Municipal Ordinance No. 005 – 2025 Series of 2025

“AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE USE OF PRE-EMPTIVE MEASURES DURING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS SUCH AS FORCED EVACUATION DURING MAN-MADE OR NATURAL DISASTERS AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREOF.”

WHEREAS, under Section 455, of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the New Local Government Code, status that, the Municipal Mayor is mandated to carry such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the after-math of man-made and natural disasters”.

WHEREAS, under section 2, (1) of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Risk Reduction Management Act of 2010, it is the policy of the state to recognize and strengthen the capacities of LGU and communities in mitigating and preparing for, responding to, and recovering from the impact of disasters.

WHEREAS, Section 458 in relation to section 16 of Local Government Code, empowers Sangguniang Bayan as the Legislative body of the Municipality to enact ordinance and adopt resolutions for the general welfare of the Municipality and its inhabitants.

Adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the municipality from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and aftermath of disasters or calamities and their return to production livelihood, following the said events:

WHEREAS, while the objective of the Local Government of Pastrana to have zero casualty, there is a need to adopt guidelines and to properly implement the same on order to mitigate the effects of man-made and natural disaster;

WHEREAS, it is settled that the government is under obligation to protect human lives at all times during the severity and magnitude of disasters renders effective response beyond the capabilities of the government;

NOW THEREFOR, BE IT ENACTED, as it is hereby enacted the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Pastrana, in session assembled, by virtue of the powers vested in it by law, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as an "ORDINANCE MANDATING THE USE OF PRE-EMPTIVE MEASURES DURING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS SUCH AS FORCED EVACUATION DURING MAN-MADE AND NATURAL DISASTERS AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREOF".

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- 1. Disaster** - shall mean the result of a natural or man-made event which causes loss of life, injury and property damage, including but not limited to natural disasters such as hurricane, tornado, storm, flood, high winds, and other weather related events, and man-made disasters, including but not limited to nuclear power plant incidents, hazardous materials incidents, oil spills, explosions, civil disturbances, public calamity, acts of terrorism, hostile military action and other events related thereto.
- 2. Imminent Danger** - shall mean an immediate threat of harm.
- 3. Designated Area**- shall mean barangay halls or outposts as pick up points.
- 4. Evacuation** - shall mean an operation whereby all or part of particular population is temporarily relocated, whether individually or in an organized manner, from an area which a disaster or emergency has been declared is dangerous for health or safety of the public.
- 5. Evacuation sites/Centers** - shall mean all public elementary and high school buildings, sports facilities such as covered courts and auditoriums, barangay hall and other public or private facilities.
- 6. Forced evacuation** - shall mean an evacuation ordered as a resort when a disaster or emergency has been declared and danger of loss of life is imminent, and conditions exist that critically imperil or endanger the lives of those in a defined area.
- 7. Response Team** - shall mean any concerted effort by two (2) or more agencies, public or private, to provide assistance or intervention before, during or immediately after a disaster to meet the life preservation and basic subsistence needs of those people affected and the restoration of public activities and facilities.
- 8. Vulnerable or Marginal Groups** - shall mean individuals or group of people that face higher exposure to disaster risk and poverty including but not limited to women, especially pregnant women, youth, children especially the orphans and unaccompanied children, elderly, differently-abled people, indigenous people, the disadvantage families and individuals in living in high risk and danger zones.

SECTION 3 RISK COMMUNICATION AND INFORMATION DISSEMINATION GUIDELINES-

- a) The Pastrana Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO) shall ensure that proper trainings, orientation on the possible natural hazards, vulnerabilities, and climate change risk as well as knowledge management and information dissemination regarding calamities and disasters, either natural or man-made, are fully organized and conducted at the barangay level.
- b) Training, orientations and activities shall also be discussed in a language understood by the local residents.
- c) Pastrana Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO) and its counterpart in the barangay level shall also cause the posting and posters of training, orientations, activities and information at the conspicuous places of Pastrana Leyte and barangay, the issuance of newsletters, brochure and pamphlets, and if possible, dissemination through radio and television advertisements.
- d) During rainy season as declared by the Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA), these trainings, orientations, activities and information dissemination shall be intensified and made on a regular basis, especially in the areas that are vulnerable to flooding, landslides and other natural disasters or calamities.

SECTION 4. ENSURING PUBLIC SAFETY DURING MAN-MADE AND NATURAL DISASTERS.

A. Implementation of force evacuation when a disaster or an emergency has been declared and danger of loss of lives is imminent in the area of jurisdiction.

