We subsequently required Cleanaway Philippines Inc. to submit specific details on the classification and description of the waste, quantity and volume, transport schedule, source and destination, and the corresponding containment, safety, and emergency response measures.

Thereafter on March 2, 2026, the Committee received a letter from Cleanaway Philippines Inc. dated February 27, 2026, submitting the required documents and supporting information. Attached is a copy of the said letter, marked as Annex "A" and made an integral part of this Committee report.

In view of Cleanaway Philippines Inc.'s substantial compliance with the required submissions and in order to monitor and ensure continuous adherence to environmental safety standards and disaster risk management protocols, we hereby recommend that Cleanaway Philippines Inc. be required to utilize the Province's Quick Monitoring System (QMS), and that a briefing with the Provincial Technical Team be conducted at the earliest possible time to ensure proper coordination and monitoring, to ensure the safety and well-being of the great people of Leyte.

236 program. He was amenable that the QMS be implemented that and he already instructed
237 Mr. Aldin Surpia to schedule a presentation to Clean-Away with the technical
238 requirements so that they can do it. But this will not preclude the members of this office
239 body from conducting physical examination or monitoring of the facilities. The QMS will
240 help us. determine if there are leakages or there are incidents that will happen along the
241 way and how we can address those incidents on a real time basis.

260 will send them copy of the report. Perhaps, the secretariat can coordinate with Mr. Adlin
261 Surpia with the briefing and if some of the Board Members are available, they could join
262 the meeting as well.

987 Mr. Chair, Item Nos. 37, 38 and 39 are related. Item No. 37 is the Decision of the
988 Ombudsman finding Mayor Ramon Oñate guilty of conduct prejudicial to the best interest
989 of the service and imposing the penalty of Suspension. Item No. 38 is the Decision of the

990 Court of Appeals reversing the Decision of the Ombudsman, in effect absolving Mayor
991 Oñate of findings of the Ombudsman. And, Item No. 39, is a Decision of the Court of
992 Appeals denying the Motion for Reconsideration, in effect, the finding that there is no
993 basis for the case against Mayor Oñate or suspension is final based on the decision of
994 the Court of Appeals.

995 At any rate, Mr. Chair, I move that we take note of all these Decisions.

1010 Mr. Chair, Mr. Floor Leader, in this case since there's already a Court of Appeals'
1011 Resolution denying the MR, the next we course for the petition is actually to bring this to
1012 the Supreme Court, either through Certiorari 65 or 45 appeal. Rule 65 or Rule 45, tama
1013 ba? So, if there is none, then we wait for a Certificate of Finality of Judgement. Pag there's
1014 an appeal then we wait for years again. Normally, it's 60 days if it's Certiorari, Rule 45 it's
1015 15. So, we still wait if they appeal this to the Supreme Court. If none, Mayor Oñate can
1016 now request for a Certificate of Finality of Judgement.

1019 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1020 Yes, Mr. Chair, this is a continuing saga of the procession of cases in the 4th
1021 District.

1022 Anyway, Mr. Chair, we took note of that.

1023 No other matters.

1024 If I may raise a point of privilege, Mr. Chair?

1025 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1026 Go ahead please.

1027 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1028 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

1029 It is a Women's Month, Mr. Chair. So, thinking about it, I remember verses from the Bible.

1030 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1031 Do you read that?

1032 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1033 I used to, Mr. Chair. It was my favorite subject way back in elementary. It is very
1034 nice. The stories of magic and goodness. Something that the world needs more of
1035 nowadays.

1036 So, there are several stories about women in that Bible, 'no. The one that strikes
1037 me most is a woman as a mother. So, Mary was there and then Jesus was giving
1038 instructions and then the other people were asking, "What should we do?" And then, Mary
1039 said, "Don't worry about me. Listen to Him." So, I think, that's the verse that strikes me
1040 most about women because we have mothers who take care of us more than they take
1041 care of themselves, and something that we should remember today, and in this month,
1042 Mr. Chair.

1043 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

1044 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1045 Coming from the Honorable Loreto.

