RESOLUTION NO. 2025-494

A RESOLUTION APPROVING ON THIRD AND FINAL READING, PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2025-13, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRANSPORT OF QUARRY, SAND, GRAVEL, AND OTHER NATURAL RESOURCES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

WHEREAS, in the transport of quarry, sand, gravel, and other natural resources within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte, environmental protection, the safety of motorists and pedestrians, and accountability are primary considerations and utmost concerns.

WHEREAS, every local government unit has the sworn obligation to enact measures that will enhance, among others, the safety and convenience and promote the general prosperity of the inhabitants of the local units.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion presented by Atty. Carlo P. Loreto, duly seconded by Atty. Ronnan Christian M. Reposar, be it.

RESOLVED to enact, as it is hereby ENACTED on third and final reading, the following:

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2025-13
Series of 2025

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRANSPORT OF QUARRY, SAND, GRAVEL,
AND OTHER NATURAL RESOURCES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF
THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

Section 1. – PROHIBITIVE TRANSPORT TIME - Except upon application and prior authorization from the Office of the Governor or his duly authorized representative, no person, whether natural or juridical, shall operate an inland transport of quarry, sand, gravel, and other natural resources within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte, from **6:00 p.m. up to 8:00 a.m. of the following day.**

Section 2. MANDATORY REQUIREMENT – In the conduct of inland transport of quarry, sand, gravel, and other natural resources within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte, the following shall be strictly observed, to wit:

- a. All inland transport or hauling of quarry, sand, gravel, and other natural resources shall at all times be covered with tarpaulin, also known as "trapal" or "lona" or other similar material, and;
- b. For sealand, whether within or going outside the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte, subject to the application requirement and payment of required fees, the transport of said resources shall, before its departure, be covered by an Ore Transport Permit (OTP) issued by the Office of the Provincial Governor or his duly authorized representative.
- c. Transport of said resources shall at all times be covered by a duly accomplished Delivery Receipt or Official Receipt, as the case may be.

Section 3. PENALTY – Without prejudice to the provisions of the Republic Act No. 7942, otherwise known as the Philippine Mining Act of 1995, Revised Penal Code, and the related laws, rules, regulations, and Ordinances, any person found to be violating this Ordinance *in flagrante delicto*, shall be meted the following:

- a. **FINE** not exceeding Five thousand pesos (P5,000.00);
- b. **IMPOUND** or **CONFISCATE** the subject vehicle, including the loaded quarry, sand or gravel, or other natural resources;
- c. Repetition of similar violation of this Ordinance and after due notice, at the discretion of the Governor, **SUSPEND** or **REVOKE** the concerned Quarry, Sand, and Gravel Permit issued by the Provincial Government of Leyte.

Section 4. Deputization of the PNP – The members of the Leyte Police Provincial Office (LPPO) and/or the concerned Municipal Police Office are hereby deputized to enforce and implement this Ordinance.

Section 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE– Any provision or provisions of this Ordinance declared to be unconstitutional by a competent court, the unaffected portion or portions shall remain valid and shall continue to have the full force and effect of law.

Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE– All Ordinances and other issuances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby amended, modified, or repealed accordingly.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days from publication in a newspaper of general circulation.

PASSED and ENACTED on October 14, 2025 by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled.
