AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EVERY FRIDAY AS "NO PLASTIC DAY" IN THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF HINDANG, PROHIBITING THE USE OF SINGLE-USE PLASTIC  
MATERIALS, PROMOTING THE USE OF ECO-FRIENDLY ALTERNATIVES AND PROVIDING  
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The proliferation of single-use plastics has become one of the most pressing environmental issues both globally and locally. In response to this, various municipalities in the Philippines have adopted localized ordinances to curb the excessive use of plastics and promote sustainable practices. This proposed ordinance aims to institutionalize "No Plastic Day" every Friday in the Municipality of Hindang, by banning the use of single-use plastics and encouraging the shift to eco-friendly containers and materials. This initiative supports Republic Act No. 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000), the Clean Air Act, and aligns with the constitutional policy on the right to a balanced and healthful ecology.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Hindang, in session duly assembled:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as the "No Plastic Day Ordinance of the Municipality of Hindang, Leyte".

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Hindang to promote a clean, healthy, and sustainable environment. In line with this policy, the Municipality shall institutionalize measures to reduce dependence on single-use plastics and encourage the use of environmentally sustainable alternatives.

**SECTION 3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE.** This Ordinance shall apply to all residents, business establishments, public markets, educational institutions, government offices, and visitors within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Hindang.

**SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

- 1. Single-Use Plastics** - Disposable plastic products meant for one-time use, including plastic bags, straws, plastic cups, Styrofoam containers, plastic utensils, and sachets.

2. **Plastic Bags** - Thin, flexible plastic film containers used for carrying goods. These include sando bags, plastic packaging, or cling wraps used at the point of sale.
3. **Eco-Friendly Alternatives** - Reusable, recyclable, or biodegradable products and packaging materials such as cloth bags, baskets (bayong), paper bags, banana leaves, reusable containers, and metal or bamboo utensils.
4. **Biodegradable Materials** - Substances capable of being decomposed by bacteria or natural processes, e.g., paper, cardboard, leaves, and certain plant-based containers.
5. **Reusable Wet Containers** - Durable, washable containers made of stainless steel, hard plastic, or food-grade glass used for purchasing wet goods.
6. **Wet Goods** - Perishable goods such as fresh fish, meat, poultry, or other items sold unpackaged in wet markets or public market stalls.
7. **Wet Markets** - Marketplaces where perishable goods are sold, including talipapa or similar public trading centers in the municipality.
8. **No Plastic Day** - A designated day each week (Friday) where the use and distribution of single-use plastics is prohibited in all establishments and transactions within the municipality.
9. **Establishments** - Includes all business and commercial enterprises, sari-sari stores, groceries, canteens, eateries, restaurants, vendors, market stalls, and similar entities.
10. **MENRO** - The Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office, which shall serve as the primary implementing body for this Ordinance.
11. **IEC Campaign** - "Information, Education, and Communication" activities aimed at public awareness and behavioral change.



**SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF "NO PLASTIC DAY"**. Every Friday is hereby declared as "No Plastic Day" in the Municipality of Hindang. On this day, the use, sale, and distribution of single-use plastic items are strictly prohibited in all commercial, institutional, and public transactions.





**SECTION 6. PROHIBITED ACTS.** On "No Plastic Day," the following acts are prohibited:

- a. Use or provision of plastic bags as primary or secondary packaging.
- b. Use of Styrofoam, plastic cups, utensils, and plastic straws in any food-related transaction.
- c. Automatic provision of plastic wrappers or bags in markets, especially when the customer has reusable alternatives.




**SECTION 7. WET MARKET PROVISIONS.**

- a. Vendors and customers in wet markets and talipapas are strongly encouraged to use reusable wet containers (e.g., pails, tubs, food-grade plastic containers, glass jars) when purchasing fish, meat, or other wet goods.
- b. Vendors may use biodegradable wrapping materials such as wax paper, banana leaves, old newspaper, or reusable alternatives.
- c. Vendors shall not automatically provide plastic bags or plastic liners unless requested and only when no reusable container is presented by the customer.
- d. During the first six (6) months of implementation, vendors may use plastic as an exception for sanitation purposes but must gradually reduce dependence on plastic, with monitoring by MENRO.



**SECTION 8. PROMOTION OF ECO-FRIENDLY ALTERNATIVES.** The MENRO, in coordination with barangays, schools, CSOs and Municipal Tourism Office shall:

- a. Launch regular IEC campaigns on the dangers of plastic pollution
- b. Promote the use of reusable and biodegradable alternatives
- c. Conduct barangay-level and market-based orientations on the ordinance
- d. Encourage partnerships with local producers of "bayong", cloth bags, and reusable containers

**SECTION 9. IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING.** A Technical Working Group (TWG) composed of representatives from MENRO, market administration, local vendors, SB Solid Waste Management Committee, and other stakeholders shall be created to:

- a. Draft the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR)
- b. Monitor compliance and submit regular reports to the Sangguniang Bayan
- c. Recommend updates and modifications to improve implementation

**SECTION 10. PENALTIES.** Violations of this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

Offense	Penalty
1st Offense	Written warning and IEC re-orientation
2nd Offense	Php 500.00 fine
3rd Offense	Php 1,000.00 fine
4th and succeeding	Php 2,000 fine and potential permit suspension

Violations by businesses or vendors may result in temporary suspension of business permits after due process for repeated non-compliance.

**SECTION 11. INCENTIVES AND RECOGNITION.** The Municipality may confer awards and incentives to barangays, schools, or establishments with exemplary compliance and innovation in the use of eco-friendly alternatives. These may include certificates, public recognition, or access to livelihood support programs.

**SECTION 12. FUNDING.** The implementation of this Ordinance shall be funded through the Annual Investment Plan (AIP), the Environmental Management Fund, or other available funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules.

**SECTION 13. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION 14. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 15. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days upon its approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after due compliance with all the requirements provided under R.A 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.




