

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 179
S. of 2025

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE NEW SIDRRMC LOGO OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO, LEYTE, PRESCRIBING ITS USE, AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR UNAUTHORIZED USE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010," mandates local government units to be primarily responsible for the DRRM within their territory;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of San Isidro recognizes the importance of effective communication, visibility, and a unified identity for its Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (DRRMC) to foster community awareness and cooperation;

WHEREAS, a unique and symbolic logo has been designed to represent the commitment, structure, and holistic approach of the municipality, its nineteen (19) barangays, and the DRRMCs in addressing disaster risk;

WHEREAS, the San Isidro Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (SIDRRMC), in its meeting on meeting on November 3, 2025, passed Resolution No. 01 Series 2025 officially endorsing the said logo design to the Sangguniang Bayan for formal adoption through a municipal ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan finds it necessary and appropriate to formally adopt this symbol as the official identifier for the DRRMC and institutionalize its design and meaning through a municipal ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of San Isidro, Leyte, in a session assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE: This Ordinance shall be known as "The SIDRRMC Logo Ordinance of the Municipality of San Isidro."

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF THE LOGO: The official logo of the San Isidro Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (SIDRRMC) of San Isidro, Leyte, with the specific design and symbolism described herein, is hereby officially adopted.

SECTION 3. DESCRIPTION AND SYMBOLISM -The logo for the San Isidro Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (SIDRRMC) of San Isidro represents a comprehensive, community-focused approach to disaster management. The various elements and their meanings are as follows:

OVERALL STRUCTURE AND IDENTITY

White rope encircling the logo: The encircling rope symbolizes unity, strength, and the collective effort of the entire municipality. It represents the strong connection and cooperation between all barangays and the SIDRRMC in working toward a common goal of disaster resilience.

Text inside the border: The logo prominently displays the name "MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO" and "DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL." This clearly identifies the specific council and its geographic jurisdiction.

19 stars: The 19 stars represent the municipality's 19 barangays. Their presence signifies that the SIDRRMC's efforts are not centralized but are inclusive of all barangay disaster risk reduction and management committees (BDRRMCs).

THEMATIC AREAS OF DISASTER MANAGEMENT.

The diamond shape inside the logo represents the multi-faceted approach to disaster risk reduction, with each of the four quadrants representing each of the four key thematic areas as mandated by Philippine law:

- **Prevention and Mitigation (with a shield and gear icon):** This quadrant, colored blue, focuses on avoiding hazards and lessening their potential impacts.
 - **Icon:** The gear or cogwheel symbolizes proactive planning, maintenance, and the operational integrity required for disaster preparedness.
- **Preparedness (with a notes and pen icon):** This area, often depicted in yellow, emphasizes building the capacity of communities to plan and respond to disasters.
 - **Icon:** The notes and pen symbolize the development of plans, protocols, and the continuous readiness-building activities that are essential before a disaster strikes.
- **Response (with a telephone and Red Cross icon):** Represented by the color red, this part of the logo highlights the council's ability to provide immediate assistance during or after a disaster.
 - **Icon:** The telephone signifies the crucial role of communication and calls for emergency assistance, while the Red Cross represents immediate medical and emergency services.

CENTRAL FEATURE

Official seal of the municipality of San Isidro: The inclusion of the municipal seal at the center of the diamond signifies that the SIDRRMC is an official council acting under the authority of the local government. It represents the council's jurisdiction and its commitment to serving the people of the municipality.

SECTION 4. PURPOSE AND AUTHORIZED USE OF LOGO. The official logo of the San Isidro Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council of San Isidro shall be used for the official purpose only. It shall appear in all official documents of the SIDRRMC and in circumstances where the Office permits the use thereof.

SECTION 5. ADOPTION AND USE OF THE SIDRRMC LOGO. The San Isidro Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), acting as the executive arm and Secretariat of the San Isidro Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (SIDRRMC), shall officially adopt and utilize the approved logo of the SIDRRMC in all its official documents, communications, uniforms, equipment, and public information materials.

SECTION 6. UNAUTHORIZED USE OF THE LOGO. It shall be unlawful for any person, natural or juridical, to print the official logo of the SIDRRMC for purposes of sale, distribution or circulate, manufacture, publish, use display or offer for sale any document or items, merchandise which simulate the said official logo of the SIDRRMC without the express written consent of the Local Chief Executive or the Head of its Office.







SECTION 7. PENALTY CLAUSE. Violation of provisions of this ordinance shall be fined an amount not more than Php 2,500.00 or punished an imprisonment of not more than 30 days or both at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other laws and executive issuances which are inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not otherwise affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and compliance with the posting and publication requirements under existing laws (Section 511 (a) R.A. 7160).
