**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF A CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM IN CERTAIN BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, AND OTHER PLACES AND SPACES CONSIDERED AS HIGH-RISK WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LA PAZ, LEYTE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), or the General Welfare Clause, empowers local government units (LGUs) to enact measures that promote the general welfare of their inhabitants, including the maintenance of peace and order and public safety;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has encouraged cities and municipalities to enact ordinances mandating the installation of CCTV systems in business establishments and high-risk areas;

**WHEREAS**, law enforcement agencies have recognized CCTV systems as effective tools in crime deterrence, prevention, detection, and solution by providing video evidence;

**WHEREAS**, surveillance cameras are capable of capturing movements of criminals and terrorists and plays important role in aiding law enforcers identify criminals even after the occurrence of crimes;

**WHEREAS**, the installation of CCTV and other monitoring devices will serve as deterrence for crimes ins La Paz, Leyte and as an effective aid in law enforcement;

**WHEREAS**, on the part of the owners, operators and managers, CCTV cameras are also effective tools of management in monitoring the flow of their clients and customers and the movements of their employees inside their establishments;

**WHEREAS**, the municipal government unit is mandated to assist our law enforcers in solving crimes committed within its jurisdiction through identification, apprehension and even in the prosecution of crime suspects;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of La Paz, Leyte, in session assembled, that:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as the "CCTV Ordinance of Municipality of La Paz, Leyte".

**SECTION 2: COVERAGE.** All businesses with capitalization not less than Three Hundred Thousand pesos (P300,000.00) and even public establishments catering the general

public and other high-risk areas are hereby mandated to install CCTV's and other video monitoring devices in their establishments.

**SECTION 3. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is the policy of the Municipal Government to ensure the safety and security of its constituents and deter criminality, while also ensuring that the fundamental right to privacy is not unnecessarily hampered, in accordance with the Data Privacy Act of 2012 and relevant NPC circulars and advisories.

**SECTION 4. LOCATION OF THE CAMERAS AND COVERAGE GUIDELINES.** Cameras should be strategically placed to cover key areas but not private spaces. Recorders must be secured. Signages indicating surveillance are required.

**SECTION 5. MINIMUM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS.** CCTV systems must meet minimum standards, including resolution of at least 720p or 1080p, recording inputs minimum of 30 frames per second, storage capacity for at least 30 days and a power supply with backup.

**SECTION 6. PRESERVATION OF THE RECORDINGS.** The owners of the establishment are responsible for continuous operation and ensure that the cameras are working properly. Business owners are required to keep, store and preserve the daily video recordings from the CCTV's for a minimum of period of at least thirty (30) days for review purposes and reference, only erasing it if not needed for investigations.

**SECTION 7. ACCESS TO THE RECORDINGS.** It is unlawful for any person to allow the unauthorized or unofficial public use of public viewing of any saved video recording from a CCTV. However, owners of the business establishments shall give the duly authorized Municipal authorities or police access to the CCTV recording or video tapes/footages if the occasion warrants, provided, the assigned officer or person in authority must show the written authority issued to him for that matter.

**SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES.** The Municipal Public Order and Safety (MPOSO) or its equivalent, shall responsible for the verification and determination of the relevant establishments' compliance with the directives of this Ordinance. The MPOSO shall specify when compulsory inspection of the installed CCTVs shall be conducted before the necessary clearance or certification therefor maybe be issued, with clearance or certification shall be mandatory requirement for the issuance or renewal by the Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) of a business permit license. The MPOSO may thereafter conduct inspection during reasonable business hours, to determine continued compliance with this Ordinance post-issuance or renewal of such establishments' business permit or license by the BPLO. For all these purposes, the MPOSO shall seek the advice and assistance of the Local Chief of Police or his duly authorized representative.

The office of Municipal Public Order and Safety (MPOSO) shall be created by virtue of an executive order to be issued by the Local Chief Executive comprising of the following:

- Local PNP Chief
- SB Chairman, Peace and Order Committee
- Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO)
- Municipal Information Officer
- Municipal Planning Development Officer
- General Services Office (GSO)

**SECTION 9. INTERNAL GUIDELINES.** Certain establishments required by this Ordinance to install and maintain a functional CCTV System shall submit a scanned copy of the CCTV Certificate of Compliance, which shall be uploaded in the Municipal Permit and Licensing System as part of the mandatory documentary requirements prior to the approval or renewal of business permits.

