanda inquire from Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo on the route plan for the entry and exit of private vehicles and motorcycles.

Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo reply that Nazareno street going to Real Street and left-turn to Del Carmen Street are open to vehicle traffic.

 Hon. Francisco R. Altres opines and asks Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo on the entry and exit for the transport vehicle bound from Carigara to Tacloban and vice-versa.

Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo reply that transport vehicles bound from Carigara to Tacloban and vice-versa, the entry point is right-turn of corners of Nazareno and San Antonio streets going to Concepcion Street and right-turn at corner of Real and Concepcion streets

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala opines and suggest to Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo-MPDO, considering that there is temporary road closures during the Medical Mission and the 174<sup>th</sup> Jaro Town Fiesta, to prohibit parking of vehicles specifically the rout for public transportation vehicle in San Antonion Street, Concepcion Street and the possible road-clearing in these particular streets.

Hon. Rey P. Aure opines and suggests to Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo to find safe and suitable parking areas for vehicles during the 174<sup>th</sup> Jaro Town Fiesta Celebration, and an organized area for the itinerant vendors.

The Chair informed the Body that according to Mr. Hubert Keith B. Vega the LEEO, there is already identified area for the itinerant vendors.




Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., informed also the Body that there will be no more food stalls, canteen/s in the market area during the Jaro Town Fiesta celebration and it could be used as the site for itinerant vendors.

Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo reply that pertaining to the parking spaces, she has suggested already to Engr. Pempe C. Quiñones to identified vacant lots, to be sued as temporary parking areas.

Likewise, Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo informed the Body that to prevent traffic congestions along Del Carmen and Real streets, the Doom/Stage used by performing artists will be installed at the front of the Municipal Hall Building, and no longer between the corners of Real and Del Carmen streets, and it should be dismantled after its use, to ease the free flow of traffic during the Jaro Town Fiesta on the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of September.

Hon. Raul A. Macanda speaks out and then suggest to Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo, that in the identifications of parking areas, is to include the school grounds of the Notre Dame if they will permit the use for parking area for those priest/s who were attending the celebration of the pontifical mass on the 21<sup>st</sup> of September.

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Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo reply that the concerns of the SB members are noted, and said further that during the Medical Mission, there is a proposal from the committee in-charge to utilized vacant private lots which are nearer to the Jaro Sports Complex.

Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo continues that pertaining to the suggestions of Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala, for the road clearing of obstructions for the route of public transport vehicles will be a priority of concerns to lessen traffic congestions in this specific area.

Hon. Rey P. Aure, opines and suggest to Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo for an alternative route plan for the entry and exit of public utility vehicle bound from Carigara to Tacloban and vice-versa to establish the point of entry from the diversion road near the Jaro-PNP Station going to San Antonio, San Jose and right-turn in the corner of Real Street.

Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., speaks out that on his observation, the focus of activity during the Fiest celebration is concentrated only in Brgy. I and Brgy. IV, he suggests for the Brgy. II and Brgy. III, to be involved, for there are vacant lots in the barangay that can be utilized as parking areas, specifically in the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of September.


The Chair said that the suggestions of Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., is in order for Brgy. II and Brgy. III to be involved in the peaceful and safe fiesta celebration, and suggest further to Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo, that the different route plans for the 174<sup>th</sup> Jaro Town Fiesta should be communicated to the PNP and Municipal Traffic Enforcers for an effective, and orderly implementation of the temporary route plan.

Hon. Raul A. Macanda opines that on his opinion the Sangguniang Bayan shall approved first the temporary road closure and route plan during the conduct of the Medical Mission on August 6-8, 2025, and for the temporary road closure and route plan for the forthcoming 174<sup>th</sup> Jaro Town Fiesta it will be approved later, for there might be some changes from the MPDO.



