116 Thank you, Mr. Chair. Thank you, Mr. Floor Leader.

117 Mr. Chair, this particular item is a Proposed Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance
118 Institutionalizing the Imposition of Community Service as An Alternative Sanction for Violations
119 of City, Municipal and Barangay Ordinances throughout the Province of Leyte, Defining Its
120 Legal Basis, Applicability, and Implementation Mechanism."

152 HON. CARMEN L. CARI: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, PCL PRESIDENT

153 Mr. Chair, may I be recognized?

154 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

155 Yes, go ahead, Honorable Carmen Cari.

156 HON. CARMEN L. CARI: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, PCL PRESIDENT

157 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

158 This is not an objection. This ordinance is good but it involves the whole Province and I
159 would like to know if there were consultations already with those who will be involved in this
160 ordinance?

161 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

162 Mr. Chair, will you please recognize the Honorable Wilson Uy?

163 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

164 Honorable Uy, you are recognized.

165 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

166 Mr. Chair, actually, there is no direct consultation with the different LGUs in the Province
167 of Leyte but if we notice, upon the review of some ordinances, there are a lot of ordinance
168 emanating from the different LGUs that prescribe community service as their penalty. Since
169 we and Honorable Reposar came up into an idea on how about institutionalizing the Penal
170 Provision of the Community Service because there are many violators that can afford and
171 some LGUs are saying that Community Service is not allowed as a penal provision. So, with
172 this Ordinance, it will now give them guidance on how they will conduct the community service
173 as a penalty. And also, it will be our social justice to our violators that couldn't afford to pay
174 penalty or fine. But this Ordinance that we proposed is in consonance with the laws and guided
175 with our Legal Office. Mr. Chair, maybe our good lawyer, Honorable Reposar, can expound
176 the purpose of this ordinance.

177 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

178 Mr. Chair, may I be recognized?

179 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: 5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

180 Go ahead, Honorable Reposar.

181 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

182 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

183 To answer the query of Honorable Carmen Cari, there was no consultation among
184 different LGUs concerned. It will be impractical to call all Mayors in one venue or proceed to
185 each LGU to present the proposed measure. However, this ordinance will guide the court or
186 the adjudicating body and will provide legal basis for the court to sanction a Community Service
187 since this is just an alternative. We have violators who are poor, first time violators, non violent
188 violators and there are criterias set forth by the ordinance that the court in the event that they
189 see that a violator cannot afford and he is qualified for a Community Service then there's a
190 provision in the ordinance which sets a community service plan but this is just an alternative.
191 So, now the court has legal basis whenever penalizing violators to implement a community
192 service plan for the violator. We are providing a pro poor ordinance and pro poor penalties set
193 forth in this ordinance. So, I hope that answers the query of Honorable Carmen Cari. And in
194 addition, we also made sure that the consitutional guaranteed rights are also protected. Hence,
195 as you can see in the ordinance, there are also safeguards to the accused or violators because
196 we would like to ensure that the ordinance will not violate any constitutional rights of the
197 accused. There's no forced labor in this ordinance. So, this is just to set and provide legal basis
198 to the LGUs and to the court to provide an alternative sanctions in the event that the violator
199 qualifies for such. Thank you.

200 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

201 Honorable Carmen Cari?

202 HON. CARMEN L. CARI: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, PCL PRESIDENT

203 Mr. Chair, is there an IRR on this resolution which is the basis of the implementation
204 later on?

205 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

206 Mr. Chair, may I answer the question?

208 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: 5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

209 Go ahead, Honorable Reposar.

210 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

211 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

212 We shall approve first the ordinance and we can propose implementing rules based on
213 the ordinance. Since the enactment of an IRR is actually an executive function, we can
214 recommend the filing of which if there are provisions that need some details in relation to the
215 implementation of the ordinance, Mr. Chair. We are actually ready for the IRR in the event that
216 the Governor would require one.

217 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

218 Mr. Chair, may I be recognized?

219 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: 5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

220 Go ahead, Honorable Floor Leader.

221 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

222 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

223 Would the distinguished authors yield for some interpellation, Mr. Chair?

224 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

225 Of course, by all means, Mr. Chair.

226 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

227 Thank you.

228 Mr. Chair, I just have a question. Offenses or crimes are committed it two ways, by *dolo*
229 or *culpa*. By *dolo* meaning intent, by *culpa* is by mistake or fault. So, in this case, Mr. Chair,
230 are we saying that violators or offenses of crimes by *dolo* or *culpa* are on even toes and eligible
231 to do community service in lieu of imprisonment or fines? Is that accurate?

232 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

233 Mr. Chair, to answer the query of Honorable Loreto, although this representation is not
234 a lawyer, maybe after my answer, if its not correct, I need the rescue of my co Board Member,
235 Honorable Reposar or Honorable Que.

236 Now, my understanding of this community service in this particular ordinance, it just an
237 alternative but subject to the decision of the court. It is the judge that will decide if ever the
238 violator will qualify to this community service, not the ordinance itself. This ordinance will just
239 pave the way for an alternative penalty. So, all of these will go to the court, not directly that the
240 penalty will be into community service. There's no discretion in the apprehending authority, it
241 always depends to the court.

242 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

243 Mr. Chair, I was asking that question because based on the principle of John Locke's
244 Social Contract Theory, when a person commits a crime, he revoked his right to liberties he
245 enjoys as a freeman. So, if he intentionally commits a crime, for instance, he steals or kills and
246 then there's a penalty, then it will defeat the purpose of penal system if he can easily choose
247 to do community service instead of being imprisoned or being fined so I was thinking, perhaps,
248 if the distinguished authors are amenable, that community service will be applicable only in
249 crimes due to fault or negligence and unintentional or special crimes.

250 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

251 Mr. Chair, if I may?

252 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: 5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

253 Go ahead, Honorable Reposar.

254 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

255 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

256 The decision on the imposing of the community service is not the decision of the violator.
257 It's upon recommendation of the LGU or the adjudicating body which is provided for under
258 Section 4, so, we have set some criteria, although I admit there is not it's a *mala in se* or *dolo*
259 or *culpa*, the violator is still subject for evaluation whether he is qualified for alternative
260 sanction. So, the recommendation will come from the LGU or adjudicating body or the court.
261 So, the violator will still be evaluated whether or not the alternative sanction will warrant.

262 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

263 Mr. Chair, if I may?

264

265 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: 5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

266 Go ahead, Honorable Reposar.

267 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

268 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

269 In that draft ordinance, it is indicated that it is subject to consent of the accused so
270 should the accused be consented first? Or he should apply for the community service option?

271 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

272 He can apply but there should be a recommendation first. So, in the event that he does
273 not consent then the alternative community service sanction will not push through because it
274 will violate his right to involuntarily solitude.

275 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

276 Perhaps, Mr. Chair, the option will be available upon application and then it will be
277 evaluated and there's recommendation, not the other way.

278 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

279 We are amenable to that suggestion, Mr. Chair.

280 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

281 So, for the procedure, Mr. Chair, perhaps, I will join the Honorable Carmen Cari in
282 suggesting that we confer with the different LGUs so that the process will be more practical
283 and ,Perhaps, what we can do instead of calling them all as suggested by Honorable Reposar
284 that will be impractical, maybe we can just send them copies for their comments so in that way
285 we can still get their ideas on how to make a more efficient procedure.

286 Mr. Chair, will you please recognize the Honorable Carmen Cari?

287 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: 5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

288 Honorable Carmen Cari, you are recognized?

289 HON. CARMEN L. CARI: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, PCL PRESIDENT

290 Well, I'm not a lawyer but I think this will affect a lot of people in the Municipalities up to
291 the barangays. This might be used to insult people and might cause problem. This has to be
292 implemented by everybody, the municipality, barangays and the province, of course. So, I think
293 we have to discuss more on this. Thank you.

294 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

295 Mr. Chair, may I please be recognized?

296 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: 5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

297 Honorable que, you are recognized?

298 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

299 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

300 For the members of this August Body, let me just put things in perspective. Let's just
301 say a child violates by stealing something, before community service sets in, he has to be
302 given due process. Once we say due process, there has to be proper charges filed in court
303 then the judge evaluates. And then the judge says "Yes, you are a child felon" or " you indeed
304 stole the watch of that particular person", so, the judge now imposes a fine. I think it will only
305 be then that if the fine is 2,000.00 or not exceeding it, the child will now say "wala kaming pera
306 that's why I stole it", then that's the time this ordinance sets in. It wouldn't be the option of just
307 anybody like the mayor saying "since you only stole this, you can do community service", at
308 the end of the day, that is not the function of the executive but rather the Judiciary Branch of
309 Government. So, lets put this in perspective that this ordinance will only set in after a decision
310 of a Municipal Trial Court Judge is in place. Am I right? Is it correct to the proponent?

