Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), our preliminary review of the **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 01 FY 2026** of the **Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte** duly enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through **Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, Series of 2026** with a total appropriation in the amount of **P5,395,000.00** reveals compliance with the same law and its implementing Rules and Regulations.

It is therefore recommended for approval subject to the following conditions:

1. That the procurement of Civil Works and other related services shall be made in accordance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;
2. That the reversion of appropriations is duly authorized by the concerned officials and is backed up by cash collections and are made available to support the expenditures under Supplemental Budget No. 01;
3. That the utilization of 20% Development Fund (DF) shall strictly adhere to DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020;
4. That the procurement of Motor Vehicle under Capital Outlay shall be made pursuant to the guidelines on the requisition and use of Government Vehicles under Budget Circular No. 2022-1 dated February 11, 2022;
5. That the allocation and utilization of the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMIF) shall conform with the provisions of NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013; and
6. That disbursement of funds shall be for the specific purpose(s) for which they have been appropriated pursuant to Sections 335 & 336 of RA 7160.

Compliance with DBM issuances, and all other accounting and auditing rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the implementing Local Government Unit.

Section 3. Use of funds. Five Million, Three Hundred Ninety Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,395,000.000) appropriated herein shall be used to provide funds for the following:

A. Procurement of heavy equipment (wheel-type backhoe)	- P3,395,000.00
B. Construction of new Slaughterhouse	- P2,000,000.00
Total New Appropriations=	P5,395,000.00

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Section 4. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other sections or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effectivity Clause. The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect on March 9, 2026.

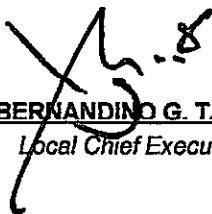

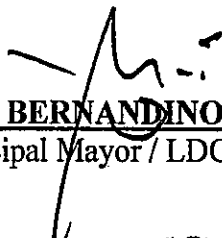

The Council recognized the project as a priority development initiative and agreed to include it in the 1st Quarter Supplemental Investment Program for Calendar Year 2026.

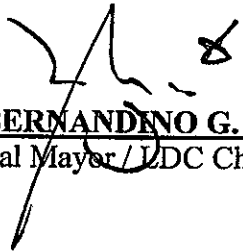

No. 10121 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) shall be utilized for disaster risk reduction and management activities, including preparedness measures and the procurement of necessary rescue vehicles and heavy equipment;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (MDRRM) Investment Fund Plan for FY 2026 serves as the official planning and budgeting instrument for allocating MDRRM funds across the thematic areas of Prevention and Mitigation, Preparedness, Response, and Rehabilitation and Recovery, based on identified hazards and risks within the municipality;

WHEREAS, the procurement of rescue vehicles and heavy equipment under the MDRRM Investment Fund Plan is an allowable expenditure, as these assets are essential to disaster preparedness, emergency response, clearing operations, flood control, rescue activities, and post-disaster rehabilitation;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Matag-ob has identified the need to procure a backhoe, which is the rescue vehicle and/or heavy equipment referred to in this Resolution, to strengthen its capacity for clearing debris, restoring access roads, maintaining drainage systems, mitigating flood risks, and supporting disaster response and recovery operations;

WHEREAS, the proposed realignment/augmentation of MDRRM funds in the total amount of Three Million Three Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Pesos (P3,395,000.00) from the Prevention and Mitigation, Preparedness, Response, and Rehabilitation and Recovery components of the MDRRM Investment Fund Plan for FY 2026 is intended for the procurement of the said backhoe under the Preparedness component;

WHEREAS, the proposed realignment was duly deliberated upon and approved by the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council during its 1st Quarter Meeting held on February 5, 2026, at the Panday Eloy Building, Matag-ob, Leyte, after consultation with concerned stakeholders, and is consistent with the disaster risk reduction priorities of the present administration;

I. CALL TO ORDER

The LDRRMO Head declared the meeting to be ordered at 9:30 AM and requested everyone to stand for the opening prayer.

II. ROLL CALL/DETERMINATION OF QUORUM

The Chairman requested the Secretariat to conduct the roll call. The MDRRMO declared the presence of a quorum, with 22 MDRRMC members in attendance.

III. CORRECTION AND APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The Presiding Officer opted to skip with the correction and approval of the minutes of the previous meeting, as well as the business arising from the previous minutes

IV. NEW BUSINESS

1. CONDUCT OF PRE-DISASTER RISK ASSESSMENT (PDRA)

Engr. Rommier-LDRRMO Head discusses the Weather Analysis Tropical Storm Basyang is currently moving west-northwestward over the Visayas region and has brought significant rainfall and gusty conditions across several islands including Leyte. This means possible flooding in low-lying and urban areas, and landslide risks in mountainous terrain where soils are saturated. Landslides Heavy rainfall and terrain increases landslide potential, particularly on hills, slopes, and unstable grounds. These hazards can occur even without direct landfall of the storm center. Strong Winds While not currently as severe as rain impacts, gale-force winds associated with Basyang can cause minor damage to trees, power lines, and loose structures.

The LDRRMO Head activated Alert Level 1 (Preparedness Phase - Partial Activation) in response to Tropical Storm *Basyang*. He also informed the Municipal Council about the possible escalation to Alert Level 2, including potential adjustments in travel and response routes due to the continuing effects of the *Ani*han (Northeast Monsoon).

Mayor Tacoy emphasized the following priorities to ensure community safety and preparedness:

- Implementation of the Evacuation Oplan for Barangay Masaba, particularly for residents in identified landslide-prone areas.
- Pre-positioning and checking of food supplies and essential relief items to ensure adequate support for evacuees.
- Activation of the logistics team and camp management personnel to facilitate orderly evacuation and proper management of evacuation centers.

- Strengthened coordination with Barangay officials and BERT (Barangay Emergency Response Team) for monitoring, early warning dissemination, and rapid response.
- Continuous preparedness actions guided by the latest weather forecasts and official advisories, including possible adjustments in response measures depending on evolving conditions.

Engr. Rommier requested the Municipal Council to designate the Incident Commander for this operational period. The Council selected PCPT Marcee M. Barzil, OIC of the PNP, to serve as the Incident Commander for the current operation period.

Engr. Rommier proposed an ordinance authorizing the suspension of classes and work as part of the municipality's adaptive measures during Red Rainfall Warning forecasts. The proposal aims to strengthen preparedness actions and reduce risks to public safety during periods of intense rainfall and severe weather conditions.

2. OTHER MATTERS

Engr. Cotejar proposed realignment/augmentation of MDRRM funds in the total amount of Three Million Three Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Pesos (P3,395,000.00) from the Prevention and Mitigation, Preparedness, Response, and Rehabilitation and Recovery components of the MDRRM Investment Fund Plan for FY 2026 is intended for the Procurement of the said Backhoe under the Preparedness component.

Engr. Rommier-LDRRMO presented to the council the proposed Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (Continuing Appropriations) Annual Investment Plan 2026 wherein the budget allocation amounted to Six Million Six Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Three Pesos and Forty-Two Centavos Only (P6,684,823.42). Engr. Romer proposed A Resolution Endorsing The Council-Approved Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Fund (Continuing Appropriations) Annual Investment Plan 2025 To The Sangguniang Bayan For Approval.

V. ADJOURNMENT

As there were no other business to discuss. The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 am.
