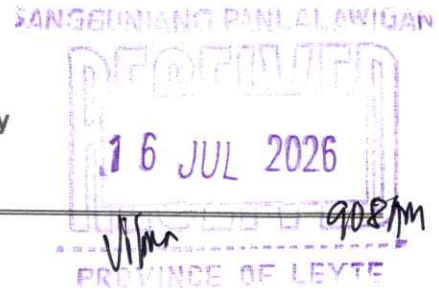

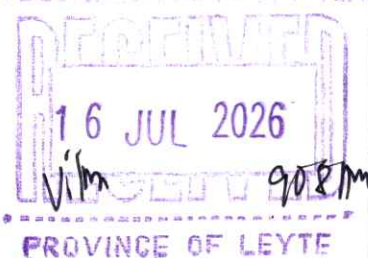

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

Tricycles-for-hire serve as one of the primary modes of public transportation within the Municipality of Jaro, providing accessible and convenient mobility to residents and visitors.

Under Republic Act No. 10963 or the Tax Reform for Acceleration and Inclusion (TRAIN) Law, which became effective last January 1, 2018, gasoline was subjected to a higher excise tax.

Recently, the association of operators and drivers of tricycles in Jaro, Leyte requested for an increase of fare mainly due to the effect of high cost of fuel and other petroleum products in its operations, among others.

Despite the increase in fuel commodities and the swelling demand for its services, fare in tricycles for hire have not been increased.

Per DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2004-91, all local government units are encouraged to entertain any petitions filed or may be filed by concerned tricycle sectors before the respective local Sanggunians seeking or fare increase and conduct public consultation thereon.

The Sanggunian Bayan Committee on Peace & Order, Public Safety and Transportation, after having conducted surveys, public consultations, and series of committee hearings, deliberated on the subject request and deemed it reasonable to fix the fare rates of Tricycle-for-Hire to allow the operators and drivers adapt to the ever-changing tide of the very unpredictable rise and fall of the price of fuel products.

There is a need to regulate and standardize tricycle fares to ensure that they are just, reasonable, and responsive to current economic conditions, including fuel prices and cost of living;

The Municipality recognizes the need to balance the welfare of commuters and the livelihood of tricycle operators and drivers;

Pursuant to the powers vested upon the Sangguniang Bayan under the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), the Municipality is authorized to regulate the operation of tricycles and fix fares for the same;

**ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FARE METRIX OF TRICYCLE-
FOR-HIRE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JARO, LEYTE, AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

INTRODUCED BY: HON. TEOFILO CABELLO

Be it ordained by the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte in session assembled and by authority of the same that-

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as ***"Tricycle Fare Matrix Ordinance of Jaro, Leyte."***

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. - This Ordinance shall apply to all tricycles-for-hire operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are hereby defined:

- a. **Tricycle-for-Hire** – A motor vehicle composed of a motorcycle with an attached sidecar, duly registered and authorized to transport passengers for a fee within the Municipality of Jaro.
- b. **Fare Matrix** – The schedule of authorized rates or charges for tricycle services based on distance, type of trip, and other applicable conditions.
- c. **Regular Trip** – A trip where a passenger shares the ride with other passengers and pays the standard fare based on the approved fare matrix.
- d. **Special Trip (Chartered Trip)** – A trip wherein the passenger hires the tricycle for exclusive use, without sharing the ride with other passengers.
- e. **First Four (4) Kilometers** – The base distance covered by the minimum fare as prescribed in this Ordinance.

- f. **Succeeding Kilometer** – The distance traveled beyond the initial four (4) kilometers, subject to an additional fare per kilometer.
- g. **Operator** – Any person or entity holding a valid franchise or permit issued by the Municipality to operate a tricycle-for-hire.
- h. **Driver** – Any person duly licensed and authorized to operate a tricycle-for-hire.
- i. **Passenger** – Any person who hires or boards a tricycle-for-hire for transportation.
- j. **Overloading** – The act of carrying passengers beyond the authorized seating capacity as prescribed by law or local regulation.
- k. **Maximum Passenger Capacity** – refers to the allowable number of passengers that a public utility vehicle may carry per trip for specific routes, as prescribed by the local government.

For the purpose of this ordinance:

- **Poblacion Route** – shall have a maximum passenger capacity of three (3) passengers only per trip.
 - **Hiagsam and Olotan Routes** – shall have a maximum passenger capacity of seven (7) passengers only per trip.
- l. **All tricycles operating under the Poblacion route** - are strictly prohibited from dropping off passengers at the Petron Station or within Olotan All passenger drop-offs must occur exclusively at the designated terminal.

SECTION 4. FARE MATRIX. - The authorized fare rates for tricycles-for-hire shall be as follows:

Discounts:

- Senior Citizens, Persons with Disabilities (PWDs), and Students shall be entitled to a **20% discount** pursuant to existing laws.

SECTION 5. DISPLAY OF FARE MATRIX.

