I. BACKGROUND

The National Youth Basketball League Eastern Visayas (NYBL Eastern Visayas) is a duly organized and existing non-stock, non-profit organization established for developmental, educational, charitable, and community-oriented purposes. It seeks accreditation as a Civil Society Organization (CSO) with the Provincial Government of Leyte to advance its mission of promoting grassroots basketball development and fostering youth empowerment through sports within the Province of Leyte and the Eastern Visayas Region.

II. FINDINGS

Upon preliminary evaluation, the Committee found that the applicant had not fully complied with the documentary requirements prescribed under the applicable laws, rules, and regulations governing CSO accreditation, particularly the submission of its Annual Accomplishment Report, latest Financial Statements, and Minutes of the Annual General Meeting.

Pursuant to Resolution No. 2026-912 the applicant was directed to submit the foregoing documentary requirements, with which it subsequently complied, thereby completing its application for accreditation.

Upon due evaluation of the completed application and the supporting documents submitted, the Committee finds that the applicant has substantially complied with the legal and documentary requirements for accreditation as a Civil Society Organization (CSO) and is therefore qualified for accreditation.

III. RECOMMENDATION

Considering the applicant's substantial compliance with the applicable legal and documentary requirements, the Committee finds the application of the National Youth Basketball League Eastern Visayas (NYBL Eastern Visayas) to be sufficient in form and substance and hereby recommends the **APPROVAL** of its application for accreditation as a Civil Society Organization (CSO) in the Province of Leyte.

REMINDERS:

The Regional Commissioner, Mr. Anton Gregor Gabriola, presented the proposed Programs and Strategic Plans of the National Youth Basketball League (NYBL) Eastern Visayas for Calendar Year 2026. He emphasized that the organization's programs are designed to strengthen grassroots basketball development, expand opportunities for young athletes, and establish sustainable partnerships that will support the long-term growth of basketball in Eastern Visayas.

The following priority programs were presented:

1. Grassroots Basketball Development Program

- Local Qualifying Tournaments to be conducted in various cities and municipalities to identify outstanding teams and athletes who will advance to higher-level competitions.
- 3x3 Basketball Competitions aimed at promoting the fast-growing format of basketball while encouraging wider participation among youth athletes and local communities.

2. Regional Competition Development Program

- Regional Qualifying Championships which will gather the top-performing teams from the local qualifiers to compete for qualification to national tournaments organized by the National Youth Basketball League Philippines.

3. Athlete High-Performance and Elite Development Program

- Basketball Clinics and Training Programs designed to enhance the technical skills, physical conditioning, discipline, leadership, and sportsmanship of players, while also providing continuing education and development opportunities for coaches and game officials.

4. International and National Exposure Program

Mr. Anton Gregor Gabriola informed the Board of the upcoming international participation of the **Leyte Pilipinas Basketball Team** in the **2026 NTOU New Southbound International Basketball Tournament in Keelung City, Taiwan on June 15-20, 2026**. It emphasized that the tournament presents a valuable opportunity to showcase the basketball talent of Eastern Visayas on the international stage. He noted that the team's participation aligns with the mission of the National Youth Basketball League (NYBL) to provide young athletes with meaningful exposure, enhance their competitive experience, and promote the region's grassroots basketball program beyond the national level.

He also discussed the financial requirements necessary to support the delegation's participation, which include:

- Airfare
- Travel Tax
- Local Transportation
- Meals and Daily Allowance
- Travel Insurance
- Uniforms and Official Team Apparel
- Other travel-related and administrative expenses

Dareen Bocateja, one of the Coaching Staff, acknowledged that international competitions offer athletes, coaches, and officials the opportunity to compete against teams from different countries, gain valuable international experience, and develop a higher level of confidence, discipline, and sportsmanship. He further recognized that participation in such events enhances the visibility of Eastern Visayas basketball, strengthens the region's reputation for developing young talent, and opens opportunities for scholarships, international partnerships, and future invitations to prestigious competitions.

