SANGGUNIANG RESOLUTION NO. 270-151225

**RESOLUTION EXPRESSING STRONG OPPOSITION TO THE
DECLARATION OF THE PALOMPON WATERSHED FOREST RESERVE
(PWFR) AS A PROTECTED AREA UNDER THE NATIONAL INTEGRATED
PROTECTED AREAS SYSTEM (NIPAS) ACT, AND INSTEAD FAVORING ITS
DISESTABLISHMENT, INSOFAR AS IT AFFECTS VARIOUS AREAS
WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF PALOMPON, LEYTE**

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. (DENR) conducted a Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) from August 11-16, 2025, and subsequently presented the data collected during a consultation meeting held on October 03, 2025, at the 2nd Floor, Municipal Hall, Palompon, Leyte, as part of the process for the proposed declaration of the Palompon Watershed Forest Reserve (PWFR) under Republic Act No. 11038, otherwise known as the Expanded National Integrated Protected Areas System (E-NIPAS) Act of 2018;

WHEREAS, part of the PWFR lies within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangays Cambacbac, Liberty, Tinubdan, Mabini, and San Joaquin, all within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Palompon, Province of Leyte, and any declaration affecting these areas directly impacts the rights, responsibilities, and welfare of the local community;

WHEREAS, during the said PASA, key informant interviews revealed that 60.75% of respondents expressed negative responses (either strongly disagreed or disagreed) toward the declaration of PWFR as a protected area, citing fears of relocation, disruption of livelihood, and other socio-economic concerns that could adversely affect the communities already mentioned;

WHEREAS, key findings from the data collected through a thorough DENR-led survey during the PASA revealed that the biodiversity within the Palompon Watershed Forest Reserve (PWFR) does not meet the ecological and scientific criteria required for protected area designation, in accordance with the standards set forth in BMB Technical Bulletin No. 2016-04;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Palompon is guided by the Forest Land Use Plan (FLUP), which serves as a strategic framework to efficiently and effectively manage forest and forest lands in accordance with the environmental laws of the Republic of the Philippines, thereby reinforcing their shared commitment to responsible land use, sustainable development, and environmental governance;

WHEREAS, the barangays concerned and the Sangguniang Bayan of Palompon, Leyte respectively have enacted ordinances and policies aligned with national environmental regulations, demonstrating proactive governance and commitment to sustainable resource management;

WHEREAS, in collaboration with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Palompon, and the Barangay Local Government Units (BLGUs) of Barangay Cambacbac, Liberty, Tinubdan, Mabini, and San Joaquin, initiated and implemented local programs focused on environmental protection, conservation, and rehabilitation, further affirming its capacity for responsible ecological stewardship;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that based on the ecological assessment and the criteria outlined in BMB Technical Bulletin No. 2016-04, and the interpretation of the Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) key informant interviews, the Palompon Watershed Forest Reserve (PWFR) does not meet the required standards for protected area designation, and is therefore not suitable to be declared as a protected area under the NIPAS Act;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this resolution be transmitted to the DENR Regional Office, the Provincial Government of Leyte, and other relevant agencies for their information and appropriate action;

RESOLUTION INFORMING SENATOR CYNTHIA VILLAR ON THE REAL STATUS OF PALOMPON WATERSHED FOREST RESERVE AND INTERPOSING OBJECTION ON THE SENATE BILL 2226 "PALOMPON PROTECTIVE LANDSCAPE ACT", FOR THE REASON THAT THE SITE DOES NOT QUALIFY INTO THAT CATEGORY BASED ON CONDUCTED PROTECTED AREA SUITABILITY ASSESSMENT (PASA) BY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIORNMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES REGION 8 (DENR R8) COMPOSITE TEAM"

WHEREAS, Senator Cynthia A. Villar sponsored a Senate Bill 2226 "Palompon Protected Landscape Act, *An Act declaring a parcel of land located in the municipalities of Palompon, Matag-ob and Villaba in the Province of Leyte, a protected area with the category of protected landscape under National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS), to be referred to as The Palomon Protected Landscape , providing for its management , and appropriating funds therefor*" filed last May 23, 2023 with a legislative status "Pending in the Committee";

WHEREAS, as per ground assessment, Palompon Watershed and Forest Reserve (PWFR) has 75% (3,843.926 hectares) of Alienable and Disposable (A&D) lands leaving only 25% of the total area (1 279.611 hectares) in timberland status. Hence, the Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) Composite Team **recommended the disestablishment** of the PWFR as an initial component of the National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS) as it does not anymore conform to the qualifications set forth under section 5 of RA 7586 as amended by RA 11038 otherwise known as the Expanded National Integrated Protected Areas System (**E-NIPAS**) Act;

WHEREAS, during the **PASA** rating activity conducted in a plenary manner using PASA Form 3 with the DENR R8 Composite Team and representatives from the local government units of Palompon, Leyte and Matag-ob, Leyte at DENR R8 Motorpool Building last November 4, 2022, the PWFR was given a failed rating of 47.5 %,

WHEREAS, at the public hearing conducted by DENR R8 Composite Team together with all the direct and indirect stakeholders of PASA in Palompon, Leyte at the NGCP Hall, Town Hall, Palompon, Leyte last April 13, 2023 to concur the recommendation of the PASA Team to disestablish PWFR as an initial component of the NIPAS, the recommendation was unanimously supported by the attending stakeholders;

WHEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED EN MASSED MOTION, to pass a resolution informing Senator Cynthia A. Villar of the status of the barangays under Palompon Watershed and Forest Reserve (PWFR) and interposing objection on the Senate Bill 2226 "Palompon Protected Landscape Act" for the reason that the site does not qualify into that category based on the conducted Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Region 8 (DENR R8) Composite Team;
