This office is of the opinion that the subject Ordinance is generally in accordance with its power under Sections 21(a) and (c)¹ of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160). Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.

¹ (a) A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park, or square falling within its jurisdiction: Provided, however, That in case of permanent closure, such ordinance must be approved by at least two-thirds (2/3) of all the members of the sanggunian, and when necessary, an adequate substitute for the public facility that is subject to closure is provided.

(c) Any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during an actual emergency, or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs, or an undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and waterworks projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the local chief executive concerned in a written order: Provided, however, That no national or local road, alley, park, or square shall be temporarily closed for athletic, cultural, or civic activities not officially sponsored, recognized, or approved by the local government unit concerned.



AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE TEMPORARY ANNUAL CLOSURE OF FLORES STREET, POBLACION ZONE I, CAPOOCAN, LEYTE, IN OBSERVANCE OF THE ANNUAL TOWN FIESTA, ANNUAL TOWN'S FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY AND CHRISTMAS SEASON

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides, among others, under Section 21 (a), and (c), to wit:

"Closure and Opening of Roads – (a) A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park, or square falling within its jurisdiction;

(c) Any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during an actual emergency, or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs, or an undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and waterworks projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the Local Chief Executive concerned in a written order;

(d) Any city, municipality, or barangay may, by a duly enacted ordinance, temporarily close and regulate the use of any local street, road, thoroughfares, or any other public place where shopping malls, Sunday, flea or night markets, or shopping areas may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities, or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public."

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Capoocan celebrates its Annual Town Fiesta and Annual Town's Foundation Anniversary, every June 5 and November 23, respectively;

WHEREAS, both momentous occasions are important cultural and social events, that showcases the rich heritage, traditions, and culture of Capoocanons through various activities such as but not limited to street dances, food fair, and other exciting activities, which are expected to attract a large number of visitors and spectators;

WHEREAS, the activities during the Annual Town's Foundation Anniversary extends to the celebration of the Christmas Season which is commenced by the lighting of the Christmas Village on the Annual Town's Foundation Anniversary Night;

WHEREAS, there is a need to adopt public safety measures to ensure the smooth conduct of these activities, and in order to maintain the free flow of traffic and to ensure the safety of spectators and visitors, the closure of the aforementioned street is respectfully sought;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Florence R. Carolino-Misagal, duly seconded by Honorable Von Lito Q. Vallar, Honorable Lander Jake D. Abillar, Honorable Federico P. Carolino, Jr. and Honorable Dave A. Nidera, without any objections;

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Capoocan, Leyte in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. The street to be temporarily closed is Flores Street, located at Poblacion Zone 1, Capoocan, Leyte, between Capoocan Multi-Purpose Sports Center and LGU grounds. It is also the street traversing towards the Holy Name of Jesus Parish Church.

SECTION 2. Rules and regulations governing the temporary closure of Flores Street.

- a. The street that have been declared temporarily closed shall primarily accommodate the activities related to the Annual Town Fiesta, Annual Town's Foundation Anniversary, and Christmas Season.
- b. The street closure shall be implemented as follows:
 1. From May 1 to June 15 for the celebration of the Annual Town Fiesta, and
 2. From November 1 to the Second Sunday of January for the celebration of the Annual Town's Founding Anniversary and the Christmas Season.
- c. Adequate signages shall be placed near and along the affected areas in order to guide the public accordingly and ensure proper management of traffic on this area.

SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT. The Municipal Police Station of Capoocan, Leyte shall be responsible for the strict enforcement of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other part or provisions hereof which are not affected shall remain to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any ordinance, executive order, and other rules and regulations, which are contrary or inconsistent, whole or in part, with this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law



10 Hon. Misagal: Madame Chair, being the Vice-Chair of the Committee on Education, Culture, Arts
11 and Tourism, I am sponsoring AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE TEMPORARY ANNUAL CLOSURE OF
12 FLORES STREET, POBLACION ZONE I, CAPOOCAN, LEYTE, FROM NOVEMBER 1 TO THE SECOND
13 SUNDAY OF JANUARY, IN OBSERVANCE OF THE TOWN'S FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY AND THE
14 CHRISTMAS SEASON.

16 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Capoocan will be celebrating its Annual Foundation Anniversary on
17 November 23 of every year. It is an important cultural and social event, that showcases the rich heritage,
18 traditions, and culture of us Capoocanons through various activities such as but not limited to street dances,
19 food fair, and other exciting activities;

20
21 WHEREAS, prior to the culmination of the Annual Foundation Anniversary, damo nga activities an ginhe-
22 held, usa na ini an grand civic parade, an aton Lantawan Festival, mga duru-dilain nga mga competition,
23 sugad man han agri-tourism fair, ngan han ceremonial lighting han una nga Lantawan Festival of Lights,
24 ngan yana, mayda kita gindudugang, amo an aton Christmas Village, which are expected to attract a large
25 number of visitors and expectators;

27 WHEREAS, there is a need to adopt public safety measures to ensure the smooth conduct of these

37 baraklason, it will take time, maybe for a week. Kun mayda man kita mga activities or agri-fairs, diri man po
38 ito dayon natumong hiton November 23, mayda pa man po ito pag-ayad nga pag-pwesto dida, amo po ito
39 nga an petsa November 1. Any questions or clarifications regarding the temporary closure of Flores
40 Street?

42 Hon. Vallar: Good morning. Actually, the process of closing a particular street, nag-iistart hiya ha
43 resolution from the barangay, and then, once the resolution is approved, we will create an ordinance for the
44 temporary closure, based on the Local Government Code ini nga process, but, I will no longer read this kay
45 bangin mag-iha kay hilaba. Ginpapasabot ko la ha iyo nga amo ito an proseso whenever kamo didto ha iyo
46 barangay, whenever usa nga street igklo-close anay for the meantime, then amo ito an bubhaton la, the
47 same, then ifo-forward la ha LGU for the approval of the ordinance. Being the Chairman on Ordinance, I
48 was suggesting to my Vice-Chairman to include han fiesta dinhi hini nga ordinance, kay during fiestas,

44 President of the Philippines;

46 WHEREAS, Section 5.3 of the Implementing Guidelines of Executive Order No. 305, states that, the
47 LGUs shall require the applicant to secure a clearance from the PNP Maritime Office in the LGU or in its
48 absence, the local PNP, certifying that the fishing vessel is not involved in any criminal offense;

50 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Capoocan,
51 Province of Leyte, in Regular Session duly assembled that:

53 SECTION 1. Section 9 of Municipal Ordinance No. 8, Series of 2023 is hereby amended to read as follows:

55 **SECTION 9 - REGISTRATION OF FISHING VESSELS**

57 F 1. An applicant for fishing vessel registration shall secure a PNP Maritime Group Clearance or Local
58 PNP Clearance, if the former is not available, certifying that the vessel is not involved in any
59 criminal offense. The clearance fee is Php100.00.
