



Section 3 (b) of Republic Act No. 11223, Sec. 3 (b) states that "the State shall ensure that all Filipinos are guaranteed equitable access to quality and affordable health care goods and services, and protected against financial risk".

As an initial step towards adopting a comprehensive approach to delivering primary care, PhilHealth has committed through PhilHealth Board Resolution No. 2479, S. 2019 to expand the primary care benefit to cover all Filipinos. The resolution mandated the issuance of PhilHealth Circular (PC) No. 2020-0002 entitled "Governing Policies of the PhilHealth Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama (Konsulta) Package: Expansion of the Primary Care Benefit to cover all Filipinos".

Section IV. B. of the aforementioned policy requires the issuance of applicable rules for member registration and assessment, service package, benefit availment, provider payment mechanism and provider performance assessment.



BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte,


that:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Adopting the Implementing Guidelines for the PhilHealth Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama (PhilHealth Konsulta Package Revision 2) and Establishing the Disposition and Allocation of the Capitation Payments in the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte".

SECTION 2. POLICY - It shall be the policy of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte to fully support and ensure the effective implementation of PhilHealth Circular 2023-0013 entitled Implementing Guidelines for the PhilHealth Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama (PhilHealth Konsulta Package Revision 2).

SECTION 3. PROVIDER PAYMENT MECHANISM

- A. PhilHealth shall pay using the Auto-credit Payment Scheme (ACPS) for services provided under the Konsulta Package (ACPS) for services provided under the Konsulta Package per Phil Health Circular 2023-0013.
- B. Providers may charge fees for services and commodities not included in the benefit package.




















SECTION 4. DISPOSITION AND ALLOCATION OF CAPITATION PAYMENTS


The Capitation reimbursements of the PhilHealth Konsulta Package as per PhilHealth Circular 2023-0013, Part V, Section E Paragraphs I, states that capitation payments shall be utilized to cover all essential services, medicines, and other operating expenses to support the delivery of health care and shall be allocated as follows:

50%	FOR ESSENTIAL SERVICES AND MEDICINES UNDER PHILHEALTH CIRCULAR 2023-0013
	Other Operating Expenses such as but not limited to: 11% Medicines 11% Laboratory reagents, equipment and other logistics 3% hiring of health workers, non-health workers such as encoders 7% Internet subscription, EMR service provider subscription fees, and IT Hardware/equipment 5% Maintenance of Health Facility 5% Acquisition of RHU Vehicle 5% Service Delivery Programs 3% Capacity Building
50%	Performance Incentives for Primary Care Workers and Administrative Staff

Utilization of Funds: In the event of a lack of funding the utilization of funds can be realigned to other operating expenses needed and shall be subject to the discretion of the Accredited Physician.

Staff Sharing Scheme: The sharing of the RHU personnel must be under the discretion of the Accredited Physician, ensuring equality among the staff and must ensure an output-based sharing scheme.

Performance incentives for Rural Health Unit personnel with direct involvement in the implementation of the program shall be given on a payroll basis, as follows:

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or word of this ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, other provisions thereof should not be affected.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, as well as pertinent rules and regulations thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY - This ordinance shall take effect Fifteen (15) days after a copy hereof is posted in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the municipality in accordance with the provision of R.A. 7160.

4. THE 2025 REVISED ORDINANCE ON GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT (GAD) CODE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF JARO, LEYTE.

The Chair gave the floor to Hon. Raul A. Macanda, who moved for the consideration of the above proposed resolutions, which was duly seconded. Thereafter, Hon. Raul A. Macanda, through the Chair requested Ms. Maria Cristina C. Coloma to read the committee report.

The Chair directed Ms. Coloma to proceed with the reading of the Committee Report. After the reading of the committee report of the first two (2) proposed ordinances, Hon. Raul A. Macanda, moved for a five- minute recess, which was duly seconded. The Chair declared a recess at 10:30 a.m.

After the recess, the Chair declared the session resumed at 10:52 a.m. and requested Ms. Coloma to proceed with the reading of the two (2) remaining Committee Reports.



A PROPOSED RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RE-ACCREDITATION OF ACCESS 5, INC. OF JARO, LEYTE.

Hon. Rey P. Aure moved for the approval of the proposed resolution, which was unanimously approved en masse by the Body.

