I. BACKGROUND

The National Youth Basketball League Eastern Visayas (NYBL Eastern Visayas) is a duly organized and existing non-stock, non-profit organization established for developmental, educational, charitable, and community-oriented purposes. It seeks accreditation as a Civil Society Organization (CSO) with the Provincial Government of Leyte to advance its mission of promoting grassroots basketball development and fostering youth empowerment through sports within the Province of Leyte and the Eastern Visayas Region.

II. FINDINGS

Upon preliminary evaluation, the Committee found that the applicant had not fully complied with the documentary requirements prescribed under the applicable laws, rules, and regulations governing CSO accreditation, particularly the submission of its Annual Accomplishment Report, latest Financial Statements, and Minutes of the Annual General Meeting.

Pursuant to Resolution No. 2026-912 the applicant was directed to submit the foregoing documentary requirements, with which it subsequently complied, thereby completing its application for accreditation.

Upon due evaluation of the completed application and the supporting documents submitted, the Committee finds that the applicant has substantially complied with the legal and documentary requirements for accreditation as a Civil Society Organization (CSO) and is therefore qualified for accreditation.

III. RECOMMENDATION

Considering the applicant's substantial compliance with the applicable legal and documentary requirements, the Committee finds the application of the National Youth Basketball League Eastern Visayas (NYBL Eastern Visayas) to be sufficient in form and substance and hereby recommends the **APPROVAL** of its application for accreditation as a Civil Society Organization (CSO) in the Province of Leyte.

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Presented for consideration is a **MEMORANDUM**
dated July 7, 2026 from Provincial Legal Office. **Re: Proposed**
Ordinance No. 2026-05, Series of 2026 entitled: "**AN ORDINANCE**
INSTITUTIONALIZING THE PROVINCIAL PHILHEALTH PROFESSIONAL FEE
TRUST FUND SYSTEM OF THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE, PROVIDING FOR ITS
ADMINISTRATION, POOLING, ALLOCATION, UTILIZATION,
MANAGEMENT DISTRIBUTION, AND INCENTIVE PROGRAM IN ALL THE
HOSPITALS AND FACILITIES OWNED AND MANAGED BY THE
PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF LEYTE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

1428 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1429 If I may, Mr. Chair, I wish to address the points raised by the Provincial Legal
1430 Office in this Memorandum.

1431 It points to several perceived infirmities in the Provincial Ordinance we
1432 passed last July 01, 2026. I wish to point, first, the Provincial Legal Office says that
1433 the Provincial Government is not allowed to manage the professional fees from the
1434 PHILHEALTH. I wish to share on the screen, a screen shot of a PHILHEALTH
1435 Circular No. 0035 series of 2013, which provides for the computation of the
1436 reimbursement for medical case rates, the HCI fee, Health Institution fee and the
1437 Professional Fee shall be 70% of the case amount, respectively. It is the
1438 computation. So, in private hospitals, we were informed that HCI fee goes to the
1439 hospital while the Professional Fee goes to the doctors or medical health workers
1440 involved in the case or in the procedure. In government hospitals, it is provided also
1441 in the PHILHEALTH Circular 0035 that the Professional Fee can be pooled and
1442 distributed allocated by the LGU through a Trust Fund. It goes to a Trust Fund. The
1443 Hospital institution fee goes to the Special Health Fund which recently have been
1444 covered by the Universal Health Care Law. So, clearly, that answers the question
1445 whether or not providing for a PHILHEALTH Professional fee trust fund is allowed.
1446 It's the management of the PHILHEALTH fund is provided for. Secondly, the
1447 Provincial Legal Office also points out that based on the administrative circular of
1448 DOH, I wish to share another screenshot about the coverage of Administrative
1449 Circulars. I was telling Atty. Acol, on the side, before our meeting, that administrative
1450 orders are not superior to Ordinances because ordinances are laws. In fact, even in
1451 the constitution, ordinances are considered for purposes of determining liability and
1452 double jeopardy. The limitation of ordinances is National Laws. At any rate,
1453 Administrative Order 2016-003 provides for the coverage and it says, "This order
1454 shall cover all Department of Health and government hospitals (Specialty, Medical
1455 Centers and Regional Hospitals) and other facilities such as infirmaries and sanitarium
1456 in consonance with all case rate policy of PHILHEALTH". In the memorandum from