5. Sponsorship and Resource Mobilization Program

Mr. Francis Cadavis shared the importance of strengthening the organization's sponsorship and partnership program to ensure the successful implementation and long-term sustainability of the National Youth Basketball League (NYBL) Eastern Visayas. Recognizing that the league's programs continue to expand, the members emphasized the need to establish strong collaborations with various sectors that share the organization's commitment to youth and sports development.

Potential sponsors and partner organizations from the following sectors were identified:

- National Government Agencies
- Local Government Units (LGUs)
- Educational institutions, including schools, colleges, and universities
- Sports organizations and associations
- Local entrepreneurs and business partners

Recognizing the significant financial commitment required, the Board discussed various funding sources, particular emphasis was given to requesting financial assistance from the Provincial Government of Leyte in recognition of the team Leyte Pilipinas in representing not only the province but also Eastern Visayas and the Philippines in international competition.

After careful deliberation, the Board unanimously approved the preparation and submission of a formal request for financial assistance to the Provincial Government of Leyte through Governor Jericho "Icot" Petilla. Mr. Dareen Bocateja was authorized to prepare the necessary communication and supporting documents, while the officers were tasked to coordinate with prospective government agencies, private sponsors, and partner organizations to secure additional financial and logistical support for the team's international participation.

Further, the Board approved the proposed sponsorship and partnership development strategies. Mr. Anton Gregor Gabriola assigned the concerned officers and committee heads to initiate formal communications with prospective sponsors, government agencies, educational institutions, private corporations, and partner organizations. Each committee was instructed to prepare sponsorship proposals, partnership presentations, and official communication letters to strengthen resource mobilization and secure financial and logistical support for the league's activities and programs throughout Calendar Year 2026.

Financial Report and Budget for CY 2026

Ms. Chrisha Tuca, the treasurer presented the NYBL Financial Report for the period October to December 2025. The National Youth Basketball League (NYBL) Eastern Visayas successfully conducted two major basketball events: the NYBL Global Cup Regional Qualifiers and the NYBL 3x3 Basketball Tournament.

The NYBL Global Cup Regional Qualifiers generated approximately ₱310,000.00 in tournament registration fees and sponsorship support. The event incurred an estimated ₱340,000.00 in expenses, which covered venue rental, referees' honoraria, basketball equipment and supplies, medals and trophies, royalties, logistics, meals, event promotion, and administrative costs. The tournament served as the official qualifying event for teams aspiring to compete in higher-level NYBL competitions and provided valuable exposure to young athletes across Eastern Visayas.

Meanwhile, the NYBL 3x3 Basketball Tournament generated approximately ₱150,000.00 in registration fees, sponsorships, and donations. Total expenses for the event amounted to approximately ₱161,850.00, covering tournament operations, officials' honoraria, equipment, awards, marketing, transportation, meals, and other incidental expenses. The tournament promoted the fast-growing 3x3 basketball format and encouraged wider participation among youth athletes from different localities.

Overall, both events generated total receipts of ₱460,000.00 while total tournament and operational expenses reached ₱501,850.00, resulting in a net operating deficit of ₱41,850.00 for the reporting period. Despite the deficit, the expenditures were necessary to ensure the successful conduct of both tournaments, enhance the quality of competition, and support NYBL's mission of developing grassroots basketball in Eastern Visayas. The organization remains committed to strengthening sponsorships, expanding fundraising initiatives, and improving revenue generation to sustain future programs and activities.

Ms. Chrisha Tuca, also presented the projected Financial Statement and the proposed Annual Budget amounting to P 900, 000.00 for Calendar Year 2026, providing the Board with an overview of the organization's anticipated income, planned expenditures, and financial priorities for the year. The presentation highlighted the importance of prudent financial planning to ensure the successful implementation of NYBL Eastern Visayas programs and activities.

