PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Villaba, being committed to sustainable development and environmental protection, recognizes the importance of prudent energy management as a critical component in promoting efficiency, reducing energy costs, and mitigating the impacts of climate change;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11285, otherwise known as the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act, mandates government entities to adopt energy efficiency and conservation measures, while the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) empowers local government units to formulate and implement policies and programs that enhance the well-being of their constituents, including the promotion of a balanced and healthful ecology;

WHEREAS, the Municipality acknowledges the need to institutionalize a Local Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan (LEECP) as a comprehensive framework that will guide municipal offices, barangays, and stakeholders in the efficient utilization of energy resources, the reduction of energy consumption, the promotion of renewable energy, and the establishment of sustainable practices in all local operations;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan, in its legislative capacity, finds it necessary and proper to enact an Ordinance that provides for the formulation, adoption, implementation, monitoring, and funding of the LEECP, ensuring alignment with national policies, technical standards, and best practices;

SECTION 1. TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the “Villaba Local Energy Efficiency and Conservation Ordinance of 2026,” which establishes a comprehensive framework for the formulation, adoption, implementation, and monitoring of the Local Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan (LEECP) of the Municipality.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY

It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Villaba to promote the judicious and efficient use of energy resources as a fundamental component of sustainable development, climate change mitigation, and environmental protection. The Municipality recognizes that energy efficiency and conservation are vital strategies in reducing energy costs, enhancing energy security, and minimizing greenhouse gas emissions. Consistent with national policies, the Municipality commits to institutionalizing a Local Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan (LEECP) to guide all government offices, barangays, and stakeholders toward responsible energy utilization.

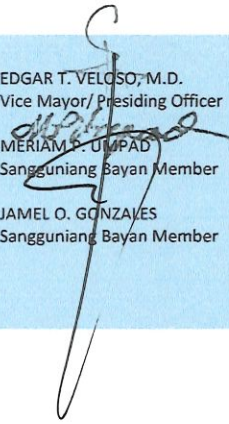
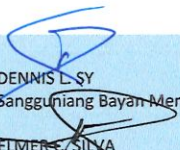
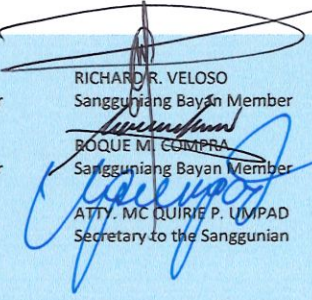
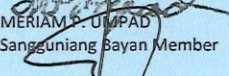
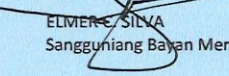
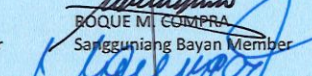
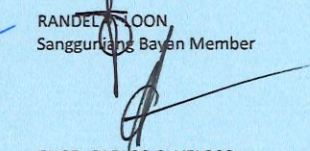
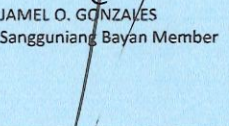
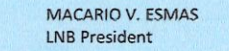
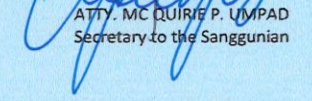
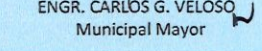
This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the powers granted to Local Government Units under the 1987 Philippine Constitution and Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991). It is further anchored on Republic Act No. 11285, otherwise known as the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act, which mandates all government entities to adopt energy efficiency and conservation measures. This Ordinance also aligns with policies of the Department of Energy (DOE) and other relevant national agencies promoting energy sustainability and climate-responsive governance.

SECTION 4. OBJECTIVES

This Ordinance aims to establish a comprehensive Local Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan (LEECP) that shall serve as the Municipality’s roadmap in reducing energy consumption, improving energy performance, promoting renewable energy adoption, and ensuring cost-effective energy use in all municipal operations. It further seeks to institutionalize behavioral change, promote awareness among constituents, and integrate energy efficiency measures into local development planning.