1457 the Provincial Legal Office, it quoted this part only up to the portion which says
1458 "government hospitals". They did not enumerate the expressed enumeration in the
1459 scope and coverage which is kind of misleading and, in a lack a of better word,
1460 malicious. We have a Latin Doctrine which we use - *Expressio unius est exclusio*
1461 *alterius*. An express enumeration excludes all others not included in the
1462 enumeration which in this case excludes" government hospitals owned or operated
1463 by the Provincial Government." Our hospitals are not Specialty, Medical Centers nor
1464 are they are Regional Hospitals. They are not infirmaries and sanitararia. They are
1465 Provincial and District Hospitals.

1466 Another point raised by the memoranda from the Provincial Legal Office , is
1467 the definition of health workers. The Provincial Legal Office says that "Health
1468 workers are limited only to doctors and etc. We take note of RA 7305 and the
1469 screenshot is flashed, which provides "Health workers shall mean all persons who
1470 are engaged in health and health related work. All persons employed in all hospitals,
1471 sanitararia, health infirmaries, health centers, rural health units, barangay health
1472 stations, clinics and other health related establishment owned and operated by the
1473 government or its political subdivisions with original charters and shall include
1474 medical allied health professional, administrative and support personnel employed
1475 regardless of their employment status." Clearly, health workers would cover the
1476 entire facility. With that, Mr. Chair, I think that we had pointed out that the points
1477 raised by the Provincial Legal Office in its memoranda, and therefore we can
1478 proceed with our ordinance.

1479 Do we have any interpolation or queries from our distinguished colleagues?

1480 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1481 Re-joinder, Mr. Chair.

1482 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1483 Go ahead, Honorable Uy.

1484 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1485 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

1486 Mr. Chair, in addition to what our Floor Leader made, mentioned a while ago
1487 in his statement, I would also like to share my point that this Trust Fund has been
1488 implemented for several years. It has become necessary to institutionalize the
1489 existing administrative policy embodied in said Executive Orders through an
1490 ordinance in order to ensure continuity of policy, provide legislative authority,
1491 promote transparency, and establish a uniform legal framework governing the
1492 Provincial PhilHealth Professional Fee Trust Fund.

1493 The Provincial Legal Office, in its legal review of proposed measure,
1494 recognized the legal basis for the establishment of a Provincial PhilHealth
1495 Professional Fee Trust Fund while recommending that the ordinance be harmonized
1496 with Republic Act No. 11223, existing Department of Health issuance, PhilHealth
1497 Circulars, Department of Budget and Management regulations, and Commission on
1498 Audit rules to ensure consistency with national policy and avoid audit disallowances.

1499 The Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds it necessary to clarify that this
1500 Ordinance does not create new compensation, allowances, salaries, or benefits
1501 beyond those authorized by existing laws, but merely institutionalizes and provides
1502 legislative parameters for the implementation of an existing trust fund system,
1503 subject at all times to applicable national laws, administrative issuances, auditing
1504 rules and fiscal regulations.

1505 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1506 Mr. Floor Leader?

1507 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1508 Yes, Mr. Chair?

1509 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1510 Isn't this a practice among health care workers among the Province of Leyte?
1511 And how come we are just talking about it now?

1512 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1513 Mr. Chair, this has been the sharing of the incentives and has been practiced
1514 using Executive Orders and supplemental budgets. That is what we did. However, to

1515 make it permanent, regardless of who sits as the Governor, Vice Governor or Board
1516 Members, it has been made into an ordinance so that it will be permanent as
1517 embodied in a law.

1518 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1519 There was no existing ordinance controlling this practice? Kasi matagal na ito
1520 eh. Ibig sabihin wala man lang gumawa ng ganitong ruling?