**SECTION 10. PENALTIES.** No business permit or permit to operate shall be issued to or renewed for the business establishment mentioned in Section 5 hereof unless the CCTVs herein specified are installed and fully operational.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Warning with the condition that the establishments shall install CCTV within 30 days from notice upon receipt.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – Fine of PhP1,5000.00 with the condition that the establishment shall install CCTV within 15 days from expiration of 30 days and with the warning for the cancellation of the business permit.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – Fine of PhP2,500.00 and cancellation of the Business Permit.

**SECTION 11. APPEAL PROCESS** - Any establishment found to be in violation of this Ordinance by the MPOSO may appeal the findings thereof to the office of the Local Chief Executive within five (5) working days from being notified of its violation by the MPOSO, furnishing a copy of the appeal to the MPOSO prior to the filing thereof with the office of the LCE. Within five (5) working days from the receipt of the copy of the appeal, the MPOSO shall submit its answer to the office of the LCE, furnishing the business establishment a copy of the same on even date. Should the MPOSO fail to file its answer to the appeal with the given period, it shall be deemed to have opposed the appeal on all its material points. The Office of the Mayor shall decide on the matter within five (5) working days lapsed, giving due notice to the parties involved. The decision of the LCE shall be final, and no motion for reconsideration shall be entertained thereafter, subject to such remedial measures as may be then available under the law or Rules of Court.

**SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE.** Business covered by the scope of this Ordinance shall have a period of ninety (90) days from the effectivity of the same within which to comply with the directives hereof.

**SECTION 13. FUNDING.** The Local Chief Executive shall appropriate an ideal amount every year in the LGU annual budget in order to fully implement the provisions of this Ordinance. The same shall also be included in the annual investment program of the Municipality.

**SECTION 14. DISSEMINATION.** The BPLO of LGU La Paz, Leyte shall the cause the widest information dissemination of this Ordinance among all qualified establishments within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of La Paz, Leyte after this Ordinance has been reviewed and approved by the Sanggunian Panlalawigan.

**SECTION 15. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If nay provision of this Ordinance of the application of such provision to any person or circumstances is declared unconstitutional, the remainder of this Ordinance of the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.


**SECTION 16. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All existing ordinances and resolutions of this municipality found to be inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


**SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY.** The ordinance takes effect 15 days after publication or posting.







**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. P – 19, AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF A CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM IN CERTAIN BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, AND OTHER PLACES AND SPACES CONSIDERED AS HIGH-RISK WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LA PAZ, LEYTE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES HELD ON FEBRUARY 23, 2026 AT THE MDC HALL**

**Present:** *See attached attendance sheet.*

The public hearing was called to order at exactly 01:30PM, with Honorable Felicit B. Acompañado, Jr. as the Presiding Officer.

The Chairperson of the Committee formally opened the hearing, together with the Co-Author of the said ordinance Hon. Marlou T. Marticio, who explained the objectives, scope, and salient provisions of the proposed municipal ordinance, particularly emphasizing the promotion of public safety and crime prevention, the deterrent effect of CCTV systems in high-risk areas, and the role of business establishments in supporting local peace and order initiatives.

The Author of the ordinance presented the legal basis and justification of the proposed municipal ordinance, citing the general welfare clause and the police power of the Municipality under existing laws. The floor was then opened for comments, clarifications, recommendations, or objections from stakeholders and attendees. After sufficient opportunity was given to all those present, no further questions, clarifications, comments, or objections were raised by any of the attendees.


After thorough deliberation, the Committee finds that:


1. The proposed ordinance is a valid exercise of the Municipality's police power pursuant to the general welfare clause of Republic Act No. 7160;
2. The installation of CCTV systems in identified high-risk establishments and areas will significantly enhance public safety, crime prevention, and law enforcement response; and
3. The stakeholders present manifested no opposition to the proposed measure during the public hearing.

Upon due review and deliberation of the matter, the Committee on Cooperatives, Livelihood Organizations, Trade and Industry, and Economic Enterprise respectfully recommends for the second reading of the proposed **MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. P – 19, AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF A CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM IN CERTAIN BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, AND OTHER PLACES AND SPACES CONSIDERED AS HIGH-RISK WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LA PAZ, LEYTE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES** on the next regular session of the Sangguniang Bayan.
