¹ (a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:

(1) Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government, and in this connection shall:

(ii) Maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion or sedition and impose penalties for the violation of said ordinances;

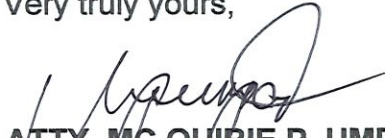

PREFATORY STATEMENT

The Municipality of Villaba recognizes the need to regulate ukay-ukay and temporary or itinerant vendors to ensure public order, safety, and sanitation due to the influx of vendors during fiestas and public events. The said fact necessitates control to prevent congestion, unfair competition, and public nuisance;

The Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) empowers local government units to regulate business operations within their jurisdiction.

Hence, there is a need to establish clear operational requirements, fees, and penalties to ensure compliance;

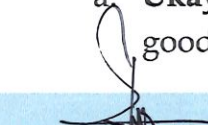
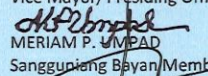
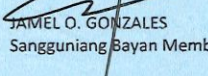
Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in regular session duly assembled that:

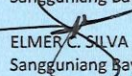
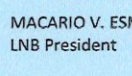
SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the “Ukay-Ukay and Temporary Vendors Regulation Ordinance of Villaba.”

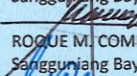
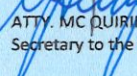
SECTION 2. POLICY. The Municipality of Villaba, pursuant to its authority under the Local Government Code of 1991, shall regulate business activities to ensure public order, safety, sanitation, and equitable economic opportunity, while preventing nuisance and unlawful practices during fiestas and other public events.

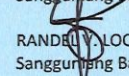
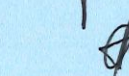
SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance:

- a. **Ukay-Ukay** – the business of selling second-hand clothing, apparel and similar goods.

- b. **Temporary Vendors/Fiesta Vendors** – persons or entities engaged in the selling of goods or services on a short-term, seasonal or event-based basis, particularly during fiestas, fairs or public gatherings.
- c. **Itinerant or Transient Vendors** – vendors who do not maintain a permanent place of business and operate within the municipality for a limited duration.
- d. **Ambulant Vendors** – vendors who sells goods by moving from place to place without a fixed stall.
- e. **Designated Vending Area** – areas specifically identified and authorized by the Local Government Unit of Villaba for vending operations.

SECTION 4. COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall apply to all ukay-ukay operators, whether permanent or temporary, and temporary, itinerant, ambulant or fiesta vendors operating within the Municipality of Villaba.

SECTION 5. PERMIT AND FRANCHISE REQUIREMENT.

- a. No person or entity shall operate any ukay-ukay business or temporary/itinerant/fiesta vending activity without securing the required permits.
- b. The grant of franchise shall be personal and non-transferable, unless expressly authorized by the Municipality.

SECTION 6. FEES, PAYMENTS AND CASH BOND. Operators shall pay rights to operate in the amount of ₱2,000.00 for town fiesta. Payment shall be made to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer.

A refundable cash bond of ₱1,000.00 shall be required from each operator, which shall serve as security for damage, violation or liability and be refunded only upon clearance and post-inspection by the Office of the Municipal Treasurer confirming compliance.

SECTION 7. PERIOD OF OPERATION. Operations shall commence on January 1 of the calendar year and shall not exceed forty-five (45) days from its commencement or shall end on February 15 of the same year. Any extension beyond the authorized period shall require prior approval from the Office of the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 8. BUSINESS OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS. All operators shall:

- a. Secure a Mayor's Permit and Barangay Clearance;
- b. Pay the rights and cash bond;
- c. Maintain cleanliness and proper waste disposal;
- d. Display permits at all times;
- e. Operate only within the designated areas
- f. Avoid obstruction to public roads and sidewalks;
- g. Comply sanitation and safety regulations, if applicable.

SECTION 9. PROHIBITED ACTS. It shall be unlawful for any operator, vendor or personnel to:

- a. Sell or serve liquor or alcoholic beverages to minors;
- b. Fail to require the presentation of valid identification card when age is in doubt;
- c. Engage in or allow littering, dumping or scattering of garbage;
- d. Commit vandalism or destruction of public or private property;
- e. Employ or allow the employment of minors;
- f. Operate beyond the designated area;
- g. Transfer or sublease the granted rights without approval from the Local Government.

SECTION 10. INSPECTION. All establishments shall be subject to pre-operation inspection, regular monitoring and post-operation inspection by the Office of the Municipal Treasurer and the Philippine National Police-Villaba Station.

SECTION 11. PENALTIES. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

- First offense: ₱500;
- Second offense: ₱1,500;
- Third offense: ₱2,500 and revocation of permit

In addition:

- The cash bond may be forfeited in whole or in part;
- Goods may be confiscated; and
- The violator may be disqualified from future operations

SECTION 12. ENFORCEMENT. This Ordinance shall be enforced by:

- Office of the Municipal Mayor;
- Business Permits and Licensing Officer;
- Municipal Treasurer's Office;
- Municipal Health Office;
- Philippine National Police; and
- Concerned Barangay Officials

SECTION 13. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and in effect.

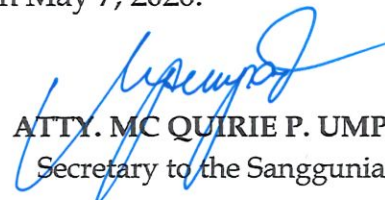

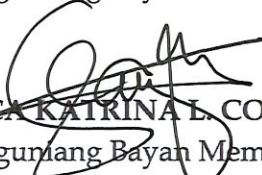

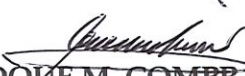

A refundable cash of Php 1,000.00 shall be required from each operator, which shall serve as security for damages, violations, or liabilities, and shall be refunded only upon clearance and post-inspection by the Office of the Municipal Treasurer confirming compliance.

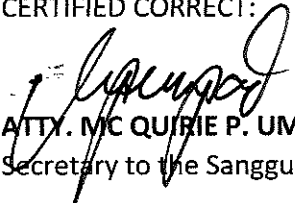
Operations shall commence on January 1 of the calendar year and shall not exceed forty-five (45) days from its commencement.

She further informed the public about the business operational requirements, prohibited acts, and corresponding penalties, as well as the enforcement mechanism of the ordinance.

- Ukay-Ukay and other traded goods sold during fiestas are necessary because they meet high consumer demand, provide livelihood opportunities, and stimulates local economic activity, while also becoming part of the festive culture.

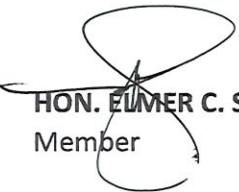
RECOMMENDATIONS:
