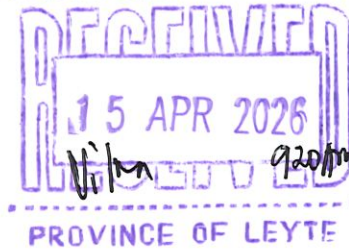

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Under Ordinance No. 27, Series of 2019, a franchise was granted to Engr. Rolando G. New Villamor for the operation of a cockpit arena in Barangay Malobago, Jaro, Leyte.

The Committee on Games and Amusement conducted a review and evaluation of the compliance of the said franchise with existing municipal ordinances, national laws, and regulatory requirements.

Records show that the as-built structure materially deviates from the plans submitted to the Local Government unit on August 23, 2019, and that no Building Permit was issued authorizing the construction of the cockpit arena.

A Temporary Locational Clearance was previously issued by former Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator Martin Cativo; however, the lot referenced therein differs from the actual parcel reflected in the as-built plan received by the LGU in August 2023.

Official records from the Municipal Assessor's Office confirm that the lot number declared and submitted by the owner differs from the actual parcel of land where the cockpit arena was constructed.

No valid Locational Clearance was issued for the subject property, as certified by the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD).




The parcel of land where the cockpit arena stands remains classified as Agricultural Land and is not covered by any approved Land Use Conversion Order from the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), in violation of existing agrarian and land use laws.

Due notice and public hearing were conducted in observance of due process, and the concerned party was afforded the opportunity to be heard.

Based on the foregoing findings, sufficient legal and factual grounds exist to revoke, cancel, and terminate the franchise granted under Ordinance No, 27, Series of 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Jaro, Leyte, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. REVOCATION, CANCELLATION, AND TERMINATION.

The franchise granted under Ordinance No. 27, Series of 2019, as approved by Resolution No, 2019-523, in favor of Engr. Rolando G. New Villamor far the operation of the cockpit arena located at Barangay Malobago, Jaro, Leyte, is hereby REVOKED, CANCELLED, and TERMINATED.

SECTION 2. ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST.

The proprietor is hereby ordered to immediately CEASE AND DESIST from operating the said cockpit arena upon the effectivity of this Ordinance,

SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE AND LEGAL CONSEQUENCES.

The appropriate municipal offices are hereby directed to enforce this Ordinance and to initiate the filing of appropriate administrative or legal actions for violations of existing laws, rules, and regulations, if warranted.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All ordinances, resolutions. executive orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby Shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and compliance with posting and publication requirements under applicable laws.



The Chair gave the floor to Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja who moved for the consideration of the above proposed resolution, which was duly seconded. Thereafter, Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja through the Chair requested Mr. Martin Alcantara to read the committee report.

The Chair directed Mr. Alcantara to proceed with the reading of the Committee Report. After the reading, the Chair inquired from the Body if there were any corrections. Hearing none, the Chair requested Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja to offer the final motion for its adoption.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja took the floor and moved for the final adoption of the Committee Report, which was duly seconded en masse.

Thereafter, the Chair declared that for Item No. 3, under the Committee Report, had been moved, carried and approved en masse.

The Chair concurred and requested Hon. Teofilo Cabello to proceed with the next order of business.

CALENDAR OF BUSINESS:

A. UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

ITEM NO. 1- EXECUTIVE AGENDA
PROPONENT: HON. LANULFO M. BORJA
Chairman Committee on Environmental protection

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION TO THE SAND AND GRAVEL APPLICATION OF MS. ANNA RINA DOMINIQUE L. SALAZAR FOR THEIR BUSINESS PERMIT, LOCATED AT BARANGAY BUENAVISTA JARO, LEYTE.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja stated that they had already submitted the required documents to the province.

Hon. Rey P. Aure stated that, with regard to the certification, there is a discrepancy in the documents. The certificate issued by the Province certifies Mr. Angelito Lago, while the resolution names Ms. Anna Rina Dominique Salazar. He further added that the application is for an industrial permit; therefore, it should have been filed with the MGB Office, not the Province, since it is classified as industrial.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja explained that Mr. Angelito Lago was the original applicant, and the rights were later transferred to Ms. Anna Rina Dominique Salazar.

Hon. Rey P. Aure emphasized that the documents must be specific and consistent, especially since the body is granting a Resolution of No Objection. Any discrepancy may lead to conflict.

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala stated that the applicant's documents lack consistency with respect to the certification.

Hon. Teofilo Cabello expressed the same observation and advised the proponents to consolidate and correct the discrepancies in their documents.

Hon. Alma A. Tamayo stated that the situation is similar to the case of Jocelyn Yu. She explained that the previous owner was Mr. Angelito Lago and that the application will now be refiled by Ms. Anna Rina Dominique Salazar. However, she added that it is up to the body to decide, and they must be cautious to avoid discrepancies.

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala stated that the issue lies between Mr. Angelito Lago and Ms. Anna Rina Dominique Salazar, and they must resolve it first so that only one owner's name appears in the documents to avoid confusion.




Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja presented the Deed of Assignment stating that Mr. Angelito Lago transferred his rights to Ms. Anna Rina Dominique Salazar.

The Chair stated that the application cannot be approved due to inconsistencies in the documents.

Hon. Teofilo Cabello inquired whether the Deed of Assignment had been submitted to the province, noting that if it had been submitted, the province should have attached the said document when issuing the certificate.

Hon. Raul Macanda stated, based on his understanding, that Mr. Lago waived his rights in favor of Ms. Anna Rina Dominique Salazar. He concurred with Hon. Teofilo Cabello's statement that if the Deed of Assignment was submitted to the province, it should have been attached to the certification.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja stated that he would communicate with Ms. Salazar to correct the documents they had submitted.



Hon. Teofilo Cabello clarified that sand and gravel extraction permits are non-transferable and non-assignable.

The Chair requested Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja to consolidate the documents and coordinate with Ms. Salazar for further review.

Upon recognition by the Chair, Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja moved to defer the item for further review. The motion was duly seconded and approved by the august body.

At this point, Hon. Teofilo Cabello acknowledged the presence of five immersion students from Teofilo Macaso National High School who will be assigned to the Vice Mayor's Office and the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) Secretary's Office.

Thereafter, Hon. Teofilo Cabello moved for a five-minute recess, which was duly seconded. The Chair declared the session in recess at 11:14 a.m.

After the recess, the Chair declared the session resumed at 11:33 a.m.

At this juncture, during a courtesy visit, the Walang Gutom Program, representative Ms. Jeane Krisha Mae Lacaba informed the August Body that, In the municipality, there are 486 existing beneficiaries, with an additional 109 beneficiaries, bringing the total number to 595 beneficiaries.

Hon. Raul A. Macanda asked regarding the qualifications to become a beneficiary of the said program.

Ms. Lacaba stated that to qualify for the program, beneficiaries must be identified as financially unstable. Members of the 4Ps program may also qualify, provided they are categorized as financially unstable based on the monitoring system.

Hon. Carmencita G. Tañala asked who conducted the listing of beneficiaries.

Ms. Lacaba answered that the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) conducts the house-to-house validation by interviewing every household.

Hon. Tañala further asked if there is a scheduled date for the house-to-house interviews.

Ms. Lacaba responded that the Central Office provides the master list to the Regional Office, which is then forwarded to the Community Engagement Coordinator. They coordinate with the LGU, and the LGU coordinates with the Barangay. Afterward, they request chairs and tables from the LGU for the set-up of their validation activities.

Hon. Tañala asked if the “Walang Gutom Program” provides assistance in kind.

Ms. Lacaba stated that the program releases goods only and is not allowed to distribute cash. She added that those not included in the program may have been absent during the interview and must wait to be included in the master list.

Hon. Lanulfo M. Borja asked if the program would continue until all residents are validated.

Ms. Lacaba answered that the program is still ongoing but will run only for three years.

Hon. Borja also asked if there is a limit or target number of beneficiaries as long as they belong to the poverty line.

Ms. Lacaba explained that they depend on the master list provided by the Central Office.

Hon. Macanda asked whether 4Ps beneficiaries who have already graduated are being enrolled in the program.

He also inquired about beneficiaries who are found not qualified to be part of the program.


Ms. Lacaba responded that in such cases, it may be that they provided inaccurate information during the interview. They only determine disqualification if a concerned citizen files a complaint. Due process is observed; they cannot immediately remove beneficiaries. A case assessment is conducted, a re-interview is done, and records are submitted to the Central Office while awaiting the results.

Hon. Alma Tamayo asked whether a senior citizen who is a 4Ps beneficiary, but whose dependents have already graduated, may still qualify for the program.

Ms. Lacaba answered that it is possible, provided the person's name appears on the master list and meets the program qualifications as financially unstable. Those included in the master list from the Central Office already have an allocated budget.

Hon. Tamayo raised a concern that some 4Ps beneficiaries are included in the Walang Gutom Program, while other qualified individuals—particularly children who are not 4Ps members—are not included. She suggested that this concern should be addressed by the LGU.







EXPLANATORY NOTE

Under Ordinance No, 27, Series of 2019, a franchise was granted to Engr, Rolando G. New Villamor for the operation of a cockpit arena in Barangay Malobago, Jaro, Leyte.

The Committee on Games and Amusement conducted a review and evaluation of the compliance of the said franchise with existing municipal ordinances, national laws, and regulatory requirements.

Records show that the as-built structure materially deviates from the plans submitted to the Local Government unit on August 23, 2019, and that no Building Permit was issued authorizing the construction of the cockpit arena.

A Temporary Locational Clearance was previously issued by former Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator Martin Cativo; however, the lot referenced therein differs from the actual parcel reflected in the as-built plan received by the LGU in August 2023.


Official records from the Municipal Assessor's Office confirm that the lot number declared and submitted by the owner differs from the actual parcel of land where the cockpit arena was constructed.

No valid Locational Clearance was issued for the subject property, as certified by the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD);

The parcel of land where the cockpit arena stands remains classified as Agricultural Land and is not covered by any approved Land Use Conversion Order from the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), in violation of existing agrarian and land use laws.


Due notice and public hearing were conducted in observance of due process, and the concerned party was afforded the opportunity to be heard.

Based on the foregoing findings, sufficient legal and factual grounds exist to revoke, cancel, and terminate the franchise granted under Ordinance No, 27, Series of 2019.



SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and compliance with posting and publication requirements under applicable laws.

V. Presentation of Findings

For the record, the following violations were presented:

1. The as-built structure materially deviates from the approved plans submitted to the Local Government Unit on August 23, 2019. Moreover, no Building Permit was issued for the construction of the cockpit arena.
2. Temporary Locational clearance was issued by former MPDC Martin Cativo but different lot applied per as built plan received last august 2023.
3. Records from the Municipal Assessor's Office confirm that the owner submitted a lot number different from the actual parcel on which the structure was constructed.
4. No valid Locational Clearance was issued, as certified by the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD).
5. The lot where the cockpit arena was constructed remains classified as Agricultural Land and is not covered by any approved land-use conversion order.

VI. PRESENTATION OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE




