EXPLANATORY NOTE

This proposed Ordinance seeks to strengthen the implementation of the Municipality of Alangalang's solid waste management system by authorizing Barangay Officials, through bonded and designated collectors, to collect the Garbage Collection Fee amounting to Twenty Pesos (P20.00) per household or establishment.

The legal basis of this measure is anchored on Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, which mandates local government units to adopt systematic, comprehensive, and ecological solid waste management programs. The law emphasizes the responsibility of LGUs to ensure proper segregation, collection, transportation, and disposal of solid waste in their respective jurisdictions.

Further, under the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), LGUs are granted the power to impose reasonable fees and charges for services rendered, including environmental and sanitation-related services, subject to proper ordinance.

Municipal Ordinance No. 2, Series of 2024, otherwise known as the "Revised Ecological Solid Waste Management Ordinance of the Municipality of Alangalang, Leyte" provides the policy framework for the implementation of solid waste management initiatives and authorizes the imposition of corresponding fees to sustain the program.

This Ordinance is therefore intended to ensure efficient and decentralized collection of fees at the barangay level, improve revenue collection efficiency, and enhance the sustainability of the municipality's environmental programs. The requirement for bonded officials further ensures accountability, transparency, and protection of public funds. In view of the foregoing, approval of this Ordinance is earnestly recommended.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Alangalang, Leyte in session assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE OF THE ORDINANCE – This Municipal Ordinance shall be known as the "Ordinance Authorizing the Collection of Garbage Collection Fee through Barangay Bonded Officials."

SECTION 2. Coverage

This Ordinance shall cover all Fifty Four (54) barangays within the Municipality of Alangalang, Leyte, and shall apply to all households and other waste-generating entities subject to garbage collection services.

SECTION 3. Authorization to Collect Fees

The Barangay Officials, through duly designated and bonded officials authorized by the Municipal Government of Alangalang, Leyte , are hereby authorized to collect the Garbage Collection Fee in the amount of Twenty Pesos (₱20.00) per household per month, in accordance with Municipal Ordinance No. 2, Series of 2024.

SECTION 4. Purpose of Collection

The collection of the Garbage Collection Fee shall be strictly used for the implementation of the Municipality's solid waste management program, including but not limited to:

- A. Garbage collection and hauling services.
- B. Maintenance and operation of material recovery facilities (MRFs);
- C. Environmental sanitation programs.
- D. Procurement of necessary equipment and supplies for waste management.

SECTION 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS

1. Barangay Officials

Refers to the duly elected and appointed officials of the barangay, including the Punong Barangay, Barangay Kagawad, Barangay Treasurer, and other authorized barangay personnel tasked with the implementation of this Ordinance.

2. Bonded Officials

Refers to barangay personnel or authorized collectors who are required to post a surety bond as prescribed by law and Commission on Audit (COA) rules to ensure accountability in the handling and remittance of public funds.

3. Garbage Collection Fee

Refers to the mandatory amount of Twenty Pesos (P20.00) imposed on each household, commercial establishment, or other waste-generating entity, collected to support the Municipality's solid waste management program.

4. Household

Refers to a group of persons, related or unrelated, who live together and share common living arrangements in a residential dwelling within the municipality.

5. Establishment

Refers to any business, commercial, industrial, institutional, or similar entity generating solid waste and operating within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Alangalang.

6. Solid Waste Management Program

Refers to the systematic administration of activities concerning the segregation, collection, transportation, storage, treatment, and disposal of solid waste in accordance with Republic Act No. 9003 and relevant local ordinances.

7. Municipal Ordinance No. 2, Series of 2024

Refers to the Revised Ecological Solid Waste Management Ordinance of the Municipality of Alangalang, which provides the policy framework and guidelines for environmental sanitation and solid waste management implementation.

8. Collection

Refers to the act of gathering and receiving the Garbage Collection Fee from households and establishments by authorized barangay or bonded officials.

9. Remittance

Refers to the turnover or deposit of collected fees by authorized collectors to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer within the prescribed period under existing laws, rules, and regulations.

10. Commission on Audit (COA) Rules

Refers to the accounting and auditing standards, circulars, and issuances governing the handling, custody, and liquidation of government funds.

SECTION 6. Bonding Requirement

All personnel authorized to collect funds under this Ordinance shall be required to post the appropriate bond, in accordance with existing accounting and auditing rules, to ensure accountability and protect public funds.

SECTION 7: Remittance of Collections

All collections shall be properly receipted and remitted to the Municipal Treasurer's Office within the period prescribed under existing government accounting and auditing regulations.

SECTION 8: Amendments of Subsection a of Section 3 Article X of the Municipal Ordinance No. 2024-02

A. Garbage collection fee shall be paid directly to the office of the municipal treasurer or to an authorized collection officer. For commercial and industrial establishment, garbage collection fee shall be paid during application for new business permit or renewal of business permit or any other month of the year subject to the assessment of the BPLO shall ***be amended to read as follows:***

A. Garbage collection fee shall be paid directly to the office of the municipal treasurer. However, for whatever acceptable reason, the household may opt to pay to any authorized and bonded barangay officials where he/she resides. The collected amount shall be remitted to the office of the municipal treasurer every end of the month. The barangay shall be entitled to a fifty percent (50%) share of the annual total collected amount which shall be deposited to the respective bank account of the barangay under trust fund. For commercial and industrial establishment, garbage collection fee shall be paid during application for new business permit or renewal of business permit or any other month of the year subject to the assessment of the BPLO.

SECTION 9: Sharing of Collections and Incentive to Barangay

Pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) and applicable budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Commission on Audit (COA), fifty percent (50%) of the total monthly garbage collection fee collected shall be retained by the Barangay concerned as an incentive share for administrative support, collection services, and program implementation, while the remaining fifty percent (50%) shall be remitted to the Municipal Treasury of the Municipality of Alangalang, Leyte for the operation and sustainability of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Program.

SECTION 10: Penalties

Any violation of this Ordinance, including misappropriation, failure to remit collections, or unauthorized use of funds, shall be subject to administrative, civil, and/or criminal liability under applicable laws and in accordance to MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES OF 2024, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "REVISED ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALANGALANG, LEYTE"

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected and shall continue to be in full force and effect. Further, other provisions in the MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES OF 2024, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "REVISED ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALANGALANG, LEYTE" remain enforce.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, executive orders, rules, and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY

This Ordinance shall take effect after 10 days from the date a copy thereof is posted in a bulletin board at the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous, places in the municipality of Alangalang, Leyte

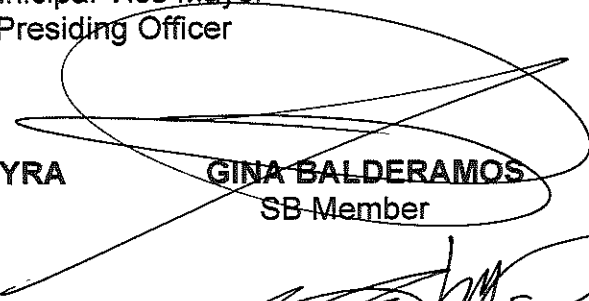

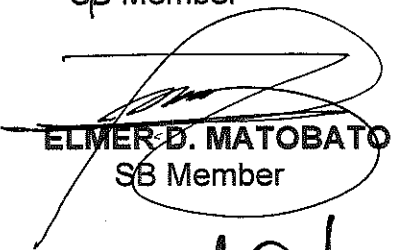

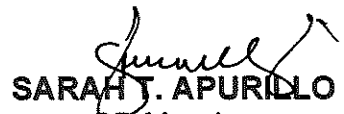
