

WHEREAS, the Municipality of San Miguel, Leyte has constructed a new two-story market building to provide modern, safe, hygienic, and efficient marketplace facilities for its vendors, stallholders, consumers, and the general public;

WHEREAS, to ensure that said market building is operated efficiently, managed transparently, and maintained in good condition, the San Miguel Sangguniang Bayan deems it necessary to enact rules governing its operations, maintenance, rentals, administration, sanitation, health, safety, and related matters;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija duly seconded by all members present;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SAN MIGUEL, LEYTE, BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN IT BY LAW, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, that:

ARTICLE I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as **"AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE NEW TWO-STOREY MARKET BUILDING IN SAN MIGUEL, LEYTE"**

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to regulate and set standards for the operation, maintenance, rental, health and safety, administration, and use of the two-story market building, to protect the welfare of vendors and consumers, and to ensure sustainable operation of the facility.

Section 3. Coverage. This Ordinance covers all stallholders, vendors, lessees, transient vendors, employees, and management staff operating in, or in connection with, the two-story market building owned or controlled by the Municipality of San Miguel, Leyte.

Section 4. Definition of Terms. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined:

- a) Market – the new two-story market building in San Miguel, Leyte.
- b) Stallholder / Lessee – a person or business who has been granted a lease or rental of a stall or booth in the market.
- d) Fixed Stall – a permanent stall/booth leased in the market building.
- e) Market Manager – the person appointed by the Municipal Mayor to be responsible for the operation and administration of the market..
- f) Market Committee – a body created by this ordinance to assist in supervisory, adjudicative, or oversight functions (e.g. stall allocation, rate setting, complaints).
- g) Utilities – water supply, electricity, garbage/waste disposal, drainage and sanitation services.
- h) Health and Sanitation Standards – standards prescribed by the Department of Health, Municipal Health Office, and relevant laws (e.g. Code on Sanitation (PD 856), RA 9003, etc.).

ARTICLE II

GOVERNANCE & ADMINISTRATION

Section 5. Management Structure.

- a) There shall be a Market Manager, appointed by the Municipal Mayor, who shall be primarily responsible for the day-to-day operation, administration, maintenance, and enforcement of rules in the market.
- b) A Market Committee shall be established, composed of:
 - The Municipal Mayor (or designated representative) as Chairperson;
 - The Vice Mayor
 - SB Member Chairman, Committee Public Works, Agriculture, Livelihood, Environmental Protection and General Services;
 - The Municipal Treasurer;
 - The Municipal Health Officer;
 - The Municipal Engineer;
 - The Market Manager;

- A representative of the market vendors (chosen by stallholders);
- Any other members as may be necessary (e.g. from barangays or BPLO).

c) The functions of the Market Committee shall include:

- Stall allocation and adjudication of vacant stalls or renewal of leases;
- Setting of other stall rental rates and fees for utilities or services not specified in this ordinance;
- Review of complaints, grievances, and enforcement of rules;
- Oversight of budget, revenue collection, reporting;
- Recommendation on policies, improvements, or regulations relative to market operation.
- classifies the stalls and market section.

Section 6. Duties and Powers of the Market Manager.

The Market Manager shall:

- Implement policies, rates, and rules as approved by the Municipal Mayor and the Market Committee;
- Supervise staff including market inspectors, sanitation personnel, maintenance staff;
- Ensure compliance with health, safety, and sanitation regulations;
- Maintain records of stall leases, payments, utilities usage, market activities;
- Prepare periodic financial and operational reports to the Municipal Mayor and Sangguniang Bayan;
- Conduct inspections and enforce all rules, including eviction or lease termination for violations;
- Coordinate with external agencies (health office, fire department, environment, etc.) for compliance.

ARTICLE III

STALLS, LEASES, RENTALS, AND FEES

Section 7. Classification of Stalls / Sections of Market.

- The market shall be divided into sections, e.g.:
 - Dry/goods section (upper floor) – dry goods, clothing, household goods;
 - Eateries / food preparation stalls;
- Stalls/facilities may be classified by size, location (front, corner, interior), accessibility (ground vs. upper floor) for purposes of rental differentiation.

Section 8. Rental Rates, Utilities, and Fees.

