**REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION/LEGAL OPINION:**

This office opines that the subject Ordinance is, in general, within the legislative authority of the Sangguniang Bayan under Section 447(a)(1)<sup>1</sup> of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160) in relation to Section 13 Article II<sup>2</sup> of the Philippine Constitution. Hence, we recommend for the declaration of its validity.

This opinion is likewise without prejudice to the opinions rendered by higher and competent authorities and/or the courts.

 (1) *Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government,*

## MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 182 Series of 2026

**AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL BARANGAYS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO TO ALLOCATE A DESIGNATED SPACE FOR THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN (SK) OFFICE AND FOR OTHER YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10742, otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015, affirms the role of the youth in nation-building and mandates the Sangguniang Kabataan to serve as the primary policy-making body for youth affairs at the barangay level;

**WHEREAS**, Section 12 of the same Act provides that the SK shall initiate programs designed to enhance the social, political, economic, cultural, intellectual, moral, spiritual, and physical development of the youth, which requires a dedicated and functional space to perform its duties effectively;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers local government units to promote the general welfare of their inhabitants, including the youth, by providing adequate facilities to encourage their participation in governance and community service;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), through various circulars and advisories, has emphasized the need

for institutional support for SK governance, including the provision of office space, equipment, and other logistical requirements to ensure transparency, accountability, and functionality of youth councils;

**WHEREAS**, several barangays in the Municipality of San Isidro currently do not have a designated Sangguniang Kabataan Office, which greatly hinders the ability of SK councils to carry out their legislative, administrative, financial, and programmatic duties, and results in difficulties in safekeeping official documents, conducting meetings, and implementing youth development initiatives;

**WHEREAS**, providing proper SK Offices is essential to enable the SK to function effectively and professionally, ensure compliance with COA and DILG standards, promote transparency and documentation, and offer a stable and conducive environment for planning and implementing youth development programs—especially for barangays which currently do not have an SK office of their own;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of San Isidro recognizes the importance of providing a safe, accessible, and conducive workspace for the SK officers to plan, organize, and implement programs aligned with the Local Youth Development Plan (LYDP) and the Comprehensive Barangay Development Plan (CBDP);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of San Isidro, in session duly assembled, that:

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE**

This ordinance shall be known as the **“Sangguniang Kabataan Office Allocation Ordinance of the Municipality of San Isidro.”**

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY**

It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of San Isidro to strengthen youth participation and governance by institutionalizing the provision of office spaces for all Sangguniang Kabataan in every barangay, to serve as their official working area and venue for youth-related programs and documentation.

The SK Office shall serve as the official repository of SK records, financial documents, and program files.

**SECTION 3. COVERAGE**

This ordinance shall apply to all **19 barangays** within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of San Isidro, Leyte.

### SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- a. **Sangguniang Kabataan (SK)** – The youth council created under Republic Act No. 10742 representing the youth sector in barangay governance.
- b. **SK Office** – A designated physical space within the barangay hall or a nearby structure, officially recognized as the working area of the Sangguniang Kabataan.
- c. **Barangay Council** – The local legislative body of the barangay tasked with allocating space and ensuring support to the SK office.
- d. **Youth Development Programs** – Activities and initiatives designed to promote the overall growth and empowerment of the youth.
- e. **LYDO** – Local Youth Development Office, which coordinates with SK and ensures alignment of programs under the LYDP.

### SECTION 5. MANDATE TO ALLOCATE OFFICE SPACE

All Barangay Governments within the Municipality of San Isidro are hereby mandated to allocate a designated space within their barangay hall or its premises for use as an SK Office.

Such space shall be:

1. Safe, accessible, and conducive for youth meetings and administrative work;
2. Sufficient in size to accommodate at least basic furniture and documentation storage;
3. Provided with essential utilities such as electricity, lighting, and ventilation; and
4. Clearly marked or labeled as the **“Sangguniang Kabataan Office.”**
5. In cases where a separate room is not available, the Barangay may designate a portion of an existing office or shared government space, provided that it is officially identified and regularly accessible for SK use.

### SECTION 6. MINIMUM STANDARDS AND EQUIPMENT

Barangays shall ensure that each SK Office is equipped with:

- a. A working table and chairs for the SK Chairperson and council members;
- b. A secured filing cabinet for SK records and COA documents;
- c. A bulletin board for SK announcements and youth transparency reports;
- d. Access to shared office equipment (printer, laptop, or desktop if available);
- e. Visibility signage indicating **“SK Office - Barangay [Name]”**; and
- f. Provision for basic cleanliness and maintenance supplies.

### SECTION 7. FUNDING AND IMPLEMENTATION

1. The Barangay Government may allocate necessary funds for the improvement or establishment of the SK Office from the following sources:
  - a. Barangay General Fund (under administrative or infrastructure expenses);
  - b. Supplemental Budget upon approval of the Sangguniang Barangay;
  - c. Possible assistance from the Municipal Government, LYDO, or partner agencies for furnishing, renovation, or youth office development.
2. No additional financial burden shall be imposed on barangays, and compliance may be achieved through reorganization or designation of existing space and resources.

### SECTION 8. ROLES OF OFFICES CONCERNED

- **Barangay Council** – Responsible for identifying and designating the space for the SK Office.
- **Sangguniang Kabataan Council** – Responsible for maintaining, managing, and utilizing the SK Office solely for youth governance purposes and shall ensure that the SK Office is used exclusively for official SK functions; and shall maintain proper records in compliance with COA regulations and DILG guidelines.
- **Municipal LYDO and DILG Field Office** – Shall monitor compliance and assist in implementation through coordination, training, and technical guidance.

### SECTION 9. MONITORING AND COMPLIANCE REPORT

Within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this ordinance, all Barangay Captains shall submit to the Sangguniang Bayan, through the Municipal LYDO, a compliance report indicating the status, location, and condition of their SK Office.

Such report shall include photo documentation and a brief description of the designated SK Office.

### SECTION 10. PENALTY CLAUSE

Non-compliance shall be subject to monitoring and appropriate administrative review by the Municipal Government and the Department of

**SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE**

All ordinances, resolutions, and other issuances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE**

This Ordinance shall take effect after posting and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.
