

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-06**

**AN ORDINANCE STRENGTHENING THE IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING OF RA 8172, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS AN ACT PROMOTING SALT IODIZATION NATIONWIDE (ASIN) ORGANIZING THE BANTAY ASIN TASK FORCE (BATF) AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HINDANG, LEYTE**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The ordinance seeks to institutionalize and strengthen the Municipality of Hindang's commitment to promoting proper nutrition and preventing iodine deficiency disorders (IDD) among its constituents. Recognizing that health and nutrition are essential components of human development, the measure aligns with the municipality's long-term goal of enhancing the quality of life and productivity of its people. Iodine deficiency remains one of the country's major nutrition concerns, with adverse effects on physical and mental development that can hinder socio-economic progress. In support of Republic Act No. 8172, also known as the "Act for Salt Iodization Nationwide (ASIN Law)," and Department of Health Memorandum Circular No. 2014-042, this ordinance provides a comprehensive local framework for ensuring access to adequately iodized salt and promoting awareness on proper nutrition. As a consistent awardee in nutrition programs, the Local Government Unit of Hindang continues to advance its efforts toward the total eradication of malnutrition and micronutrient deficiencies, thereby contributing to poverty reduction and sustainable human development within the Municipality.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Hindang during its regular Session assembled, that:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as "*Strengthening the ASIN Law and Organizing the Municipality of Hindang Bantay Asin Task Force.*"

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is a declared policy of the municipality of Hindang to promote the health of the people, to maintain an effective food regulatory system, and to provide the entire population, especially women and children with proper nutrition. For this purpose, the municipality of Hindang shall promote food fortification to combat micronutrient malnutrition, particularly Iodine deficiency disorders, as a priority health and nutrition program.

Further, Republic Act No. 8172 or the Act for Salt Iodization Nationwide (ASIN), enacted into law in 1995, requires the Iodization of all salt for human and animal consumption. Specific reference to LGUs in RA 8172 and its implementation Rules and Regulations (IRR) are as follows:

- a. IRR Rule VI. Section 2, Roles. To require Local Government Units (LGUs), through their Health Officers and Nutritionist-Dietitians, or in their absence, through their Sanitary Inspectors, to check and monitor regularly the quality of food-grade salt being sold in their market to ascertain that such salt is properly iodized;
- b. Section 5.c. Applicability. All food outlets, restaurants and stores are hereby required to make available to customers only iodized salt in their establishment upon effectivity of this Act. These establishments shall be monitored with the help of LGUs through its Health Officers and Nutritionist-Dietitians, or in their absence, the Sanitary Inspectors, to check and monitor regularly of food-grade salt being sold or served in such establishments.

**SECTION 3. PURPOSE.** This Ordinance aims to strictly implement and monitor the distributions, sale, and use of adequately-iodized salt, and organize an Iodized Salt Monitoring Team in the Municipality of Hindang

**SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following term and phrases shall mean:

- 1. **Adequately Iodized Salt** - ordinary salt with fortificant Potassium Iodate (k103) and/ or Potassium Iodine (KI) added consistent with the level of iodine prescribed by Food and Drug Administration (FDA), which at present is 30-70 mg/kg of iodine and could be modified in the future.
- 2. **Bantay Asin Task Force (BATF)** - a multi-sectoral working group organized at regional and local levels with members from different government agencies and non-government organization, which is responsible for the implementation of activities related to the Salt Iodization Program.
- 3. **Food Fortification** - refers to the addition of nutrients to processed foods at level above the natural state.
- 4. **Food Grade Salt** - refers to salt for human and animal consumption as distinguished from industrial salt; food-grade salt should be adequately iodized salt.
- 5. **Food Manufacturer** - refer to establishments engaged in all operations involved in production of food products including products including preparation, processing, filling, packaging, repacking, altering, finishing, and labelling with the end view of its storage, sale, or distribution. The business or enterprise of manufacturing or processing food using adequately iodized salt on its products.
- 6. **Food Service Establishments** - refers to hotel, restaurant, carenderias, catering firms, hospitals and related health facilities and institutions, canteens, food chains, street food outlets, and similar outlets that serve or sell food to consumers.
- 7. **Importer** - one who buys salt outside the country, either food-grade or for industrial use.
- 8. **Iodine Deficiency Disorders** - a broad spectrum of manifestations resulting from insufficient stores of iodine in the body, which leads to maternal and birth abnormalities, and the reduction of intellectual and physical capacity affecting one who is iodine deficient and may manifest as miscarriage or stillbirth among pregnant women, goiter, mental retardation, physical and mental defects, or cretinism.