- Rental rates for stalls shall be set by the Market Committee and approved by the Sangguniang Bayan; they may vary depending on section, size, location, and category of goods.
- Lease term shall be renewable subject to good standing; short-term leases for transient vendors may also be allowed.
- Utilities (water, electricity, drainage, sanitation) shall be billed either collectively (to all lessees) or individually if meters are installed; charges shall be apportioned fairly.
- A rebate/discount may be given for early payment (e.g. payments made on or before a certain date each month).

e) Penalties for late payment or non-payment shall be established (e.g. surcharge + interest).

f) Stallholders may be required to pay a one-time goodwill fee or security deposit as determined by the Committee.

Section 9. Stall Rental and Occupational Rights

1. Occupational Rights for Market Buildings - - - - -25,000.00(payable within 3 years)

Small Stall – ₱3,000.00 per lease term per month

Medium Stall – ₱5,000.00 per lease term per month

Large Stall – ₱8,000.00 per lease term

Section 10. Stall Allocation, Adjudication, Vacancy & Transfer.

a) When a fixed stall becomes vacant, it shall be allocated through drawing of lots or bidding (transparent method), in accordance with criteria set by the Market Committee.

b) Transfer of stall lease or sublease shall require approval of the Market Manager and the Market Committee; may be allowed only under certain conditions (e.g. to immediate family or under special circumstances) and subject to fees.

c) Non-use or abandonment: if a stall is unoccupied for 30 consecutive days without notification or payment, it may be considered abandoned and the lease may be terminated after due process.

d) Transient vendors shall be assigned designated areas during market days or special market events; they shall not block aisles or obstruct safety paths.

ARTICLE IV

HEALTH, SANITATION, SAFETY, AND STRUCTURAL MAINTENANCE

Section 11. Sanitary Requirements.

a) Stallholders shall observe cleanliness of stall and surroundings; dispose of waste properly; stalls to have drainage, proper flooring materials, walls, etc.

b) Food-handling stalls (meat, fish, eateries) shall comply with health permits, inspections, food safety rules, use of protective clothing, clean water; MHO shall issue and monitor health compliance.

c) Common toilets, wash areas, slaughter or fish processing areas (if applicable) must be maintained by the Market Manager and stallholders, with regular cleaning and inspection.

Section 12. Waste Management.

a) Solid waste to be segregated, collected and disposed in accordance with RA 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act); market management shall provide adequate waste containers.

b) Hazardous or bio-waste (if any) must be handled according to law.

c) Drainage, sewage, water outlets must be maintained to avoid water stagnation, mosquito breeding, odors.

Section 13. Safety, Structural Maintenance, Utilities, and Physical Facilities.

- a) The building's structural integrity, roofing, flooring, lighting, ventilation, fire protection (fire exits, extinguishers), electrical wiring shall be maintained properly by the Market Manager/Engineering Office.
- b) Fire safety equipment must be in place; market shall comply with the Fire Code of the Philippines (RA 9514) and related implementing rules.
- c) Adequate lighting, passageways/aisles must be kept clear to ensure access and safety.
- d) Drainage and water supply systems must be kept functioning.

ARTICLE V

MARKET HOURS, OPERATIONS & CONDUCT

Section 14. Operating Hours.

- a) The market shall be open from 4:00 A.M. up to 10:00 PM, or as may be set by the Market Manager and approved by the Market Committee.
- b) Stallholders must open stalls at opening hours, close only at closing hours; no overnight stay inside stalls except those establishments operating 24 hours/7 days a week.

Section 15. Vendor Conduct / Prohibited Acts.

- a) Vendors shall conduct themselves decently, respecting others; no loud disturbances, no blocking of aisles.
- b) Sleeping inside stalls is prohibited.
- c) Cooking in non-eateries stalls are prohibited.
- d) Selling of prohibited items (as per national/local laws) is disallowed.
- e) All vendors must secure required licenses, permits, health certificates, etc.

ARTICLE VI

ENFORCEMENT, PENALTIES, AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Section 16. Violations and Penalties.

- a) First offense: written warning;
- b) Second offense: fine of 500.00 pesos;
- c) Third offense: fine of 1,000.00 pesos
- d) Repeated or serious violation: temporary suspension of lease, revocation or termination of lease, eviction of stallholder after due process.

Section 17. Appeals and Complaints.

- a) Stallholders or vendors may appeal decisions of the Market Manager to the Market Committee.
- b) Appeals must be made in writing within 15 days after notice.
- c) The Market Committee shall resolve appeals within 15 days.

ARTICLE VII
FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

Section 18. Use of Revenues.

- a) All revenues from rentals, fees, fines, etc. collected under this Ordinance shall accrue to the Municipality of San Miguel.
- b) Portions thereof shall be earmarked for maintenance of the market building, utilities, sanitation, staff salaries, improvements, and reserve for repairs.
- c) Surplus may be utilized for other market-related improvements or as may be approved by the Sangguniang Bayan.

Section 19. Budget and Accounting.

- a) The Market Manager together with the Municipal Treasurer shall prepare an annual budget for the market operation.
- b) Proper accounting records must be kept; revenues and expenditures must be audited in accordance with government accounting rules.

ARTICLE VIII
MISCELLANEOUS


Section 20. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 21. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.



**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE ENTITLED:
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE NEW TWO-
STOREY MARKET BUILDING IN SAN MIGUEL, LEYTE HELD AT THE NEW PUBLIC MARKET,
BARANGAY CAYARE, SAN MIGUEL, LEYTE ON DECEMBER 03, 2025**

Stakeholders and Stall owners of the public market

The public hearing was called to order by the sponsor of the said proposed ordinance Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija at exactly 2:00 P.M. The table was declared open for suggestions, comments and recommendations in aid of legislation after Hon. Martija discussed the salient features of the proposed ordinance to the stakeholders.

Mr. Nilo Arpon suggested to the sponsor to raffle the slots in the public market and it should be in the first come first serve basis so that the availment will be fair to all.

Municipal Engineer Edmundo B. Brazil, Jr. explained to the august body the sizes of the spaces available for rent in the public market and they are as follows:

Ground Floor

- a. Small area - 3 meters by 11.4 meters
- b. Medium area - 6 meters by 11.4 meters
- c. Large area - 6 meters by 13.78 meters

Second Floor

- a. Small areas - 4 meters by 3 meters
- b. Medium area - 5.7 meters by 6.25 meters
- c. Large area - 4.6 meters by 6.25 meters

Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija further explained that the following rates will be as follows based on the recommendations from the Office of the Municipal Mayor:

- a. Small area - P 3,000.00 per month
- b. Medium area - P 5,000.00 per month
- c. Large area - P 8,000.00 per month
- Rights fee - P 25,000.00

Mateo Amador inquired if the dry goods section will be allowed to occupy the first floor since their goods will not saleable if they will be placed in the second floor.

Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija explained that the Market Committee will be the one to decide where the dry goods and other commodities will be placed or located.

Mateo Amador again asked where will be the Barber Shops be placed?

Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija replied that it will be placed in the second floor.

Minerma B. Babiano also asked in connection to the composition of the Market Committee and who will be the one to choose the representative of the stall owners to the said committee?

Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija answered that it will be the Market Association who will choose their representative to the Market Committee.

Marietta Abadingo appealed to the proponent to consider their request that all low-income stall owners be allowed to occupy the first floor.

Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija explained to the body that all their suggestions and requests are being noted and will be given consideration during the deliberation of the said ordinance.

Antonio Jadulan also appealed to the sponsor to stop those illegal peddlers roaming around the poblacion because it is prejudicial to those fish vendors situated in the public market.

Nilo Arpon again inquired from the sponsor where will be the meat section of the public market be located?

Engr. Brazil informed the stall owners that the meat section will be located at the back of the public market building.

Marissa Enoviso also appealed to the proponent to look into those meat shops without business permits.

Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija assured the stall owners that once the public market starts to operate, the Slaughter House will simultaneously operate. Once it operates, there will be no slaughter of any kind without the necessary permit from the Meat Inspector.

Nilo Arpon asked the proponent when is the tentative opening of the Public Market?

Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija replied that the proposed opening is next year.

Jun Sancajo also pointed out that the public market cannot open without first organizing the market association.

Hon. Norman Niel G. Martija answered in the negative and explained that the august body will first enact the ordinance and after that the public market can now open without the market association.

There being no more questions, inquiries, recommendations and comments on the said proposed municipal ordinance, the public hearing was terminated at 4:45 P.M.


