



**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING EXCESSIVE AND UNNECESSARY NOISE WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MIGUEL, LEYTE PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates local government units to promote the general welfare by ensuring the health, safety, peace, and comfort of their inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, excessive and unnecessary noise adversely affects public health, disrupts peace and order, and diminishes the quality of life of residents, particularly children, the elderly, students, and the sick;

**WHEREAS**, complaints have been received by the Municipal Government regarding loud and disturbing noises arising from, among others, motor vehicles with modified mufflers, sound systems, videoke machines, construction activities, and other similar sources;

**WHEREAS**, the regulation of excessive and unnecessary noise is essential to maintain public tranquility, protect the well-being of residents, and ensure the peaceful enjoyment of homes, schools, churches, and public spaces within the Municipality;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Government of San Miguel, Leyte recognizes the need to establish clear standards, prohibited acts, and penalties to effectively regulate noise levels and promote responsible behavior among individuals and establishments;

**WHEREAS**, the enactment of an ordinance regulating excessive and unnecessary noise is a valid exercise of the police power of the Municipality for the promotion of public welfare;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Richard Len B. Lapidario duly seconded by Hon. Jerome P. Penaranda, Hon. Letecia G. Espos and Hon. Danilo L. Aureo.

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2025-14  
Series of 2025

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING EXCESSIVE AND UNNECESSARY NOISE WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MIGUEL, LEYTE PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Sponsor: HON. RICHARD LEN B. LAPIDARIO  
SB Member/Chairman on Peace and Order, Public Safety and Legal Matters

**SECTION 1. TITLE** This ordinance shall be known as the "Anti-Noise Ordinance of the Municipality of San Miguel, Leyte."

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of San Miguel, Leyte, to safeguard public peace, health, comfort, and welfare by regulating excessive, unnecessary, and unreasonable noise within its territorial jurisdiction.

This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the general welfare clause of Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) and consistent with the policies of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and the Land Transportation Office (LTO) regarding noise and vehicle modification.

**SECTION 3. OBJECTIVES**

To prevent and control noise pollution that disturbs public peace and affects the health and well-being of residents;

To regulate loud music, sound systems, and the use of modified motor vehicle mufflers; and

To provide a practical, community-based enforcement system that does not require technical noise measuring instruments.

**SECTION 4. SCOPE**

This ordinance shall apply to all persons, residences, establishments, motor vehicles, and activities within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of San Miguel, Leyte.

**SECTION 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS**

For purposes of this Ordinance, the following shall be defined as such:

a. Noise – Any sound that disturbs or annoys reasonable persons, endangers health, or interferes with public peace and quiet.

b. Excessive Noise – Sound that can be clearly heard beyond twenty (20) meters from its source, or that causes disturbance to nearby households, schools, hospitals, churches, or offices.

c. Amplified Sound – Sound produced by speakers, amplifiers, videoke, or similar devices.

d. Modified Muffler – Any alteration of a motor vehicle's original exhaust system that increases sound or removes the factory-installed silencer.

e. Public Place – Streets, parks, plazas, markets, terminals, and any open area accessible to the general public.

**SECTION 6. PROHIBITED ACTS.** It shall be unlawful for any person or entity within the Municipality of San Miguel, Leyte to:

**A. Loud Music and Sound Systems**

Play, use, or operate any radio, sound amplifier, videoke, karaoke, musical instrument, or similar devices at a volume that:

- a. Is clearly audible beyond twenty (20) meters from the property boundary; or
- b. Disturbs nearby residents, particularly during nighttime hours.
- c. Operate videoke or karaoke systems in residential areas from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- d. Use sound systems for public gatherings, parades, or motorcades without a permit from the Municipal Mayor or Barangay Captain.
- e. Conduct commercial, political, or promotional activities using sound trucks or loudspeakers without authorization.

**B. Motor Vehicle Noise**

The following is prohibited any hour of the day or night:

- 1. Operate or allow the operation of any motorcycle, tricycle, or motor vehicle with modified or defective mufflers that produce excessive or explosive noise.
- 2. Accelerate engines unnecessarily, blow horns continuously, or cause backfiring that disturbs the peace.
- 3. Conduct motorcycle drag racing or similar activities that cause unnecessary noise and endanger public safety.

**C. Other Sources of Noise**

Engage in any construction, repair, or operation of light and heavy equipment between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., unless urgently necessary for public safety or authorized by the Barangay Captain.

Holding of public events with amplified sound within 200 meters of schools, hospitals, or churches during class hours, worship services, or curfew hours without prior proper coordination and/or permit from the LGU or Barangay concerned.

**SECTION 7. EXEMPTIONS**

The following shall not be considered violations:

- a. Emergency alarms or sirens used by authorized emergency vehicles (police, ambulance, fire trucks).
- b. Public safety or disaster response operations.
- c. Religious activities (e.g., church bells, calls to prayer) conducted within reasonable volume and hours.

d. Official Municipal activities authorized by the Office of the Mayor.

### SECTION 8. ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY

Primary enforcement shall be vested in the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO), the Philippine National Police (PNP)-San Miguel Station, and the concerned Barangay Officials.

Barangay Tanods and other authorized agents may warn, record, and report violators for appropriate action.

For motor vehicle violations, coordination shall be made with the Land Transportation Office (LTO) for inspection or administrative sanctions.