All tricycle operators and drivers are required to conspicuously display the approved fare matrix inside their units at all times.

SECTION 6. CONDITIONS FOR FARES AND FREIGHT - The driver/operator shall not charge more than what is provided for in this Ordinance. Fares and freight shall also be subject to the following conditions:

- a. Any operator or driver is not allowed to automatically impose a fare adjustment based on the preceding Section. The Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) shall make an official announcement or declaration as to when a new rate will take effect, in the event of an increase or decrease in fare, as the case maybe.

The operator or driver concerned must secure first a clearance from the BPLO in order to impose an increase in fare.

Complaints regarding fare shall be lodged with the BPLO who shall conduct investigation, hear complaints, and make recommendation, in coordination with and assistance of the Municipal Transportation Traffic Management Office (MTTMO).

For this purpose, the BPLO shall provide the necessary guidelines.

- b. Children below five (5) years old shall not be charged any fare unless the child has occupied a seat.

- c. Each passenger is entitled to a baggage load not exceeding 15 kilograms for free. Cargoes and baggage in excess of 15 kgs. shall pay freight equivalent to an adult passenger.
- d. Cargoes whose length is longer than 6 meters (20 feet) shall not be allowed.

SECTION 7. PROHIBITED ACTS.

The following acts are prohibited:

- a. Charging fares higher than those prescribed in this Ordinance;
- b. Refusal to convey passengers without justifiable reason;
- c. Failure to display the fare matrix; and
- d. Overloading beyond authorized passenger capacity.

SECTION 8. ADMINISTRATIVE FINES - In lieu of prosecution in proper courts, any driver/operator who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance may be sanctioned, as follows:

FIRST OFFENSE - One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00)

SECOND OFFENSE - Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000.00)

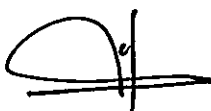
THIRD OFFENSE - Three Thousand Pesos (Php 3,000.00)

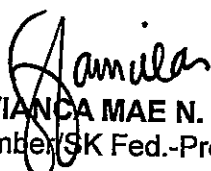
FOURTH OFFENSE AND SUCCEEDING OFFENSE - Out of court settlement through voluntary payment of administrative fine is no longer available. The case shall be filed with the proper court who may impose the proper penalties under Section 7 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9. PENALTY CLAUSE - In case of non-payment of administrative fine as prescribed in Section 6 or commission of the same offense for the fourth time, any driver/operator who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall suffer the penalty of a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00) or an imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both, at the discretion of the court.

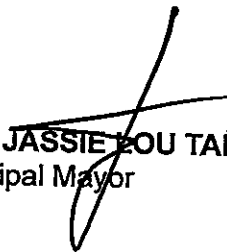

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Tricycles-for-hire serve as one of the primary modes of public transportation within the Municipality of Jaro, providing accessible and convenient mobility to residents and visitors.

Under Republic Act No. 10963 or the Tax Reform for Acceleration and Inclusion (TRAIN) Law, which became effective last January 1, 2018, gasoline was subjected to a higher excise tax.

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Recently, the association of operators and drivers of tricycles in Jaro, Leyte requested for an increase of fare mainly due to the effect of high cost of fuel and other petroleum products in its operations, among others.

Despite the increase in fuel commodities and the swelling demand for its services, fare in tricycles for hire have not been increased.

Per DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2004-91, all local government units are encouraged to entertain any petitions filed or may be filed by concerned tricycle sectors before the respective local Sanggunians seeking or fare increase and conduct public consultation thereon.

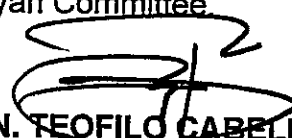
The Sanggunian Bayan Committee on Peace & Order, Public Safety and Transportation, after having conducted surveys, public consultations, and series of committee hearings, deliberated on the subject request and deemed it reasonable to fix the fare rates of Tricycle-for-Hire to allow the operators and drivers adapt to the ever-changing tide of the very unpredictable rise and fall of the price of fuel products.

There is a need to regulate and standardize tricycle fares to ensure that they are just, reasonable, and responsive to current economic conditions, including fuel prices and cost of living;

The Municipality recognizes the need to balance the welfare of commuters and the livelihood of tricycle operators and drivers;

Pursuant to the powers vested upon the Sangguniang Bayan under the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), the Municipality is authorized to regulate the operation of tricycles and fix fares for the same;

Premises considered, the Honorable Sanggunian Bayan duly concurs with the recommendation of the aforesaid Sanggunian Bayan Committee.