1521 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1522 Mr. Chair, before yung ginagamit natin ay EO lang. This time, gusto natin ma
1523 institutionalize na. That's why we came up with in to this ordinance para maging
1524 permanent na. Considering yung PhilHealth Fund and Hospital Services natin ay
1525 lumalaki na, I think it is but proper na gawin nating ordinance.

1526 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1527 Bakit dati ba improper yan? Since I was a mayor for 9 years, I know there has
1528 been a practice and I thought it has been based on law.

1529 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1530 Mr. Chair, the EO provides for the mechanism and the sharing pero yung
1531 ordinance which provides for the disbursement of funds, it through a supplemental
1532 budget and we have been approving several supplemental budgets for these
1533 incentives for the hospitals and for the health workers. Yun po yung law, yung
1534 ordinance providing for the supplemental budget but with this ordinance we will
1535 provide not only for the budget, but also for the mechanism.

1536 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1537 In addition, Mr. Chair, with the passage of this ordinance, hindi na natin
1538 kailangan ng EO kasi embodied na yung system sa ordinance. Before kasi yung
1539 IRR nasa executive office, but since we already came up with an ordinance, hindi na
1540 necessary na magkaroon ng EO. Through this ordinance, immediately, pag andyan
1541 ang pondo, we can already disburse the said funds.

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1544 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1545 Mr. Chair, I have shared on the screen the Section 34 (a) of RA 1066, which
1546 provides "that all payments for Professional services rendered by salary public
1547 providers should be allowed to retain the health facility, in this case the provincial
1548 hospitals, in which services are rendered and be pulled and distributed among
1549 health personnel." May legal basis po. Mayron pong law to what we provide through
1550 supplemental budget and disbursement of funds but with this ordinance, mas
1551 detailed and permanent na yung sharing.

1552 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1553 Yung IRR is which allows the salaries to be retained by the health facility.
1554 Diba? Embedded na ito dito sa ordinance so hindi na kailangan ng supplemental.
1555 Kasama na iton sa policy ng hatian nila.

1556 HON. WILSON S. UY: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1557 Yes, Vice Gov. Mayron tayong Republic Act governing itong pagbigay ng
1558 incentive. Since na yung pera nasa Provincial Government, dapat may ordinance
1559 tayo to allocate the said funds pero mayroong guidelines na pwede tayo magbigay
1560 ng incentives sa mga, doctors at mag support staff. So yun ang guidance natin.

1561 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1562 Alam nyo naman, sabi ban nga sa Senado, ang hirap kausap ng walang legal
1563 background. So, I'm asking the lawyers in this body, aren't we going to jail? Or will
1564 the Governor or the Board members will not go to jail? If not, then let's approve this.

1565 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1566 Actually, the idea of the Governor is that even if the Governor, Vice Governor
1567 and Board Members are gone from our respective positions, the idea is the hospitals
1568 will continue to function as they are and the hospitals will not only be buildings with
1569 patients. They will be building with patients and medical practitioners who will take
1570 care of the patients. That is the idea.

1571 I wish to share, Vice Gov, when I was in Antique, they had a very nice
1572 hospital. I was there for a client and they were developing hydro facilities there.

1573 They had a very nice hospital but when I was shown around, they had a problem,
1574 there were no doctors and no takers because medical practice is more lucrative in
1575 private, rather than in government. So, the idea of the Governor of Leyte, by
1576 providing this incentive to medical practitioners, we will be able to retain more
1577 doctors in our hospitals to take care of the patients.

1578 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1579 Ano sabi ng mga abogado? Honorable Que? Honorable Reposar?

1580 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1581 Vice Gov, walang masama sa ordinance natin. Like Congress, the
1582 Sangguniang Panlalawigan can legislate anything for as long as it is not outside of
1583 law, public morals, public policy. So, yung ginawa natin na PhilHealth ordinance,
1584 there is nothing wrong. Lalagyan lang ng mga safety nets na it will always conform
1585 to the national law and national policies. And ang nangyari kasi, Mr. Chair, lumaki
1586 na yung funds natin according to Governor, umabot na ito nga sobra Isang Billion so
1587 medyo mainit lang sya that is the reason why yung mga Executive Orders ni
1588 Governor gusto nya mainstitutionalize na because he is seeing that our incoming
1589 funds from Philhealth contribution will go higher and higher in the next few years.