1. The Municipal Mayor shall declare the use of pre-emptive measures such as forced evacuation. Force Evacuation shall be done only upon recommendation of the Pastrana Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office after due consultation with the different government agencies such as, but not limited to, Dam Administrators, PAGASA, PHIVOLCS, DPWH and PNP and when a disaster for emergency has been declared and the danger of loss of lives is imminent within the area of jurisdiction of the Municipality of Pastrana, Leyte.

If possible, the order of the pre-emptive evacuation must be thoroughly evaluated after consultation with different government, agencies, especially during rainy seasons. Forced evacuation shall be announced to the vulnerable of marginalized groups in the area who will be affected at least two (2) hours before the commencement of the forced evacuation to give the affected individuals or groups to prepare their necessary needs or belongings.

2. Vulnerable or marginalized groups in the identified danger zones or areas that are to be affected by the incoming typhoon or any other identified situation or event that may cause a disaster shall be temporarily relocated to evacuation sites or centers.

Assistance from the private sectors such as private school shall be secured. Temporary use of private school's sport facilities or auditorium may be requested if the need arises and if the shortage of evacuation sites exists.

3. Barangay halls and outposts shall be designated as the pick-up points or areas. The MDRRMC shall take the lead in preparing for responding to, and recovering from the effects of any disaster based on the criteria provided under Rule II, Section 1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulation of Republic Act 10121.

4. Enlist the assistance of the Municipal Chief of Police, AFP Commander or Coast Guard, Municipal Fire Marshall Chief, Municipal Jail Officer, Pastrana Rescue Unit (PASRU), or any accredited community disaster volunteers (ACDVs) in preparation and enforcement of pre-emptive measures such as force evacuation before and during the disaster or calamity situations.

5. Strict enforcement of the pre-emptive measures shall be done on the area/s affected by man-made or natural disaster. The Barangay Chief Executive or any of barangay officials, who will as much as possible, be responsible in leading the response team composed of MDRRMC team, the PNP or any enforcement agency, local rescue teams or volunteers. The responses shall make sure that no person has been left unaccounted in the area or allowed to return in the affected area without an order issued to this effect.

If any from the vulnerable or marginalized groups does not adhere to the order of forced evacuation and found within the danger or target area, he/she may be arrested and forcibly be taken as a means of ensuring his/her safety.

a) The high risk and the elderly people

b) Differently-abled people;

c) Pregnant women and children, especially the orphan and unaccompanied children;

d) Indigenous people

6). Social services shall be on an alerts status to monitor and provide services and necessary materials such as but not limited to beddings, blanket, clothing, foods and medicine, to the victims in times of disasters or calamity. Medical personnel shall also be on an alert status to provide medical assistance to the vulnerable or marginalized groups, and other persons that need immediate medical attention. In the aftermath of the calamity and/ or man-made or natural disaster, the Local Government of Pastrana shall extent any assistance that it can provide to victims for the rapid recovery.

7). Response teams must be equipped with proper trainings and necessary equipment's suitable for a particular situation. The Local Government of Pastrana may provide additional equipment's and paraphernalia to the response team as maybe needed to properly and respectively respond to the needs of those who are affected by the calamity and/or man-made or natural disasters.

The Municipal Government of Pastrana shall take full responsibility for the enhancement, welfare and protection of volunteers and shall submit the list to the office of the civil Defense through MDRRMO for and inclusion in the database of community disaster volunteers.

The Municipal Government of Pastrana shall be responsible for providing insurance and necessary benefits to any volunteers who dies or sustain injury while engaging in any of the activities defined in Republic Act 10121 otherwise known as the Philippines Risk Reduction Management Act of 2010.

SECTION 5. Guidelines in implementing forced evacuation.

a) Forced evacuation shall be carried out in a manner that is humane, respectful of the dignity of a person, not using disproportionate force, without discrimination and with conscious attention to the needs of vulnerable sectors such as children, women, the elderly and persons with disabilities.

b) Personnel and volunteers carrying out the force evacuation shall make sure that all measures are taken to inform the evacuees, in a manner and language that they can understand, of the need to the evacuation, the lack of other alternative for their safety, the place where they will be taken and the length of time of their evacuation;

c) Personnel and volunteers carrying out the force evacuation shall comply with other rules being promulgated by the Commission Human Rights (CHR) for the protection of human rights of all persons.

Section 6. The Philippines National Police (PNP) and the Bureau of Fire of Protection (BFP).- The Philippine National Police (PNP) and the Bureau of Fire of Protection (BFP), as members of the response team, shall maximize their resources in assisting the Members of Pastrana Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office, barangay officials, Barangay health emergency response teams and community disaster volunteers during the implementation of forced evacuation, with the end of maintaining order and safety of the local residents throughout the process of forced evacuation.

They shall also take appropriate measures in safeguarding the belongings left behind and brought along by the evacuated residents of the Pastrana Leyte.

