EXPLANATORY NOTE

This proposed ordinance seeks to establish the **“Pasidungog ha Three (3)-Termer Punong Barangay”** in the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte — a ceremonial and institutionalized form of recognition for Punong Barangays who have completed three (3) full consecutive terms of service.

Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), also known as the General Welfare Clause, empowers every local government unit to exercise such powers and discharge such functions as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective governance. This includes the promotion of general welfare and the recognition of exemplary public service.

As the basic political unit, the barangay serves as the frontline of government operations, directly influencing the daily lives of constituents. At the helm of each barangay is the Punong Barangay, whose leadership is instrumental in implementing policies, maintaining peace and order, delivering basic services, and promoting grassroots development.



Completing three (3) full consecutive terms as Punong Barangay is not only a rare achievement but also a clear reflection of the people's sustained trust and confidence in the individual's capacity to serve. It demonstrates a long-standing commitment to public service, resilience in governance, and dedication to community development.

The enactment of this ordinance aims to institutionalize a formal system of acknowledgment through the "Pasidungog ha Three-Termer Punong Barangay." This program shall confer honors to qualified barangay captains, fostering a culture of integrity, excellence, and good governance at the barangay level. It also seeks to inspire other local leaders to uphold the highest standards of public service.

Finally, the ordinance includes an appropriation of funds to ensure the sustainability and solemnity of this recognition program, affirming the Municipal Government of Jaro's commitment to celebrate the exemplary service of its community leaders.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE "PASIDUNGOG HA THREE (3) -

EXEMPLARY SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY, AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Jaro, Leyte assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Pasidungog ha
Three (3)- Termer Punong Barangay Ordinance of the Municipality of Jaro,
Leyte."

SECTION 2. STATEMENT OF POLICY - The Municipality of Jaro, Leyte
recognizes the value and impact of grassroots leadership and hereby honors Barangay
Captains who have completed three (3) consecutive terms of service for their
commitment, integrity, and contribution to community development.

SECTION 3. OBJECTIVES. This Ordinance seeks to:

- A. Provide formal recognition to Punong Barangays who served three
full consecutive terms;
- B. Promote good governance, leadership excellence, and public service
commitment at the barangay level; and
- C. Inspire future leaders by giving due honor to long-serving officials.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of this Ordinance, the
following terms shall be defined as follows:

- A. **Pasidungog** - A Visayan term meaning "tribute" or "honor" In this ordinance, it refers to the ceremonial and formal recognition given to qualified Punong Barangays.
- B. **Punong Barangay (Barangay Captain)** - The elected head of a barangay who performs executive, administrative, and supervisory functions within their jurisdiction.
- C. **Three-Termer** - A Punong Barangay who has served three (3) consecutive full terms, each term comprising three (3) years, as mandated by law.
- D. **Token of Appreciation** - A symbolic gift or item (monetary or non-monetary) awarded in recognition of outstanding public service, not constituting a salary or pension benefit.
- E. **Qualified Awardees** - Punong Barangays who have verifiably completed three consecutive full terms of service, without interruption, disqualification, or removal from office.
- F. **MLGOO** - Municipal Local Government Operations Officer of the DILG assigned to oversee and coordinate local governance compliance and technical assistance.

SECTION 5. COVERAGE - This Ordinance shall apply to all Punong Barangays within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte who have served three (3) consecutive full terms as defined above.

SECTION 6. NATURE OF AWARD - Qualified awardees shall receive:

- A. A Plaque of Recognition;
- B. A Certificate of Appreciation;
- C. Cash Award or Token of Gratitude (subject to availability of funds);
and
- D. Public recognition during a formal ceremony.

The awarding may be conducted every three years or aligned with the Municipal Foundation Day or similar significant event.

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING PROCEDURE - The following procedure shall govern the implementation of the Pasidungog ha Three (3) -Termer Punong Barangay program:

A. Identification and Initial Verification

1. The Barangay Secretary, under the guidance of the Barangay Council, shall submit documentation for any Punong Barangay believed to have served three (3) consecutive terms.
2. Each submission must include:
 - a. Full name of the Punong Barangay
 - b. Barangay and municipality affiliation
 - c. Term duration for each of the three consecutive terms
 - d. Certification from the Barangay Council on continuous
 - e. service
 - f. Copy of election results or certificate of election per term (if available)

B. Validation and Certification

1. The Municipal Local Government Operations Officer (MLGOO)
2. shall validate submissions based on official records and service
3. history.
4. A Certified List of Qualified Three (3)-Termer Punong Barangays shall be prepared by the MLGOO.

C. Submission to the Office of the Mayor

1. The MLGOO shall submit the final list, along with supporting documentation, directly to the Office of the Municipal Mayor.
2. Upon receipt, the Mayor shall review and issue the Executive Approval for the implementation of the recognition program.