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Ar. EnP. Christabel M. Ribo speaks out and said that she concurs to the suggestions of Hon. Raul A. Macanda, to approved first the temporary road closure and route plan for the conduct of the Medical Mission, and for the approval of temporary closure and route plan for the 174<sup>th</sup> Jaro Town Fiesta, will follow later, so that the LGU could conduct a dry-run to determine if the route plan is feasible to be implemented, to ease the traffic congestions.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello speaks out that he concur to the suggestions, to approve first the temporary road closure and route plan for the conduct of the Medical Mission which will start on August 6, 2025, and for the approval of the temporary road closure and route plan for vehicles during the 174<sup>th</sup> Jaro Town Fiesta will soon follow, after the MPDO could conduct the dry-run, and could submit the final route plan for vehicles and other public transportation, and the roads to be temporarily be closed.

The Chair opines that it has been resolved by the Body, to approve first the identified roads to be temporarily be closed, and the route plan of vehicles for the conduct of the Medical Mission on August 6-8, 2025, and for the approval of the temporary road closure and route plan for the vehicle traffic for the 174<sup>th</sup> Jaro Town Fiesta will follow, to give ample time to the MPDO to finalize the plan, and then the Chair asks from the Body for any further discussions, and no one signify, request Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello to offer the final motion.

Before the final motion, Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello reiterates the final route plan for the vehicles during the conduct of the Medical Mission on August 6-8, 2025.

- a. For the route plan during the Medical Mission for public utility vehicles bound from Tacloban City to Carigara and vice-versa, the entry point is corner Nazareno and San Antonio streets going to Concepcion Street and right-turn in Real Street;
- b. For other transport vehicles is from Nazareno street to Real Street left-turn to Del Carmen Street.





1. Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja, informed the Body pertaining to the problem in Barangay San Pedro, that a certain barangay official informed him that there is no medicine/s at their Barangay Health Center for the barangay residents, and asks for the assistance (solicitation) from the Sangguniang Bayan for the purchase of medicines.

The Chair opines and asks Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja who was the barangay residents that informed him of the problem of Brgy. San Pedro, pertaining to their medicines.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja reply that a certain person named Nelia Lizarondo, came to his office, a Barangay Health Worker.

Hon. Alma A. Tamayo opines and suggests to Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja to informed Nelia Lizarondo, that under the MSWDO Program, the barangay/s are required to allocate funds in their annual barangay budget under the GAD Program solely intended for purchase of medicines for the barangay consumptions and for the feeding program, and the purchase of medicines could be charged to the GAD Funds.

Hon. Raul A. Macanda opine that this kind of problem specifically pertaining to the supply of medicines to the barangay through the Barangay Health Stations/BHS should be resolved following a protocol, the lack of medicines in the barangay should be addressed through the midwives assigned to the BHS, for the MHO conduct a continuous consultation in the BHS.



Hon. Raul A. Macanda said further to advise the Barangay Health Worker (Nelia Lizarondo) to verify their barangay budget, if there is an allocation for the purchase of medicines.

Hon. Zandro T. Morabe in addition thereto said that pertaining to the problem of medicines in Barangay San Pedro, request the SB members that in cases like this to accompany the Barangay Officials or a Barangay Health Worker to his office (ABC Office), so that a solution to their problem could be addressed immediately.

2. Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja suggest to the Body to established in the Sanggunian, an effective monitoring of visitors of the Sangguniang Bayan's Offices.


The Chair opines that he has assigned already an employee in the person of Mr. Ruben D. Batucan at the front desk at the entrance of the SB Office to monitor the visitors entering the SB Office, and to register in the logbook their purpose of visiting the SB Office.

Further, the Chair informed the Body that the repair of the comfort room is almost finished and it can already be used after its rehabilitation.



Hon. Raul A. Macanda, suggest to provide a visitor's ID, and visitors logbook to indicate the purpose of their visit.

The Chair said that on his view there is no need to provide a visitor's ID, registering in the logbook is already an effective monitoring device.

Hon. Rey P. Aure opines and suggests to the Body for the Sangguniang Bayan Office to install CCTV in some strategic location/areas in the SBO, and pertaining to the suggestions of intercom, basically it should be connected to the respective offices of the SB members.

