EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Municipal Population and Youth Development Office (MPYDO) of the Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte was formally institutionalized in 2025 through Municipal Ordinance No. 228, Series of 2025. The establishment of the Office marked a significant milestone in local governance by integrating the functions of the Population Office and the Youth Development Office into a single institution mandated to promote population management and youth development within the municipality.

The MPYDO serves as the lead office in the formulation, implementation, coordination, and monitoring of programs, projects, and activities that advance population welfare and youth empowerment. Among its core functions are the integration of population and youth development principles into local planning processes; the implementation of programs on responsible parenthood, adolescent reproductive health, and gender sensitivity; the provision of

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technical assistance to the Sangguniang Kabataan; the management of the Municipal Tertiary Scholarship Program; and the strengthening of partnerships with national government agencies, civil society organizations, and academic institutions.

The Office likewise plays a crucial role in promoting youth participation in governance, supporting community-based training and digital inclusion initiatives, maintaining demographic and youth development data for evidence-based planning, and implementing national programs in coordination with the Commission on Population and Development (CPD), the National Youth Commission (NYC), the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA).

In view of the broad mandate and strategic role of the MPYDO in advancing people-centered development, it is necessary to formally adopt an official logo that symbolizes its institutional identity, values, and functions. The official logo visually communicates the Office's commitment to education and capacity development, family and population welfare, youth empowerment and leadership, unity through participatory governance, and alignment with the broader development agenda of the Municipality of Matag-ob.

The adoption of an official logo will ensure consistent representation of the Office in official documents, programs, and activities while protecting the symbol from unauthorized use or misrepresentation.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of the Honorable Ana Love D. Borden, with the unanimous accord of all other members present, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte, in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "MPYDO Official Logo Adoption Ordinance of Matag-ob, Leyte."

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SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipal Government of Matag-ob to promote institutional identity, transparency, and accountability in the delivery of public services by formally recognizing and protecting the official symbols of its offices.

Consistent with the municipality's commitment to integrated population management and youth development, the Municipal Government recognizes the need to establish an official logo that reflects the mandate, principles, and development objectives of the Municipal Population and Youth Development Office.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

- (a) MPYDO - refers to the Municipal Population and Youth Development Office, a municipal office responsible for the formulation, implementation, coordination, and monitoring of population management and youth development programs in the Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte.
- (b) Official Logo - refers to the officially adopted graphical symbol representing the Municipal Population and Youth Development Office, including its visual elements, design features, and color scheme.
- (c) Authorized Use - refers to the lawful use of the official logo in official documents, communications, programs, projects, publications, and activities of the Municipal Government of Matag-ob, Leyte and the MPYDO.
- (d) Unauthorized Use - refers to any use, reproduction, alteration, or distribution of the official logo without proper authorization from the Municipal Government of Matag-ob, Leyte.
- (e) Commercial Use - refers to the use of the official logo for profit-oriented activities, merchandising, advertising, or private enterprise.

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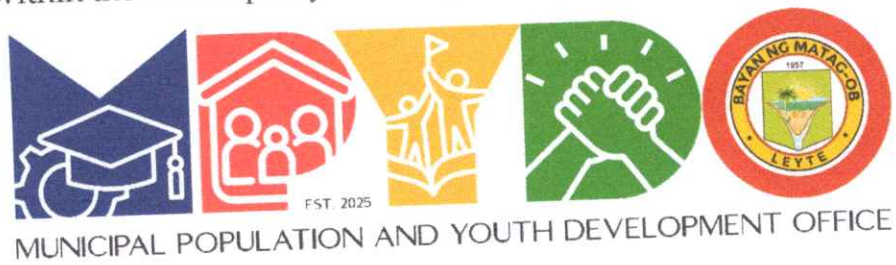

(f) Municipal Government - refers to the Municipal Government of Matag-ob, Leyte, including all its offices, instrumentalities, and officials.

SECTION 4. ADOPTION OF THE OFFICIAL LOGO. The Municipal Government hereby formally adopts the Official Logo of the MPYDO as the official emblem representing the office in all official communications, programs, activities, publications, and initiatives of the Municipal Government.

