102 of the Abuyog Community College to make a brief presentation. Why and how? Abuyog
103 Community College achieved having topnotchers and so many passers in the latest board
104 exams. So, if this representation would be indulged, we would like to render a Committee
105 Report through the firsthand presentation of the Abuyog Community College President.

117 Dr. Montallana, go ahead, please.

118 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

119 Good morning to the Honorable Vice Governor Leonardo "Sandy" Javier Jr and to
120 members of this August Body. My special respect to the Chairman of the Committee on
121 Education, Atty. Carlo P. Loreto and to my former boss at San Isidro, Leyte, Honorable
122 Alan Ang, to our Board Member of the 5th District of Leyte, Honorable Michael Cari, to our
123 neighbor, of course, Honorable Lumen and to the Board Members virtually present
124 through the Zoom Meeting. Maupai na aga ha iyo na tanan.

125 In a very short presentation, let me present to you what happened to the
126 investment that was duly approved by this August Body as a Community College. I call
127 this particular presentation "From Survival To Significance, A Local College Story."

131 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

132 After my presentation, I would like to end it with this note. "Good teachers know
133 how to bring out the best in students and we teachers can do it with the support of this
134 August Body and our officials." Daghang Salamat sa tanan. God bless you all.

135 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

136 Thank you, Dr. Montallana. Do we have questions from the floor?

137 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

138 I have a question.

139 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

140 Dr. Montallana, the Vice Governor has a question.

141 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

142 Yes, po, Vice Gov.

143 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

144 What do they need? What particularly does this Community College need?

145 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

146 Mr. Chair, in this time of information age, we have put in our budget the provision
147 of Smart classroom but wala pa po syang budget and if eve we could have a little of for
148 Pedagogi for strategy, perhaps, information and technology materials po.

149 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

150 Like for example, computers? Or internet?

151 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

152 Yes, Sir. It's very important, sir.

153 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

154 Do you have internet connection in your school?

155 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

156 Yes, sir. But then, yun sana ibibigay ko yung budget ngayun sir but its more on
157 personnel service. Kasi po yun po yung malaking aspect ng aming budget because every
158 single month we have a 3 million PS expense so we go away with what is left para sa
159 capital outlay and equipment like ICT.

160 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

161 Do you get a budget coming from the Department of Education?

162 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

163 From CHED, yes Sir, pero bago palang po kasi kami na na confere in UniFAST,
164 so, we are in the second year so minabuti po naming nay ug budget mapunta muna po
165 sa PS po muna. So konti nalang po ang Capital Outlay.

166 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

167 Please educate me, ano ba ang UniFAST?

168 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

169 UniFAST po is the tuition subsidy given by the Commission on Education. Ka Party
170 po ito ng Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Law. Mayron pong tuition
171 reimbursement amounting to 30 million pesos per sem and we do away with that. Ito po
172 yung aming operating budget kaya po PS po una yung na allocate namin.

174 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

175 Sino yung kausap nyo sa CHED?

176 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

177 We interface po with the Regional Director and sila na yung nag iinterface sa
178 Central office.

179 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

180 Do you need an increase in your budget?

181 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

182 Yes, Sir. If granted on mobility and internet access and on the teaching needs side
183 para mo ma enhance.

184 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

185 Can you make a request because the gentleman who gave you a speech on your
186 graduation has a nephew, which is also my nephew, who sits in the congress. The
187 Congressman Carl Cari from the 5th District. Maybe he can push for your budget lalo na
188 ngayun malapit na ang budget call. Siguro kaya nating pagtulongan nyan.

189 Floor Leader, maybe we can ask our nephew, to help ACC.

190 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

191 Vice Gov, Congressman Carl is very helpful to us po. We also invite him every now
192 and then.

193 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

194 Actually, Vice Gov, Dr. Montallana called me before because their budget in CHED
195 was pending in Congress. So, he was asking me to call Congresswoman Janette Garin
196 and I think she solicited also the help of Congresswoman Karen Javier and Congressman
197 Carl Cari. So, they worked together that is why meron na pong reimbursement sa mga
198 students. And I think that helped, Vice Gov, but it's never enough and more help coming
199 is always welcome.

200 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

201 Yes, po sir. We have 560 students from Jaro, Leyte po.

203 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

204 How about from Javier, Leyte.

205 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

206 Marami din po, Sir. In fact, my executive assistant is from Javier. We have about
207 700 from Javier and that's a figure that we can show.

208 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

209 Alam mo Doc, kaibigan ko nga yung speaker ngayun eh baka pwede tayo
210 makahingi ng tulong tungkol dyan. But you have to do your part also by telling the primary
211 sponsors, siguro Congressman Carl Cari, because that is under him. Pag humingi ka na
212 kay Congressman Carl, we will follow it up. We promise to help you.

213 DR. CLEMELLE L. MONTILLANA: PRESIDENT, ABUYOG COMMUNITY COLLEGE

214 Thank you so much, Sir.

215 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

216 Thank you, Vice Gov. Thank you, Dr. Montallana.

217 On that note, Mr. Chair, considering the modest achievements of Abuyog
218 Community College, notwithstanding the limited resources, it is commendable, Mr. Chair.
219 So, I move that we pass a resolution commending Abuyog Community College.

234 Congresswoman Karen Javier. So, ngayon wala nang ginagastos ang LGU Dulag kasi
235 nasa GAA na po ang budget.

236 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

237 Teka muna, ang tanong ko, can a community college be also subsidized by
238 CHED?

239 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

240 Hindi po, Vice Gov, kasi dapat university. Community College po is I think funded
241 by the LGU.

242 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

243 Mr. Chair, I amend my motion.
