We hope this message finds you well. We are reaching out with a shared vision of expanding economic opportunities across Leyte, especially for communities without direct access to traditional BPO hubs.

We would like to formally express our intent to bring Ante Tracey to Tacloban for a focused training workshop on Virtual Assistance. She is widely recognized for empowering Filipinos to access global employment opportunities from home, removing geographical barriers and opening doors to sustainable income.

By way of context, we recently brought Ante Tracey to Ormoc City, where the response was overwhelmingly positive. Her one-day training drew well over 100 participants, nearing 150 attendees. More than three-fourths of the participants were sponsored by Lucy Torres Gomez for graduating Bachelor of Science in Office Administration students from the City College of Ormoc. The outcome was a resounding success, with strong engagement and immediate interest in pursuing Virtual Assistance as a viable career path.

Beyond her training programs, Ante Tracey has built a strong and highly engaged following on Facebook, where she consistently shares practical, relatable, and easy-to-digest content about freelancing and remote work. Her communication style resonates deeply with the younger generation, making her an effective bridge between opportunity and action for aspiring VAs.

This initiative is designed to benefit a wide range of Leyteños, including single parents, retirees who wish to remain productive, call center professionals transitioning into remote work, fresh graduates exploring career opportunities, and individuals seeking additional income through side engagements.

We believe this program can help jumpstart a stronger outsourcing ecosystem in Leyte — bringing in foreign-sourced income, strengthening local economies, and positioning the province as a viable hub for remote talent.

This effort is being led by Trustline Virtual Services, in collaboration with BeMore Training and Consultancy Services, headed by Maricel Reyes Ngo, with Kenneth Enecio, Head of Growth, and Ethel Matres, Head of Finance, supporting the initiative.