D. Implementation and Recognition Ceremony

1. The Office of the Mayor, in coordination with the MLGOO, Municipal Administrator and the Liga ng mga Barangay, shall organize the Pasidungog Ceremony.
2. Awardees shall receive:
 - a. A Plaque of Recognition
 - b. Certificate of Appreciation
 - c. Cash Award or token of gratitude (subject to availability of funds)

E. Record-Keeping and Reporting. The MLGOO shall maintain a record of all honorees.

SECTION 8. FUNDING. An initial amount of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 100,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the available funds of the Municipal Government of Jaro, Leyte. This amount shall cover the production of plaques, tokens, event logistics, meals, and other expenses necessary for the implementation of the program. Subsequent funding shall be included in the annual municipal appropriations.

SECTION 9. IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING. The Office of the Mayor shall be the lead implementing office, in close coordination with Liga ng mga Barangay, and the MLGOO.




SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations or any part thereof inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after a copy hereof is posted in accordance with the provision of R.A. 7160, in at least four (4) conspicuous places in the municipality.

The Chair opines and directed Ms. Togonon to proceed to read the committee report. And after it has been read the Chair asks from the Body for any corrections thereto, and hearing none from the floor, request Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja to offer the final motion for its adoption.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja took the floor and then moves for the final adoption of the committee report, duly seconded en masse.

And then after the Chair declared that for Item No. 1, under the committee report, it has been moved, carried and approved en masse by the Body.

Hon. Francisco R. Altres, manifest that Hon. Rey P. Aure is absent, suggested for the Vice Committee Chairman the Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja to offer the motion in lieu of Hon. Rey P. Aure.

The Chair opines in as much that the Vice Committee Chairman is present, request the Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja to offer the motion.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja took the floor and then manifest that for and in behalf of Hon. Rey P. Aure, he is offering the proposed resolution, and it was duly seconded by Hon. Francisco R. Altres. And then after the Chair declare the plenary discussions.

Hon. Francisco R. Altres took the floor and then reiterates the information given by Miss Thelma B. Arguelles-Tourism Officer, that there was an Investigation Report/Evaluation of Tigbao Hotspring located at Brgy. Rubas, dated July 6, 2021.

The recommendation of the DENR is for the "Temporary Closure" of the Tigbao Hotspring for the safety of everyone (local and tourist users) until the new pools and cottages will be built at a safe area and will be operated, for the riverbank of the Tigbao Hot Spring is prone to soil erosion or landslide.

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala opines that she has the occasion to meet the Punong Barangay of Rubas, Hon. Teresita R. Albonida, that she was given the copy of the DENR-Hazzard Assessment and Evaluation Report of Tigbao Hotspring, and the DENR recommendations is for its "Temporary Closure" to the public (tourists), until such time the pools and cottages will be built/transferred in a safe area.

Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., opines and asks if (1) there is a need for a Barangay Resolution as a requirement for re-accreditation, (2) and if residents from another barangay are allowed to be a member of the Tigbao Hotspring. For according to Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., review on the documents of Tigbao Hot Spring Association, there are members which are not a resident of Barangay Rubas.



The Chair opines and said that the inquiry of Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., may be addressed to the new CSO Desk Officer, Mr. Hubert Keith B. Vega, for he is newly appointed CSO Desk Officer.

Hon. Raul A. Macanda opines and then suggested to the Body that the re-accreditation of the Amandewing Hotspring Tourism and Agri-Farmers Association, shall be referred first to the committee for review, in order to verify if the association has already complied the DENR recommendations, indicated in the notice of Temporary Closure, and all the inquiries of the SB members could be answered.

Further, Hon. Raul A. Macanda said that the SB shall be cautious in granting the re-accreditation, for the safety of the Sanggunian to prevent any legal entanglements in the future, because the Sanggunian has committed an error.

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala opines and said that she concurs to the suggestions of Hon. Raul A. Macanda, to conduct first a committee meeting before the SB will approve the application for re-accreditation of the association, so that, all the concerns of the SB will be answered.

The Chair opines that as far as he knows the LGU-Jaro, through the office of the Local Chief Executive, has offered assistance to the association, however it did not materialize for unknown reasons, resulting to non-compliance of the association of the recommendation of the DENR, for it would require a considerable amount.



Hon. Alma A. Tamayo opines that she concurs to the suggestions of the SB members to refer to the committee level, the application for re-accreditation of the association for review before the Sanggunian will enact the resolution for its approval.




