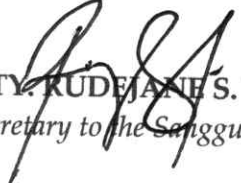

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 4 AND 7 OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 25-24, SERIES OF 2025 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "UNLAD KABATAAN DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE OF BURAUEN, LEYTE"

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Burauen, Leyte, in session assembled, that:

Section 1. Section 4 of the Municipal Ordinance No. 25-24, Series of 2025, otherwise known as the "Unlad Kabataan Development Ordinance of Burauen, Leyte" is hereby amended by adding items (f) to (n), which shall hereafter read as follows:

- f) **Disadvantaged Youth** – refers to young people who experience social, economic, or personal challenges that hinder their full development and participation in society, such as poverty, lack of access to education, unemployment, or other circumstances that put them at risk.
- g) **Sports Tournament** – competition of sports activities in the regional, provincial, national, and international level.
- h) **Academic Competition** – refers to organized contests or challenges among students that measure knowledge, skills, and abilities in various academic fields such as Mathematics, Science, English, History, Quiz Bee and other subject areas.
- i) **Skills and Livelihood** – refers to the knowledge, abilities, and competencies acquired through education or training which enable individuals, especially the youth, to engage in productive activities and income-generating undertakings for sustainable living.
- j) **Capacity Development Trainings for Youth** – refers to organized programs, activities, or workshops, designed to enhance the knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values of young individuals, enabling them to actively participate in community development, leadership, livelihood, and other productive endeavors.
- k) **Youth Leadership and Excellence Award** – refers to a recognition conferred by the Local Government Unit to outstanding young individuals who have demonstrated exemplary leadership, academic achievement, community involvement, or other meritorious contributions that promote positive change and inspire fellow youth.
- l) **Youth-led Initiatives or Activities** – refer to programs, projects, or undertakings that are planned, organized, and implemented primarily by the youth, either individually or through youth organizations, aimed at addressing community needs, promoting youth development, and fostering active participation in governance and nation-building.
- m) **Government Internship Program (GIP)** – refers to a program of the Local Government Unit (LGU) that provides young workers, particularly from poor or indigent families, with temporary employment opportunities in public service. It aims to help them gain meaningful work experience, enhance their skills, and foster interest in pursuing a career in government service while contributing to local development and poverty reduction.
- n) **Special Program for Employment of Students (SPES)** – refers to a program of the Local Government Unit (LGU) that provides employment opportunities to poor but deserving students, out-of-school youth, and dependents of displaced or marginalized workers during vacation or other appropriate periods, with the purpose of helping them earn income to support their education while gaining valuable work experience in government service.

Section 2. Section 7 (7.8) of Municipal Ordinance No. 25-24, Series of 2025 is hereby amended by adding items (a) to (e), which shall hereafter read as follows:

- a) Skills and livelihood trainings;
- b) Participation in youth camps, sportsfest, leadership trainings, and advocacy seminars;
- c) Involvement in community development programs;
- d) Access to support for youth-led initiatives and projects; and
- e) Recognition and incentives of outstanding youth volunteers and leaders.

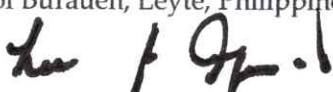
Section 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations, or parts thereof, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

Section 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

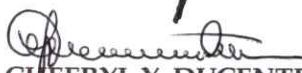
Section 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
