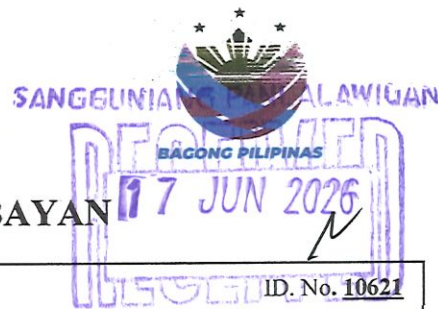

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03 SERIES 2026

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE TABONTABON WATER
DISTRIBUTION SERVICE OTHERWISE KNOWN AS
“TABONWATER”, PRESCRIBING THE CONNECTION FEES,
MONTHLY CONSUMPTION FEES, IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES THEREOF.**

WHEREAS, The Municipality of Tabontabon recognizes that access to safe, sufficient, and affordable water is essential to public health, sanitation, and the overall well-being of its people. At present, the municipality owns and operates two (2) existing water supply facilities which serve as the backbone of its water distribution system, namely:

1. The Sitio Gubat Water Facility located within the premises of Riverside Residences, Barangay Mering, Tabontabon, Leyte; and
2. The Sitio Casilion Water Facility located within the premises of Riverside Residences II, Barangay Mercaduhay, Tabontabon, Leyte;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of RA 7160, authorizes Local Government Units to exercise powers necessary and appropriate for the promotion of the general welfare, including ensuring basic services for their constituents;

WHEREAS, Section 17 (Basic Services and Facilities), mandates municipalities to provide infrastructure facilities, including water supply systems;

WHEREAS, Section 447(a)(1)(vi) and (viii), empowers the Sangguniang Bayan to regulate the use of municipal utilities, prescribe fees and charges for services rendered, and enact measures to protect public welfare;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion by Hon. Francisco M. Fernandez and unanimously seconded;

BE IT RESOLVE, as it is hereby resolved to enact/approve Municipal Ordinance No. 03 Series of 2026 entitled “AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE TABONTABON WATER DISTRIBUTION SERVICE OTHERWISE KNOWN AS “TABONWATER”, PRESCRIBING THE CONNECTION FEES, MONTHLY CONSUMPTION FEES, IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREOF;

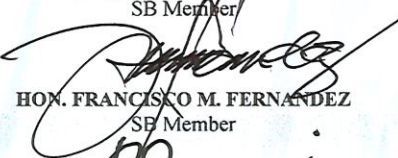

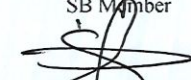

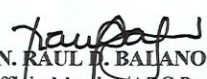

BE IT ORDAINED by the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan, in its Regular Session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as the “Tabontabon Water Distribution Service Ordinance of 2025.”

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Tabontabon to provide safe, reliable, and sustainable potable water supply to its inhabitants, consistent with the powers and responsibilities vested in local government units under the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160).

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS

For purposes of this Ordinance:

1. **TABONWATER** – Refers to the Tabontabon Water Distribution Service, the municipal water utility system created under this Ordinance.
2. **Concessionaire** – Any household, establishment, or institution legally connected to the municipal water system.
3. **Connection Fee** – The one-time charge for the installation of a new water service connection.
4. **Monthly Consumption Fee** – The regular charge for water usage by a concessionaire.
5. **Illegal Connection** – Any unauthorized tapping into the water supply system.
6. **Tampering** – Any act of altering or interfering with the water meter or facilities to take due advantage defraud or evade payment.
7. **Facilities** – Includes water tanks, pipelines, pumps, meters, valves, and all other related equipment and infrastructure.

SECTION 4. CREATION OF “TABONWATER”

There is hereby created the Tabontabon Water Distribution Service (TABONWATER), which shall be owned, managed, and operated by the Municipality of Tabontabon, through the Office of the Municipal Mayor and such management structure as may be hereafter organized.

