

WHEREAS, Constitutionally-declared in Sections 4 and 5, Article II of the **1987 CONSTITUTION** are the *Principles* that the prime duty of the Government is to serve and protect the people and that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty and property, and promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy. Ditto, Constitutionally-enshrined are the *State Policies* in Sections 9, 10 and 11, Article II of the **1987 CONSTITUTION** which, *inter alia*, promote social justice in all phases of national development and a just and dynamic social order, as well, that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the nation and free the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services, promote full employment, a rising standard of living and an improved quality of life for all; which value the dignity of every human person and which guarantee full respect for human rights;;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of **RA 7160**, otherwise known as **THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991** is the authority for the mandate that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare such that, within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation of health and safety, the enhancement of social justice, the maintenance of peace and order, and the preservation of the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section **447 (a) (1) (v)** of **RA 7160**, otherwise known as the **Local Government Code of 1991** expressly provides that the Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the Municipality, shall approve ordinances necessary for the efficient and effective municipal government, and in this connection, *enact ordinances intended to prevent, suppress and impose appropriate penalties for such other activities inimical to the welfare and morals of the inhabitants of the municipality*,

WHEREAS, furthermore, Section **447 (a) (4) (i)** of **RA 7160**, otherwise known as the **LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991** expressly provides that the Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the Municipality, shall enact ordinances for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality, and *shall declare, prevent or abate any nuisance*,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Bayan, Municipality of Alangalang, Province of Leyte, in Regular Session assembled.

**(Page-3-Municipal Ordinance No. 2025-22)
November 5, 2025**

Section 1. This Ordinance shall be cited as the **ANTI-NOISE ORDINANCE OF 2025 FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALANGALANG.**

Section 2. Noise Constituting Nuisance. In addition to the pertinent provisions of Article 694 to Article 707 of the Civil Code of the Philippines, and except as otherwise provided herein, it is hereby declared unlawful as constituting nuisance, the following:

- a. To use loud noise or to make or cause to make a noise by talking loudly, shouting, unnecessary and indiscriminate hammering, sawing, operating machines, and the like, or to play loud music with such intensity as to reasonably cause disturbance or annoyance to the residents of the neighborhood through the use of graphophone, phonograph, radio or any other instrument at any time of day or night. Provided, however, that serenading or the singing of Christmas carols during the Yuletide season shall be allowed not later than the hour of 12:00 o'clock midnight nor earlier than 5:00 o'clock in the morning of the day following. For purposes of this Ordinance, the Yuletide Season shall be for the period between the 16th of December and the 6th of January of the year following;
- b. To improperly use automobile horn or to repeatedly sound any automobile horn while the vehicle is not in motion and in a public street, plaza or other public place, except in so far as may be necessary under the law governing the operation of motor vehicles and warning signals in traffic;
- c. To use loudspeakers, amplifiers, graphophone, phonograph, radio or any other instrument or device outside hotels, restaurants, and other commercial establishments for the purpose of advertising, marketing or sales promotion or outside theaters for the purpose of announcing or reproducing outside thereof the picture or program shown or held therein;

Section 3. Except as herein otherwise provided, music played or the noise generated private residences and in public programs or affairs shall be so modulated in volume so as not to constitute a disturbance or annoyance to the neighborhood or to the public.

Section 4. Permit from the Office of the Municipal Mayor is required before any person, firm or corporation is allowed:

- a. To utilize any string band, orchestra, radio, amplifier, loudspeaker or any device which produce loud noise for the purpose of announcing to the public within the Municipality of Alangalang any business advertisement in connection with the sale, disposition, distribution or exhibition of any article, merchandise, business, picture, show or program;
- b. To hold any dance, program, or exhibition in any public place or building or in case payment is required at the entrance to or for participating in the dance, program or exhibition.

Section 5. Business propaganda made in the manner stated in paragraph (a), Section 4 of this Ordinance shall not be allowed from 1.00 o'clock to 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon and between 10:00 at night to 6:00 in the morning of the day following. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no such announcement and/or music through any of the means mentioned in said Section shall be made or played within a distance of fifty (50meters from any school, court, church, hospital or from the Municipal Hall or the Legislative Building of Alangalang.

Section 6. The permit specified in Section 4 hereof shall be granted upon application in the form required by the Office of the Municipal Mayor and upon payment to the Municipal Treasurer a fee of P500.00 per day the permit is used in accordance with Section 5 hereof.

Section 7. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished upon conviction by a fine of P2,500.00 or imprisonment of not less than one (1) month nor more than six (6) months or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court. In the case of a firm, corporation or a group of persons, the criminal liability shall devolve upon the manager, proprietor or the president thereof, as the case may be.

Section 8. The provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to night clubs, cabarets or dancing schools or to civic, patriotic, or religious announcements, the ringing of church bells, meetings, parades or processions nor to advertisements, announcements or music given or played inside theaters, stadia and other public amusement places.

Section 9. Any and all parts of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions hereof are deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 10. This Ordinance shall be posted at prominent places within the Municipal Hall for a minimum period of three (3) consecutive weeks and shall likewise be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Alangalang. It shall take effect on the day following its publication, or at the end of the period of posting, whichever occurs later.
