Gentlemen and Ladies:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), our preliminary review of the **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 2 FY 2026** of the **Municipality Kananga, Leyte** duly enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through **Appropriation Ordinance No. 24L.26-022 Series of 2026** with a total appropriation in the amount of **P20,624,446.95** reveals compliance with the same law and its implementing Rules and Regulations.

It is therefore recommended for approval subject to the following conditions:

1. That the procurement of Civil Works, Goods, Supplies, Equipment, and other related services shall be made in accordance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and to the latest procurement issuances;
2. That the proposed expenditures for the Energy Cost Subsidy Program and the Rural Electrification Program is pursuant to the provisions of Section 294 of Republic Act No. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991;
3. That the allocation and utilization of the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMIF) shall conform with the provisions of NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013; and
4. That disbursement of funds shall be for the specific purpose(s) for which they have been appropriated pursuant to Sections 335 & 336 of RA 7160.

Compliance with DBM issuances, and all other accounting and auditing rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the implementing Local Government Unit.

ORDINANCE NO. 24L.26-022 (Series of 2026)

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY MILLION SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-SIX PESOS AND NINETY-FIVE CENTAVOS (P20,624,446.95) EMBODIED UNDER SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 2 CY 2026 FOR THE PROVISION OF 80% ROYALTY TAX, 20% ROYALTY TAX AND 5% MDRRM FUND AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive, in pursuance of the provision of Section 444 (3) (ii) of Republic Act No. 7160, has caused the preparation of Supplemental Budget No. 2 outlining therein the Budgetary Requirements for the continued delivery of basic services, facilities, other functions of the Local Government under Section 17 of the said Code;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan, through the Committee of the Whole, in the exercise of its power under the Local Government Code, has considered the proposed Supplemental Budget, reviewed evaluated and recommended the approval of the ordinance embodying the proposed appropriation for the Supplemental Budget No. 2 for Calendar Year 2026

NOWHEREFORE, considering the above cited premises; be it enacted by the 24th Sangguniang Bayan of Kananga, Leyte on a regular session duly assembled on this 10th day of August 2026 and upon motion of SB Member Mary Daniela L. Cubero, duly seconded by All SB Members, to wit:

Section 1. The Supplemental Budget No. 2 of the Municipality Government of Kananga for Fiscal Year 2026 in the total amount of Twenty Million Six Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Six Pesos and Ninety-Five Centavos (P20,624,446.95) for the Provision of 80% Royalty Tax, 20% Royalty Tax and 5% MDRRM Fund is hereby approved.

Section 4. Expenditure Component – Except by act of the Sangguniang Bayan, no changes or modification shall be made on the expenditure items authorized in the ordinance as detailed in the LBP Form 161 duly signed by the Municipal Budget Officer and the Local Chief Executive.

Any changes or modifications in the expenditure items in violation of this shall subject the erring official or employee to appropriate criminal and administrative sanctions as maybe provided under existing laws.

Section 5. Use of Savings and Augmentation. In accordance with Section 336 of Republic Act No. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipal Mayor and the Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan are authorized to augment any item in the approved annual budget for their respective offices from savings in other items within the same expense class of their respective appropriations.

For their purpose, "savings" refer to portions or balances of any programmed appropriation free from any obligation or encumbrance still available after the satisfactory completion or the unavoidable discontinuance or abandonment of the work, activity or purpose for which the appropriation is authorized or arising from unpaid compensation and related costs pertaining to vacant positions and leaves of absences without pay.

"Augmentation" implies the existence in the budget of an item, project or activity or purpose with an appropriation which, upon implementation or subsequent evaluation of needed resources, is determined to be deficient.

Section 6. Separability Clause – If, for any reason, any item of expenditure appropriated in this ordinance is declared unlawful nor invalid, other items of the appropriations which are not otherwise affected shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 7. Effectivity Clause – This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MDRRMC RESOLUTION NO. 01 SERIES OF 2026, ENTITLED, "A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF THE AMENDED 2026 LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND INVESTMENT PLAN (LDRRMFIP) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KANANGA, ADJUSTING THE 5% LDRRM FUND FROM P20,204,611.89 TO P21,422,277.74".

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Manuel Vicente M. Torres, in his letter dated June 2, 2026, requested the Sangguniang Bayan for a resolution adopting the MDRRMC Resolution No. 01 Series of 2026, entitled, "A Resolution recommending approval of the Amended 2026 Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund Investment Plan (LDRRMFIP) of the Municipality of Kananga, adjusting the 5% LDRRM Fund from P20,204,611.89 to P21,422,277.74" as approved through MDC Resolution No. 03 Series of 2026.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Disaster Preparedness, to which the subject matter was referred to, in its Committee Report No. 2026-24-04 provides that the LDRRMFI Plan of the Municipality, as submitted, serves as the guiding tool in addressing disaster prevention and mitigation, disaster preparedness, disaster response, disaster rehabilitation and recovery, and relevant activities to prevent and minimize impact to the vulnerable families and infrastructure facilities.
