



Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through the SP Secretary, the attached Ordinance No. 25-37 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Burauen, Leyte.

Issues/concerns for review/recommendation/legal opinion is/are as follows:

- Ordinance No. 25-37 entitled: “An Ordinance providing for the temporary closure of San Luis St. covering the Burauen Commercial Complex, to give way to the construction of the centralized wastewater treatment facility for the Burauen Public Market, and for other purposes.”

REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:

This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance with its power under Sections 21(a) and (c)¹ of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160). Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.

Please note that the opinion rendered by this Office are based on the facts available and may vary or change when additional facts and documents are presented or changed. This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.

¹ (a) A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park, or square falling within its jurisdiction: Provided, however, That in case of permanent closure, such ordinance must be approved by at least two-thirds (2/3) of all the members of the sanggunian, and when necessary, an adequate substitute for the public facility that is subject to closure is provided.

(c) Any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during an actual emergency, or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs, or an undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and waterworks projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the local chief executive concerned in a written order: Provided, however, That no national or local road, alley, park, or square shall be temporarily closed for athletic, cultural, or civic activities not officially sponsored, recognized, or approved by the local government unit concerned.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SAN LUIS STREET, COVERING THE BURAUEN COMMERCIAL COMPLEX, TO GIVE WAY TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CENTRALIZED WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY FOR THE BURAUEN PUBLIC MARKET, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Burauen is undertaking the construction of a Centralized Wastewater Treatment Facility for the Burauen Public Market to promote public health, sanitation, and environmental protection;

WHEREAS, the temporary closure of a portion of San Luis Street, covering the Burauen Commercial Complex, is necessary to facilitate the safe and efficient construction of the said facility;

WHEREAS, the closure shall be limited to the duration necessary for the construction of the Centralized Wastewater Treatment Facility;

WHEREAS, the project proponent shall coordinate with the Municipal Engineering Office, Green Cops, and other relevant agencies to implement alternative routes and ensure public safety;

WHEREAS, adequate public notice shall be given at least one (1) week prior to the closure to inform the public and affected stakeholders;

WHEREAS, the proponent shall restore the affected road section to its original condition upon completion of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Burauen, Leyte, in session duly assembled:

Section 1. TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE. — Of an area of San Luis Street, in front of the Burauen Commercial Complex, is hereby declared temporarily closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic, effective **August 4, 2025**, until **October 2025**, or until the completion of the construction of the Centralized Wastewater Treatment Facility, whichever comes first.

Section 2. ALTERNATIVE ROUTES. — The project proponent, in coordination with the Municipal Engineering Office, Green Cops, and other relevant agencies, shall implement and clearly mark alternative routes for affected motorists and pedestrians. An alternative route plan, as attached hereto, shall form an integral part of this Ordinance.

Section 3. PUBLIC NOTICE. — Adequate public notice of the temporary road closure and alternative routes shall be given at least one (1) week prior to the effectivity of the closure, through conspicuous posting in public places and other means as may be necessary.

Section 4. RESTORATION OF ROAD. — Upon completion of the project, the proponent shall restore the affected section of San Luis Street to its original condition, subject to inspection and acceptance by the Municipal Engineering Office.


Section 5. ENFORCEMENT. — The Municipal Engineering Office, Green Cops, and the Philippine National Police shall ensure the proper implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance.

Section 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. — If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY. — This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and compliance with publication and posting requirements.


