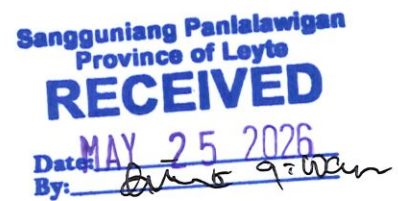

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 476-080523, otherwise known as the "2023
Revenue Code of the Municipality of Palompon," was enacted to establish a
comprehensive system of revenue generation and regulatory measures within the
municipality;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangays of Barangays Parilla and San Guillermo, Municipality of Palompon, Leyte, through Joint Barangay Resolution No. 02, Series of 2026, respectfully requested the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of Palompon to expand and amend the Palompon-Cambinoy-Rizal-Taberna motorized tricycle route to include Barangays San Guillermo and Parilla in order to improve transportation accessibility and mobility of their constituents;

WHEREAS, residents of the affected barangays regularly travel to the town proper and neighboring communities for employment, education, health services, commerce, and other essential activities, thereby necessitating improved and adequate public transportation services;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan recognizes the need to amend the number of authorized units operating along the Palompon-Cantandoy-Rizal-Taberna route to respond to increasing transportation demand and to promote convenience, accessibility, and economic activity within the municipality;

WHEREAS, Article XL, Section 160 (3) of the same Revenue Code provides the rates for water services, including bulk water sales supplied by the municipal water system;

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary to change the rate of bulk water sales per cubic meter, particularly for cargo/passenger vessel's water supply and other large-volume consumers, in order to ensure that the charges remain fair and commensurate with operational and maintenance costs of the municipal water system;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Palompon, Leyte, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Amendment of Article XV, Section 66 (b), paragraph 8 (e).

Article XV, Section 66 (b), paragraph 8 (e) of Municipal Ordinance No. 476-080523, otherwise known as the "2023 Revenue Code of the Municipality of Palompon," is hereby amended to change the number of units allocated to the Palompon-Cantandoy-Rizal-Taberna route, which shall now read as follows:

- e. Palompon-Cantandoy-Rizal-Taberna route = 40 units

SECTION 2. Amendment of Article XL, Section 160 (3).

Article XL, Section 160 (3) of the same ordinance is hereby amended by changing the rate for bulk water sales per cubic meter, particularly applicable to vessels and other bulk consumers purchasing water from the municipal water system.

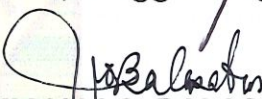

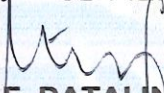

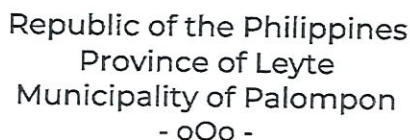

SUBJECT : REPORT RECOMMENDING FOR ADOPTION AND APPROVAL OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 476-080523, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "2023 REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALOMPON," PARTICULARLY ARTICLE XV, SECTION 66 (b), PARAGRAPH 8 (e), BY AMENDING THE NUMBER OF UNITS ALLOCATED TO THE PALOMPON-CANTANDROY-RIZAL-TABERNA ROUTE, AND ARTICLE XL, SECTION 160 (3), BY CHANGING THE RATE OF BULK SALES PER CUBIC METER."

Referred to this committee was Municipal Ordinance entitled, "An ordinance amending certain provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 476-080523, otherwise known as the "2023 Revenue Code of the Municipality of Palompon," particularly article XV, section 66 (b)(8)(e), by amending the number of units allocated to the Palompon-Cantandoy-Rizal-Taberna Route, and article XL, section 160 (3), by changing the rate of bulk sales per cubic meter."

The Committee conducted a committee hearing on March 2, 2026, to deliberate on the proposed ordinance and to gather inputs, comments, and clarifications from concerned offices regarding the proposed amendments. During the deliberation, the Committee carefully examined the necessity of increasing the number of units allocated to the Palompon–Cantandoy–Rizal–Taberna route in order to respond to the growing demand for transportation services along the said route and to ensure adequate and efficient mobility for commuters.

Likewise, the Committee also reviewed the proposed adjustment of water rates under article XL, Section 160 (3) of the Revenue Code. The adjustment is intended to ensure that bulk users are charged appropriately based on the volume of water consumed, while also generating additional revenue to support the operation, maintenance, and sustainability of the municipal water system.

