¹ (a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:
(1) Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government, and in this connection shall:
(ix) Authorize the payment of compensation to a qualified person not in the government service who fills up a temporary vacancy or grant honorarium to any qualified official or employee designated to fill a temporary vacancy in a concurrent capacity, at the rate authorized by law;

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF TANAUAN, LEYTE IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every Local Government Unit shall exercise powers necessary and appropriate for effective governance and those essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the Barangays serve as the primary implementing arm of the Local Government Unit in the delivery of basic services and facilities at the grassroots level;

WHEREAS, Barangay Volunteers act as frontline partners of the government in delivering essential community services in public health, nutrition, peace and order, mediation and dispute resolution, violence prevention, disaster response, and social protection;

WHEREAS, these volunteers include but are not limited to Barangay Health Workers (BHWs), Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS), Barangay Tanods or Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPAT), Barangay Service Point Officers (BSPOs), Barangay Daycare Workers and members of the Lupong Tagapamayapa, who continuously render time, effort, and community service without regular compensation;

WHEREAS, they perform vital functions such as community health monitoring, nutrition program implementation, law enforcement support, assistance to victims of violence, conflict mediation, maintenance of peace and order, and other barangay-mandated responsibilities;

WHEREAS, it is proper for the Local Government Unit and the Barangays to recognize and support the dedication and continuous voluntary services of these Barangay Volunteers through the authorization of a cash gift as an incentive and recognition for actual services rendered, without creating an employer-employee relationship;

WHEREAS, barangays have the authority to allocate portions of their respective budgets for programs, projects, services, and activities that promote the general welfare and recognize the contributions of community volunteers, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations;

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE : This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Barangay Volunteers Recognition and Incentives Program of Tanauan, Leyte.**"

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY

The Municipality of Tanauan affirms its commitment to strengthening grassroots governance by recognizing the crucial role of barangay volunteers in advancing public service delivery in public health, nutrition, early childhood care and development, peace and order, mediation and dispute resolution, social protection, and disaster risk reduction and management.

Pursuant to the General Welfare Clause under Republic Act No. 7160, this Ordinance institutionalizes the grant of cash incentives as a mechanism to acknowledge actual services rendered, enhance morale, and encourage sustained volunteerism, without creating an employer-employee relationship.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS

For purposes of this Ordinance:

a. Barangay Volunteers – refer to accredited community-based workers officially recognized by the Barangay Government who render services without regular salary, including but not limited to:

1. Barangay Health Workers (BHWs)
2. Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS)
3. Barangay Tanods / BPAT Members
4. Barangay Service Point Officers (BSPOs)
5. Members of the Lupong Tagapamayapa
6. Barangay Daycare Workers / Child Development Workers
7. Other duly recognized volunteer workers performing barangay-mandated functions

b. Active Volunteer – a barangay volunteer who actually performs assigned duties and participates in barangay activities, meetings, programs, patrols, mediations, classes, sessions, or official functions.

c. Cash Gift / Incentive – a non-salary financial recognition granted for services rendered, not wage, honorarium, allowance, or compensation and shall not establish employer-employee relationship.

SECTION 4. AUTHORITY TO GRANT CASH GIFT

All Barangays in the Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte are hereby authorized to grant a cash gift to qualified Barangay Volunteers subject to availability of funds and compliance with budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules.

SECTION 5. PURPOSE

The cash gift is intended as recognition and appreciation for essential and continuous services rendered by barangay volunteers in promoting community welfare, including health services, nutrition programs, daycare and child development services, peacekeeping, mediation, social protection, and disaster response.

SECTION 6. COVERAGE AND ELIGIBILITY

A. To qualify for the cash gift, the recipient must:

1. Be a duly accredited Barangay Volunteer included in the official barangay master list;
2. Be certified by the Punong Barangay as an Active Volunteer;
3. Have rendered actual service within the calendar year;

B. Covered volunteers include:

1. Barangay Health Workers (BHWs)
2. Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS)
3. Barangay Tanods / BPAT
4. Barangay Service Point Officers (BSPOs)
5. Members of the Lupong Tagapamayapa
6. Barangay Daycare Workers / Child Development Workers
7. Other officially designated barangay volunteer workers

SECTION 7. FUNDING SOURCE

The cash gift shall be charged solely to the Barangay Budget of each barangay, subject to the availability of funds and compliance with existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.

The amount and schedule of grant may be provided annually or as determined feasible in the barangay appropriations.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTATION

The Barangay Government through the Punong Barangay and the Barangay Treasurer shall implement this Ordinance, including:

- a. Preparation of the official masterlist of qualified volunteers;
- b. Certification of eligibility; and
- c. Disbursement of funds.

