EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 1, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the Philippines is a democratic and republican State and that sovereignty resides in the people and all government authority emanates from them. Governance must therefore be responsive to the real conditions and needs of the population, which necessarily requires reliable and updated data at the grassroots level.

Section 9, Article II of the same Constitution mandates the State to promote a just and dynamic social order that ensures the prosperity and independence of the nation and frees the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services and promote full employment. Effective planning and delivery of such services depend upon accurate demographic, economic, health, education, employment, and migration information.

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Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers local government units to exercise powers necessary and appropriate to promote the general welfare. Sections 106 and 109 thereof further require LGUs to undertake comprehensive development planning, while Section 458 authorizes the Sangguniang Bayan to enact ordinances to ensure the effective delivery of basic services and facilities.

In order to properly formulate the Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP), Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP), Annual Investment Program (AIP), Barangay Development Plans (BDP), Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plans (LDRRMP), Gender and Development (GAD) Plans, and other sectoral programs, the Municipality of Matag-ob must maintain a systematic, updated, and reliable local population database.

This proposed measure institutionalizes the Registry of Barangay Inhabitants and Migrants (RBIM) using the RBIM Brooke's Point Mobile Application installed in authorized tablets for digital data collection. It designates the Municipal Population and Youth Development Office (MPYDO) as the lead implementing office consistent with its data banking functions, mandates annual updating of records, and ensures compliance with Republic Act No. 10173 or the Data Privacy Act of 2012.

Through the institutionalization of the RBIM, the Municipality strengthens evidence-based governance, improves program targeting, enhances disaster preparedness, promotes transparency and accountability, and ensures that public resources are allocated efficiently and equitably.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of the Honorable Evangeline C. Carno, with the unanimous accord of all other members present, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte, in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Matag-ob RBIM Ordinance of 2026."

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SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Matag-ob to:

- Establish and institutionalize a comprehensive and updated Registry of Barangay Inhabitants and Migrants (RBIM);
- Promote evidence-based planning and resource allocation;
- Improve targeting of social protection and development programs;
- Strengthen disaster risk reduction and emergency response systems;
- Institutionalize responsible data governance consistent with the Data Privacy Act; and
- Enhance transparency, accountability, and efficiency in local governance.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- Household** – Refers to a social unit consisting of a person living alone or a group of persons who sleep in the same housing unit and have a common arrangement in the preparation and consumption of food.
- Family** – Refers to a group of persons usually living together and composed of the head and other persons related to the head by blood, marriage, or adoption, including both nuclear and extended family members.
- Institutional Living Quarter (ILQ)** – Refers to a structurally separate and independent place of abode intended for habitation by large groups of ten (10) or more individuals, with shared facilities such as kitchen, dining, toilet, and bath areas, including but not limited to dormitories, boarding schools, care institutions, rehabilitation centers, convents, seminaries, and similar establishments.

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- d) **Migrants** – Refers to persons who have transferred residence to the Municipality of Matag-ob or between its barangays, whether on a temporary or permanent basis, for purposes of employment, education, marriage, family reunification, or other lawful reasons.
- e) **RBIM** – Refers to the Registry of Barangay Inhabitants and Migrants, established as the official municipal data banking system under this Ordinance, designed to systematically collect, record, manage, update, and store demographic, social, economic, and migration-related information of households, families, migrants, and institutional living quarters within the Municipality of Matag-ob.
- f) **MPYDO** – Refers to the Municipal Population and Youth Development Office, designated under this Ordinance as the lead implementing office and official custodian of the RBIM database, responsible for policy implementation, supervision of data collection and updating, validation of records, data protection compliance, and overall administration of the RBIM program.
- g) **BSPO** – Barangay Service Point Officer, the designated officer responsible for implementing and assisting in RBIM data collection at the barangay level.
- h) **BLGU** – Barangay Local Government Unit, responsible for implementing local ordinances and programs, including RBIM activities.
- i) **Enumerator** – An individual designated by the barangay to conduct household interviews and collect data for the RBIM.

SECTION 4. COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall apply to all barangays within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte, and shall cover all households, families, migrants, and institutional living quarters subject to registration under the RBIM.

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SECTION 5. DATA COMPONENT. The RBIM shall collect, process, and maintain relevant information necessary for local planning, policy formulation, and program implementation. All data collected under this Section shall be subject to verification, validation, and updating by the MPYDO in accordance with applicable laws, including Republic Act No. 10173, otherwise known as the "Data Privacy Act of 2012," and other relevant rules and regulations. The data to be gathered shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following:

- Basic Demographic Characteristics, including name, sex, age, civil status, and household composition;
- Employment Variables, including employment status, occupation, and industry classification;
- Education Variables, including educational attainment and school attendance;
- Health and Environmental Indicators, including selected health and nutrition indicators, source of water supply, type of toilet facility, and access to sanitation;
- Migration Information, including place of origin, date of arrival, migration status, and length of stay in the Municipality; and
- Household Information, including type of housing structure, number of families within the household, and whether such families separately prepare and consume food.

SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTING STRUCTURE AND ROLES. To ensure the efficient and secure collection, processing, and utilization of the RBIM, a clear implementing structure is hereby established. This structure designates responsibilities at both the municipal and barangay levels, to promote accuracy, accountability, and proper use of data for planning, policy formulation, and program implementation.

- The MPYDO is hereby designated as the lead implementing office and official custodian of the municipal RBIM database as part of its data banking functions. In coordination with the BLGUs, the MPYDO shall:

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- (1) Formulate operational standards, protocols, and procedures for enumeration, data collection, processing, and management;
- (2) Supervise and provide technical guidance for all enumeration activities;
- (3) Maintain, secure, and back up the central RBIM database;
- (4) Conduct annual updating, validation, and verification of records to ensure accuracy and completeness;
- (5) Provide capacity-building, training, and technical assistance to barangays, enumerators, and BSPOs;
- (6) Monitor compliance with applicable laws, including the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (RA 10173) and other relevant rules and regulations;
- (7) Prepare and submit annual implementation and monitoring reports to the Municipal Mayor and the Sangguniang Bayan, as required; and
- (8) Facilitate the use of RBIM data for local planning, policy formulation, and program development.

b) At the barangay level, the BSPO shall serve as the lead implementing individual responsible for RBIM activities, working closely with the Barangay Secretary. The BLGUs shall:

- (1) Designate enumerators through a Barangay Resolution, ensuring the selection of competent and trained personnel;
- (2) Provide logistical support, including tablets, forms, transportation, and other necessary resources for enumeration;
- (3) Mobilize the community and facilitate barangay residents' participation in data collection;
- (4) Ensure strict adherence to field protocols and data privacy guidelines during enumeration and data handling;
- (5) Maintain accurate, updated, and secure copies of the RBIM records at the barangay level, with the Barangay Secretary overseeing safekeeping; and

- (6) Utilize RBIM data in barangay planning, program monitoring, and decision-making processes to address local development priorities.

SECTION 7. OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR DATA COLLECTION, FIELD PROTOCOLS, AND DATA MANAGEMENT. To ensure the integrity, accuracy, and security of the RBIM, the following operational guidelines shall be observed at both municipal and barangay levels. These guidelines cover the system of data collection, field enumeration protocols, and validation and storage of collected information.

- a) **Data Collection System.** – The official data collection tool shall be the RBIM Brooke's Point Mobile Application and its succeeding versions or formats, installed exclusively in authorized tablets provided by the BLGU to enumerators. Data collection shall be conducted primarily through digital means to ensure efficiency, standardization, and real-time consolidation. Updates to the RBIM database shall be conducted at least once every year or as otherwise scheduled by the MPYDO.
- b) **Field Protocols.** – All enumerators, whether municipal or barangay-assigned, shall strictly observe the following field protocols during data collection:
 - (1) Read aloud the informed consent form prior to commencing the interview.
 - (2) Secure voluntary consent from respondents before collecting any data.
 - (3) Interview the household head or, in their absence, any responsible adult household member.
 - (4) Clearly explain the purpose, scope, and benefits of the RBIM to respondents.
 - (5) Ask clarifying questions to ensure accurate responses.
 - (6) Verify information by cross-checking with household records or observations when applicable.

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- (7) Observe the housing structure and facilities as required by the data instrument.
- (8) Reiterate the confidentiality of responses and provide contact information for inquiries or clarifications.
- (9) Inform respondents about possible data quality checks and follow-up validation.
- (10) Conclude the interview courteously and professionally, maintaining respect for the household.

c) **Data Validation and Storage.** – The MPYDO, as the custodian of the municipal RBIM database, shall:

- (1) Validate and cleanse all submitted data to ensure completeness, consistency, and accuracy;
- (2) Remove duplicate, incomplete, or inconsistent entries from the system;
- (3) Maintain password-protected and secure electronic systems to prevent unauthorized access;
- (4) Ensure regular backups of the RBIM database to safeguard against data loss;
- (5) Maintain a registry of all data requests, releases, and disclosures in accordance with Republic Act No. 10173, the Data Privacy Act of 2012; and
- (6) Coordinate with BSPOs and Barangay Secretaries to maintain accurate, updated, and securely stored copies of RBIM data at the barangay level for reference and planning purposes.

SECTION 8. DATA PRIVACY, CONFIDENTIALITY, AND PROTECTION. In the implementation of the RBIM, all personal, household, and community data collected, processed, and stored shall be handled in strict compliance with Republic Act No. 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act of 2012, and other applicable laws and regulations.

