The proposed Ordinance seeks to address the lack of proper and standardized signage. Beyond functionality, it recognizes that signage is a powerful tool to express heritage, history, and culture. A simple historical note, a few lines, added to a street name introduces not only who the street was named for, but is also a medium for public education and heritage appreciation.

It also introduces legislation on the naming and designation of street names. Many of our streets remain unnamed, and this poses challenges to navigation and location identification.

Lastly, this proposed Ordinance affirms that Carigara is a historical town with a rich heritage. Markers as signage express this fostering appreciation and awareness, and enhance the experience of visitors and tourists

The implementation of this ordinance represents a significant step toward a more organized, navigable, and culturally vibrant Carigara, benefiting residents, visitors, and all stakeholders.

regulate the use of streets, public spaces, and facilities to ensure public safety, convenience, and the efficient delivery of basic services pursuant to Section 447 (a) (5) (v) thereof, and to prescribe, name, and rename streets and public ways under Section 13(c)(2), within their territorial jurisdiction;


WHEREAS, the Municipality of Carigara, Leyte, recognizes that municipal signage and street names serve not only functional purposes for navigation and safety, but also play an important role in expressing local history, culture, and identity;

WHEREAS, a comprehensive and uniform system of municipal signage enhances wayfinding, road safety, emergency response, and accessibility, and supports the orderly movement of residents, visitors, and service providers within the municipality;

WHEREAS, there are numerous streets, particularly outside the poblacion, without officially designated street names, and existing signage is dilapidated, non-existent, and inconsistent;

WHEREAS, the absence of officially designated street names and standardized signage complicates wayfinding, navigation, public documentation, land administration, mapping, and the accurate identification of locations and properties;

WHEREAS, the adoption of clear policies for the naming of

streets, with the participation of barangays and residents and guided by nationally accepted standards, promotes transparency, heritage appreciation, and community involvement;

WHEREAS, the progressive implementation of street naming should not delay the immediate need for installation and improvement of municipal signage for streets with existing official names, directional and wayfinding purposes, and landmark identification;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN THAT:

SECTION 1. *Title:* This Ordinance shall be known as the “**Municipal Signages Ordinance of Carigara, Leyte**”.

SECTION 2. *Declaration of Policy:* It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Carigara, Leyte, to develop and establish a uniform, visible, accessible, functional, and well-designed system of Municipal Signage to enhance public safety, support efficient navigation throughout the municipality, and facilitate the ease of movement of residents, visitors, and newcomers.

Moreover, the Municipality of Carigara, Leyte shall:

- a. Affirm that Municipal Signage is both a functional public service and a medium for expressing local identity;

- b. Ensure the proper installation, maintenance, and protection of all covered Municipal Signage;
- c. Strictly regulate acts that impair their visibility, integrity, or purpose; and
- d. Facilitate easier referencing in public documentation and land administration;
- e. Commit to improving the quality of Municipal Signage as part of a broader effort to strengthen Carigara as a Heritage Town and the First Established Town of Eastern Visayas, to foster community pride, promote cultural awareness, and enhance the municipality’s appeal as a welcoming and navigable destination.

SECTION 3. Coverage: This Ordinance shall apply to all Municipal Signage in the Municipality. It shall cover officially named streets, as well as streets that may hereafter be established, named, renamed, or recognized by the Municipality, regardless of classification of Municipal or Barangay Road.

This Ordinance shall govern the installation, design, and maintenance of:

- a. Street Name Signs;
- b. Directional and Wayfinding Signage;

- c. Landmark Signage;
- d. Barangay Entrance and Exit Signs at the boundaries of each barangay.

SECTION 4. *Definition of Terms.*

- a. **“Ordinance”** refers to the Municipal Signages Ordinance.
- b. **“Municipal Signage”** refers to all official signs installed, maintained, or authorized by the Municipal Government of Carigara, Leyte, for identification, direction, information, and wayfinding within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality. It includes Street Name Signs, Directional and Wayfinding Signs, Landmark Signages, and Barangay Entrance and Exit Signs, whether permanent or temporary.
- c. **“Street Name Signs”** refer to the official sign installed or authorized by the Municipal Government indicating the name of the street and may include a brief historical, cultural, or heritage information related to the street name.
- d. **“Directional and Wayfinding Signage”** refers to official signage designed to guide the public with specific directional instructions through the municipality by providing orientation, route guidance, and location information through arrows, distances, or route indicators that point to a particular destination, barangay, landmarks, public facilities, and points

- e. **“Landmark Signage”** refers to official Municipal Signage that identifies, marks, or directs attention to public, cultural, historical, or heritage landmarks within the Municipality, including historic and heritage buildings, monuments, parks, plazas, heritage sites, and other points of interest. Landmark signage may include directional information or historical/cultural context to guide residents, visitors, and tourists.
- f. **“Barangay Entrance and Exit Signs”** refer to the official sign marking entry into or exit from a barangay, identifying its name and serving as a boundary, identification, or welcome marker.
- g. **“Legacy Signage”** refers to any signage previously installed before this Ordinance, including those installed by civic groups that are no longer in active use or require repair.