The Board reviewed the organization's projected sources of income, which include:

- Membership Fees from participating teams
- Sponsorship from government agencies
- Donations from individuals and business establishments

The Board also examined the proposed expenditures necessary to support the organization's operations and planned events, including:

- Tournament Expenses for local, regional, and national qualifying competitions
- Administrative and Operational Expenses
- Logistics and Transportation
- Venue Rental and Facility Fees
- Office Supplies, Equipment, and Event Materials
- Officials' honoraria, coaches' support, and other personnel-related expenses

She also discussed the need to strengthen revenue-generating initiatives by expanding sponsorship opportunities, increasing partnerships with government and private institutions, and organizing fundraising activities to supplement the organization's financial resources. In addition, the Board stressed the importance of maintaining accurate financial records, timely liquidation of expenses, and regular financial reporting to promote transparency and accountability in all organizational transactions.

After careful review and deliberation, the Board unanimously approved the proposed Annual Budget for Calendar Year 2026. The Treasurer was authorized to implement the approved budget in accordance with established financial policies and procedures. The Board likewise adopted stricter financial monitoring and reporting mechanisms, including the preparation of periodic financial reports, proper documentation of all income and expenditures, and regular financial reviews to ensure transparency, accountability, and the efficient utilization of organizational funds.

V. OTHER MATTERS

The Regional Commissioner, Mr. Anton Gregor Gabriola reminded all officers to continue working together in implementing the organization's programs and maintaining professionalism in all NYBL activities.

The Sports Development Coordinator, Mr. Michael Octaviano, emphasized the importance of early planning and effective coordination with Local Government Units (LGUs), schools, sports organizations, private partners, and community stakeholders to ensure the successful implementation of all scheduled activities. He also discussed the need to avoid conflicts with academic calendars, local festivals, and other major sporting events to maximize participation from teams and athletes across the region.

He further recognized the importance of securing suitable venues such as Tacloban City Sports Complex, mobilizing qualified coaches and officials, preparing logistical requirements, and strengthening promotional efforts through media and social media platforms to ensure the success of every event.

After thorough discussion and deliberation, the Board unanimously approved the proposed plan / programs for Calendar Year 2026. The Regional Commissioner, together with the concerned committee heads, was authorized to finalize the schedule of activities and coordinate with Local Government Units, educational institutions, partner organizations, and other stakeholders. The Board also directed all committee heads to begin preparations for their respective responsibilities to ensure the timely and successful implementation of all NYBL Eastern Visayas programs and events.

VI. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further matters to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 8:25 pm.