311 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

312 Yes.

313 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

314 So, again, we do not violate any constitutional right because the Judicial Branch of
315 Government sets in and then the community service, we are talking of here is just as an
316 alternative that if the decision of the Judge says you will be fined or will be prisoned for how
317 many days then our ordinance sets in and says, wait we have provincial ordinance which gives
318 us the option to do community service which we can now apply. So, maybe this just needs to
319 be refined in the IRR. If this August Body agrees with me, due process is given because there
320 is the right to be heard. This is not imposed in a dictatorship mode. Thank you.

323 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

324 Thank you very much, Honorable Chair and Floor Leader. And mostly, to Honorable
325 Que.

326 That is what I am actually trying to say after the comments of Honorable Carmen Cari
327 that this decision is not coming from the LGUs or Executive Branch or any other instruments
328 of any LGUs but this ordinance will only be applied after the filing of charges in court just like
329 any other ordinances. To reiterate, just like what I was saying a while ago, this will give the
330 court a legal basis to provide or to sanction community service if the violator qualifies. And in
331 addition, we have already actually drafted an implementing rules and regulations but it cannot
332 be presented before this August Body since it is an executive act. So, we'll be presenting that
333 to the Governor.

334 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

335 And also, Mr. Chair, this ordinance is more of minor offenses that can have community
336 service as an alternative penalty. Kun nakamatay ka diri ka puydi magsilhig hin lima ka tuig.

337 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

338 Mr. Chair, may I please be recognized?

339 HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: 5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

340 Honorable Que, you are recognized?

341 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

342 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

343 I just would like to give an example. When I was Mayor in Dulag, we were able to catch
344 4 people who are playing Tong-its. The penalty was 20 days imprisonment. Pumayag naman
345 so they were imprisoned. But there are cases pag ang fine ay mataas na kasi nagnakaw, there
346 is now an option for community service. These are actually for petty crimes, if you see the
347 violations here should not exceed 2,000.00 or imprisonment not exceeding 30 days. So, adto
348 na Tong-its maqualify unta dinhi kay imbis nag-iinukoy hira ha prisohan for 20 days, why not
349 use them. Tong-its for them is just a petty crime. Actually, na agi-an han pulis ha may
350 baybayun nga nagmumulay ngan may piso piso takay anti-illegal gambling naman iton an aton
351 consideration so napriso hin 20 days, takay mga tao ko pagud, so diri mahihimo kay they have

352 to follow the law so priso la anay hra hin 20 days. But this is actually a good alternative because
353 instead of them being in the jail, you can use them magclean within the vicinity. Productive pa
354 and instead na aadto ha jail and papakaunon mo pa. That's all. Thank you.

355 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

356 Mr. Chair, we would like to assure Honorable Carmen Cari that there are mechanisms
357 in place in this ordinance to avoid partisan implementation.

358 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

359 Mr. Chair, I just noticed that in the draft ordinance, it refers to community service as an
360 alternative penalty for violations of City, Municipal and Barangay Ordinance. Perhaps, we can
361 include also Provincial Ordinances?

362 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

363 I'm actually wondering because of the constituency concern. I mean, we already have
364 the municipalities and I don't know how we go about or what Provincial Ordinances would
365 have, since we are fining, most ordinances that we have seen, most of them provides more
366 than 2,000.00 penalties already. So, these are only for small non-violent offenses. So, the
367 Provincial Ordinances provide higher penalties and fines. Then we don't have specific subject
368 constituencies except for the municipalities and barangays.

369 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

370 But then, Provincial Ordinances can also impose lesser penalties. The maximum is
371 5,000.00 but we can impose 1,000.00 or 2000.00. I think there are some ordinances where the

745 the mandatory requirements of Public Hearing and the Publication. Under Sections 186 and
746 187, it is actually a mandatory requirement that for revenue before the enactment of a Revenue
747 Measure or a Tax Ordinance, a Public Hearing shall be conducted. And under Section 188,
748 after 10 days of the enactment, such ordinance shall be posted and be published.

749 If this will guide our LGUs. I'd like to sponsor a Resolution stating, among others that
750 requirements, that should be disseminated to all local government units that before they submit
751 Revenue or Tax Revenue or Tax Ordinances Compliance, they should comply with the
752 requirements under Section 186, 187 and 188 of the Local Government Code because I have
753 observed that other LGUs are actually attaching those evidences or documentary attachments
754 in compliance with the requirements under those sections, Mr. Chair. I'll be happy to draft the
755 resolution. It gets for the guidance of our Local Government Units, Mr. Chair. Thank you very