SECTION 5. *Design Standards:* All Municipal Signage covered by this Ordinance shall conform to Philippine National Engineering standards as prescribed in the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Road Safety Design Manual and the Road Signs and Pavement Markings Manual:

- Signages shall be reflectorized for visibility during night and

adverse weather conditions.

- They shall be installed at the proper height, oriented towards approaching traffic, and employ legible lettering.
- Signage shall use material of low resale value to prevent theft and unauthorized removal.

The Municipal Engineering Office, in consultation with the relevant national government agencies, may approve minor enhancements to design, size, or orientation as necessary, provided that the minimum standards established are observed.

Moreover, the design standard shall follow applicable accessibility laws as mandated by the 2024 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of the amendments to BP 344.

SECTION 6. *Municipal Identity and Branding:* Municipal Signage covered by this Ordinance shall incorporate elements that reflect the municipality's identity through the use of its official colors, where practicable and without compromising legibility, safety, or compliance with design standards.

The use of symbols, icons, and pictograms shall be representative of the municipality's landmarks, history, and heritage.

SECTION 7. *Installation and Maintenance:* The installation and

maintenance of Municipal Signage, specifically street names, directional and wayfinding signage, and landmark signage, shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Engineering Office (MEO), in coordination with the Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO).

The maintenance shall include repairing or replacing damaged, deteriorated, or missing signs within a reasonable period as determined by the MEO and ensuring continued compliance with the minimum design standards.

SECTION 8. *Legacy and Historical Signage:* Signage previously installed by civic groups is hereby considered legacy signage. Legacy signage of historical or heritage significance may be transferred to the municipal museum or archives, and others shall be properly disposed of in accordance with environmental and municipal waste regulations. Barangays shall assist the MEO in locating old or obstructed signs, but responsibility for removal, disposal, or storage rests solely with the Municipality.

SECTION 9. *Clearing of Obstruction:* The trimming or removal of vegetation or natural growth, such as trees, vines, and branches, that impede the visibility of the Municipal Signage shall be the responsibility of the respective barangay where the signage is located.

SECTION 10. *Street Name Sign Historic and Heritage Detail:*

Existing Street Names within the Municipality shall, in addition to displaying the street name, incorporate a brief historical, cultural, or heritage detail, when applicable, promoting local heritage, history, and identity. The Municipal Planning and Development Office, in coordination with the Carigara Council on Culture and the Arts, shall prepare and verify the historic and heritage details to be included in the street name, and, if necessary, propose corrections.

The format shall be as follows:

- First Line shall display the Street Name.
- Secondary Line shall contain concise historical or heritage information.

Illustrative Examples:

Rebolledo Street

Alberto T. Aguja Street

Congressman (Jan. 27, 1958 - Dec. 13, 1961)

SECTION 11. *Naming and Designation of Streets:* Street names may be proposed either by the respective Sanggunian, depending on the classification of the road, either a barangay or municipal road, or directly by any Kalgaranon to the Sangguniang Bayan.

The MPDO, in coordination with the MEO, shall identify the unnamed roads. The concerned Sanggunian shall then propose and recommend street names after consultation with residents of the affected street or area and taking into consideration the donor of the land, local history, tradition, and commonly used or recognized street names.

All proposed street names shall be coordinated with the appropriate barangay and/or the Carigara Council on Culture and the Arts (CCCA) to ensure that the names are historically, culturally, and morally appropriate.

In designating street names, the following shall be given priority:

- The traditional or commonly used name of the street as recognized by the local community, if such a name exists;
- The person who donated land for the establishment of the street;

- Historic events, places, or persons who have significantly contributed to the development of the barangay or the Municipality, including former municipal officials and barangay officials;
- Names reflective of the cultural heritage, geography, or identity of the locality.

Provided, that priority consideration given to donors shall not automatically entitle any person to have a street named after them. All proposed names shall be evaluated based on historical significance, moral standing, suitability, and consistency with applicable laws and nationally accepted standards, including the Guidelines on Naming and Renaming issued by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines.

Provided further, that the designation of a street name shall not be construed as conferring ownership, vested rights, honorific entitlement, or proprietary interest in favor of any person, family, or entity.

All proposed street names are subject to approval through ordinance by the Sangguniang Bayan. The National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) may be consulted for guidance as appropriate.

All approved names shall be integrated into the Municipal Road Map

SECTION 12. *Municipal Landmark Signages:* There shall be municipal landmark signages or markers that identify, mark, or direct attention to public, cultural, historical, or heritage landmarks within the Municipality, including the Municipal Hall, Legislative Hall, Municipal Museum, and Town Plaza, and built heritage and heritage sites declared as local cultural property, including buildings and sites that may be officially designated by the Municipality. Each landmark signage shall display a brief historical, cultural, or heritage detail, when applicable, to promote awareness of the landmark's significance.

