**WHEREFORE**, upon the approval of all who attended the meeting, it was:



# CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

13 August 2025

**2025 CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS (CBL)**  
**OF THE**  
**ALANGALANG VETERANS POST (AVP)**

**PREAMBLE**

We, the members of the Alangalang Veterans Post of Alangalang, Leyte, invoking the aid and guidance of Divine Providence and dedicating ourselves to the good of the Philippines and the Filipino people, in order to foster love and pride of country; live up to the democratic way of life and governance; help promote peace and order, unity and stability, aspire and works for the Filipino veterans to be united, one in all and all in organization, the Alangalang Veterans Post, do hereby adopt, proclaim and ordain this Constitution and By -Laws pursuant to Republic Act No. 2640, as amended.

**ARTICLE I**  
**NAME, OFFICE AND SEAL**

Section 1. Name. – The name of the organization shall be “**ALANGALANG VETERANS POST**” or “**AVP**” for short, and hereafter referred to as the post.

Section 2. Office. The principal office of the post shall be located in Alangalang, Leyte.

Section 3. Seal – The seal is under construction and subject for deliberation.

**ARTICLE II**  
**NATURE**

The post shall be non-sectarian and non-political in character.

**ARTICLE III**  
**AIMS AND PURPOSE**

The aims and purpose of the post shall be as follows:

1. Manage and administer activities for the veterans' needs, benefits and welfare such as processing of their request for health care assistance, wake assistance, military honors assistance during interment and any such other assistance as deemed necessary;
2. Contribute to the development of a unified and empowered Filipino Veterans community that is reliable partner in achieving community progress;
3. Undertake acts of charity and relief works, help preserve peace and order, to foster love of country and inculcate individual civic consciousness;
4. Provide the leadership, formulate guidelines and set priorities and directions to the members;
5. Establish a machinery for the promotion of services and programs designed for self-reliance and socio-economic life of veterans in support of the declared municipal policies to improve their living standards;
6. Encourage those retired personnel of the AFP and PCG to join the post and those who served six (6) years honorable service, to include those who served with the PC for six (6) years of honorable service:
7. Preserve and enhance the honor and dignity of the Filipino veterans collectively and individually, further the cause of veteranism and keep alive the ideals of freedom and democracy.

In general, the federation shall exist solely for purposes of a benevolent character, and not for pecuniary profit of its members.

**ARTICLE IV**  
**MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1. Qualifications of membership - For admission to the post, an applicant for

- a) Retired members of the PA, PN, PAF, PCG and those who served six (6) years honorable military service. Likewise, those who serve also the PC for at least six (6) years honorable service.
- b) Surviving Spouses of WW2 Veterans.
- c) Surviving of Spouses of Post War Veterans.

Section 2. Right of Members - A members shall have the following rights:

- a) To be eligible to any elected and appointed office of the post.
- b) To participate and vote in all deliberations/meetings of the post.
- c) To avail of the facilities of the post.
- d) To inspect the records or books of the federation at reasonable hours during business days.

Section 3. All members shall pay the membership dues and other assessments as may be imposed by the Post President.

#### **ARTICLE V ORGANIZATION**

Section 1 Officers. – The officers of the post are the following:

- a) Post President.

The Regional Representative of Veterans Federation of the Philippines Regional Assistance Center-8 through the District President has the sole authority to direct the incumbent Post President to conduct an election of the Post President as deemed necessary.

Section 2. The Elected Post President has the authority to appoint the following officers to help him manage the administration of personnel, the proper utilization of funds and office resources to include post operations, plans and programs.

- a) Post Vice President
- b) Post Secretary
- c) Post Treasurer
- d) Post Auditor

#### **ARTICLE VI DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF OFFICERS**

Section 1. Post President – The Post President shall exercise the following functions:

- a) To manage and supervise the business affairs of the post.
- b) To implement the administrative and operational policies of the Veterans Federation of the Philippines through the Regional Representative of VFP Region-8.
- c) To represent the administrative and operational policies of the post.
- d) To oversee the preparation of the budget and the statement of accounts of the post.
- e) To preside the monthly meeting of the post.
- f) To perform such other functions as may be directed by the District President though Regional Representative-8.