SECTION 5. INITIAL WATER FACILITIES

Upon its creation, TABONWATER shall own, operate, and manage the following initial water supply facilities:

1. Sitio Gubat Water Facility – located within Riverside Residences I, Barangay Mering, Tabontabon, Leyte; and
2. Sitio Casilion Water Facility – located within Riverside Residences II, Barangay Mercaduhay, Tabontabon, Leyte.

SECTION 6. EXPANSION OF WATER FACILITIES

Future water facilities to be constructed, acquired, or developed by TABONWATER shall, upon approval of the Sangguniang Bayan, be incorporated into this Ordinance through the adoption of supplemental ordinances or resolutions.

SECTION 7. CONNECTION FEES AND MONTHLY CONSUMPTION FEES

All concessionaires shall pay connection fees and monthly consumption fees as prescribed in the Schedule of Fees as follows:

a. CONNECTION FEES

1. Residential Household – ₱2,500
2. Commercial Establishment – ₱4,000
3. Institutional/Government – ₱3,000

b. MONTHLY CONSUMPTION FEES

1. Residential – ₱200.00 (first 10 cu.m.), ₱25.00 per excess cu.m.
2. Commercial – ₱400.00 (first 10 cu.m.), ₱30.00 per excess cu.m.
3. Institutional – ₱300.00 (first 10 cu.m.), ₱25.00 per excess cu.m.

c. OTHER CHARGES

1. Reconnection Fee – ₱300.00
2. Transfer of Connection Fee – ₱500.00
3. Meter Testing/Replacement – ₱500.00

d. PENALTY FOR LATE PAYMENT – 5% of unpaid bill per month.

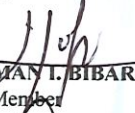
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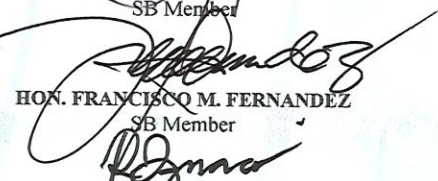
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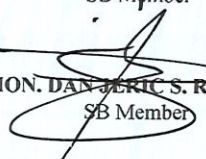

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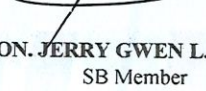

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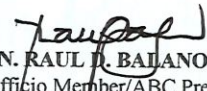

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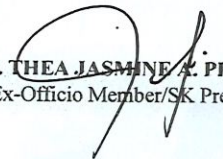

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SECTION 8. PENAL PROVISIONS

The following acts are strictly prohibited and shall be penalized accordingly:

1,500.00 for 1st Offense,

2,000.00 for 2nd Offense,

2, 500.00 for 3rd Offense and an imprisonment of 1 month or upon discretion of the local court

a. Illegal Connections – Any person or entity found undertaking illegal tapping into the system.

b. Meter Tampering / Pilferage – Any act of tampering or altering the water meter.

c. Collusion between Employees and Concessionaires – Any employee of TABONWATER found guilty of conniving with concessionaires to defraud the system shall face administrative sanctions, while the concessionaire shall be penalized as mentioned in Section 8 (Penal Provisions).

d. Vandalism or Destruction of Facilities – Any person who vandalizes or destroys water tanks, pipelines, or related equipment.

e. Any concessionaire/s who will be found guilty by the Local Court, shall be disconnected from the system.

SECTION 9. PERIODIC REVIEW AND ADJUSTMENT OF FEES

The connection fees, monthly consumption fees, and other charges shall be subject to review every three (3) years, or as the need arises, upon recommendation of TABONWATER and approval of the Sangguniang Bayan. Updates shall be appended through supplemental ordinances or resolutions.

SECTION 10. CRAFTING OF IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS.

Implementing Rules and Regulations shall be crafted by the representative of the Municipal Mayor through the TabonWater Management, together with the Chairman and Members of the Sangguniang Bayan Committee on Economic Enterprise, Market, Cemetery and Slaughterhouse, for the purpose of effective and sustainable implementation of the Ordinance.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, resolutions, or regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY

This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days after posting in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the Municipality of Tabontabon and publication in a local newspaper of general circulation, pursuant to the Local Government Code of 1991.
