

PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, Barangay Councilors play a vital role in grassroots governance, local legislation, community development, and the delivery of essential services in their barangays;

WHEREAS, there is a need to institutionalize a formal organization of Barangay Councilors within the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte to strengthen coordination, enhance capacity development, and ensure representation in local policy formulation;

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Barangay Councilors’ League (BCL) shall promote unity, camaraderie, continuous learning, and collective action among Barangay Councilors in the Municipality;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 authorizes the creation of local leagues and organizations that support and enhance the roles of local government officials;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SB Member Fernando M. Aseo, duly seconded by all the Sangguniang Bayan Members present, be it ordained:

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE BARANGAY COUNCILORS’ LEAGUE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF KANANGA, LEYTE

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as the **“Charter of Barangay Councilors’ League of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte.”**

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

It is the policy of the Municipality of Kananga to:

- a. Recognize the vital role of Barangay Councilors in local governance, public service delivery, and community development;
- b. Support, capacitate, and empower Barangay Councilors to become effective, responsive, and accountable public servants;
- c. Institutionalize a mechanism for consultation, policy advocacy, leadership development, and coordination through the formation of the **Barangay Councilors’ League (BCL)**;
- d. Promote their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being; and
- e. Inculcate patriotism, nationalism, and civic responsibility aligned with national and local development goals.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

For purposes of this Ordinance:

- a. **Barangay Councilors' League (BCL)** – refers to the officially recognized organization of all elected and duly appointed Sangguniang Barangay members in the Municipality of Kananga.
- b. **Sangguniang Barangay Councilor** – a duly elected member of the Sangguniang Barangay during the regular Barangay Elections, or those lawfully appointed in the case of vacancy.
- c. **League** – a collective organization of Barangay officials formed for a common purpose, advocacy, or interest.

SECTION 4. OBJECTIVES OF THE BCL.

The Barangay Councilors' League shall aim to:

- a. Promote the welfare, professional growth, and development of all Barangay Councilors;
- b. Provide a platform for consultation, legislative advocacy, and policy formulation;
- c. Facilitate training, seminars, leadership programs, and capability-building initiatives;
- d. Strengthen unity, cooperation, and coordination among all Barangay Councilors in the Municipality;
- e. Foster linkages, partnerships, and collaboration with local, regional, and national organizations.

SECTION 5. MEMBERSHIP.

All elected and duly appointed Sangguniang Barangay members (*also known as Barangay Councilor or Barangay Kagawad*) in the Municipality of Kananga are members of the Barangay Councilors' League.

SECTION 6. FEES.

Every member of the Barangay Councilors' League shall pay the following fees:

- a. Membership fee of ₱200.00 to be paid only once;
- b. Annual dues of ₱500.00 to be paid on the first meeting of the year;
- c. A registration fee shall be collected from each member or individual attending a meeting, activity, or assembly called for by the League, the amount of which shall be determined by the President of the League, subject to the guidelines set forth in DBM National Budget Circular No. 563 dated April 22, 2016 and such other subsequent issuances for the said purpose; and
- d. Other fees as may be deemed necessary by the League.


SECTION 7. MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING.


A member in good standing is one who has fully paid all required fees, including the membership fee, annual dues, registration fee, and any assessments set by the Board of Directors. In addition, a member in good standing must fulfill all responsibilities and obligations of membership and must regularly attend the League or its Committee's meetings, assemblies, or conventions at least 3 times a year.

SECTION 8. LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP.

Membership to the BCL shall automatically be lost for any of the following grounds or circumstances:

- a. Death;




- b. Conviction of any crime involving moral turpitude or any offense which is incompatible with being a member of the League;
- c. Commission of any act contrary to and in violation of the purposes and objectives of the League;
- d. Willful nonpayment of annual dues and such special assessments as are duly approved by the Board of Directors;
- e. Resignation, separation, and/or termination from office; and
- f. Such other causes as would render impossible for the member to comply with the obligations to the BCL.

Any member who is complained of due to ground stated in paragraphs c and d, shall be required in writing to comment or explain why he or she should not be suspended, removed or expelled. The said member shall be required to comment or answer in writing citing his/her reasons, which is to be made within the period of 72 hours from the receipt of the letter.

From then, the Board may take decision based on the allegations and supporting documents, with due consideration of the answer provided by the member.

SECTION 9. LEAGUE OFFICERS.