1048 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1049 So, we should love women also, the same way that they're taking care of us, our
1050 wives.

1051 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1052 Mr. Chair.

1053 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1054 Go ahead please.

1055 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1056 Mr. Chair, I have only one concern which I would like to bring up to this August
1057 Body. With the rising conflict in the Middle East, Mr. Chair, we cannot stop the rising cost
1058 of fuel in the market considering that all fuels we get from the market came from other
1059 countries, and we are very much dependent to the pricing or the commodities. Right now,
1060 the crude oil price reaches already more than 117 dollars per barrel. And, this is very
1061 alarming, Mr. Chair.

1062 I strongly suggest that we in the Province of Leyte come up, maybe a contingency,
1063 what will happen, what we must do, to prevent this crisis or to prevent the impact brought
1064 about by the conflict in Middle East. I know we can do so little but I think we should
1065 prepare. By this time the Province of Leyte should be prepared for any eventuality that
1066 may arise, Mr. Chair. Maybe we can come up with as mandated by the national
1067 government for this flexible work or maybe we can have an online work or whatever just
1068 to mitigate the impact. That is all, Mr. Chair.

1069 So, I call on our Executive branch of the province, the Legislative branch, to come
1070 up with measures that will be able to mitigate the circumstances. Mr. Chair.

1071 So, if my motion is in order, Mr. Chair, I move that we come up with, maybe I should
1072 say, management committee or any steps, as I've said, that will mitigate the situation.

1073 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

1074 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1075 Do you have any suggestions on who will lead this?

1076 May I recommend Honorable Uy?

1077 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1078 Of course, the Chief Executive should lead the situation, Mr. Chair.

1079 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1080 If I may, Mr. Chair.

1081 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1082 Go ahead please.

1083 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1084 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

1085 In connection with the manifestation of the Honorable Uy, I join him in his concern.

1086 In fact, during the recent Liga ng Mga Barangay activities assembly in Cebu, I was with

1087 Honorable Kabigting. All flights were cancelled. I think the airlines, not only a particular

1088 airline, all flights were cancelled. And, I was informed as well, that Roble Shipping, the

1089 trip from Cebu to Baybay was cancelled also. And then the Ocean Jet trips in Palompon

1090 and Bohol were cancelled. So, they're only taking care of routes which are more

1091 financially rewarding.

1092 On that note, Mr. Chair, if I may, for more concrete recommendation, perhaps, we

1093 can ask the Committee on DRRM to confer with the Philippine Ports Authority and the

1094 Cebu Ports Authority. So that we may know what measures they are doing, and we can

1095 complement the efforts they're doing, 'no. The Philippine Ports Authority and the Cebu

1096 Ports Authority.

1097 Number 2, perhaps we can also request the Committee on Education to confer

1098 with DEPED, if possible, to have online classes. Just like in the pandemic, Mr. Chair, so

1099 that we can minimize the consumption of fuel. I talked with the Honorable Uy. He said it

1100 is okay if fewer people will buy fuel, because anyway, the fuel prices will keep on

1101 increasing. So, it's also income even if people will not buy as much. So, I so move.

1102 HON. MJ LUINLY D. LUMEN: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, SK PRESIDENT

1103 Second.

1104 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1105 Mr. Chair, Mr. Floor, may I be recognized?

1106 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1107 Yes, go ahead.

1108 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1109 Regarding DEPED, I think classes is about to end by March, so I do not know if
1110 this will affect the final exams, considering that they will be having their graduation rights
1111 or end year rights at around March 27 onwards, I think. I just do not know. So, maybe we
1112 need to consult them if the online classes would still apply.

1113 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1114 So that the committee can confer, what to do.

1115 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1116 Yes, considering that this is already final exams. Can we conduct final exams
1117 online?