The official logo shall embody the integrated mandate of the MPYDO in advancing population welfare, youth empowerment, education, and participatory governance within the Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte.



SECTION 5. SYMBOLISM OF THE OFFICIAL LOGO. The official logo shall contain the following symbolic elements representing the mandate and functions of the MPYDO:

- Education and Capacity Development - symbolized by a graduation cap set against a gear, representing education as a foundation of sustainable development, lifelong learning, and institutional efficiency in the delivery of public service.
- Family and Population Welfare - symbolized by a family within a home, representing the central role of the family as the fundamental unit of society and the core focus of population and development initiatives.
- Youth Empowerment and Leadership - symbolized by figures rising from an open book, representing youth participation in governance, leadership development, civic engagement, and the promotion of education as a pathway toward nation-building.

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- (d) Unity and Participatory Governance – symbolized by clasped hands representing solidarity, collaboration, and partnerships among government agencies, civil society organizations, academic institutions, and community stakeholders in advancing population and youth development.
- (e) Municipal Identity and Institutional Authority – represented by the official seal of the Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte and the mark “EST. 2025,” signifying the formal institutionalization of the MPYDO and its alignment with the broader development agenda of the Municipal Government.

SECTION 6. OFFICIAL COLOR SIGNIFICANCE. The official colors of the MPYDO logo shall represent the following principles:

- (a) Navy Blue – stability, knowledge, and institutional integrity
- (b) Red – strength, passion, and dedication to public service
- (c) Gold – excellence, opportunity, and a hopeful future
- (d) Green – growth, vitality, and sustainable development
- (e) Orange – energy, innovation, and proactive leadership

SECTION 7. AUTHORIZED USE OF THE LOGO. The official logo shall be used in:

- (a) official documents, communications, and reports of the MPYDO;
- (b) program materials, manuals, and advocacy publications;
- (c) official events, trainings, and activities conducted by the Office;
- (d) banners, signages, identification materials, and information campaigns; and
- (e) official digital platforms of the Municipal Government and the MPYDO.

SECTION 8. CUSTODY AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE LOGO. The MPYDO shall have primary responsibility for the custody, protection, and administration of the official logo.

The MPYDO shall maintain official design files and may issue technical guidelines governing the reproduction, display, and application of the logo.

SECTION 9. PROHIBITION OF UNAUTHORIZED USE.

The Official Logo shall be used only for official purposes of the Municipal Government. Any reproduction, display, distribution, or use of the logo without prior written authorization from the Municipal Government through the MPYDO is prohibited. The logo shall not be used in any way that suggests endorsement, affiliation, sponsorship, or official participation by the Municipal Government or the MPYDO.

Any alteration, modification, distortion, or misrepresentation of the logo, or its use for commercial or private purposes, advertising, or other unauthorized activities, is likewise prohibited. Acts that mislead the public, damage the reputation of the Municipal Government, or weaken the identity of the MPYDO shall be considered violations of this Ordinance and shall be subject to the penalties provided herein.

SECTION 10. PENALTY CLAUSE. Any person, association, organization, or entity, whether natural or juridical, who violates any provision of this Ordinance, including the unauthorized use, reproduction, alteration, or misrepresentation of the Official Logo of the MPYDO, shall be liable for the following penalties:

- (a) First Offense - Written warning.
- (b) Second Offense - Fine of One Thousand Pesos (₱1,000.00).
- (c) Third and Subsequent Offenses - Fine of Two Thousand Pesos (₱2,000.00).

The MPYDO, in coordination with the Office of the Municipal Mayor (OMM), shall enforce these penalties and may refer violators for appropriate administrative, civil, or legal action under applicable laws, including RA 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) and other relevant statutes.

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SECTION 11. IMPLEMENTING OFFICE. The MPYDO shall serve as the primary implementing office of this Ordinance and shall coordinate with the Office of the Municipal Mayor (OMM) and other concerned offices in ensuring its effective implementation.

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the Courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Municipal Ordinances, Executive Order, and issuance inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. AMENDMENTS CLAUSE. This Ordinance may be amended or modified as necessary through appropriate legislative process.

SECTION 15. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