SECTION 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS

For purposes of this Ordinance, “Energy Efficiency” refers to the reduction of energy consumption while maintaining or improving the same level of service. “Energy Conservation” refers to practices that reduce energy use through behavioral or operational changes. “Local Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan (LEECP)” refers to a strategic document outlining policies, programs, and targets for energy efficiency within the Municipality. “Designated Establishments” refer to facilities or offices required to comply with energy reporting and efficiency standards as mandated by law.

SECTION 6. COVERAGE AND APPLICATION

This Ordinance shall apply to all offices of the Municipal Government of Villaba, including all barangay government units, public schools, government-owned facilities, and, where applicable, private establishments operating within the Municipality. All covered entities shall comply with the provisions of this Ordinance and actively participate in the implementation of the LEECP.

SECTION 7. FORMULATION OF THE LOCAL ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION PLAN (LEECP)

The Municipality, through the Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO) in coordination with the General Services Office (GSO), MENRO, and other concerned offices, shall formulate a comprehensive LEECP within six (6) months from the effectivity of this Ordinance. The Plan shall include baseline energy consumption data, sectoral analysis, energy-saving targets, strategies, timelines, and performance indicators, and shall be aligned with national energy policies and local development plans.

SECTION 8. ADOPTION AND INTEGRATION

The LEECP, once formulated, shall be formally adopted by the Sangguniang Bayan through a resolution and integrated into the Municipality’s Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP), Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP), and Annual Investment Program (AIP), ensuring that energy efficiency becomes a core component of local governance and planning.

SECTION 9. IMPLEMENTATION MECHANISMS

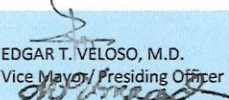
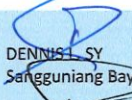
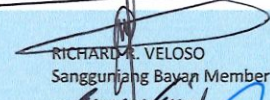
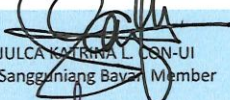
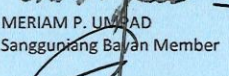
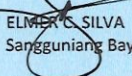
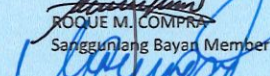
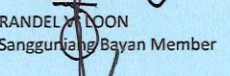
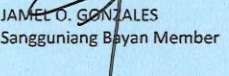
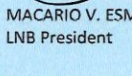
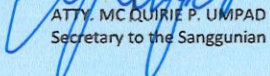
The implementation of the LEECP shall be led by the Municipal Government through a designated Municipal Energy Efficiency and Conservation Committee (MEECC), which shall oversee the execution of programs, ensure compliance among offices, and coordinate with national agencies such as the Department of Energy. Each municipal office shall designate an Energy Efficiency Officer responsible for implementing energy-saving measures within their respective offices.

SECTION 10. ENERGY EFFICIENCY MEASURES

All government offices shall adopt energy efficiency measures, including but not limited to the use of energy-efficient lighting systems, regular maintenance of electrical equipment, adoption of inverter technologies, temperature regulation of air conditioning systems, prudent use and monitoring of fuel consumption and the gradual transition to renewable energy sources such as solar power. Behavioral measures such as switching off unused appliances and maximizing natural lighting shall likewise be strictly enforced.

SECTION 11. ENERGY AUDIT AND REPORTING

All covered government offices shall conduct periodic energy audits and submit annual energy consumption reports to the Municipal Energy Efficiency and Conservation

Committee. The Municipality may seek technical assistance from the Department of Energy or accredited energy auditors to ensure accurate monitoring and compliance.

SECTION 12. CAPACITY BUILDING AND IEC CAMPAIGN

The Municipality shall conduct regular Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaigns to promote awareness on energy efficiency and conservation among municipal employees, barangays, schools, and the general public. Training programs, workshops, and seminars shall be conducted to build local capacity in implementing energy-saving practices.