Further, Hon. Alma A. Tamayo said that the information given by Hon. Francisco R. Altres is true for it was discuss by Miss Thelma B. Arguelles-Tourism Officer during the Budget Hearing in Sabin Resort, Ormoc City, that there was a DENR Notice for temporary closure of the Hot Spring, and the Sangguniang Barangay through Punong Barangay Hon. Teresita R. Albonida has been furnish the copy of the notice. But according to Punong Barangay Hon. Albonida, despite such notice for temporary closure, the owner Mr. Reynaldo Batis, still continue to operate the Hot Spring and its facility. She also suggests to defer first the approval of the re-accreditation of the association after the committee meeting has been conducted.

Hon. Raul A. Macanda speaks out that the opinion of Hon. Alma A. Tamayo is in order, that there is a need to defer first the approval of the re-accreditation, for the Sangguniang Bayan to verify if indeed there were violations on the part of the owner/proprietor in operating the facility, for if there is, perhaps the Sanggunian shall refrain from approving the application for re-accreditation of the association.

Hon. Benjamin H. Gariando, Jr., speaks out that it is understood, the Sangguniang Bayan will only approve seventeen (17) application for accreditation and for the Amandewing Hotspring Tourism and Agri-Farmers Association is being deferred until the SB could conduct the committee meeting.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja opines that on his view, the Amandewing Hotspring Tourism and Agri-Farmers Association is being deferred until the SB could conduct the committee meeting.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja opines that on his view, the Amandewing Hotspring Tourism and Agri-Farmers Association is a small-scale enterprise, and its owner/proprietor perhaps has limited resources to comply the mandate of the DENR, therefore, there is a need for the LGU interventions in order to rehabilitate the area, in accordance to the specifications contained in the notice of "Temporary Closure" issued by the DENR, so that, they could operate a safe tourism site.



Hon. Francisco R. Altres opines that as far as he can remember, when the association has been called a dialogue by the previous Sanggunian, there was an offer to the owner Mr. Reynaldo Batis for partnership between the LGU to develop the tourism site, considering that it is a potential tourist destination in the LGU, however, according to Hon. Francisco R. Altres the owner (Mr. Reynaldo Batis) did not agree to the offer.

In addition, thereto, the Chair said that the information of Hon. Francisco R. Altres is correct for there was indeed an offer for partnership between the LGU and the association to develop the tourism site, but it did not materialized.

Hon. Alma A. Tamayo opines that she concurs to the opinion of Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja, that the development of the Amandewing Hotspring would require a huge amount, that perhaps the association in this point in time cannot provide the financial requirement, being new to the tourism industry, and that she agrees that a committee meeting should be conducted with the presence of the officials/owners of the association, so that the problem could be resolved, and most likely to push through the negotiations for partnership between the LGU and the association to develop the tourism site.

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala, speaks out that the propositions of the SB members, most likely will resolved the issue/problem on the operation of the Amandewing Hotspring, and a dialogue with the association is necessary to find the solution to comply the mandate of the DENR, and probably the association will be willing to partner with the LGU or other stakeholders for the development of the tourism site.

Hon. Raul A. Macanda speaks out and then suggests to the Committee on Tourism Chaired by Hon. Alma A. Tamayo and the Committee on Agriculture and Accreditation, Chaired by Hon. Rey P. Aure, to see to it that all officials of the association, shall attend the committee meeting, so that their problem in the compliance to the DENR recommendations will be resolved.

The Chair opines and asks Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja, on the schedule of the committee meeting, with the appearance of all the officials of the association.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja said that for and in behalf of Hon. Rey P. Aure, he is proposing to conduct the committee meeting on September 15, 2025, at 1:00 P.M., and suggest to invite the following resource persons, namely:




This proposed ordinance seeks to establish the “Pasidungog ha Three (3)-Termer Punong Barangay” in the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte — a ceremonial and institutionalized form of recognition for Punong Barangays who have completed three (3) full consecutive terms of service.

Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), also known as the General Welfare Clause, empowers every local government unit to exercise such powers and discharge such functions as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective governance. This includes the promotion of general welfare and the recognition of exemplary public service.


As the basic political unit, the barangay serves as the frontline of government operations, directly influencing the daily lives of constituents. At the helm of each barangay is the Punong Barangay, whose leadership is instrumental in implementing policies, maintaining peace and order, delivering basic services, and promoting grassroots development.

Completing three (3) full consecutive terms as Punong Barangay is not only a rare achievement but also a clear reflection of the people’s sustained trust and confidence in the individual’s capacity to serve. It demonstrates a long-standing commitment to public service, resilience in governance, and dedication to community development.


The enactment of this ordinance aims to institutionalize a formal system of acknowledgment through the “Pasidungog ha Three-Termer Punong Barangay.” This program shall confer honors to qualified barangay captains, fostering a culture of integrity, excellence, and good governance at the barangay level. It also seeks to inspire other local leaders to uphold the highest standards of public service.



