SECTION 1. TITLE  
The Ordinance shall be known as the "Temporary Road Opening and Closure Ordinance of Matag-ob, Leyte".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE  
This Ordinance aims to

a) Ensure public safety during events, construction emergencies, or repairs involving roadways.

b) Provide clear procedures for the temporary opening or closure of roads.

c) Minimize disruption to traffic and public inconvenience.

d) Establish clear guidelines and procedures for the proper coordination among concerned agencies and stakeholders, including prior notification and approval to safeguard pedestrians, motorists, and properties while also preserving the integrity of public structure.

**WHEREAS**, as observed, the ingress and egress of heavy transport vehicles and equipment along the provincial, municipal, and barangay roads within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Carigara, Leyte, specifically those that are loaded with, among others, quarry or sand and gravel resources affect the safety and longevity of these roads;

**WHEREAS**, these heavy transport vehicles and equipment traversing these road network have undeniably caused material damage, including, but not limited to, cracks, potholes which significantly shortens the useful life of the concrete roads and eventually poses inconvenience and threat on the safety of motorists and pedestrians;

**WHEREAS**, the technical design of aforementioned roads can cater only to light vehicles or equipment as the thickness of these roads are either six (6) inches or eight (8) inches only;

**WHEREAS**, the interests of the few must not supersede the number

**WHEREAS**, every local government unit has the sworn obligation to enact measures that will enhance, among others, the safety and convenience, and promote the general welfare of its constituents;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental to its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, including the maintenance of peace and order, the preservation of the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants, and the protection of its property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Carigara, Leyte, in session assembled, that:

*Section 1.* Title. This ordinance shall be known as the “Carigara Truck Ban Ordinance of 2025”.

*Section 2.* Declaration of Policy

It is the policy of the Municipality of Carigara, Leyte to promote general welfare and protection of property by ensuring the safety and longevity of provincial, municipal and barangay road within its

territorial jurisdiction by providing a sustainable mechanism for road protection and preservation that bans the passage of transport vehicles or equipment of whatever type with more than six (6) wheels, including, but not limited to cargo trucks, dump trucks and other similar vehicles or equipment with a gross vehicle weight of more than 16,880 kilograms including its load.

Section 3. Definition of Terms

- **Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW):** The total weight of the vehicle and its maximum load, as indicated in its certificate of registration.
- **Heavy Transport Vehicle:** any vehicle or equipment with more than six (6) wheels, including but not limited to cargo trucks, dump trucks, and other similar vehicles, which has a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) as indicated in its certificate of registration of more than 16,880 kilograms.
- **Impounding:** the act of taking an apprehended heavy transport vehicle into temporary legal custody by deputized officers to a designated area within the barangay where the violation occurred.
- **Two-axle or Dual Axle Trucks:** are vehicles with four to six wheels and generally have a lower maximum gross vehicle weight and payload capacity of up to 16,880 kilograms only.

These are trucks that are widely used for regional transport, or urban distribution carrying light to medium loads.

**Section 4. Scope**

**PROHIBITED VEHICLES** - Trucks with more than six (6) wheels, and other vehicle or equipment of whatever type with gross vehicle weight including its load of more than 16,880 kilograms, is strictly prohibited from entering, traversing or exiting all provincial, municipal, barangay and unclassified roads within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Carigara, Leyte.

Exempted from the coverage of this Ordinance, to wit:

1. Vehicles and/or equipment of the Provincial Government of Leyte, and its component city and municipalities, if any;
2. Vehicles and/or equipment of the national government doing construction projects, or other governmental activities along or near or within the vicinity of a provincial road, if any;
3. Vehicles and/or equipment used for humanitarian, emergency, peace and order, disaster, and health operations, and analogous activities, if any;
4. Such other vehicles and/or equipment as may be

exempted or authorized by the Municipal Mayor or his duly authorized representative.

**ALLOWED HEAVY VEHICLE** – Pursuant to RA 8794, only “six (6) wheeler trucks” or two (2) axle trucks shall be allowed to use the provincial, municipal, barangay and unclassified roads within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Carigara, Leyte.

Section 5. **SIGNS AND SIGNAGES**- Upon effectivity of this ordinance, appropriate signs shall be posted at designated entry points, informing the motorists concerned about the regulations herein contained.

Section 6. **-DEPUTIZATION OF BARANGAY TREASURER, CARIGARA PNP, CATEMO** –the Barangay Treasurers, PNP-CARIGARA, CATEMO are hereby deputized and authorized to issue citation tickets for violations of this ordinance within its jurisdiction. The deputized collectors shall be entitled to collect an honorarium in the amount of ten (10%) of the total amount paid to the municipal treasurer’s office on a weekly basis as a result of their performance as deputized officers.

Section 7. **PENALTY** – Any person who is found to have violated this Ordinance shall be meted with the civil penalty of:

FIRST OFFENSE - vehicle will be impounded until a P2,000.00 fine is paid

SECOND OFFENSE	-	₱2,500.00 with 5 working days impound of vehicle
THIRD OFFENSE	-	₱2,500.00 with 10 working days impound of vehicle

The apprehended vehicle will be taken into custody and stored at the barangay where the violation occurred. All costs associated with vehicle storage not exceeding ₱250.00 per day shall be for the account of the vehicle owner.

