¹ (a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:

(1) Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government, and in this connection shall:

(ii) Maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion or sedition and impose penalties for the violation of said ordinances;

On motion of Hon. Sarah T. Apurillo duly seconded en masse by all Sangguniang
Members present be it:

“AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE INSTALLATION AND
MAINTENANCE OF CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SYSTEMS IN
ALL BARANGAYS OF ALANGALANG, LEYTE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY,
SECURITY AND CRIME PREVENTION, PROVIDING GUIDELINES
THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”

WHEREAS, public safety and security are primary responsibilities of
the government and essential to the general welfare
of its constituents;

WHEREAS, Senator Win Gatchalian files Senate Bill No. 742,
otherwise known as the “CCTV Act of 2019”, mandating
the installation and use of CCTV systems as a tool to
prevent crime and ensure public safety;

WHEREAS, although Senate Bil No. 742 is still pending in Congress,
its principles and objectives serve as a strong legal and
moral foundation to enact local legislation promoting the
safety of residents;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Alangalang, Leyte through its
Sangguniang Bayan, recognizes the need to strengthen
security measures in all barangays by utilizing
technolgh to support law enforcement and emergency
responses;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Alangalang Leyte in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE

An Ordinance Mandating The Installation And Maintenance Of Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) Systems In All Barangays Of Alangalang, Leyte For Public Safety, Security, and Crime Prevention, Providing Guidelines Thereof And For Other Purposes.

SECTION 2. COVERAGE

This Ordinance shall apply to all 54 barangays in the Municipality of Alangalang, Leyte.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS – For purposes of implementation of this Municipal Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

1. **Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV)** – A video surveillance system that transmits signals to a specific set of monitors, used for monitoring and recording public or private spaces to ensure safety and security.
2. **Barangay CCTV System** – A set of cameras, monitors, recording devices, and other equipment installed by the barangay in public areas for surveillance purposes.
3. **Strategic Areas** – Locations within the barangay identified as prone to crime, public disturbances, or emergencies, including but not limited to barangay halls, entry/exit roads, covered courts, and public spaces.
4. **High-Risk Zones** – Specific areas within the barangay identified by the Barangay Peace and Order Council (BPOC) as requiring additional surveillance due to frequent reports of criminal activity or public safety concerns.
5. **Data Privacy** – The right of individuals to control how their personal data (including visual images) is collected, stored, and used, in accordance with Republic Act No. 10173, also known as the Data Privacy Act of 2012.
6. **Access Authority** – Refers to authorized persons or agencies permitted to view or retrieve CCTV footage, including the Punong Barangay, PNP, Municipal Peace and Order Office, and other government authorities with lawful cause.
7. **Retention Period** – The minimum period during which CCTV footage shall be securely stored, which shall be not less than thirty (30) calendar days from the date of recording.
8. **Resolution** – A formal decision or declaration by the Sangguniang Barangay in support of or in compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. MANDATE

All barangays in Alangalang, Leyte are hereby mandated to install and maintain CCTV systems in the following strategic areas:

- Barangay Halls and vicinity
- Covered courts or public convergence areas
- Entry and exit points of the barangay
- Areas identified by the Barangay Peace and Order Council (BPOC) as high-risk zones

SECTION 5. MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS

CCTV systems to be installed must comply with the following minimum standards:

- Must have high-resolution cameras (minimum 1080p)
- Must have night vision capability
- Minimum of 30-day video storage capacity
- Systems must operate 24/7

SECTION 6. DATA PRIVACY AND ACCESS

All CCTV footage shall be considered confidential and may only be accessed by:

- Punong Barangay or designated officer
- Philippine National Police (PNP)
- Municipal Peace and Order Office
- Other government authorities upon lawful request

Access to footage shall be subject to the provisions of the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (R.A. 10173).

SECTION 8. FUNDING

Barangays may utilize the following sources of funds:

- Barangay Funds (including 20% Development Fund)
- Support from the Local Government Unit of Alangalang, Leyte
- Assistance from National Government Agencies
- Donations and grants from private entities

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, other parts or provisions that are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE

All other ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders or rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 11. . EFFECTIVITY

The provision of this ordinance shall take effect upon approval of the Local Chief Executive.