**ORDINANCE NO. 30
SERIES OF 2026**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FARE METRIX OF TRICYCLE-FOR-HIRE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JARO, LEYTE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

INTRODUCED BY: HON. TEOFILO CABELLO
Chairman Committee on Peace & Order, Public Safety and Transportation

Be it ordained by the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte in session assembled and by authority of the same that-

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as *"Tricycle Fare Matrix Ordinance of Jaro, Leyte."*

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. - This Ordinance shall apply to all tricycles-for-hire operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are hereby defined:

- a. **Tricycle-for-Hire** – A motor vehicle composed of a motorcycle with an attached sidecar, duly registered and authorized to transport passengers for a fee within the Municipality of Jaro.
- b. **Fare Matrix** – The schedule of authorized rates or charges for tricycle services based on distance, type of trip, and other applicable conditions.
- c. **Regular Trip** – A trip where a passenger shares the ride with other passengers and pays the standard fare based on the approved fare matrix.
- d. **Special Trip (Chartered Trip)** – A trip wherein the passenger hires the tricycle for exclusive use, without sharing the ride with other passengers.
- e. **First Four (4) Kilometers** – The base distance covered by the minimum fare as prescribed in this Ordinance.

- f. **Succeeding Kilometer** – The distance traveled beyond the initial four (4) kilometers, subject to an additional fare per kilometer.
- g. **Operator** – Any person or entity holding a valid franchise or permit issued by the Municipality to operate a tricycle-for-hire.
- h. **Driver** – Any person duly licensed and authorized to operate a tricycle-for-hire.
- i. **Passenger** – Any person who hires or boards a tricycle-for-hire for transportation.
- j. **Overloading** – The act of carrying passengers beyond the authorized seating capacity as prescribed by law or local regulation.
- k. **Maximum Passenger Capacity** – refers to the allowable number of passengers that a public utility vehicle may carry per trip for specific routes, as prescribed by the local government.

For the purpose of this ordinance:

- **Poblacion Route** – shall have a maximum passenger capacity of three (3) passengers only per trip.
 - **Hlagsam and Olotan Routes** – shall have a maximum passenger capacity of seven (7) passengers only per trip.
- l. **All tricycles operating under the Poblacion route** - are strictly prohibited from dropping off passengers at the Petron Station or within Olotan All passenger drop-offs must occur exclusively at the designated terminal.

SECTION 4. FARE MATRIX. - The authorized fare rates for tricycles-for-hire shall be as follows:

Poblacion - Hiagsam	P20.00	P16.00	P25.00	P20.00

Discounts:

- Senior Citizens, Persons with Disabilities (PWDs), and Students shall be entitled to a **20% discount** pursuant to existing laws.

SECTION 5. DISPLAY OF FARE MATRIX.

All tricycle operators and drivers are required to conspicuously display the approved fare matrix inside their units at all times.

SECTION 6. CONDITIONS FOR FARES AND FREIGHT - The driver/operator shall not charge more than what is provided for in this Ordinance. Fares and freight shall also be subject to the following conditions:

- a. Any operator or driver is not allowed to automatically impose a fare adjustment based on the preceding Section. The Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) shall make an official announcement or declaration as to when a new rate will take effect, in the event of an increase or decrease in fare, as the case maybe.

The operator or driver concerned must secure first a clearance from the BPLO in order to impose an increase in fare.

Complaints regarding fare shall be lodged with the BPLO who shall conduct investigation, hear complaints, and make recommendation, in coordination with and assistance of the Municipal Transportation Traffic Management Office (MTTMO).

For this purpose, the BPLO shall provide the necessary guidelines.

- b. Children below five (5) years old shall not be charged any fare unless the child has occupied a seat.

- c. Each passenger is entitled to a baggage load not exceeding 15 kilograms for free. Cargoes and baggage in excess of 15 kgs. shall pay freight equivalent to an adult passenger.
- d. Cargoes whose length is longer than 6 meters (20 feet) shall not be allowed.

SECTION 7. PROHIBITED ACTS.

The following acts are prohibited:

- a. Charging fares higher than those prescribed in this Ordinance;
- b. Refusal to convey passengers without justifiable reason;
- c. Failure to display the fare matrix; and
- d. Overloading beyond authorized passenger capacity.

SECTION 8. ADMINISTRATIVE FINES - In lieu of prosecution in proper courts, any driver/operator who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance may be sanctioned, as follows:

- FIRST OFFENSE** - One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00)
- SECOND OFFENSE** - Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000.00)
- THIRD OFFENSE** - Three Thousand Pesos (Php 3,000.00)
- FOURTH OFFENSE AND SUCCEEDING OFFENSE** - Out of court settlement through voluntary payment of administrative fine is no longer available. The case shall be filed with the proper court who may impose the proper penalties under Section 7 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9. PENALTY CLAUSE - In case of non-payment of administrative fine as prescribed in Section 6 or commission of the same offense for the fourth time, any driver/operator who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall suffer the penalty of a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00) or an imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 10. ENFORCEMENT. - The Municipal Mayor, through the Municipal Traffic Management Office (MTMO) and/or designated enforcement units, shall ensure the proper implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – In case any provision of this Ordinance or any part thereof be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the court, other provisions or any part thereof not affected shall continue to be in full force or effect.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE - Any other existing Ordinance or any provision thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby deemed repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its posting in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte.