Hon. Francisco R. Altres suggests to the Body for the installation of intercom and CCTV's is to utilized the fuds allocated in the SB Office under the Item for Video Conferencing.

The Chair opines and said to verify first the funding to be used for the purchase and installations of intercom and CCTVs in the SB Office, there is also a need to consult the Budget Office if the funds suggested by Hon. Francisco R. Altres is allowed to be used for the purpose.

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**EXCERPT RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE:**

**ITEM NO. 1- APPROVAL ON THIRD-AND-FINAL-READING  
OF ORDINANCE NO. 01, SERIES OF 2025**

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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The establishment and operation of a municipal infirmary with qualified/trained personnel as well as the provision of primary care facilities with 24-hours emergency and observational care, including diagnostics services, laboratory services and medicine dispensary under the PhilHealth e-Konsulta, are part of the improvement of the health services and local revenue measures of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Jaro, Leyte.

Records from the Rural Health Unit (RHU) of Jaro indicate that an average of 80 to 100 patients are referred monthly to hospitals outside the municipality. Many of these patients come from indigent families, and some have tragically died in transit due to the long travel time of 15 minutes to an hour. The lack of an accessible health facility within Jaro has not only caused physical and emotional strain on families but has also left many residents feeling alienated as they seek medical help in unfamiliar places, often with limited means.

To address this gap in health services and to prevent further loss of lives, the establishment of a local infirmary is necessary and urgent. Such a facility will significantly reduce referrals to distant hospitals and ensure that patients receive timely and adequate medical attention within their own community.

Section 16 of Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7610) provides that, "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants"


  
  
  
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Furthermore, Section 76 of R.A. 7160 provides that "Every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission".

In view of the foregoing, the undersigned strongly believes that the enactment of this ordinance is vital for the general welfare of the constituents of Jaro, especially the underprivileged. The promotion of public health and safety must remain a priority of the LGU. Hence, the passage of this measure is respectfully sought.

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**ORDINANCE NO. 01**  
**SERIES OF 2025**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN INFIRMARY IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF JARO, LEYTE, TO BE NAMED AS "JARO MUNICIPAL INFIRMARY" AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Jaro, Leyte assembled:

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE** - This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Establishing the Jaro Municipal Infirmary".

**SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE JARO MUNICIPAL INFIRMARY** - There shall be established a government-owned Infirmary of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Jaro, Leyte, classified as Other Health Facility, particularly as a Category A: Primary Care Facility - Infirmary with in-patient beds for Infirmary/Dispensary and Birthing Home and without beds for medical out-patient clinics, OFW clinics and Dental Clinics, as well as Category B: Diagnostic/Therapeutic Facility with a laboratory and ionizing machines, pursuant to the Department of Health (DOH) Administrative Order No. 2012-0012, known as the "Rules and Regulations Governing the New Classification of Hospitals and Other Health Facilities in the Philippines and the DOH-Food and Drug Administration Guidelines on the License To Operate".

**SECTION 3. INFIRMARY PERSONNEL** - The Jaro Municipal Infirmary shall have an adequate number of qualified, trained, and competent staff, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Commission and Republic Act No. 1080, to ensure efficient and effective delivery of quality health care services; hence, the following various Plantilla positions are hereby created to operate the infirmary, as follows:

Provided, that the formulation and recommendation of the duties and functions for the newly created plantilla positions under Section 3 shall be delegated to the Municipal Health Office (MHO), in coordination with the Human Resource Management Office (HRMO), consistent with and subject to the standards and guidelines set by the Civil Service Commission (CSC) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM).

**SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS** - Funding shall be appropriated by the LGU of Jaro, Leyte, as follows:

SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** – If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a competent court, such judgment or provision found to be invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect or impair the other provisions therefore.

**SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE** – All local Ordinance, rules and regulations or parts thereof, inconsistent with, or in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed or amended accordingly.

**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY** – This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after a copy hereof is posted in accordance with the provision of R.A. 7160, in at least four (4) conspicuous places in the municipality.