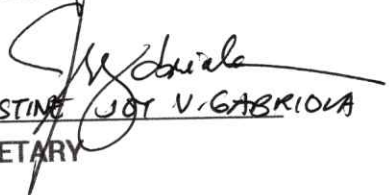

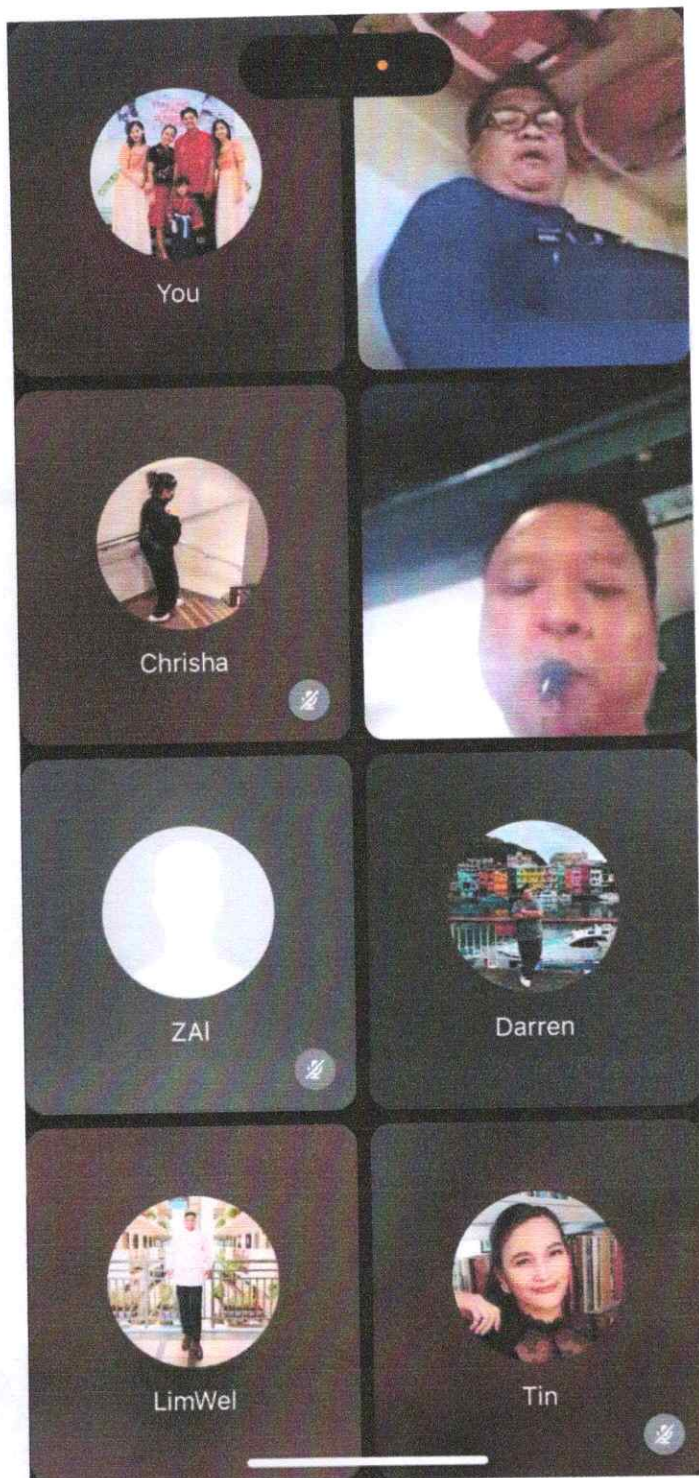

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-902

A RESOLUTION ADVISING THE LEYTE PILIPINAS BASKETBALL TEAM TO COMPLY WITH THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCREDITATION OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE AND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, submitted to the August Body is a request for accreditation of the **LEYTE PILIPINAS BASKETBALL TEAM**, with office address at Palo, Leyte, as a non-government organization in the Province of Leyte;

WHEREAS, Section 34 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, encourages the establishment and participation of non-governmental organizations, people's organizations, and other civic groups as active partners in local governance and development;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code and its Implementing Rules and Regulations provide for the accreditation of NGOs and POs to enable their participation in local special bodies and development initiatives of local government units;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has issued various memorandum circulars prescribing the guidelines, procedures, and documentary requirements for the accreditation of civil society organizations, non-governmental organizations, and people's organizations seeking recognition and participation in local governance mechanisms;

WHEREAS, compliance with accreditation requirements promotes transparency, accountability, legitimacy, and effective collaboration between local government units and private sector or civil society partners;

WHEREAS, the Leyte Pilipinas Basketball Team, as an organization engaged in sports development and community activities within the Province of Leyte, may benefit from accreditation and recognition in accordance with applicable laws, rules, and regulations governing NGOs, Pos and CSOs;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion presented by Atty. Ronnan Christian M. Reposar seconded by the Atty. Carlo P. Loreto and Honorable MJ Luinly D. Lumen, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to advice and encourage the Leyte Pilipinas Basketball Team and its officers to comply with the minimum requirements prescribed under the Local Government Code of 1991 and pertinent DILG issuances governing the accreditation of NGOs, Pos and CSOs;