During the discussion, Hon. Francisco R. Altres inquired, based on his reading of the documents of Access 5, Inc., why the 49th member listed was handwritten instead of encoded, and suggested that it should be countersigned.

Hon. Rey P. Aure responded that he believed the 49th member was an insertion. He further stated that he is a member of the said organization but no longer an active member.



The Chair remarked that this organization has the same advocacy as the *Kabalikat*, which had already been accredited as a CSO by the August Body.

The Body, however, responded that *Kabalikat* had not yet applied for CSO accreditation.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja commented that the issue was only minor and that the President of Access 5, Inc. is already known to the Body. He further informed the Body that Access 5, Inc. has made significant contributions to the Municipality. He also mentioned that he was previously a member of the organization's Alangalang Chapter, where he observed its activeness when it comes to the events in the municipality such as during Town Fiesta Celebration, where they provided assistance. He therefore recommended the approval of its accreditation.


Hon. Rey P. Aure added that Access 5, Inc. provides public assistance and communication services during significant events in the municipality, as well as in times of emergency such as disasters. He stressed that the organization has been of great help and urged the Body for the approval of its accreditation.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello said that while he is also a member of the organization, he is already inactive. He added that Access 5 is helping especially disasters and other activities in terms of traffic management. Moreover, he stated that he has no objection to its approval, even though his name still appears in the list of members despite his inactive status.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja suggested that the organization provide valid identification cards for their members.

Hon. Rey P. Aure responded that the organization maintains a roster of officials.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello suggested that the three-year validity period for accreditation was too long and proposed reducing it to one (1) year only, in order to monitor their activities and ensure their continued existence. He also shared his experience with farmers' organizations that were only active while funds were available, hence the need for yearly accreditation.



Hon. Rey P. Aure clarified that under the law, the accreditation of these organizations is term-based, and therefore valid for three (3) years.

The Chair opined and suggested that the validation of these CSOs should nevertheless be conducted annually.

Hon. Raul A. Macanda stated that during the deliberation on the accreditation of the 17 CSOs, he had suggested conducting actual visits to the organizations to verify their existence. He stressed that the SB must allocate time to validate these associations, especially those that are beneficiaries of financial assistance from the government. He also emphasized that the SB should check whether these organizations and their respective Barangay Councils observe parliamentary procedures in their sessions.

The Chair noted that Access 5, Inc. is very active and may be tapped anytime. He also mentioned that he is a member of *Kabalikat*.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello agreed to the suggestion of Hon. Raul A. Macanda and further proposed conducting the validation during Barangay Assemblies for efficiency in both time and resources. He suggested inviting CSOs during these assemblies to check and validate their organizational status.

The Chair concurred to the suggestion of Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello.

Hon. Rey P. Aure stated, before his final motion, that while verification and validation of organizations may be useful in aid of legislation, such tasks are already beyond the duties of the Sangguniang Bayan members, as these organizations have their own Constitution and By-Laws to be follow.



2. The Chair informed the Body of changes in the schedule for the Barangay Assembly in Brgy. Sagkahan on October 4, 2025, since their Punong Barangay, Hon. Tañada will be going to Taiwan. He then requested Mr. Ricky Chu to explain the schedule of activities.

Mr. Ricky Chu emphasized that, as per Ms. Mia Margallo, the activity will be a joint assembly of the Barangay and the *Katipunan ng Kabataan (KK)*. He further explained that the assigned SB Member in each barangay must stay for the entire program of the Barangay Assembly to address constituents' concerns. However, if time permits, they may still proceed to attend the next scheduled Barangay Assembly.

The Chair clarified that all SB Members will go together to the venue of the Barangay Assembly, but the SB Member assigned to that Barangay shall remain until the end of the program.

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala remarked that the matter must first be consulted with the DILG since the Barangay Assembly is primarily focused on barangay matters.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello concurred and emphasized that while it must be clarified with the DILG, the intent is to bring LGU services closer to the people.

Mr. Ricky Chu added that the agencies invited are the Municipal Health Office and the Philippine National Police to focused on HIV Awareness. If there are concerns with the other offices such as the Municipal Treasurer's office, the Barangay itself was the one inviting them to be present during the assembly.