A master list of qualified volunteers with certification shall be maintained for auditing purposes.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

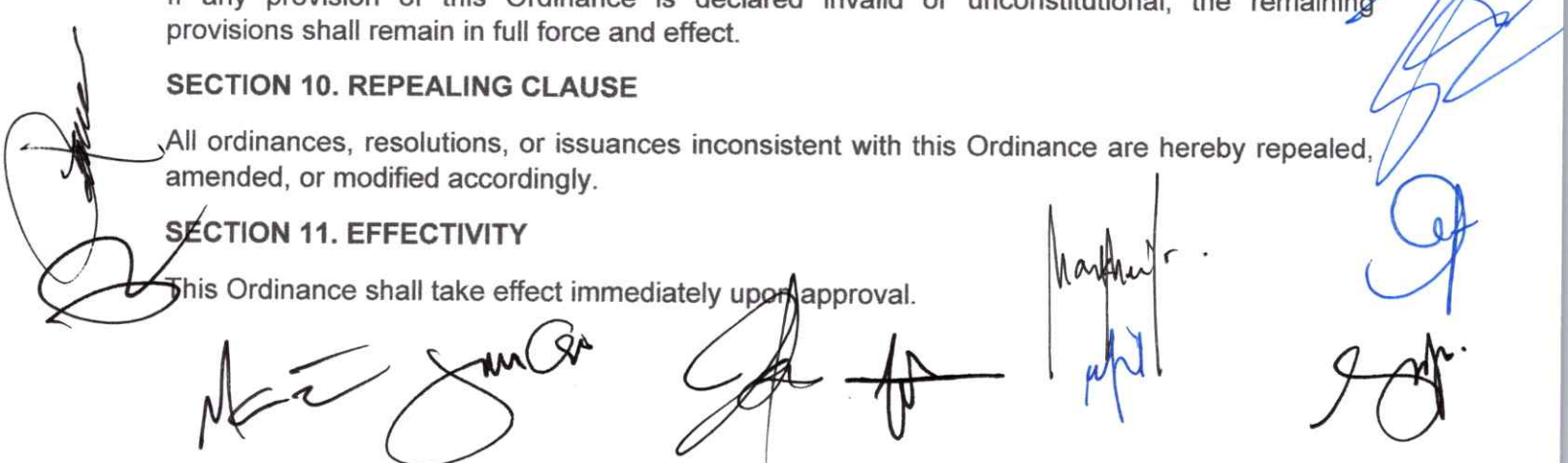
If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, resolutions, or issuances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.

39 **C. PRESENTATION OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCES AND OPEN FORUM**

40
41 Hon. Octa presented the provisions of his proposed ordinances, emphasizing the rationale
42 and legal basis of the said proposed measures against HIV/AIDs which he emphasized delves
43 only on the information and education campaign in the communities.

44
45 After the presentation of the said ordinance, the Chairman of Brgy. Camire contended that
46 the provision on confidentiality should not be indicated in the ordinance and that that they
47 should be able to get the information as to who are affected so that they will know how to
48 avoid the spread of the said decease in their respective barangays should there be someone
49 from their barangay. The author then emphasized that the confidentiality provisions is
50 strictly incorporated in the ordinance as it is also the mandate of the national law
51 particularly RA No. 8504. Also, Barangay Kagawad from Brgy. San Miguel inquired whether
52 they can at least get the data or the specific number of HIV patients in their barangay to

The Chairman of Brgy. Pago suggested to include the appropriation or funding clause in the ordinance considering that the barangay cannot decide on the budget of the Sangguniang Kabataan, to which the author has taken notice of considering that the target of information and education campaign is on the youth.

Having no further question on the first proposed Ordinance, Hon. Octa then proceeded with his second proposed Ordinance.

After thoroughly presenting the provisions thereof and explaining the purpose of the said ordinance, no questions nor suggestions were raised.

Afterwards, Hon. Morabe presented the provisions of her proposed ordinance on granting cash gifts to Barangay Tanods and BHWs. She also explained that the amount of Php3,000.00 will not be indicated in the ordinance as it will depend on the available fund of the concerned barangays. She added that the ordinance aims to include not only the tanods and BHWs but also the other volunteer workers such as the Day Care Workers, Barangay Nutrition Scholar (BNS) and the BSPO.

The Chairman of Barangay Pago stated that there is no need for the Sangguniang Bayan to pass the said Ordinance since the concerned barangay can just pass their own barangay Ordinance if they have funds.

It was explained however that the passage of the SB Ordinance was upon the advise of the Municipal Accountant when Barangay Buntay first introduce such idea of granting cash gifts to their volunteer workers. Hon. Dandan of Barangay Pago then insisted that they can just pass their own ordinance in that way the other barangays who cannot afford to grant cash gifts to their volunteer workers will not be pressured. Hon. Dandan was further informed that the grant contemplated in the proposed ordinance is not a mandatory benefit that the barangay can just provide to the volunteer workers.

As emphasized by the author, the basis of her proposed ordinance is the general welfare clause of the Local Government Code, in such case, there needs to have an enabling law or ordinance for the disbursement of such public funds to be given as cash gifts to volunteer workers, the reason why the Municipal Accountant advised Barangay Buntay to lobby to the Sangguniang Bayan to pass the said proposed Ordinance.

The audience also inquired if the LGU can provide a counterpart to the barangays for the grat of the said cash gifts, to which the author stated that she will verify with the Local Finance if the same can be possible.

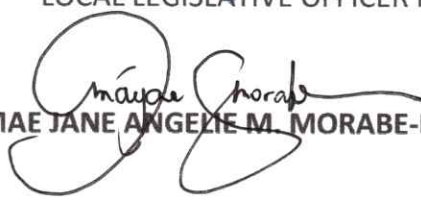
There having no more matters to be discussed, the public hearing was adjourned at 12:10 in the afternoon.
