99 Mr. Chair, Item no. 53 pertains to a resolution from the Municipal Government of Abuyog

100 that empowers the Municipal Government to defend its territorial integrity and assert its

101 jurisdiction over 13 barangays which are being claimed by the Municipality of Silago. Actually,

102 the Provincial Government of Leyte recognizes that Abuyog is one of the component

103 municipalities and, of course, our Provincial Government through our Governor Carlos Jericho

104 Petilla, takes this seriously because it actually affects the territorial integrity of Leyte. However,

105 the Sangguniang Panlalawigan has been called upon to act under Section 118 of the Local

106 Government Code. The Committee on Boundary Disputes was tasked to conduct the

107 proceedings in accordance with law, receive evidence from both parties and coordinate with

108 the Provincial Government of Southern Leyte, receive evidence from both parties and

109 coordinate with the Provincial Government of Southern Leyte as required and thereafter submit

110 its recommendation to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan. Since this matter was already referred

111 to the Committee on Boundary Disputes, I move that Item no. 53 be referred, be noted and

112 refer to the Committee on Boundary Disputes.

130 Government of Silago shall likewise be afforded the same opportunity to be heard during the
131 next proceedings. May I now request for the suspension of our Rules in order to hear out the
132 manifestation of the Municipal Government of Abuyog.

158 Maupay na aga ha aton na tanan. First of all, I would like to extend my gratitude to the
159 Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte for having us here. We have a short presentation here
160 about the history of the territories involved in this dispute. Also, we would like to present to you
161 a brief presentation about the few of the many evidences that we have. I will not be the one to
162 present but I asked someone from the Sangguniang Bayan members to present which is SB
163 Member Rodolfo Cabilas. Han kapanahunan before pa, nakada na ini hya asya very well
164 versed ini hya hini na mga sitwasyon na amon ginaatubang. Thank you very much ha iyo nga
165 tanan han pag hatag hin oras ngan panahon ha amon. Salamat.

171 To the Honorable Michael Cari, the Presiding Officer of today's session, Honorable
172 Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan ng Leyte, my colleagues from the Municipality of
173 Abuyog, to all of us, a pleasant good morning.

174 Actually, we are not here to submit evidences yet. We are here to present our position,
175 as the Sangguniang Bayan of these 13 barangays being claimed by Silago. Here is my
176 presentation of the Abuyog-Silago Boundary Dispute and Disposition.

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180 HON. RODULFO CABIAS: SM MEMBER/ MUNICIPALITY OF ABUYOG

181 That would be all and we are open to questions, if there are any.

182 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

183 Mr. Chair and Mr. Floor Leader, I recommend that the SP simply receive this
184 manifestation of the Municipal Government of Abuyog. No action of the merits should be taken
185 today because the SP must first notify the Municipality of Silago and coordinate with the SP of
186 Southern Leyte, in accordance with Section 118 of the Local Government Code. And the SP
187 will conduct the necessary proceedings and submit recommendations to both August Bodies.
188 There will be next steps to this proceeding which will be that Committee on Boundary Disputes
189 will issue an order requiring both Municipal Government of Abuyog and Silago to submit their
190 position papers as well as all of those supporting documents, technical, historical and legal
191 pieces of evidence. The next, would of course is that the SP Leyte will coordinate with SP of
192 Southern Leyte that will finally create a coordinative body to hear both of them. The SP can
193 also request technical assistance and records from agencies like the NAMRIA, LMP, DILG and
194 other relevant government offices. An initial hearing and conference will be then be scheduled
195 once we are presented with their position papers as well as with their documents or pieces of
196 evidence and after completion of the proceedings, of course both SPS of Leyte and Southern
197 Leyte will prepare and submit its report as well as its recommendation. Currently, again as I
198 said, this is simply a manifestation from the Municipal Government of Abuyog. We appreciate
199 that we are being informed of their position and as I said, we will protect the territorial integrity
200 of Leyte as much as we can but section 118 of the Local Government Code requires us to be
201 an impartial charge to this case. Therefore, I so move that there will be no action to this. Thank
202 you so much.