- a) **Confidentiality of Data.** – All information gathered under the RBIM shall be treated as confidential and shall only be accessed by authorized personnel of the MPYDO, BSPOs, Barangay Secretaries, and other duly

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designated barangay or municipal staff for purposes directly related to local planning, policy formulation, program implementation, or statistical analysis.

b) **Conditions for Release of Personally Identifiable Information.** – Personally identifiable information (PII) shall not be disclosed, released, or shared except under the following conditions:

- (1) When expressly authorized by law;
- (2) With the written consent of the data subject or their legal representative;
- (3) Pursuant to a lawful order issued by a competent court; or
- (4) Under a valid and duly executed data-sharing agreement between the Municipal Government of Matag-ob and another government agency, ensuring compliance with all data privacy and security requirements.

c) **Data Protection and Security Measures.** – The MPYDO, in coordination with Punong Barangays, Barangay Secretaries and BSPOs, shall implement appropriate organizational, physical, and technical measures to safeguard data from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. Such measures shall include, but are not limited to:

- (1) Maintaining password-protected and encrypted databases;
- (2) Limiting access to authorized personnel only;
- (3) Conducting regular backups and secure storage of digital and hard copy records;
- (4) Providing training to all personnel handling data on proper data protection practices and obligations under RA 10173; and
- (5) Ensuring that any third-party service providers or partners comply with equivalent data privacy and protection standards.

- d) **Accountability and Liability.** - Any unauthorized disclosure, misuse, or breach of data confidentiality shall render the responsible personnel or entity liable to appropriate administrative, civil, or criminal sanctions in accordance with RA 10173 and other relevant laws. The MPYDO shall monitor compliance and report any incidents of data breaches to the Data Protection Officer (DPO), the National Privacy Commission and other appropriate authorities.

SECTION 9. DATA SHARING AND COLLABORATION. To promote informed decision-making and coordination, the MPYDO, in accordance with applicable laws, shall:

- Provide RBIM data to national and local government offices, accredited research institutions, and agencies, including the Commission on Population and Development (CPD), for planning, monitoring, and evaluation purposes;
- Require that all data-sharing agreements are in writing, specifying the purpose, scope, and duration of use, while ensuring the confidentiality of personally identifiable information;
- Ensure that all requests for data access comply with the Data Privacy Act of 2012, and that no unauthorized disclosure occurs;
- Maintain a registry of all data requests, approvals, and releases to ensure transparency and accountability;
- Encourage collaboration among BLGUs, barangay offices, and civil society organizations to enhance the use of RBIM data in local development planning and program implementation.

SECTION 10. MANDATORY UTILIZATION AND INTEGRATION INTO LOCAL PLANNING. To ensure evidence-based governance, all municipal departments or offices and BLGUs are mandated to integrate and utilize data collected through the RBIM in the formulation, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of local development initiatives, programs, and projects.

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Presiding Officer

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- a) **Coverage of RBIM Utilization.** – The RBIM data shall serve as one of the official references for the preparation, review, and updating of the following:
- (1) Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP);
 - (2) Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP);
 - (3) Annual Investment Program (AIP);
 - (4) Barangay Development Plan (BDP);
 - (5) Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plans (LDRRMP);
 - (6) Gender and Development (GAD) Plans; and
 - (7) Social protection and targeting programs.
- b) **Mandatory Reference.** – No major development plan, program, or project proposal within the Municipality or at the barangay level shall be finalized, approved, or implemented without appropriate reference to relevant RBIM data, where applicable.
- c) **Responsibility and Compliance.** – The MPYDO shall provide guidance, technical assistance, and capacity-building to ensure proper utilization of RBIM data by all municipal and barangay offices. Barangay Secretaries and BSPOs shall support their respective BLGUs in integrating accurate and up-to-date RBIM information in planning and decision-making processes.
- d) **Monitoring and Evaluation.** – The MPYDO shall be responsible for monitoring and evaluation and documenting the utilization of RBIM data in all planning documents and program implementation, and shall provide relevant reports and updates on such utilization to the Commission on Population and Development (CPD) to ensure compliance, facilitate technical support, and guide policy formulation at the municipal, barangay, and national levels.

- a) **Municipal Appropriations.** – The funds necessary for the effective implementation of this Ordinance at the municipal level shall be charged against the current municipal appropriations, in accordance with existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations, and shall thereafter be included in the annual budget. A portion of the municipal budget shall be specifically allocated under the Special Purpose Appropriation (SPA) of the MPYDO to support continuing capacity-building activities, maintenance of the RBIM system, and other aspects necessary for its sustained operation.
- b) **Barangay Appropriations.** – At the barangay level, the funds necessary for the effective implementation of this Ordinance shall be charged against the current barangay appropriations and shall thereafter be included in the annual barangay budget. Barangays shall allocate sufficient resources to support the participation of BSPOs, barangay enumerators, and ensure the proper maintenance, security, and utilization of RBIM data within the barangay.

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the Courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Municipal Ordinances, Executive Order, and issuance inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. AMENDMENTS CLAUSE. This Ordinance may be amended or modified as necessary through appropriate legislative process.

SECTION 15. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