Finally, the ordinance includes an appropriation of funds to ensure the sustainability and solemnity of this recognition program, affirming the Municipal Government of Jaro's commitment to celebrate the exemplary service of its community leaders.

**ORDINANCE NO. 03
SERIES OF 2025**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE "PASIDUNGOG HA THREE (3) -
TERMER PUNONG BARANGAY" IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JARO, LEYTE,
RECOGNIZING THREE-TERMER PUNONG BARANGAYS FOR THEIR
EXEMPLARY SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY, AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Jaro, Leyte assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Pasidungog ha
Three (3)- Termer Punong Barangay Ordinance of the Municipality of Jaro,
Leyte."

SECTION 2. STATEMENT OF POLICY - The Municipality of Jaro, Leyte
recognizes the value and impact of grassroots leadership and hereby honors Barangay
Captains who have completed three (3) consecutive terms of service for their
commitment, integrity, and contribution to community development.

SECTION 3. OBJECTIVES. This Ordinance seeks to:

- A. Provide formal recognition to Punong Barangays who served three
full consecutive terms;
- B. Promote good governance, leadership excellence, and public service
commitment at the barangay level; and
- C. Inspire future leaders by giving due honor to long-serving officials.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of this Ordinance, the
following terms shall be defined as follows:

- A. **Pasidungog** - A Visayan term meaning "tribute" or "honor." In this ordinance, it refers to the ceremonial and formal recognition given to qualified Punong Barangays.
- B. **Punong Barangay (Barangay Captain)** - The elected head of a barangay who performs executive, administrative, and supervisory functions within their jurisdiction.
- C. **Three-Termer** - A Punong Barangay who has served three (3) consecutive full terms, each term comprising three (3) years, as mandated by law.
- D. **Token of Appreciation** - A symbolic gift or item (monetary or non-monetary) awarded in recognition of outstanding public service, not constituting a salary or pension benefit.
- E. **Qualified Awardees** - Punong Barangays who have verifiably completed three consecutive full terms of service, without interruption, disqualification, or removal from office.
- F. **MLGOO** - Municipal Local Government Operations Officer of the DILG assigned to oversee and coordinate local governance compliance and technical assistance.

SECTION 5. COVERAGE - This Ordinance shall apply to all Punong Barangays within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte who have served three (3) consecutive full terms as defined above.

SECTION 6. NATURE OF AWARD - Qualified awardees shall receive:

- A. A Plaque of Recognition;
- B. A Certificate of Appreciation;
- C. Cash Award or Token of Gratitude (subject to availability of funds);
and
- D. Public recognition during a formal ceremony.

The awarding may be conducted every three years or aligned with the Municipal Foundation Day or similar significant event.

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING PROCEDURE - The following procedure shall govern the implementation of the Pasidungog ha Three (3) -Termer Punong Barangay program:

A. Identification and Initial Verification

1. The Barangay Secretary, under the guidance of the Barangay Council, shall submit documentation for any Punong Barangay believed to have served three (3) consecutive terms.
2. Each submission must include:
 - a. Full name of the Punong Barangay
 - b. Barangay and municipality affiliation
 - c. Term duration for each of the three consecutive terms
 - d. Certification from the Barangay Council on continuous
 - e. service
 - f. Copy of election results or certificate of election per term (if available)

B. Validation and Certification

1. The Municipal Local Government Operations Officer (MLGOO)
2. shall validate submissions based on official records and service
3. history.
4. A Certified List of Qualified Three (3)-Termer Punong Barangays shall be prepared by the MLGOO.

C. Submission to the Office of the Mayor

1. The MLGOO shall submit the final list, along with supporting documentation, directly to the Office of the Municipal Mayor.
2. Upon receipt, the Mayor shall review and issue the Executive Approval for the implementation of the recognition program.

D. Implementation and Recognition Ceremony

1. The Office of the Mayor, in coordination with the MLGOO, Municipal Administrator and the Liga ng mga Barangay, shall organize the Pasidungog Ceremony.
2. Awardees shall receive:
 - a. A Plaque of Recognition
 - b. Certificate of Appreciation
 - c. Cash Award or token of gratitude (subject to availability of funds)

E. Record-Keeping and Reporting. The MLGOO shall maintain a record of all honorees.

SECTION 8. FUNDING. An initial amount of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 100,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the available funds of the Municipal Government of Jaro, Leyte. This amount shall cover the production of plaques, tokens, event logistics, meals, and other expenses necessary for the implementation of the program. Subsequent funding shall be included in the annual municipal appropriations.

SECTION 9. IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING. The Office of the Mayor shall be the lead implementing office, in close coordination with Liga ng mga Barangay, and the MLGOO.


SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations or any part thereof inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after a copy hereof is posted in accordance with the provision of R.A. 7160, in at least four (4) conspicuous places in the municipality.