### SECTION 9. PENAL PROVISIONS

A. For loud music, sound systems and other excessive noise except motor vehicle noise.

1. First Offense : Verbal warning and immediate cessation of noise; record of violation.
2. Second Offense: Fine of ₱1,000 and confiscation or temporary impoundment of sound equipment.
3. Third Offense: Fine of ₱2,500, confiscation of sound equipment and /or instruments, and/or eight (8) hours of community service.
4. Fourth and Subsequent Offenses: Fine of ₱5,000, confiscation or suspension of business permit, and possible filing of charges for disturbance of peace.

B. Motor Vehicle Noise.

Any person found operating or allowing the operation of a motor vehicle fitted with a modified, improvised, non-stock, or open muffler that produces excessive or unnecessary noise in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to the following penalties:

1. First Offense: A fine of One Thousand Pesos (₱1,000.00) and immediate removal and confiscation of the modified muffler by the apprehending officer and the offender shall be required to replace the confiscated muffler or with a stock or manufacturer- recommended muffler before the vehicle is released or allowed to operate.
2. Second Offense: A fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱2,500.00) confiscation of the modified muffler and mandatory replacement with a stock plus issuance of a warning for stricter penalties upon further violation.
3. Third and Succeeding Offenses: A fine of Five Thousand Pesos (₱5,000.00) Permanent confiscation of the modified muffler; and possible suspension or recommendation for revocation of vehicle registration, subject to applicable laws and coordination with the Land Transportation Office (LTO).

Certified Correct:

All fines shall be payable to the Municipal Treasurer and credited to the Environmental Management Fund of the Municipality of San Miguel, Leyte.

**SECTION 10. SUMMARY ABATEMENT AND CONFISCATION.**

The use of modified or non-stock mufflers producing excessive noise is hereby declared a public nuisance. As such, authorized enforcement officers may summarily abate the nuisance by ordering the confiscation of the modified muffler, subject to proper documentation and issuance of a receipt. Confiscated mufflers shall be disposed of in accordance with applicable laws and regulations after due notice to owner.

No confiscation shall be made without the issuance of a citation ticket or confiscation receipt, and the vehicle owner shall be informed of the steps required for compliance and retrieval, if allowed.

**SECTION 11. PROCEDURE UPON VIOLATION.**

Any enforcement officer or barangay official who observes a violation shall order the immediate cessation of the noise.

If the offender refuses, the officers or officials may confiscate the sound equipment or instruments or report the motor vehicle to the PNP for proper action. The corresponding penalties shall then apply.

The offender shall be issued a Citation Ticket or Violation Report indicating the offense and penalties

Confiscated items shall be released only upon payment of fines and assurance of compliance or strict adherence to the Ordinance.

**SECTION 12. COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION.**

Residents are encouraged to report persistent noise disturbances to the local Law Enforcement Officials, Barangay Officials or MENRO. Barangay officials shall maintain a Noise Complaint Logbook for documentation and monitoring.

**SECTION 13. IMPLEMENTING OFFICE**

The MENRO, in coordination with the Office of the Mayor, shall issue implementing guidelines, conduct education campaigns, and coordinate with the Barangays and the PNP for consistent enforcement.

**SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.**

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 15. REPEALING CLAUSE**

All ordinances or portions thereof that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its approval and publication in a newspaper of local circulation and posting in conspicuous places within the Municipality of San Miguel, Leyte.



MINUTES OF COMMITTEE HEARING AND PUBLIC CONSULTATION OF PROPOSED (1) ORDINANCE IMPOSING A CURFEW FOR MINORS AND PROHIBITING THE DRINKING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR, (2) PROPOSED ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DRINKING, CONSUMPTION, AND POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE PUBLIC PLACES OUTSIDE PRIVATE RESIDENCES AND PROPOSED, (3) AND ORDINANCE REGULATING EXCESSIVE AND UNNECESSARY NOISE WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MIGUEL, LEYTE, PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

The committee hearing and public consultation formally start at 9:10 in the morning at ABC Hall on November 6, 2025.

Hon. Richard Len B. Lapidario, presiding officer, gave an introductory message on the proposed ordinances.

The chair presented to the body the three (3) ordinances and was delivered as read per section.

After the presentation, Hon. Lapidario solicited comments, observations, and suggestions from the body.

The following were the concerns raised:

**A. AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A CURFEW FOR MINORS**

1. Hon. Gavino Valleramos Punong Barangay Bairan, suggested the curfew hours is 9:00 PM to 4 AM.
2. Hon. Melcon Viador, Punong Barangay Bagacay questioned the exception of this proposed ordinance such as: Fiesta and Christmas Day.

Hon. Lapidario, stated the penalties of MINORS are the following:

**1<sup>st</sup> offence** – warning and counselling of minors and parents/guardians.

**2<sup>nd</sup> offence** – community service not less than 4 hours

**3<sup>rd</sup> offence and succeeding offence** – referral to the MSWDO for intervention

Penalties for ADULT/PARENTS/GUARDIANS who neglect the responsibilities are the following:

**1<sup>st</sup> offence** – Warning

**2<sup>nd</sup> offence** – PHP 500.00 or community service

**3<sup>rd</sup> offence** – PHP 1,000 .00 for attendance for mandatory parenting seminar

The implementing agencies are the following:

PNP, Barangay Officials, MSWDO; Incoordination with the municipal council for protection of children.

**B. AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DRINKING, CONSUMPTION, AND POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE PUBLIC PLACES OUTSIDE PRIVATE RESIDENCES**

The Chair manifested 7 eleven to control their area, hours of drinking have limit. After that Hon. Lapidario, stated the content of this ordinance.



3. Nancy Ara suggested that 15 years old below they are not allowed to work that could mean that minors only.