SECTION 13. INCENTIVES AND RECOGNITION

To encourage compliance, the Municipality shall establish an incentive system, including awards and recognition for offices, barangays, and establishments demonstrating exemplary performance in energy efficiency and conservation practices.

SECTION 14. PROHIBITED ACTS

It shall be unlawful for any covered entity to engage in wasteful energy practices, including but not limited to the unnecessary use of lighting and air conditioning, tampering with energy monitoring devices, and failure to comply with mandated energy-saving measures under this Ordinance.

SECTION 15. MONITORING AND EVALUATION

The Municipal Energy Efficiency and Conservation Committee shall establish a monitoring and evaluation system to assess the effectiveness of the LEECP, including periodic review of targets, performance indicators, and compliance levels. Annual reports shall be submitted to the Sangguniang Bayan.

SECTION 16. FUNDING AND APPROPRIATION

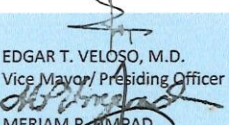
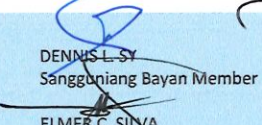
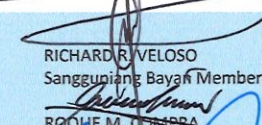
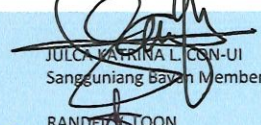
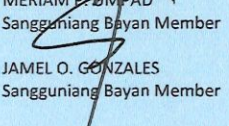
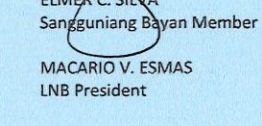
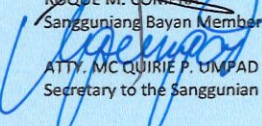
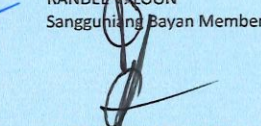
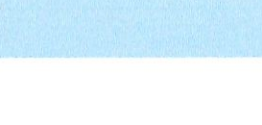
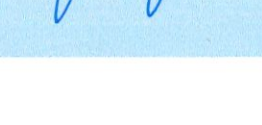
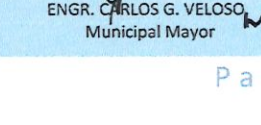
Funds necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be sourced from the Municipal Government’s annual budget, including the 20% Development Fund, and may be supplemented by grants, partnerships, and assistance from national government agencies and private sector entities.

SECTION 17. INTER-AGENCY COORDINATION

The Municipality shall coordinate with the Department of Energy, Department of the Interior and Local Government, and other relevant agencies to ensure technical support, policy alignment, and access to national programs on energy efficiency and conservation.

SECTION 18. PENALTIES

Any violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to administrative sanctions, including warnings, fines, or other penalties as may be determined by the Sangguniang Bayan, without prejudice to the filing of appropriate charges under applicable laws.

SECTION 20. REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, resolutions, and issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 21. EFFECTIVITY

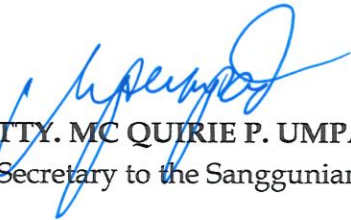
This ordinance shall take effect upon its completion of the publication requirement.