There shall be a set of officers of the League who shall be elected through a general assembly of all the Barangay Councilors in the Municipality of Kananga, which are as follows:

1. President
2. Vice-President
3. Secretary
4. Treasurer
5. Auditor
6. Public Relations Officer (PRO)
7. Sergeant-at-Arms
8. Board of Directors (7) – Shall be composed of the duly elected presidents of the Committees

Roles and Responsibilities

Within **ninety (90) days** after the Barangay Elections, the BCL President shall convene all Barangay Councilors in the Municipality to elect a new set of officers through consensus or secret balloting.

Duties and responsibilities of the officers

A. President

1. Serve as the highest executive officer of the League;
2. Implement and enforce all resolutions, plans, and objectives of the League;
3. Preside over all meetings and activities;
4. Represent the League in official functions.



B. Vice-President


1. Assume the duties of the President in case of death, resignation, incapacity, suspension, or removal;
2. Assist the President in implementing programs and activities.

C. Secretary

1. Maintain records of meetings, correspondence, and official documents;





2. Issue notices of meetings and activities;
3. Certify officers and members;
4. Perform duties as assigned by the President.

D. Treasurer

1. Manage and safeguard League funds and properties;
2. Receive, collect, and disburse League funds in accordance with accounting rules;
3. Submit monthly and annual financial reports;
4. Perform related functions as authorized.

E. Auditor

1. Conduct periodic auditing of financial transactions;
2. Ensure financial integrity and compliance;
3. Recommend measures to protect League assets.

F. Public Relations Officer (PRO)

1. Disseminate information on League activities and programs;
2. Manage communication and public relations initiatives.

G. Sergeant-at-Arms

1. Maintain order and decorum during meetings and official gatherings;
2. Perform duties as may be assigned by the President.

H. Board of Directors

1. Set the association's vision, mission, and strategic direction.
2. Establish and approve policies, plans, and major organizational decisions.
3. Provide financial oversight and ensure responsible use of resources.
4. Ensure compliance with legal, ethical, and governance standards.
5. Oversee the performance of officers and committees.
6. Represent the interests of members and ensure transparent communication.

GENERAL POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE LEAGUE

The BCL shall:

1. Formulate policies to fulfill its goals and objectives;
2. Adopt Internal Rules of Procedure (IRP);
3. Implement programs and activities for the welfare and development of members;
4. Create committees as necessary;
5. Conduct fundraising activities, subject to existing laws;
6. Establish partnerships and linkages with organizations and institutions;
7. Promote camaraderie and cooperation among members;
8. Deliberate and resolve issues affecting the League;
9. Administer its funds and properties;
10. Ensure all Barangay Councilors undergo capacity-building activities;
11. Hold year-end awards and recognition for outstanding members.

SECTION 10. ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

Within **ninety (90) days** after the Barangay Elections, the incumbent BCL President shall convene all Barangay Councilors in the Municipality to elect a new set of officers through consensus or secret balloting.

Election Process

A. Election Committee

A neutral Election Committee will be formed, composed of three (3) members who are not running for any position. This committee will oversee and facilitate the election.

Members of the Election Committee shall be elected from among the members of League whose functions and term shall end right after the election.

B. Campaign Period:

A short campaign period of 2-3 days will be given to the candidates to introduce themselves and share their platforms with the League.

Campaigns may be done via in-person, online, or any practical modes. They must follow ethical guidelines and avoid slander, bribery, or any form of unfair practice.

C. Election Day

- Elections shall be conducted during a scheduled League meeting or assembly.
- A secret ballot system will be used to maintain the anonymity of voters.
- Each voter will receive a ballot paper listing the candidates for each position.

D. Voting Procedures

- Voters must mark their choice for each position by ticking the box next to the candidate's name.
- Completed ballots will be placed in a secured ballot box, managed by the Election Committee.

E. Counting of Votes

- After voting concludes, the Election Committee will publicly count the votes.
- Each ballot will be carefully reviewed, and votes for each candidate will be tallied.
- Any ballot that contains multiple marks for the same position, unclear markings, or extraneous comments will be considered invalid.
- The Election Committee shall resolve any dispute or ambiguity regarding ballots cast.

F. Proclamation of Winners:




- The candidate with the highest number of votes for each position will be declared the winner.
- In case of a tie, a toss coin or draw-by-lot will be conducted for that specific position.

G. Post-Election Protocol

H. Announcement of Results:

Election results will be officially announced immediately after the vote count.

I. Oath of Office:



Elected officers will take an oath of office right after the proclamation committing to uphold their responsibilities. The EC shall prepare the oaths of office.

J. Transition Period:

- Outgoing officers, if any, will assist in the smooth transition of duties to the newly elected officers.
- Outgoing officers shall turn over properties, equipment, documents, and other similar instruments to the incoming officers

K. Election Disputes

Filing a Complaint and Resolution:

- Any protest, dispute, concern, complaint, or question about the conduct of the election must be raised orally before the winners are proclaimed, and the EC shall address and resolve it immediately.
- The decision of the Election Committee shall be final, binding, and irrevocable, and cannot be appealed.

L. Special Elections In Case of Vacancy:

- If a position becomes vacant during the term, a special election will be held to fill the position.
- The same election process will be followed, with a shortened timeline.
- If a vacancy occurs in the office of the president, the vice president shall automatically assume the presidency in accordance with the rule of succession, without the need for an election, and shall serve only the remainder of the term.
- If the vacancy is in the other offices or positions, special elections shall be conducted.
- Newly-elected officers as a result of this shall serve only the remaining portion of the term.

SECTION 11. TERM OF OFFICE.




All officers of the BCL shall serve a term co-terminus with their elective barangay positions unless removed for cause, incapacitated, resigned, or deceased.

SECTION 12. CREATION OF STANDING COMMITTEES AND THEIR COMPOSITION.

There shall be seven (7) standing committees within the League. Each Barangay Councilor who serves as the chairperson of any of these committees in his or her respective barangay shall, by virtue of such position, automatically become a member of the corresponding League committee.

- A. Committee on Education and Tourism
- B. Committee on Appropriations, Finance, Ways and Means, and Rules
- C. Committee on Women, Family, Children, Senior Citizens, and PWDs
- D. Committee on Peace and Order, Public Safety, and Transportation
- E. Committee on Cooperative Development, Trade and Industry, Agriculture, Livelihood, and Socio-Economic Affairs
- F. Committee on Infrastructure
- G. Committee on Environmental Protection, Health, and Sanitation

SECTION 13. COMMITTEE OFFICERS.

The members of each of the Standing Committees shall elect their committee president. The committee president or upon the call of the majority of the committee members may hold and conduct meeting to be attended by the committee members themselves, without the need of the approval of the League President. The Committee can independently transact business as long as it is within the goals and objectives of the League. The Committee may elect their own officers, which are as follows:

- a. President
- b. Vice-President
- c. Secretary
- d. Treasurer
- e. Auditor
- f. Public Information Officer (PIO)
- g. Business Manager

In spite of the granted autonomy, each committee, thru its president, is required to submit Annual Report to the League to be submitted not later than December 31 of each calendar year.

SECTION 14. MEETINGS AND QUORUM.

Regular Meetings

The League or any of its Committee shall convene **at least once every quarter** or as often as necessary.

Special Meetings

Special meetings may be called for by the President of the League, or upon the order of the majority of the Board of Directors, or upon written request of at least 1/3 of the members.

Quorum

The presence of one-half plus one of the total members in good standing shall constitute a quorum.

Notices



Notices regarding the time and location of assemblies, meetings, special meetings, and other League activities shall be communicated through modern means such as email, group chats, social media or online platforms, and text, voice, or video calls. These notices may be in the form of a letter detailing the purpose, time, place, registration fee, and other relevant information, or as a program of activities.

Order of Business

The order of business of the assembly or meeting shall conform to the following:

- a. Call to order;
- b. Roll call;
- c. Presentation of the proof of the required notice of meeting;
- d. Consideration of the minutes of the previous meeting/assembly;
- e. Reports of officers;
- f. Unfinished business;
- g. New business;
- h. Other matters;
- i. Adjournment.

SECTION 15. REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES.



League officers and members shall be entitled to reimbursement of authorized transportation, travel, and training expenses chargeable to their respective Barangay Funds, subject to existing auditing rules and regulations pursuant to R.A. 7160.

SECTION 16. RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS.

Members in good standing shall enjoy the following:

- a. Participation in all League activities;
- b. Access to League programs and services;
- c. The right to vote and to be elected to any League position;
- d. Use of League facilities, where available;
- e. Enjoyment of other rights provided by law or by the League.

SECTION 17. CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING.

The Local Government Unit (LGU) shall conduct annual capacity-building programs, seminars, and training activities for all members of the Barangay Councilors' League.

SECTION 18. SOURCE OF FUNDS.

The financial requirements for the operation of the League shall be sourced from:

- a. Municipal General Fund;
- b. Contribution from Barangay Budget;
- c. Membership Fees and Annual Dues;
- d. Other lawful sources.

SECTION 19. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 20. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All ordinances, rules, and regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 21. EFFECTIVITY.

