





**WHEREAS**, institutionalizing these CDD and CEAC processes will ensure the continuity of good practices, promote participatory governance aligned with the mandate of the Local Government Code of 1991, and enhance collaboration among the Municipal Government, Barangays, community organizations, and stakeholders;

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to adopt a local policy framework that embeds CDD principles into planning, budgeting, implementation, and sustainability mechanisms, including counterparting schemes, to safeguard public funds and maximize the impact of local development investments;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion by the **Honorable Ronnie S. Saballa**, duly seconded by the **Honorable Mark Cloyd M. Tan-piengco**; be it

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MAYORGA, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN IT BY LAW, THAT:**

#### SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as the **“Community-Driven Development Institutionalization Ordinance of Mayorga.”**

#### SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Mayorga to promote community participation, transparency, and accountability in the identification, prioritization, resource allocation, implementation, operation, and sustainability monitoring of all locally funded programs and projects.

To this end, the Community-Driven Development (CDD) approach is hereby institutionalized. Selected activities under the Community Empowerment Activity Cycle (CEAC), including the Barangay Assembly, Participatory Situation Analysis, Criteria Setting, resource counterparting mechanisms, project development processes, community volunteer-based implementation for selected projects, and sustainability monitoring, are adopted as strategies to support the attainment of the municipality’s development goals.

#### SECTION 3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE.

This ordinance covers projects implemented through counterparting between the MLGU, BLGU, and the community. Externally funded projects may adopt the mechanisms herein, in which case a corresponding MOA shall be executed.


#### SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:



- **Community-Driven Development (CDD)** – a development strategy wherein communities, especially the poor, are empowered as initiators, planners, and collaborators in managing development resources at the local level.
- **Community Empowerment Activity Cycle (CEAC)** – a multi-stage process that mobilizes community capacity to identify and prioritize needs, design activities, seek technical support, manage resources, implement solutions, and sustain development actions.
- **Barangay Assembly (BA)** – the meeting of all qualified residents of the barangay as provided under Sec. 397 of R.A. 7160.
- **Participatory Situation Analysis (PSA)** – a collective method of data gathering, analysis, and planning that enables communities to identify conditions, issues, and opportunities from their own perspective.
- **Criteria Setting** – a process of establishing standards for selecting responsive development interventions to address priority issues.
- **Sustainability Evaluation (SE)** – a mechanism to determine the functionality, benefits, and maintenance adherence of completed subprojects.
- **Local Project Monitoring Committee (LPMC)** – an executive-created body that monitors, evaluates, and recommends actions on the implementation of local development plans and projects.

## SECTION 5. SUSTAINABILITY MECHANISM.


The following components and activities are hereby institutionalized:

### 5.1 Local Development Planning

- Mandatory conduct of Municipal Orientation/Project Launching for the Expanded Municipal Development Council (EMDC) and Municipal Inter-Agency Committee (MIAC) for all incoming programs and projects.
- Convergence of stakeholders for programs requiring MOAs with the municipality and concerned agencies.
- Continuation of transparency mechanisms through regular reporting in Barangay Assemblies and consultative involvement of at least 70% of households in local development decision-making.
- Adoption of the PSA process in identifying priority barangay needs.
- Conduct of orientation and selection of Barangay Development Council (BDC) sectoral representatives at the start of every term of office.



f. Strengthening the participation of community-based organizations by expanding the BDC and the Municipal Development Council (MDC).

## 5.2 Budget Formulation

a. Strengthening and expanding the Barangay Development Council to include the Barangay Representation Team (BRT) Chairperson, Barangay Sub-Project Management Committee (BSPMC) Chairperson, and Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Group President/Chairperson as regular members.

b. The expansion of the Municipal Development Council (MDC) shall include additional sectoral representatives, such as the Barangay Sub-Project Management Committee (BSPMC) Chairperson and Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Group President/Chairperson, **as non-voting members**, without prejudice to the composition prescribed under RA 7160.

c. Integration of unmet barangay needs into the Municipal Development Plan (MDP) and Local Development Investment Plan (LDIP).

d. Creation of a Technical Working Group (TWG) composed of MIAC members/department heads to review all proposed projects, including technical documents and social and environmental safeguards.

e. Strict implementation of the policy: **“No Social and Environmental Safeguards, No Project Implementation.”**

f. Annual allocation of funds for the operation and maintenance of all projects, regardless of fund source.

g. Mandatory inclusion of O&M funding in all projects listed in the AIP.