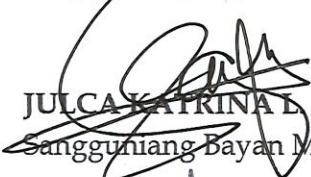

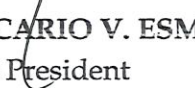

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING CONDUCTED BY THE COMMITTEE ON DISASTER AND RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT ON THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE FORMULATION, ADOPTION, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LOCAL ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION PLAN (LEECP) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLABA, LEYTE, PROVIDING FOR ITS IMPLEMENTING MECHANISMS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

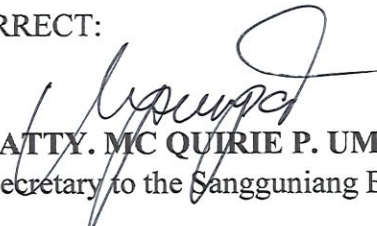
ON MAY 05, 2026 AT MUNICIPAL FUNCTION HALL

The public hearing commenced at exactly 02:25 in the afternoon, with an opening prayer, followed by the singing of the Philippine National Anthem and the Villaba Hymn. The hearing was attended by Jesus P. Juanero, Engineer III; Teddy Vapor, HRMO; Thelma L. Romero, GSO; Cliff Richard O. Omega, Representative from DPWH 3rd District; Member of the concerned committee of the Sangguniang Bayan were also present, in the person of the Hon. Roque M. Compra; Punong Barangays, and School District Representatives.

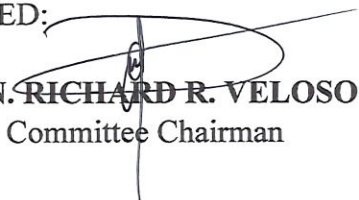
Hon. Roque M. Compra inquired about the LGU's measure when it comes to energy conservation for government vehicles. Mr. Teddy Vapor stated that an Executive Order from the Mayor's Office already restricts the use of government vehicles on holidays, weekends, and now Fridays due to the temporary work schedule. Vehicle use, including trucks, is minimized to conserve fuel. He added that the ordinance aims to make these measures permanent, except for ambulances used for emergencies. He also mentioned that the MDRRM has proposed the adoption of solar energy, including solar panels and backup fuel provisions, as well as the possible procurement of a fuel tank to be included in next year's capital outlay to ensure fuel availability amid rising prices. He further suggested the assignment of technical personnel to maintain the solar systems to ensure proper upkeep and prevent them from becoming non-functional due to lack of maintenance. Ms. Thelma Romero suggested removing unnecessary ground lights to save energy, limiting the use of lighting especially from 5:00–6:00 PM and during break time when there are usually no clients, and setting air conditioning to a maximum of 25°C in compliance with COA guidelines while prioritizing inverter air conditioners. She also recommended minimizing the use of government vehicles for travel, as employees already receive travel allowances, to avoid double expenses. Ronie Lucañas suggested that Section 10 on Energy Efficiency Measures be expanded to include fuel consumption, in addition to electrical energy use, as part of the ordinance.

Without further deliberations, the public hearing adjourned at 03:09 in the afternoon.

SUBJECT:

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE FORMULATION, ADOPTION, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LOCAL ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION PLAN (LEECP) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLABA, LEYTE, PROVIDING FOR ITS IMPLEMENTING MECHANISMS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

FINDINGS

1. The LGU already implements an Executive Order restricting the use of government vehicles on holidays, and weekends to conserve fuel.
2. Vehicle use, including trucks, is minimized, with ambulances exempted for emergencies.
3. There is a proposal to institutionalize these measures through an ordinance for long-term implementation.
4. The MDRRM proposed the adoption of solar energy, backup fuel provisions, and possible procurement of a fuel tank under the next capital outlay.
5. There is a need for technical personnel to maintain solar energy systems.
6. Fuel consumption is proposed to be included in the energy efficiency measures under the ordinance.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Institutionalize the Executive Order into a permanent ordinance on vehicle use and fuel conservation.
2. Strengthen policies on the efficient use and monitoring of government fuel consumption.
3. Allocate technical personnel for the maintenance of solar energy systems.
4. Strictly implement energy-saving practices such as regulated lighting and 25°C air-conditioning.
5. Promote the use of inverter-type appliances in all government offices.
6. Regulate the use of government vehicles for official travel to avoid unnecessary expenses.
7. Provide funding support for renewable energy and fuel storage under the capital outlay.