This Ordinance shall take effect **fifteen (15) days after its approval** and compliance with publication and posting requirements under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING HELD BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN ON NOVEMBER 14, 2025 AT THE ABC HALL BUILDING, BRGY. POBLACION, KANANGA, LEYTE FOR THE FOLLOWING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES:

1. ORDINANCE NO. 24L25-004 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 21L18-037 ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND ESTABLISHING THE SYSTEM OF OPERATION OF MOTORIZED AND ELECTRIC-POWERED TRICYCLES GRANTING OF FRANCHISE FOR THE OPERATION THEREOF WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KANANGA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF”.
2. ORDINANCE NO. 24L25-006- AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE BARANGAY COUNCILOR’S LEAGUE (BCL) AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF.

The Public Hearing was conducted by the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan spearheaded by the Office of the Vice Mayor thru Facebook Page and Posting in the public places. The Public Hearing was attended by the Punong Barangay during the monthly meeting of Liga Ng Mga Barangay and it was open at 9:25 in the morning with opening prayer led by SB Secretary Atty. Allan R. Castro and also the master of the ceremony.

Atty. Castro introduced Hon. Richie C. Cruz as proponent and authored of ordinance No. 24L25-004.

Hon. Cruz (Chairman of the Committee on Transportation) said that there is a need to amend the municipal ordinance No. 21L18-037 to incorporate or include the request and some other concerns such as the new fare rate and new open route for the tricycle in the municipality of Kananga and the growing demand for transportation services, particularly in newly developed residential, commercial, and institutional areas, requires updated regulatory measures to ensure that tricycle operations remain responsive, orderly, and aligned with public welfare and safety. He added also that the new applicant must be a resident within the route he/she applied and the assigned identification number of unit. He explained that each unit shall be assigned and bear an identification number:

- a. A two digit number shall be appended to the route code letter to be numbered consecutively starting from number dash zero one(-01) up to the number dash one zero(-10) the size of the number including the route code letter shall be its twelve inches (12”) in length and twenty two inches (22”) in width in red color with white rectangular shape background with a dimension of thirteen (13) inches by 23 inches to be painted at the front, two sides and back of the cab/tricycle of every unit. Hence, all Municipal Public Utility Tricycle or Tricycle for Hire belonging or plying the route A shall be numbered as follows: the first unit shall be numbered as A dash zero one (A-01) the second unit A dash zero two (A-02) and all the succeeding unit shall be consecutively numbered up to the limit of A-10, this procedure of numbering shall be the rule to be followed in the assigning of number per unit of Tricycle for Hire plying or belonging to other zone or route;

Discussion/Comment/Suggestion.

Hon. Elna Gabilan (Punong Barangay of Montebello) observation regarding the different fares rate providing for Hiluctogan, Aguiting and Masarayao. She asked why the fares are different, they are the same distance.

Atty. Castro answered it's just clerical error and we will correct it that later on.

Hon. Francisco (Punong Barangay of Libongao) suggested to include Sitio Camote and Sitio Calunasan as additional routes travelling to Brgy. Libongao.

Hon. Empleo (Punong Barangay of Tugbong) suggested to include Sitio Sagka and Sitio Mabika for additional routes travelling to Brgy. Tugbong.

Hon. Anoy (Punong Barangay of Naghalin) also suggested to include Sitio Canlutaog for additional route travelling to Brgy. Naghalin.

Atty. Castro introduced Hon. Fernando M. Aseo as proponent and authored of ordinance No. 24L.25-006.

Hon. Aseo (Chairman of the Committee on Rules and Laws) said that there is a need to institutionalize a formal organization of barangay councilors within the Municipality of Kananga to ensure coordination, capacity building, and representation in local policy formulation. He explained that also the sangguniang allocate funds for our councilors for the operation of the league activities, ensuring they align with broader goals of good governance. Institutionalizing the BCL makes its functions a regular part of local government operations. Moving it from a voluntary association to a formally supported entity for barangay development.

No question, comment and concern being raised during the deliberation of this ordinance.

Atty. Castro introduced Hon. Alma N. Orfano as proponent and authored of ordinance No. 24L.25-008

Hon. Orfano said that this the proposed ordinance aims to strengthen and institutionalize LGU engagement in preventing and controlling African Swine Fever (ASF) by establishing an effective ASF monitoring, surveillance, and reporting system. It also seeks to enhance biosecurity measures at both farm and border levels, intensify awareness campaigns and other capacity-building activities, and assist in the recovery and repopulation of previously affected areas. Additionally, they seek to generate and mobilize resources to ensure its effective implementation of the program.

No question, comment and concern being raised during the deliberation of this ordinance.

The closing and final message was rendered by Municipal Vice Mayor Hon. Miguel Jorge P. Tan and public hearing formally ended at 10:45 AM.