1118 Maybe also that's one reason because Secretary Angara just declared DEPED
1119 offices to have a 4-day work week. But the classes, he did not declare it na 4-days classes
1120 lang. Maybe because of it. Naghahabol na. And then a lot of suspension also. And then
1121 for the whole month of April children are all in vacation, so that's also a good timing. But
1122 if we check the geopolitical analyst, the Iran-US war is not yet stopping and it's getting
1123 worse because there are already some plans to bomb desalination plants. So, when you
1124 bomb desalination plants, water is a big problem in the Middle East. It's going to really
1125 affect the whole global economy. Wala pang signs, and in fact, Trump just announced a
1126 few days ago, mapadayon la gihap hira pag giyera. Waray gihap na open hin negotiation.
1127 And then, he Iran, the highest leader there, they are trying to have a caucus to look for a
1128 new leader, sabi niya, "we have to retaliate kasi pinatay niyo ang aming Supreme Leader".
1129 And I heard also, that there are refinery plants in the Middle East that have been shut
1130 down. So, even the oil supply is going to get lesser. So even if it is not passing through
1131 Strait of Hormuz, the oil supply is going to get less. Because, I think there are two refinery
1132 plants that were already shut down.

1133 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1134 If I may, Mr. Chair, in connection with the 4-day work week, perhaps, we can
1135 discuss, because this will adversely affect most of our employees especially in the
1136 Provincial Board, because our employees are paid on a daily basis. So, if they work only
1137 for four days, they get only paid for four days. It will adversely affect them. Perhaps, we
1138 can discuss how to lessen the impact of the crisis on our employees.

1139 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1140 Mr. Chair, Mr. Floor, what if instead of working for eight hours a day, they just work
1141 for ten hours a day, meaning until 7:00 p.m. And then, still get the five days salary and
1142 wages. Because I think in Manila, their work now is from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. with one
1143 hour break. So, instead of an 8-hour a day it becomes 10-hour a day. Same pa rin, 40
1144 hours a week.

1145 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1146 I check ta eto ha, i discuss ta eto.

1147 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1148 Floor Leader, I suggest we create a Technical Working Group to gather all these
1149 piecemeal solutions and find out which is the best for the people in the province, 'no. Ang
1150 daming factors na pwede nating ipag sama-sama and come up with an optimal solution
1151 to elevate our life, because oil prices will really go up. Matter of fact, I also created that in
1152 our company because, imagine, we deliver to all over the country and fuel prices are big
1153 factor. So, dito din sa atin if we talk about the education sector, our provincial people and
1154 the province as a whole, baka pwedeng gumawa tayo ng Technical Working Group. In
1155 the next meeting, we can come up with some solutions para matulungan natin ang mga
1156 tao. Because right now, I think we don't have to monopoly of having good ideas, so, baka
1157 pwedeng ma consolidate natin 'yung ideas ng lahat ng members of this August Body,
1158 and come up with something more efficient, more effective. That's a suggestion from your
1159 Vice-Governor.

1160 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1161 So, Mr. Chair, with your suggestion, I would like to move that we come up with a
1162 Crisis Management Team for this purpose as suggested by our good Vice-Governor.

1163 HON. MJ LUIPLY D. LUMEN: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, SK PRESIDENT
1164 Second.

1165 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
1166 Second.

1167 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
1168 Second.

1169 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR
1170 Who will be the members of the group?

1171 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
1172 Perhaps, Mr. Chair, I think, the Governor will be in the best position to have the
1173 Crisis Management Team, and some members of the committees involve, 'no.

1174 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR
1175 Mahirap etong problemang eto.

1176 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
1177 All encompassing, Mr, Chair.

1178 HON. LEONARDO M. JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR
1179 It will definitely affect all of us. Mga family natin apektado rito e. It's not good.

1180 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
1181 Anyway, to move on, Mr. Chair, I also have one matter which I would like to bring
1182 up with this August Body.

1183 The EVRAA, Mr. Chair, has come to an end. I think it is but proper that we have to
1184 extend our Congratulations! to the host, the City of Baybay, headed by no other than our
1185 Mayor Jose Carlos L. Cari, of course, supported by Congressman Carl Nicolas C. Cari,
1186 the DEPED family headed by the Regional Director Ronelo Al Firmo, I move for resolution
1187 extending the Province of Leyte's congratulatory message for the successful event that
1188 gave pride to the Province of Leyte, Mr. Chair. I so move.
