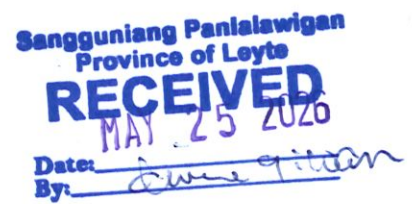

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 513-211025, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICE FEES ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALOMPON, LEYTE," PARTICULARLY SECTIONS 5 AND 6 THEREOF, BY REVISING, RESTRUCTURING, AND PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS THEREIN

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Palompon is mandated under Republic Act No. 7160 and Republic Act No. 9003 to ensure effective and sustainable solid waste management services;

WHEREAS, there is a need to strengthen regulatory mechanisms and clarify payment systems for waste collection and disposal services to ensure environmental protection and operational sustainability;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan finds it necessary to amend certain provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 513-211025 to improve implementation and administration thereof;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Members of Sangguniang Bayan of Palompon, Leyte, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as an Ordinance amending certain provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 513-211025, Otherwise Known as the 'Solid Waste Management Service Fees Ordinance of the Municipality of Palompon, Leyte.'"

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 5 – GARBAGE FEES AND CHARGES

Section 5 of Municipal Ordinance No. 513-211025 is hereby amended by revising Subsection 2 (j) and Subsection 3 (a) to read as follows:

j. Special Collection Services

- I. Special Collection within the Municipality
A separate waste collection activity conducted outside the regular collection schedule established and regulated by the Municipal Environment and Eco-Tourism Office (MEETO). This service may be requested for bulky waste, yard waste, construction debris, special wastes, or sanitary-related waste requiring immediate or additional collection.

The following Service fees shall apply:

- i. Trucks or Dump trucks (Elf, Canter, Forward) - A service fee of One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00) per request.
- ii. Tricycle Garbage Compactors - A service fee of Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00) per request.

II. Enhanced Collection Service for High-Waste Generators

Food establishments, restaurants, eateries, hotels, boarding houses, markets, and other similar high-waste generating establishments that require daily or additional waste collection beyond the regular municipal schedule for sanitary and public health considerations may formally request enrollment in a Enhanced Collection Service for High-Waste Generators.

Establishments approved under this program shall be charged a service fee of:

- One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 1,500.00) per month, for daily or regularly scheduled additional pickup, as coordinated with and regulated by MEETO.

Enrollment in this program shall not exempt the establishment from compliance with segregation-at-source, proper storage, and other requirements under this Ordinance and existing Solid Waste Management regulations.

III. Payment and Regulation

All special collection fees shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer's Office, and an official receipt shall be issued accordingly. MEETO shall regulate scheduling, routes, and operational feasibility to ensure efficiency and sustainability of services.

3. Fees and Charges for external solid wastes generated outside the territorial jurisdiction of Palompon.

a. Acceptance Fee

Acceptance Fee shall be imposed for the privilege of receiving and authorizing the disposal of solid waste generated outside the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Palompon.

i. The Acceptance Fee shall be:

Sixty Centavos (Php 0.60) per kilogram, computed against the declared estimated quantity of waste to be delivered by the generator or authorized transporter per year.

ii. Annual Quantity Limitation

The total allowable quantity for acceptance of external solid waste shall not exceed the available allowable capacity of the Municipal Sanitary Landfill (SLF) for the applicable calendar year, as determined by the Municipality based on operational, environmental, and engineering assessments.

Such allowable capacity shall be subject to allocation and approval by the Municipality and may be adjusted when necessary to protect landfill lifespan, environmental compliance, and public welfare.

No Contract shall be approved unless the annual allowable quantity has been fully allocated.

iii. Excess Deliveries Against the Approved Annual Waste Allocation

In the event that actual deliveries exceed the annual waste quantity approved under the Contract:

1. Acceptance of the excess deliveries shall be subjected to the available annual capacity of the Municipality's SLF.
2. Acceptance of the excess delivery is subjected to written authorization from the Municipality.