Section 2. Vice Post President – The Vice Post president shall have such powers and duties as the Post President may from time to time prescribe. In case the Post President is absent or

incapacitated, the Vice Post President, shall have the powers and discharge of the duties of the Post President.

**Section 3. Secretary** – The Secretary shall exercise the following functions:

- a) To records the minutes and resolutions in all membership and trustees' meetings and maintain corporate books in such form and manner required by law.
- b) To keep the membership book and records f the federation and affix the post seal to all official documents requiring the same.
- c) To give or send notices of the association required by law and these by laws.
- d) To determine the existence of a quorum in any meetings of the members of the board of Trustees.
- e) To perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the Post President.

**Section 4. Treasurer** - The Treasurer shall have the following functions.

- a) To keep full and accurate accounts of the funds, receipts and disbursements in the books of the post.
- b) To deposit in the name and to the credit of the post in such bank as designated by the Veterans Federation of the Philippines, all the funds, money, securities and valuable effects of the post.
- c) To submit monthly the Funds Utilization Report of the Trust Fund (Membership Shares) to the Post Auditor prior approval/notification of the Post President.
- d) To present and report the Fund Utilization Reports of the Trust Fund (Membership Shares) on monthly basis during the Monthly Meeting by using a Manila Paper for the awareness of all and transparency.
- e) To perform such other duties and functions as by assigned to him by the Post President.

**Section 5. Auditor** - The Auditor shall audit the books of the post and prepare the Annual Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Statements. He / She shall submit his Audit Report in time.

## **ARTICLE VII GOVERNANCE**

**Section 1.** The Post is a Geographical Organization of the Veterans Federation of the Philippines and under the direct supervision of the District President of 1<sup>st</sup> Leyte Veterans District of Veterans Federation of the Philippines Regional Administrative Center-8, hence, a public entity. Any action or decision shall be subject to the approval of the District President.

## **ARTICLE VIII MEETING OF THE MEMBERS**

**Section 1. Regular Meeting.** The Regular Meeting of the post is scheduled every second Saturday of the month.

**Section 2. Special Meetings.** Special meetings may be called as the need arises thereof, by the President, or upon the petition of the general membership.

**Section 3. Annual General Assembly.** The Annual General meeting will be held on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of December of each year, if a legal holiday, then on the day following.

**Section 4. Place of Meeting** - The meetings shall be held in the principal office of the federation or at any place designated by the Post President in the municipality indicated therein. Meetings may

also be held outside the place where the principal office of the association is located, provided that the meeting shall be with due notice and within the Philippines.

Section 5. Notices - Notices of meetings shall be given by the Secretary by personal delivery or mail or electronic messages, at least two (2) weeks for regular meetings or one (1) week for special meetings prior the date set forth for such meeting to save member of record at his last known address. The notice shall state the place, date and hour of the meeting, and purpose for which the meeting is called.

Section 4. Waiver of Notice - Notice of meeting may be waived verbally by any member attending it.

Section 5. Quorum - A quorum for any meeting of the member shall consist of a majority of the members and a majority of such a quorum may decide any question at the meeting. If no quorum is constituted, the meeting shall be adjourned until the requisite number of members shall be present.

Section 6. Proxy - members may vote in person or by proxy in all meetings of members. Proxies shall be in writing, signed by the member and filed with the Secretary of the post at least one (1) day prior the scheduled meeting. Unless so filed, a proxy shall not be recognized.

#### **ARTICLE IX TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1. Termination of Membership - Suspension, expulsion and termination of membership shall be decided by the Post President in consultation of his officers and members in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Veterans Federation of the Philippines

#### **ARTICLE X FUNDS**

Section 1. Funds - The funds of the post shall be derived from the Annual Membership Fees of its members and or through donations from the public.

Section 2. Disbursement - Withdrawal from the funds of the post, whether by check or any other instrument shall be signed by the Post Treasurer and the Post President, while the deposit of checks and other instrumentalities can be done by the Post Treasurer.

Section 3. Fiscal Years - The fiscal year of the post shall be from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.


#### **ARTICLE XI AMENDMENT**
