**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 5, S. 2026**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5G.02, ARTICLE 6 (MARKET FEES AND CHARGES) OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 126, S-2020 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 2020 "REVISED REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLABA"**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Ordinance No. 126, S-2020 was enacted to regulate the application, lease and use of public market stalls in Building Number 1-9, and to impose corresponding fees in the Municipality of Villaba. However, there is a need to amend and strengthen certain provisions of the said ordinance to ensure transparency, efficiency, fairness and sustainability in the management of Villaba Public Market.

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipality of Villaba is empowered to regulate the use of public property and impose reasonable fees and charges.

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion by the Hon. Meriam P. Umpad, duly seconded en masse,











Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Villaba, Leyte, that:

**CHAPTER I  
GENERAL PROVISION**

**SECTION 1. - TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known as the "Regulation for the Application to Lease Stalls in Villaba."

**SECTION 2. - SCOPE.** The ordinance shall govern all stalls in Building Nos. 1-9 which is owned and managed by the Municipality of Villaba.

**SECTION 3. - POLICY.** It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Villaba to promote and improve its capabilities to deliver desired public services and ensure the safety, comfort and well-being of vendors and the buying public as well.

**SECTION 4. - DEFINITION OF TERMS.** As used in this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:












- a. Public Market – refers to any structure building or place of any kind which have been established, designated, or authorized by the Municipal Council, whether government or privately-owned and operated dedicated to the service of the general public where basic food items and other commodities are displayed and offered for sale.
- b. Market Stalls – refers to any allocated space, stand, compartment, store or any place wherein merchandise is sold, offered for sale, or intended for such purpose in the public market.
- c. Stallholder – refers to the awardee of a definite space or spaces within a public market who pays a rental fee thereof for the purposes of selling his/her goods or commodities or service.
- d. Lease/ Award – refers to the document that grants to lessee/tenant the right to occupy the stall. Lease or award as a term may be used interchangeably and shall mean the same.
- e. Stall Rights Fee– refers to the fee paid to and collected by the Municipal Government thru the Municipal Treasurer’s Office for the rights and privilege of using the stalls in building 1-9.

**SECTION 5 - APPLICATION.** Filipino citizens who are actual residents of the Municipality of Villaba shall be given preference in the award of public market stalls. All application to lease or rent shall be filed to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer in a form prescribed herein.

A stall rights fee and a monthly rental shall be collected from each application to cover the necessary expenses relative to the award and lease of the stall and any excess thereof shall form part of the general fund, *to wit:*

Provided, that stalls, booths, tiendas, and/or spaces located in the best areas, e.g., corner space or those designated by the Market Administrator, shall pay rental charges of twenty-five percent (25%) higher than the rates imposed herein.

Further, where occupancy is more permanent, such as stalls, booths, tiendas, the same shall pay a monthly rental of Php 50.00 per square meter.

**SECTION 6 - Rebates and Penalties.**

- a) A two percent (2%) rebates from the current amount due shall be granted if payment is made on the due date and within five (5) working days of the following month. However, delinquent leases shall not be entitled for such benefits;
- b) A penalty of five percent (5%) to all unpaid amount shall be charged for failure to pay the rental within the prescribed period.

**SECTION 7. APPLICATION.** The application form to be issued by the Municipal Treasurer's Office shall be in the following form which shall be made under oath:



Should the above-mentioned stall be awarded to me for lease in accordance with Municipal Ordinance No. \_\_, S-2025, other ordinances, rules and regulations, I promise to hold the same under the terms and conditions of the contract of lease and subject to the following undertakings:

- (1) That while I am occupying the stall, I shall at all times have the right to possess the awarded stall;
- (2) That I shall keep the stall at all times in good, clean and sanitary condition and comply strictly with all market rules and regulations on sanitation now existing or which may hereafter be promulgated;
- (3) That I shall pay the corresponding application and market stall fees for the stall in the manner prescribed in this Ordinance or in other pertinent ordinances;
- (4) That I shall not sell or transfer my rights or privilege to lease the stall, or otherwise permit other persons to conduct business therein.

Any violation on my part to any of the undertakings shall be a sufficient cause for market administrator to cancel or revoke the contract of lease to be executed in may favor.

SECTION 8. - DURATION OF REGULAR LEASE. Any awarded lease in any form upon approval of this Ordinance shall be five (5) years renewable contract subject to review by the Market Administrator, who will determine if the conditions of the lease/award are faithfully complied with by the stallholder/awardee during his last five (5) years preceding the contract. In case of violations, said stall shall be declared vacant and will be declared available for occupancy to any new qualified applicant.









Contracts of Lease entered into by the Local Government Unit (LGU) prior to the approval of this ordinance shall remain enforceable and effective. However, lessees who violated the provisions of the contract or are expired, shall enter into a new contract with the LGU subject to the conditions stipulated in the preceding paragraph.

SECTION 9. -PROHIBITION OF THE TRANSFER OF RIGHTS. No lessee of any market shall convey, transfer, assign, mortgage, encumber or in any other manner dispose of his rights or interests thereto during the term of the contract. Any person other than the lessee, his helpers or registered partner/s or in case of death, the lessee's surviving spouse or legal heir, found selling in the leased premises shall be prima facie evidence of transferring or sub-leasing. Such shall be a ground for the outright revocation of the contract of lease.