3. The Excess Quantity shall be charged at the rate of 1.20 Peso per Kilogram of the excess quantity delivered.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT AND RESTRUCTURING OF SECTION 6

Section 6 of the same Ordinance is hereby AMENDED and RESTRUCTURED, which shall now be divided into Section 6A and Section 6B, to read as follows:

SECTION 6A. CONTRACT REQUIREMENT FOR EXTERNAL WASTE

No external solid waste generated outside the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Palompon shall be accepted, transported, unloaded, or disposed of within the Municipality without a duly executed Contract between the Municipality and the generator or its authorized transporter.

1. The Contract shall specify, among others:

- a. Approved annual waste allocation
- b. Approved waste classification
- c. Applicable Acceptance Fee and Tipping Fee
- d. Payment terms and deadlines
- e. Installment terms
- f. Delivery schedule
- g. Excess delivery conditions
- h. Grounds for suspension or revocation
- i. Reporting and record requirements
- j. Term and renewal provisions

The Contract shall be valid for one (1) calendar year and shall be subject to renewal.

For renewal applications, the declared estimated quantity shall be reasonably based on the actual delivery data of the immediately preceding year, subject to approval by the Municipality.

2. Grounds for Suspension and Revocation

- a. Non-payment of required fees.
- b. Unauthorized excess delivery.
- c. Delivery of unapproved waste types.
- d. Violation of environmental or operational regulations.

Revocation shall be imposed only after due notice and opportunity to be heard, except in cases involving urgent environmental or public health risk where preventive suspension may be immediately imposed.

1. The fees prescribed in this ordinance shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer or an authorized representative who shall collect the said fee on or before the 10th day of every month or during the application for new or renewal of permits for the transport services.

2. Failure to pay collection fees within the prescribed period shall subject the violator to a surcharge of 25% of the unpaid amount and possible revocation of business permits for establishments depending on the gravity of the violation.

3. Non-payment for three (3) consecutive months shall authorize the Municipal Treasurer's Office, as applicable, to endorse the matter for enforcement, which may include revocation of business permits for establishments.

For external waste generators outside the jurisdiction of the Municipality:

1. Acceptance Fees

External waste generators shall pay the prescribed Acceptance Fee on a yearly basis, corresponding to the declared estimated quantity approved under the Contract.

a. Full Payment Option - The Acceptance Fee shall be paid in full on or before January 31 of the applicable calendar year, or prior to the first delivery of waste, whichever comes first.

b. Installment Payment Option - Installment payment may be allowed, subject to stipulation in the Contract, under the following conditions:

i. At least fifty percent (50%) of the total Acceptance Fee shall be paid on or before January 31 of the applicable year.

ii. The remaining balance shall be paid in full on or before April 30 of the same year.

iii. Delivery of external waste shall be limited only to the equivalent quantity covered by the amount already paid.

iv. Failure to pay the remaining balance within the prescribed period shall automatically suspend the authority to deliver waste without need of prior notice.

A. First (Q1), Second (Q2), or Third (Q3) Quarter of the calendar year, installment payment may be allowed under the following conditions:

- i. At least fifty percent (50%) of the total Acceptance Fee shall be paid within one (1) month from the date of execution of the Contract;
- ii. The remaining balance shall be paid in full within three (3) months from the date of execution of the Contract;
- iii. Delivery of external waste shall be limited only to the equivalent quantity covered by the amount already paid;
- iv. Failure to complete payment within the prescribed period shall automatically suspend the authority to deliver waste without need of prior notice.

B. Fourth Quarter (Q4) of the calendar year, the generator or authorized transporter shall be required to pay the Acceptance Fee in full, based on the estimated quantity to be delivered for the remainder of the year. Installment payment shall not be allowed.

2. Tipping Fees – The Tipping Fee shall be computed based on the actual volume or tonnage of waste delivered and disposed of. A corresponding Bill or Statement of Account shall be issued by the Municipal Treasurer or duly authorized representative. *(Retained without modification)*

3. Penalties and Surcharges

Failure to pay the required Acceptance Fee or Tipping Fee within the prescribed period shall subject the generator to the following:

a. Grace Period

A grace period of not more than fifteen (15) calendar days from the date the payment becomes due shall be allowed.