Hon. Teofilo C. Cabello further informed the Body that he will be unable to attend the Barangay Assembly in Barangay Hiagsam as he will be out of town on that day.

4. Hon. Rey P. Aure reminded the SB Secretary to invite as Resource Person, for the committee meeting on Wednesday, Mr. Judy Calabia, Municipal Agriculturist.





Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991 empowered local government to take such measures and pass such ordinances as may be needed to improve the delivery of public services and promote the general welfare.

Section 2 (b) of Republic Act No. 11223 "Universal Health Care Act", states that "the State shall adopt health care model that provides all Filipinos access to a comprehensive set of quality and cost-effective, promotive, preventive, curative, rehabilitative and palliative health services without causing financial hardship, and prioritizes the needs of the population who cannot afford such services".

Section 3 (b) of Republic Act No. 11223, Sec. 3 (b) states that "the State shall ensure that all Filipinos are guaranteed equitable access to quality and affordable health care goods and services and protected against financial risk".

As an initial step towards adopting a comprehensive approach to delivering primary care, PhilHealth has committed through PhilHealth Board Resolution No. 2479, S. 2019 to expand the primary care benefit to cover all Filipinos. The resolution mandated the issuance of PhilHealth Circular (PC) No. 2020-0002 entitled "Governing Policies of the PhilHealth Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama (Konsulta) Package: Expansion of the Primary Care Benefit to cover all Filipinos".

Section IV. B. of the aforementioned policy requires the issuance of applicable rules for member registration and assessment, service package, benefit availment, provider payment mechanism and provider performance assessment.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE PHILHEALTH KONSULTASYONG SULIT AT TAMA (PHILHEALTH KONSULTA PACKAGE REVISION 2) AND ESTABLISHING THE DISPOSITION AND ALLOCATION OF THE CAPITATION PAYMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JARO, LEYTE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Adopting the Implementing Guidelines for the PhilHealth Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama (PhilHealth Konsulta Package Revision 2) and Establishing the Disposition and Allocation of the Capitation Payments in the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte".

SECTION 2. POLICY - It shall be the policy of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte to fully support and ensure the effective implementation of PhilHealth Circular 2023-0013 entitled Implementing Guidelines for the PhilHealth Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama (PhilHealth Konsulta Package Revision 2).

SECTION 3. PROVIDER PAYMENT MECHANISM

- A. PhilHealth shall pay using the Auto-credit Payment Scheme (ACPS) for services provided under the Konsulta Package (ACPS) for services provided under the Konsulta Package per Phil Health Circular 2023-0013.
- B. Providers may charge fees for services and commodities not included in the benefit package.

SECTION 4. DISPOSITION AND ALLOCATION OF CAPITATION PAYMENTS The Capitation reimbursements of the PhilHealth Konsulta Package as per PhilHealth Circular 2023-0013, Part V, Section E Paragraphs I, states that capitation payments shall be utilized to cover all essential services, medicines, and other operating expenses to support the delivery of health care and shall be allocated as follows:

50%	FOR ESSENTIAL SERVICES AND MEDICINES UNDER PHILHEALTH CIRCULAR 2023-0013
	Other Operating Expenses such as but not limited to: 11% Medicines 11% Laboratory reagents, equipment and other logistics 3% Hiring of health workers, non-health workers such as encoders 7% Internet subscription, EMR service provider subscription fees, and IT Hardware/equipment 5% Maintenance of Health Facility 5% Acquisition of RHU Vehicle 5% Service Delivery Programs 3% Capacity Building
50%	Performance Incentives for Primary Care Workers and Administrative Staff

Utilization of Funds: In the event of a lack of funding the utilization of funds can be realigned to other operating expenses needed and shall be subject to the discretion of the Accredited Physician.

Staff Sharing Scheme: The sharing of the RHU personnel must be under the discretion of the Accredited Physician, ensuring equality among the staff and must ensure an output-based sharing scheme.

Performance incentives for Rural Health Unit personnel with direct involvement in the implementation of the program shall be given on a payroll basis, as follows:

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or word of this ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, other provisions thereof should not be affected.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, as well as pertinent rules and regulations thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY - This ordinance shall take effect Fifteen (15) days after a copy hereof is posted in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the municipality in accordance with the provision of R.A. 7160.