1590 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1591 Kaya ako nagtatanong kasi kapag lumaki ng lumaki ang perang yan, eh,
1592 baka magka loop hole.

1593 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1594 I gave suggested provisions on the ordinance that actually gives us kung may
1595 mga non conformity amendments na pag meron mang provisions na hindi makapag
1596 conform sa national law, magcoconform sya sa national law. May additional
1597 provisions akong pinapadagdag na hopefully mairevise at maidagdag.

1598 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1599 Okay. Any objections? Hearing none, is there a motion to approve this?

1600 HON. MILDRED JOY P. QUE: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1601 Vice Gov, we already approved it during the discussion of the item.

1602 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1603 Yung ngayun, Vice Gov, I just took the liberty to in answering the points

1604 raised by the Provincial Legal Office.

1605 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1606 Okay, Thank you, Floor Leader.

1607 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1608 Mr. Chair, there are no other items in our agenda so we now proceed to other

1609 matters.

1612 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1613 Mr. Chair, will you please recognize the Honorable Gimenez?

1614 HON. LEONARDO JAVIER, JR.: PRESIDING OFFICER/VICE-GOVERNOR

1615 Honorable Gimenez, you are recognized.

1616 HON. MA. MARTINA L. GIMENEZ: EX-OFFICIO MEMBER, LIGA NG MGA BRGY PRESIDENT

1617 Thank you, Mr. Chair and Mr. Floor Leader.

1618 Please lend me 5 minutes of your time as I rise today on a matter of privilege

1619 to express my support and share with you an advocacy that is both timely and

1620 necessary. The strengthening of Filipino values through the #MagalangNaPinoy

1621 Movement, an initiative we, at the Liga ng mga Barangay National, we are

1622 advocating in the barangays all throughout the country.

1669 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1670 Thank you, Mr. Chair.

1671 If I may, Mr. Chair, I wish to rise on a point of privilege.

1672 Yesterday, Mr. Chair, the president on his SONA addressed the need demanded,
1673 in fact, to take out system loss from our electricity bills. And to take out as well the VAT
1674 on the system loss from our bills. And then he demanded that the EPIRA Law be
1675 revisited or reviewed. If I may, Mr. Chair, more than that, perhaps the EPIRA Law can
1676 be viewed such that governments, like Local Government Units, may be allowed to
1677 create an energy generation facility because, right now, government is not allowed to
1678 set up power plants because it's only the private sector that is allowed. I remember
1679 having this discussion with Governor Icot Petilla and Governor Sharee Ann Tan before,
1680 they were talking about why the LGUs are not allowed and Gov Petilla as Secretary of
1681 the Department of Energy said that it is because of the EPIRA Law. If LGUs will be
1682 allowed to build our own power plants, that will be good. Perhaps, if the Honorable Vice
1683 Governor would become the Speaker of the House next time, it can be a good idea to
1684 empower LGUs to build powerplants aside from the private sectors only. I so move.

1685 HON. ELMER FREDERICO N. CODILLA: 4TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1702 because the system loss and VAT should not be shouldered anymore by the
1703 consumers. And I have one issue which I would like to raise, a crucial reform for our
1704 Region, allowing Eastern Visayas Electric Cooperative to purchase power directly from
1705 Leyte Geothermal Powerplant. We can do so because of this EPIRA Law and it is very
1706 ironic that Leyte, a home of one of the largest “clean and green” geothermal energy
1707 sources in the nation, cannot buy or purchase or access the said power. Maybe through
1708 the amendment of the EPIRA Law, without passing through this spot market, we can
1709 directly purchase or whatever means where we can access our own energy so that in a
1710 long term, Eastern Visayas can have a cheaper power or better rates for our
1711 constituents. That is my concern, Mr. Chair.

1712 If this August Body is willing to pass a resolution to the House of Congress or to
1713 the Senate to look into this possibility. I so move.
