

Dear Vice-Governor Javier, Jr.:

Pursuant to Section 22(c), Chapter II, and Section 465(b)(1)(vi), Chapter III, Article 1 of the Local Government Code of 1991, this Office most respectfully requests the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan for the issuance of a **RESOLUTION** authorizing CARLOS JERICO L. PETILLA, *Provincial Governor*, or CORAZON M. ALVERO, *Provincial Administrator*, or Atty. JOSE RAYMUND A. ACOL, *Provincial Legal Officer*, to represent the Province in all cases to be filed by the Province of Leyte and/or filed against the Province of Leyte, before any court, tribunal, quasi-judicial office, to wit:

- 1.) *To initiate or file any case, and represent for and on behalf of the Province of Leyte;*
- 2.) *Sign the Verification and Certification of Non-Forum Shopping;*
- 3.) *Appear for and on my behalf of the Province of Leyte, at all stages of the proceedings, including hearings of whatever motions or pending incidents involved in the action;*
- 4.) *Enter into an amicable settlement or to submit any case to other alternative modes of dispute resolution;*
- 5.) *Decide for and on behalf of the Province of Leyte, on matters involving simplification of the issues in the above-mentioned case;*
- 6.) *Decide for and on my behalf of the Province of Leyte, on matters involving the necessity or desirability of amendments to the pleadings; and other matters, such as:*
 - a. *The possibility of obtaining stipulations or admissions of facts to avoid unnecessary proof;*
 - b. *The limitation on the number of witnesses;*

- c. *The advisability of a preliminary reference of the issues to a commissioner;*
 - d. *Determining the propriety of rendering judgment on the pleadings or summary judgment or of dismissing the action should a valid ground therefore be found to exist;*
 - e. *The advisability or necessity of suspending the proceedings; and*
- 7.) *Such other matters as may aid in the prompt disposition of the action.*
- 8.) *HEREBY GIVING AND GRANTING unto our said attorney-in-fact full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary or proper to be done in and about the premises as fully to all intents and purposes as we might and could lawfully do if personally present, with power of substitution and revocation, and hereby, ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney -in-fact shall lawfully do or cause to be done under and by virtue of these presents.*

Your expeditious consideration of the matter is highly appreciated, as the same is considered urgent.
