ORDINANCE NO. 10, SERIES OF 2026

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND REGULATING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A FIESTA BARBECUE FOOD PLAZA, WITH CONTROLLED SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, DURING THE CONDUCT OF FIESTA ACTIVITIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DAGAMI, LEYTE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Dagami, Province of Leyte, celebrates its annual town fiesta through a series of socio-cultural, religious, and community activities from April 1 to May 30, 2026 and every year thereafter during the same period, aimed at promoting cultural heritage, tourism, and local economic development;

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Fiesta Barbecue Food Plaza provides livelihood opportunities to local vendors, supports micro and small enterprises, and enhances community participation and public enjoyment;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Department of the Interior and Local Government to ensure the maintenance of peace and order, public safety, and discipline in public places, including the regulation of activities involving the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, local government units are vested with police power to enact measures necessary to promote the general welfare, including the regulation of businesses, public gatherings, and the use of public spaces;

SECTION 9. REGULATION OF LIQUOR AND BEER

- a. Sale of alcoholic beverages shall be allowed only within the designated Barbecue Food Plaza area;
- b. Only duly permitted vendors may sell alcoholic beverages;
- c. No sale or serving of alcohol to minors;
- d. No sale beyond authorized operating hours;
- e. Alcoholic beverages shall not be brought outside the designated premises;
- f. Drunken, disorderly, or disruptive behavior is strictly prohibited;
- g. The Municipal Government, with assistance from the Philippine National Police, may immediately stop or confiscate alcoholic beverages in case of violations.

SECTION 10. PEACE AND ORDER

- a. Adequate security personnel shall be deployed;
- b. Coordination with PNP, MDRRMO, DATU and other agencies is required;
- c. Illegal gambling and unlawful activities are strictly prohibited.

SECTION 11. FIRE SAFETY

All vendors shall comply with fire safety regulations and coordinate with the Bureau of Fire Protection.

SECTION 12. PROHIBITIONS

The following are strictly prohibited:

- a. Selling alcohol to minors;
- b. Operating beyond allowed hours;
- c. Obstruction of roads and public pathways;
- d. Engaging in illegal gambling or unlawful acts;
- e. Failure to comply with sanitation and safety standards.

SECTION 13. PENALTIES

Any violation of this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

First Offense:

- * Fine of ₱1,000.00

Second Offense and Every Subsequent Offense:

- * Fine of ₱2,000.00; and
- * Suspension of operation for one (1) day

SECTION 14. ENFORCEMENT

The Office of the Municipal Mayor, in coordination with the Philippine National Police, Municipal Health Office, Bureau of Fire Protection, and MDRRMO, DATU shall enforce this Ordinance.

SECTION 15. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, other provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY

This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance with posting/publication requirements.

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the operation of a Barbecue Food Plaza, including the controlled sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages, to ensure compliance with existing laws, protect public health, maintain sanitation, and preserve peace and order;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Dagami recognizes the importance of balancing economic activity and public safety by imposing reasonable regulations, operating hours, and enforcement mechanisms during the conduct of fiesta activities;

SECTION 1. TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Dagami Fiesta Barbecue Food Plaza Ordinance of 2026."

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

This Ordinance is enacted to:

- a. Promote local entrepreneurship and tourism;
- b. Provide regulated space for food vendors during fiesta activities;
- c. Ensure public safety, sanitation, and order;
- d. Regulate the limited sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages consistent with national policies.

SECTION 3. LEGAL BASIS

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the general welfare clause of Republic Act No. 7160 and in line with policies of the Department of the Interior and Local Government regulating public order and safety.

SECTION 4. COVERAGE AND DURATION

This Ordinance shall apply during the conduct of fiesta-related activities from April 1 to May 30, 2026, and every year thereafter during the same period, unless otherwise modified, amended, or repealed by subsequent ordinance.

SECTION 5. LOCATION

The Barbecue Food Plaza shall be established at the designated area within the Municipal Premises, specifically at the Rizal Plaza as may be determined and approved by the Office of the Municipal Mayor.

All application for permits related to participation and operation within the Barbecue Food Plaza shall be subject to the approval or denial of the Office of the Municipal Mayor in accordance with existing laws, ordinances, and regulations.

SECTION 6. OPERATING HOURS

The Barbecue Food Plaza shall operate strictly from:
- 4:00 PM to 12:00 MIDNIGHT daily


SECTION 7. PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

All vendors/operators shall secure:


- a. Mayor's Permit /Special Permit;
- b. Health Card/Sanitary Permit;
- c. other clearances as may be required by the Municipal Government.


SECTION 8. FOOD SAFETY AND SANITATION


- a. Strict compliance with food safety and hygiene standards;
- b. Mandatory waste segregation and daily clean-up;
- c. Regular inspection by the Municipal Health Office.