- 9. **Iodized Salt Outlets** - refers to department stores, shops, supermarket, groceries, mini-marts, drugs stores, sari-sari stores, wet markets and other points of purchase that sell wholesale or retail iodized salt to consumers.
- 10. **Industrial Salt**- refers to salt used in the treatment processing and/or manufacture of non-food commercial products; this salt need not be iodized.
- 11. **Micronutrient Malnutrition** – a disorder resulting from deficiencies in vitamin A, iron, iodine and other micronutrients that the body needs in minute quantities every day.
- 12. **Salt Industry** – refers to the business sector engaged in the production, distribution, trading, retailing and importation of salt.
- 13. **Salt Iodization**- the addition of iodine to salt intended for human and animal consumption in accordance with the specification as to form, fortificant, method, manner, and composition as may be prescribed by FDA. Salt iodization continues to be the most efficient and effective strategy to prevent iodine deficiency.
- 14. **Salt Manufacturer** - refers to establishments engaged in all operations involved in the importation or production of salt including preparation, processing, formulating, filling, packaging, repacking, altering, finishing, and labeling with the end view of storage, sale, or distribution.
- 15. **Trader** - refers to establishments engaged in buying and selling of food-grade salt by wholesale or retail.
- 16. **WYD Method** - refers to the salt testing method that quantitatively measure the iodine content of salt. It uses an instrument called WYD Iodine Checker which, together with WYD solutions, qualitatively measures the salt iodine content based on a colorimetric method.

**SECTION 5. COVERAGE.** The following establishments are covered by this Ordinance:

- 1. The entire salt industry including salt producers, manufacturers, re-packers, importers, traders, distributors, and retailers;
- 2. All food service establishments where food is being served or sold;
- 3. All food manufacturers or processors using iodized salt in their manufacturing process; and
- 4. All iodized salt outlets which sell wholesale or retail iodized salt to consumers.

**SECTION 6. CREATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HINDANG BANTAY ASIN TASK FORCE (HINDANG BATF).** The Municipality of Hindang BATF is hereby organized with the following composition:

- Chairperson : Municipal Health Officer
- Co-Chairperson : Municipal Market Administrator
- Member : Sanitary Inspector
- Mun. Nutrition Action Officer
- Barangay Nutrition Action Officers
- Barangay Nutrition Scholars
- Representative from Business Permit and Licensing Office
- School Health Coordinators- Elementary
- School Health Coordinators- High School
- NGO Representative

**SECTION 7. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.** The Municipality of Hindang BATF shall have the following duties and functions, to wit:

- a. Disseminate information on the health benefits of using adequately iodized salt.

- b. Collect and test using the WYD method, or other quantitative or semi-quantitative methods, the salts sold in market, groceries, supermarkets, sari-sari stores, food establishment, including school canteens, and salt from wholesalers, retailers and other major salt suppliers, at least twice a year to determine iodine level;
- c. Submit all salt testing results and findings, including records of violations to the Regional Bantay Asin Task, Office of the Major, and the Food and Drug Administration Regional Office; and
- d. Monitor action on reports of salt testing results and pursue needed action for resolution.

**SECTION 8. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS.**

- a. All food service establishment and iodized salt outlets in the Municipality of Hindang are hereby required to make available to customers only adequately iodized salt in their establishment.
- b. All food manufactures or processors using food-grade salt are also required to use adequately, iodized salt in the processing of their products provided that the use of iodized salt shall not prejudice the quality and safety of their products.
- c. The benefits of the use of iodized salt shall be disseminated and promoted through organized, systematic, and effective information campaigns which shall involve major sector of community to be spearheaded by the Rural Health Unit
- d. This HINDANG BATF, shall check and monitor the quality of food-grade salt being produced, sold, or used/served in food establishments at least twice a year.

**SECTION 9. PENAL PROVISIONS.** Any person or establishment who violates Section 8 of this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

- a. Any person or caught violating this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

- First Offense : Fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00)
- Second Offense : Fine of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00)
- Third Offense : Fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00)

- b. Any establishment caught violating this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:


- First Offense : Fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) and suspension of operation for Three (3) days
- Second Offense : Fine of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) and suspension of operation for One (1) week
- Third Offense : Fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) and suspension of operation for One (1) month

**SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any portion of this Ordinance is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected or impaired by such declaration and shall remain valid and enforceable.

**SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts of thereof in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Ordinance shall take effects Thirty (30) days upon its approval and posting.