## 5.3 Budget Execution

a. Ensuring the involvement of women in all project implementations (regardless of fund source and mode of implementation).

b. Strengthened enforcement of the Full Disclosure Policy in all barangays.

c. Adoption of policies ensuring women’s participation in paid labor roles for contract-implemented community projects.



a. Conduct of Functionality Audit (FA) and Final Inspection (FI) of all completed subprojects prior to turnover to barangay/O&M groups.



Local Project Monitoring Team/ Multi-Stakeholders Inspectorate Team (MSIT) and Barangay Stakeholders Inspectorate Team (BSIT), alongside regular community monitoring.

c. Installation and updating of Property, Plant, and Equipment (PPE) Books across all barangays and at the municipal level.

## SECTION 6. REQUIREMENTS AND SANCTIONS.

The following requirements and sanctions shall ensure the institutionalization and sustainability of the CDD approach:

6.1 No barangay project shall be included in the CDP or considered for funding unless it was identified during the PSA and validated through Barangay Assembly proceedings. Compliance shall be evidenced by minutes and attendance sheets;

6.2 No barangay funding request to the MLGU shall be granted unless the barangay provides its counterpart (cash or in-kind). Cash counterpart shall be supported by the annual budget/appropriation ordinance; in-kind counterpart shall be supported by a Barangay Resolution. For labor contributions, a labor matrix shall be prepared;

6.3 All counterparting project requests must be accompanied by the Program of Work and complete technical plans and designs.

6.4 Requests for financial assistance from external agencies shall require SB endorsement and must include the Program of Work, technical plans, and an SB Resolution.


6.5 For projects implemented through counterparting, MLGU funds shall be transferred to the BLGU, which shall lead project implementation. A MOA shall govern implementation guidelines, including MLGU inspectorate authority over physical and financial aspects.

6.6 No counterparting project shall be implemented if combined funds (MLGU, BLGU, and community, including in-kind) are insufficient to complete a usable and functional project.


6.7 Barangay Officials shall lead counterparting projects and may be assisted by organized volunteer groups such as the Project Implementation Team and the Monitoring and Inventory Team.

The Barangay Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) shall be constituted strictly in accordance with RA 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

6.8 All procurement activities shall strictly comply with the provisions of RA 9184, its IRR, and relevant GPPB issuances.



## SECTION 7. ALLOCATION OF LOCAL COUNTERPART CONTRIBUTION (LCC).

To ensure sustained implementation of counterparting initiatives, the Municipality of Mayorga shall endeavor to allocate at least twenty percent (20%) of its Twenty Percent (20%) Economic Development Fund (EDF) as Local Counterpart Contribution (LCC), subject to annual budget preparation processes under RA 7160.

## SECTION 8. PRIORITIZATION BY THE MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL.

Due to limited financial resources of both the MLGU and BLGUs, the MDC shall undertake prioritization of barangay projects to ensure optimal use of the LCC and greater impact on community welfare.

## SECTION 9. CONTINUING ENGAGEMENT OF THE MIAC.

The Municipal Inter-Agency Committee (MIAC) shall continue to operate and provide technical assistance to barangays to sustain CDD practices and technologies.

## SECTION 10. TRANSPARENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY MECHANISMS.

To promote transparency and accountability:

- A transparency billboard shall be installed at the project site, indicating project details, cost, duration, and counterpart contributions.
- Physical and financial accomplishments shall be reported during Barangay Assemblies and posted in the barangay hall and other conspicuous places

## SECTION 11. CREATION OF A CDD UNIT AND DESIGNATION OF A CDD FOCAL PERSON

The Local Chief Executive is authorized to create a CDD Program Unit within the municipal structure as a program or coordinating mechanism, and to designate an existing municipal employee as CDD Focal Person.

This provision shall not be construed as creating new plantilla positions unless otherwise authorized by the DBM and RA 7160.


## SECTION 12. AUTHORITY TO FORMULATE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR).

The Municipal Development Council (MDC) is hereby authorized to formulate the IRR of this ordinance, which shall include, among others, prioritization criteria and resource allocation guidelines consistent with national laws, COA regulations, and available barangay resources.

## SECTION 13. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Ordinance or any part thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.



**SECTION 15. REPEALING CLAUSE.**

All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders or regulations and other issuances inconsistent with the provisions and/or purposes of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.**

This ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte.