SECTION 10. OTHER PROHIBITIONS. Dwellings in stall or any place within the market premises is strictly prohibited. Any person other than the stallholder or his/her partner or helpers found conducting business at the stall shall be required to pay rent in addition to the corresponding rents collected from the regular holder of lease, provided that the payment of such additional rents shall not waive the right of the market authorities to impose whatever penalties may be levied upon the lease for violation of this provisions including the revocation of lease.

No person shall be allowed to lease more than one stall. Provided, that when two stalls are leased to one person, such stall shall adjoin one another and shall be allocated in the same section of the market. Provided further, that it shall be a violation of this section for mor than one member of a family consisting of a father, mother, sons and daughters to hold stalls unless the latter are already married and with their families of their own support or when they are already living by themselves.

SECTION 11. LIMITATIONS ON CONSTRUCTION AND REMOVAL OF STRUCTURES. No stallholder shall construct, repair, renovate or undertake any kind of construction of stalls without first securing a permit from the Market Administrator. Stalls constructed/repared or renovated in violations of this section may be removed or destroyed by the Market Administrator

and/or his employees. No lessee shall remove, construct, and alter the original structure of any stall or electrical wiring or water connection without prior permit from the Market Administrator.

**SECTION 12. - INSURANCE.** The lessee shall not take any fire insurance on properties within the leased premises without first securing a written approval from the Market Administrator through the Municipal Treasurer. Neither shall the lessee insure his properties therein for an amount beyond the value thereof.

For this purpose, the lessee shall submit beforehand an inventory of the property or goods within the leased premises to be insured, subject to the inspection, review and verification by the Municipal Government through its duly authorized representatives.

**SECTION 13. - FORFEITURE OF RIGHTS.** Failure to occupy an awarded stall within sixty (60) days from the date of award shall mean automatic forfeiture of the right to lease the stall.

**SECTION 14. - EJECTED STALLHOLDERS DISQUALIFIED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE APPLICATION OF NEW STALLS.** Should a stallholder be ejected from his/her stall for valid cause as provided in this Code, he/she and his/her helpers are disqualified from leasing again said stall or of any other stall in the market for a period of one (1) year.


**SECTION 15. - REPEALING CLAUSE.** Any Ordinances which are in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 16. - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions thereof.

**SECTION 17. - DATE OF EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

This Ordinance was approved by the Sangguniang Bayan in its Regular Session on January 29, 2026.



The public hearing was called to order by the presiding officer at exactly 1:35 in the afternoon followed with a prayer and the singing of the Philippine National Anthem.

**AGENDA**

**PROPOSED MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03, S – 2026, ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5G.02, ARTICLE 6 (MARKET FEES AND CHARGES) OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 126, S – 2020 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE “2020 REVISED REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLABA”**

The presiding officer presented and discussed the proposed municipal ordinance and which was followed by deliberations and clarifications.

Several lessees raised their concerns regarding the proposed stall rights fee and rental per month particularly requesting for the reduction of the proposed amount, to wit;

*Building number 1-4, from Php 25,000 stall rights fee to Php 20,000 with a rental fee per month from Php 3,000.00 to Php 2,000.00*

*Building number 7, from Php 2,000.00 rental per month to Php 1,500.00*

*Building number 8, from Php 30,000.00 stall rights fee to Php 25,000 with rental per month from Php 4,000.00 to Php 2,200.*

*Building number 9, from Php 40,000.00 stall rights fee to Php 35,000.00 with rental per month from Php 5,000.00 to Php 3,500.00*

More than majority of the stall lessees of the above-mentioned buildings have agreed to the said rates.

Mrs. Resol, the market administrator, inquired as to what will be the action of the LGU for the delinquent lessees.

Mrs. Alicia Devota responded that the Municipal Treasurer's Office will send them demand letters to the said lessees. On the other hand, she also informed that the delinquent lessees will be charged an additional 3% penalty of the monthly rental for not paying on time.

Mrs. Devota also suggested to the temporary stall vendors to secure business permits instead of paying rentals daily.

SB Member Elmer Silva suggested that the lessee who pay their rental earlier than the due date be given rebates/incentives.


No other matters discussed.

The public hearing was adjourned at 3:05 in the afternoon.

**COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 3, S- 2026**

**SUBJECT:**

**PROPOSED MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03, S – 2026, ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5G.02, ARTICLE 6 (MARKET FEES AND CHARGES) OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 126, S – 2020 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE “2020 REVISED REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLABA”**

**FINDINGS:**

The LGU was providing long term contracts with low rates of market fees and charges to the lessees.

Number of lessees were not promptly paying their obligations.

Concerns on sanitation issues become a main problem.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

To update the Local Revenue Code of the Municipality for an increase of rental rates and market fees that are reasonable as second class municipality.

Enforce strict collection of market fees and rentals.

The LGU and municipal market administration be directed to assess and immediately address the cleaning and maintenance of canals and other sanitation-related concerns within the public market.