SECTION 7. Coordination. - All emergency measures adopted shall be coordinative and collaborative effort between the concerned Municipal Officials of Pastrana, The Philippines National Police (PNP) and the bureau Fire of Protection (BFP)

SECTION 8. Administrative Sanctions. -DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2012-35 provides for the filing of appropriate administrative case against responsible local Government agencies (MDRRMO, DSWD) for non-compliance hereof.

SECTION 9. Separability Clause. - If any part or provisions of this Ordinance is found to be inconsistent with the Constitution, laws or decrees, other provisions hereof shall continue to be in force and effect.

SECTION 10. Repealing Clause. - Any ordinance, memo circulars, rules and regulations that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 11. Effectivity. -This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its completion of its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.





MINUTES OF THE **COMMITTEE HEARING** ON THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE “AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE USE OF PRE-EMPTIVE MEASURES DURING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS SUCH AS FORCED EVACUATION DURING MAN-MADE OR NATURAL DISASTERS AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREOF” LAST OCTOBER 13, 2025 AT THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN SESSION HALL.

COMMITTEE HEARING PROCEEDINGS

The Committee Hearing was called to order by the Presiding Officer, Hon. Gerardo S. Carian, at exactly **2:00 o'clock in the afternoon**. The proceedings commenced with a prayer led by **Engr. I. Reazelf C. Alferez**.

Thereafter, the Presiding Officer directed the Sangguniang Bayan Secretary-Designate to conduct the roll call. Having confirmed the presence of a quorum, the Presiding Officer acknowledged the attendance of the committee members and proceeded to present the agenda for the day.

The Presiding Officer likewise acknowledged the presence of the invited resource persons, Mr. Michael M. Castillo (LDRRMO), SFO4 Benjamin Tanala, Engr. Reazelf Alferez.

The Presiding Officer opened the discussion by inquiring from the body if there were any comments, suggestions, or corrections regarding the updated title of the proposed ordinance entitled:

“An Ordinance Mandating the Use of Pre-Emptive Measures During Emergency Situations such as Forced Evacuation During Man-made or Natural Disasters and Providing Guidelines Thereof.”

The Presiding Officer noted that this proposed ordinance had already been discussed in the previous committee meeting held on **August 4, 2025**, and that **Ms. Nona M. Petilla**, Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer (MSWDO), suggested shortening the title for conciseness.

Since the draft ordinance was adopted and based on an existing City Ordinance, the Committee proceeded to review and recommend several minor edits and deletions for contextual accuracy and applicability to the Municipality of Pastrana.

Page-by-Page Review:

- **Page 1:**
Hon. **Jerlyn C. Borja** suggested that the term “*City Mayor*” be changed to “*Municipal Mayor*” and “*City Government*” be changed to “*Municipal Government*.”
- **Page 2:**
Hon. **Jerlyn C. Borja** also recommended that the word “*man*” be corrected to “*mean*” and that “*Pastrana, Leyte*” be replaced with “*Municipality of Pastrana*.”
- **Page 3:**
Mr. **Michael Castillo**, MDRRMO, proposed that “*MCDRRMO*” be corrected to “*MDRRMO*.”
He also recommended that Section 4, Number 4, “*City Chief of Police*” be changed to “*Municipal Chief of Police*.”

SF04 Benjamin Tanala further suggested changing "City Fire Chief" to "Municipal Fire Marshal" and "City Jail" to "Municipal Jail." He also proposed the deletion of Section 4, Letter B, referring to the "Prohibition of fishing vessels and activities on areas declared by PAGASA under PSWS", as this provision is not applicable to the municipality.

- **Page 4:**
No corrections or comments were raised.
- **Page 5:**
Mr. Michael Castillo, MDRRMO, recommended that in Section 5, Number 5, "Disaster Risk Reduction Management Group" be changed to "Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office."
- **Page 6:**
Hon. Loida B. Villablanca proposed that in the last paragraph of Section 11, "Sangguniang Panglungsod" be changed to "Sangguniang Bayan."

After thorough deliberation, Hon. Alex C. Sequito moved to recommend the proposed ordinance entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE USE OF PRE-EMPTIVE MEASURES DURING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS SUCH AS FORCED EVACUATION DURING MAN-MADE OR NATURAL DISASTERS AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREOF"

for Second Reading in the next regular session. The motion was duly seconded unanimously and was approved by the body.

There being no other matters to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 2:48 o'clock in the afternoon upon motion of Hon. Loida B. Villablanca, duly seconded by Hon. Jerlyn C. Borja. It was formally closed with a prayer led by Hon. Loida B. Villablanca.


V. ADJOURNMENT