During the grace period, no surcharge shall be imposed; however, delivery of waste may be temporarily suspended at the discretion of the Municipality.

b. Surcharge

If payment remains unpaid beyond the fifteen (15)-day grace period, a surcharge equivalent to twenty-five percent (25%) of the unpaid amount shall be imposed.

c. Suspension and Revocation

Failure to settle the unpaid amount, including the applicable surcharge, within one (1) month from the original due date, shall result in:

- i. Automatic suspension of delivery privileges.

- ii. Revocation or termination of the Contract, after due notice and opportunity to be heard.

During the period of non-payment, no delivery of external waste shall be allowed.

Revocation shall be without prejudice to the Municipality's right to recover unpaid amounts through appropriate legal action.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY



The Committee on Environmental Protection and Utilization of the Sangguniang Bayan of Palompon, Leyte, convened a meeting on March 2, 2026, to deliberate on the proposed ordinance amending certain provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 513-211025, otherwise known as the "Solid Waste Management Service Fees Ordinance of the Municipality of Palompon, Leyte," particularly Sections 5 and 6. The meeting was presided over by Sangguniang Bayan Member William O. Balasabas, Chairman of the Committee and attended by the members of the Committee along with representatives from the concerned municipal offices. The Committee meeting was conducted prior to the scheduled Public Hearing to discuss the draft ordinance and gather inputs on its provisions.

During the meeting, the Committee thoroughly reviewed the proposed amendments. For Section 5, the Committee discussed and agreed upon the revisions to the Special Collection Services, including provisions for Special Collection within the Municipality and the Enhanced Collection Service for High-Waste Generators. The Committee also agreed that all special collection fees shall be collected by the Municipal Treasurer's Office, and MEETO shall continue to regulate scheduling, routes, and operational feasibility to ensure efficiency and sustainability of services.

Regarding fees and charges for external solid wastes generated outside the territorial jurisdiction of Palompon, the Committee agreed that the Acceptance Fee shall be imposed for the privilege of disposing of waste within the Municipality. The fee shall be Sixty Centavos (Php 0.60) per kilogram based on the declared estimated quantity of waste. It was further agreed that in the event of excess deliveries beyond the approved quantity, such deliveries shall be subject to the available annual capacity of the Municipal Sanitary Landfill, require prior written authorization from the Municipality, and be charged at Php 1.20 per kilogram.

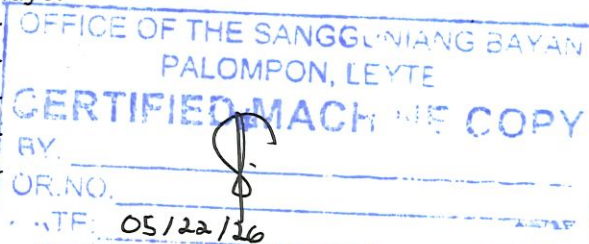

With the presence of thirty (30) punong barangays, representatives from the business sector, concerned municipal offices and other stakeholders, the public hearing on the proposed ordinance was called to order at exactly 1:34 P.M. and commenced with an opening prayer led by Mr. Dario P. Raymundo.

The hearing was presided over by Hon. Javes Keith R. de la Calzada, Municipal Vice Mayor and the Overall Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan, in coordination with the Committee on Environmental Protection.

The Municipal Vice Mayor de la Calzada, opened the public hearing by expressing his sincere appreciation to all participants for taking the time to attend and actively participate in the deliberation of the proposed measure. He provided an overview of the proposed ordinance entitled "An ordinance amending certain provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 513-211025, otherwise known as the "Solid Waste Management Service Fees ordinance of the Municipality of Palompon, Leyte," particularly sections 5 and 6 thereof, by revising, restructuring, and providing additional provisions therein," and explained the rationale behind the amendments, particularly the need to strengthen the existing Solid Waste Management Service Fees Ordinance of the Municipality of Palompon. The Presiding Officer highlighted that the proposed amendments seek to enhance the Municipality's capacity to effectively manage solid waste, ensure sustainability of waste collection and disposal services, and establish clearer guidelines on the imposition and collection of service fees.

Furthermore, he explained that the amendments introduce additional provisions to regulate waste generators, including measures governing special collection services, payment of service fees, and other regulatory mechanisms intended to promote compliance with the Municipality's solid waste management policies consistent with existing environmental laws and regulations.