The installation, maintenance, and repair of these signages shall be the responsibility of the Municipality through the MEO, in coordination with the MPDO and the Carigara Council on Culture and the Arts. Barangays may assist in monitoring the visibility of these signages within their jurisdiction.

SECTION 13. *Barangay Entry and Exit Signage:* Barangays, in coordination with their Sangguniang Kabataan (SK), shall be responsible for the installation and upkeep of welcome or entry signs and exit signs at the boundaries of their respective barangays.

All installations shall conform to the approved minimum design standards established by the Municipality.

SECTION 14. *Funding:* The Municipality shall fund the installation, maintenance, and replacement of Municipal Signage, namely existing and future Street Name Signs, Directional and Wayfinding Signs, and Landmark Signage. To ensure the effective implementation of this Ordinance, an initial amount of Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P500,000.00) shall be sourced from the General Fund and shall be included in the subsequent annual or supplemental budget of the Municipality.

Barangays, in coordination with the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) shall fund the installation and upkeep of their respective Barangay Entry and Exit Signage within their jurisdiction and shall be sourced from the SK's own fund.

SECTION 15. *Prohibited Acts:* The following acts are hereby declared prohibited:

- **Unauthorized Installation or Alteration:** The installation, modification, relocation, or removal of any Municipal Signage covered by this Ordinance without prior approval of the Municipal Government.

- **Defacement or Damage:** Any act to deface, vandalize, destroy, or otherwise damage any Municipal Signage or any part thereof.
- **Obstruction of Visibility:** Knowingly place, allow, or maintain any structure, object, stickers, posters, advertisement, or the growing of any vegetation that obstructs the visibility or legibility of Municipal Signage.
- **Political or Commercial Purpose:** Any act to use any Municipal Signage for a political campaign, commercial advertising, private promotion, or any purpose other than intended by this Ordinance.
- **Neglect of Maintenance:** Failure of responsible offices, barangays, municipal departments, or personnel to repair, replace, or maintain damaged, faded, illegible, or missing signage within their respective responsibilities under this Ordinance, within a reasonable period after due notice or official report.

SECTION 16. Penalties: Violations of this Ordinance shall be subject to the following penalties.

First Offense: A written warning and a fine of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 1,500.00).

Second Offense: A fine of Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000.00) or an imprisonment of One (1) month, but not more than Three (3) months, or both, at the discretion of the court.

Third Offense: A fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00) or an imprisonment of Three (3) months, but not more than Six (6) months, or both, at the discretion of the court

Fourth and Subsequent Offenses: The maximum allowable fine, plus the cost of repair or replacement of any damaged or altered signage.

SECTION 17. *Implementation Clause.* Provisions of this Ordinance, such as the naming of unnamed streets, shall be carried out progressively and must not deter the full implementation of this Ordinance upon effectivity.

SECTION 18. *Separability Clause:* Should any portion of this Ordinance be found unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of proper jurisdiction, all remaining provisions shall remain in effect and shall not be affected by the ruling on the invalid section.

SECTION 19. *Repealing Clause:* All ordinances, rules, and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

32 **IV. PRESENTATION OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE:**

33 The author of the Ordinance Hon. Myla L. Aguilar presented the key provisions of the
34 proposed ordinance. As our municipality continues to grow and develop, there is a need for a
35 standardized and organized system of street signs, directional markers, and public information
36 signs. At present, variations in signage design, placement, and naming conventions may cause

1 confusion among residents, visitors, emergency responders, delivery services, and government
2 agencies.

3 This ordinance seeks to establish a uniform municipal signage system that promotes
4 order, accessibility, public safety, and the effective delivery of services.
5 Specifically, this ordinance aims to: Establish a comprehensive and uniform design for
6 municipal signs throughout Carigara; Ensure proper installation and maintenance of all official
7 municipal signage; Provide clear guidelines and standards for naming and renaming streets;
8 Enhance navigation, emergency response, tourism, and local governance; Preserve local
9 heritage and identity through appropriate street naming policies.

10 A systematic process shall be established for naming new streets and renaming existing
11 ones, ensuring consultation with concerned stakeholders and compliance with applicable laws
12 and regulations. Street names may recognize significant historical events, geographical
13 features, local culture, or distinguished individuals who have contributed to the municipality.
14 Unauthorized installation, alteration, removal, or vandalism of official signs shall be prohibited
15 and subject to appropriate penalties. All official municipal street signs, directional signs, and
16 informational signs shall follow standardized specifications regarding size, color, lettering,
17 materials, and placement.

18

19 V. OPEN FORUM/PUBLIC COMMENTS:

20 The public and other stakeholders were invited to express their views and suggestions.

21 The floor was opened for comments, suggestions, and recommendations from
22 stakeholders, barangay officials, and other attendees.

23

24 MR. EMILIANO JUSTIMBASTE, Local Historian

25 He underscored that signages tell stories and brings history into everyday life, reflecting
26 the depth, memory and pride of the town- a heritage worth preserving and sharing.