**Section 8. IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT** - The Philippine National Police (PNP-Carigara), Carigara Traffic Enforcement and Management Office (CATEMO), and Barangay Officials and Barangay Tanods of the municipality of Carigara shall be responsible for the strict implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance. The deputized enforcers shall be authorized to issue citation tickets.

**Section 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** - If for any reason or reasons, any part of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**Section 10. REPEALING CLAUSE** - All other Ordinances, orders, issuances, and rules, and regulations inconsistent with this Order are hereby modified and/or repealed accordingly.





9 **I. CALL TO ORDER**

10 The Chairman of the Committee calls the meeting to order.

11 **II. ROLL CALL**

12 The Secretary of the Sanggunian disclosed that present thereat are the  
13 chairman of the Committee on Rules Hon. Fernando N. Moriel, members Hon.  
14 Carlo Angelo B. Go, Hon. Mildred C. Modesto, Hon. Joenlee C. Larraga and  
15 Hon. Arvin N. Urmeneta. Present thereat are Hon. Guillermo I. Panal, Hon.  
16 Ulpiano U. Arpon, Jr., Hon. Vilma M. Domus, Atty. Leo L. Pruel-Mun.

23 **III. OPENING STATEMENT:**

24 The Presiding Officer welcomed everyone and explained that the purpose  
25 of the Public Hearing was to gather public comments and recommendations  
26 regarding the Proposed Municipal Ordinance No. 2025-010 titled "AN  
27 ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PASSAGE OF HEAVY TRANSPORT  
28 VEHICLES ON PROVINCIAL, MUNICIPAL AND BARANGAY ROADS  
29 WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF

1 CARIGARA, LEYTE AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS  
2 THEREOF”

3 **IV. PRESENTATION OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE:**

4 The author of the Ordinance Hon. Fernando N. Moriel, presented the key  
5 provisions of the proposed ordinance, including the roads covered by the  
6 prohibition, its issuance of special permits for limited exemptions, the penalties  
7 for violations, and its implementation mechanisms, including signages,  
8 monitoring and coordination with PNP and barangays.

9 **V. OPEN FORUM/PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

10 The public and other stakeholders were invited to express their views and  
11 suggestions.

12 The following comments were recorded;

13 ENGR. RAUL Z. LLOREN- Business Owner

14 Expressed concern about the totality of the prohibition of the passage of  
15 heavy transport vehicle and proposed to amend from prohibiting to regulating.

16 HON. EDUARDO COMBINIDO, Brgy. Chairman Brgy Manloy

17 Expressed concern about the delivery delays if heavy trucks cannot pass  
18 through main municipal roads.

19 HON. JOSE PLATILLA JR, Chairman Brgy. Lower Sogod

20 Supported the ordinance due to resultant road damage and safety issues  
21 along barangay roads, specifically at their barangay.

22 Requested for the inclusion of maintenance funds in the ordinance.

23 MS. JULIET R. HANOPOL, Mun. Treasurer

24 Expressed that the share of the barangays must be expressly indicated.

25 HON. PEDRO ROYO, Chairman Brgy. Jugaban

26 Requested to conduct a training for the Brgy. Tanods as one of the  
27 enforcement team in the barangay on this proposed municipal ordinance with the  
28 full coordination of the PNP.

29 ENGR. DODIE PADILLO, Business Owner

1 Clarifies if national government vehicles are exempted from the  
2 prohibition.

3 *All suggestions were noted by the Sangguniang Bayan Committee.*

4 V. RESPONSE FROM THE AUTHOR AND THE MEMBERS OF THE  
5 COMMITTEE

6 While the author of the ordinance acknowledge the proposed shift toward  
7 *regulating rather than prohibiting*, he respectfully respond and emphasized that  
8 the original version was crafted as prohibition, remains the effective and practical  
9 solution on limited road width and structural capacity of barangay roads, and its  
10 primary intent is to protect municipal and barangay roads-most of which are not  
11 designed to withstand the load of heavy transport vehicles, primarily due to the  
12 documented deterioration of our municipal roads and safety concerns reported by  
13 residents regarding large trucks navigating the narrow residential streets. He  
14 further emphasized that a total ban during certain hours was seen as the most  
15 effective measure to instantly mitigate these risks.

16 The Chairman fully support the exemptions for emergency transport  
17 vehicles and government vehicle, but it must be strictly controlled where they  
18 may be allowed to navigate with a Special Permit issued by the mayor or  
19 authorized office, the weight limit must remain within tolerable road capacity.

20 Finally, the author welcomes the stakeholders' recommendations, and  
21 assure to refine the ordinance to ensure its effective implementation, fairness to  
22 stakeholders, protection of public infrastructure and safety of all road users, and  
23 further clarified that the intent of the ordinance is not to hinder commerce but to  
24 protect public safety and prolong road life.