Subsequently, a Public Hearing was conducted on March 3, 2026 on the abovementioned ordinance, presided over by Hon. Javes Keith R. de la Calzada, Municipal Vice Mayor and the Overall Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan, in coordination with the Committee on Public Works and Utilization and other Committees. The intent, implications, and necessity in enhancing the revenue measures and transportation allocation was clearly presented by Sangguniang



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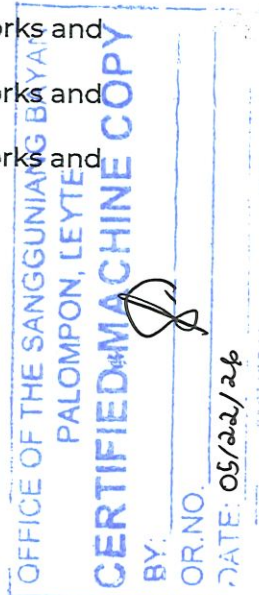

A Committee Hearing of the Committee on Public Works and Utilization was conducted on March 2, 2026, at the Sangguniang Bayan Session Hall of this Municipality, presided over by Sangguniang Bayan Member Leonardo C. Quiamco, Jr., Chairman of the Committee on Public Works and Utilization in coordination with concerned municipal offices, for the purpose of deliberating on the proposed ordinance amending certain provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 476-080523, otherwise known as the "2023 Revenue Code of the Municipality of Palompon."

During the deliberation, Sangguniang Bayan Member Leonardo C. Quiamco, Jr., Chairman of the Committee on Public Works and Utilization, explained the necessity of expanding the Palompon-Cantandoy-Rizal-Taberna (PCRT) route to include Barangays San Guillermo and Parilla. He stated that the road network connecting the said barangays is now fully passable and accessible to motorized tricycles, thereby making the expansion of the route feasible and responsive to the transportation needs of residents. He further emphasized that the inclusion of the said barangays would improve mobility, provide convenient access to the town proper, and support economic activities within the affected communities.

After discussion and evaluation of the transportation requirements, the Committee agreed to amend the number of authorized units operating along the PCRT route by adding five (5) additional units, thereby increasing the total allocation from thirty-five (35) units to forty (40) units, subject to the approval of the Sangguniang Bayan.

The Committee likewise deliberated on the proposed adjustment of water rates under Article XL, Section 160 (3) of the Revenue Code, specifically concerning bulk water sales. The Presiding Officer explained that the current rate of Forty-Five Pesos (₱45.00) per cubic meter is no longer sufficient to sustain operational and maintenance expenses of the municipal water system, particularly for cargo/ passenger vessels water supply and other high-volume consumers.

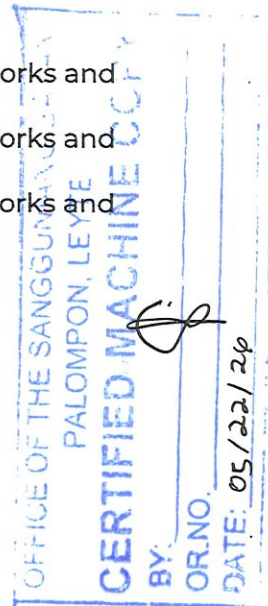

With the presence of thirty (30) punong barangays, concerned municipal offices and other stakeholders, the public hearing on the proposed ordinance was called to order at exactly 1:34 P.M. and commenced with an opening prayer led by Mr. Dario P. Raymundo.

The hearing was presided over by Hon. Javes Keith R. de la Calzada, Municipal Vice Mayor and the Overall Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan, in coordination with the Committee on Public Works and Utilization.

The Municipal Vice Mayor de la Calzada, opened the public hearing by expressing his sincere appreciation to all participants for taking the time to attend and actively participate in the deliberation of the proposed measure. He then presented a brief summary of the subject matter to be discussed, particularly the proposed amendments to certain provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 476-080523, otherwise known as the "2023 Revenue Code of the Municipality of Palompon." He explained that the proposed amendments include the increase in the number of units allocated to the Palompon-Cantandoy-Rizal-Taberna route under Section 66 – Administrative Provisions (b)(8)(e) in order to address the growing demand for transportation services along the said route and to improve accessibility and convenience for commuters.

He also explained the proposed adjustment of water rates under Section 160 (3) of the Revenue Code, clarifying that the amendment applies only to bulk water sales, particularly to vessels and other large-volume consumers purchasing water from the municipal water system. The adjustment aims to ensure that bulk users are charged appropriately based on the volume of water consumed and to support the sustainability, operation, and maintenance of the municipal water system.

Subsequently, SB Member Leonardo C. Quiamco, Jr., Chairman of the Committee on Public Works and Utilization, further elaborated on the proposed amendments and presented the justification and supporting details of the ordinance. He likewise presented to the body Joint Barangay Resolution No. 02, Series of 2026, jointly adopted by Barangays
