SUBJECT: FORMAL CLARIFICATION AND RESPONSE TO ITEM NO. 8 OF THE PROVINCIAL LFC BUDGET REVIEW FINDINGS

Honorable Members of the Provincial Local Finance Committee:

This is in formal response to the review findings issued by the Provincial Local Finance Committee (PLFC) of Leyte regarding the Annual Budget of the Municipality of Dagami, specifically addressing **Item No. 8**, which states:

"8. That the Municipal Planning and Development officer is hereby reminded to affix the required signatures on the Local Budget Preparation Forms No. 1, 2, 4 and 6 in accordance to the procedural guidelines of Local Budget Memorandum No. 92 dated June 9, 2025;"

I respectfully submit this clarification to place on record the administrative and procedural facts regarding the absence of my signature on the subject Local Budget Preparation (LBP) Forms.

1. Factual Antecedents and Official Logbook Record

During the internal evaluation of the draft Local Expenditure Program (LEP) at the Municipal Local Finance Committee (LFC) level, this office conducted a plan-budget consistency review. The evaluation revealed that several proposed budgetary allocations exceeded the approved funding ceilings set in the Municipality's Annual Investment Program (AIP), in contravention of Section 305(i) of Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991).

To ensure statutory compliance and budget-plan alignment, this office returned the budget documents together with the LBP Forms to the Municipal Budget Office for proper reconciliation and correction. As officially recorded in our office receiving logbook:

- **Date Returned:** March 9, 2026
- **Receiving Office / Staff:** Municipal Budget Office Staff- Reynaldo C. Almenario
- **Logbook Control / Particulars:** *Annual Budget 2026 (Reviewed by MPDC and the necessary corrections had been attached)*

Relative thereto I have enclosed a copy of LBP Form 4 of the Office of the Mayor as approved by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dagami, Leyte and reviewed by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte and the portion of the approved 2026 AIP of Dagami, Leyte. The highlighted portions are examples and are self-explanatory. I have also enclosed a summary of the Plan-Budgetary inconsistencies we prepared after the plan-budget consistency review.

2. Disqualification and Invalid Designation of the Municipal Budget Officer Designate

In addition to the plan-budget discrepancies, this office officially raised inquiries regarding the legal capacity of the handling official. Per the official reply from our Human Resource Management Office (HRMO) to my formal query, alongside established guidelines under the 2017 Omnibus Rules on Appointments and Other Human Resource Actions (ORAOHRA) and the official legal opinion rendered by the Civil Service Commission (CSC) Regional Director, the designated Municipal Budget Officer failed to meet the mandatory Qualification Standards (QS) prescribed for the position.

Consequently, the designation was legally invalid and defective. A designated official who lacks the requisite qualifications under CSC rules and ORAOHRA lacks the statutory administrative

authority to prepare, finalize, or transmit the Local Expenditure Program and its accompanying preparation forms.

3. Procedural Bypass and Status of LBP Forms

Following the document's return to the Municipal Budget Office, the draft budget was never re-submitted to the Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO) for verification or re-examination. Instead, the draft budget bypassed final clearance and was directly submitted to the Sangguniang Bayan for enactment, and subsequently forwarded to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and Provincial LFC for review.

Under the Local Budget Operations Manual and applicable DBM circulars, LBP Forms No. 1, 2, 4, and 6 are **ex-ante preparation instruments** designed to recommend and certify plan-budget consistency *prior* to budget enactment. Because the budget has already been enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan and reviewed by the Provincial Board, executing or affixing preparation signatures retroactively on un-reconciled forms processed under a defective designation serves no administrative function and misrepresents the preparation sequence prescribed by law.

This clarification is submitted for your official record to reflect the exact procedural history of the document.

Greetings.

This refers to your letter dated April 29, 2026 requesting clarification on matters relative to the designation of the Municipal Budget Officer.

At the outset, it is understood that the designation may have been issued by the appointing authority in the exercise of administrative discretion to ensure continuity in the operations of the office.

However, it may be respectfully noted that the position of Municipal Budget Officer is governed by qualification standards prescribed under Republic Act No. 7160 and relevant Civil Service Commission issuances. As such, any designation to the said position remains subject to compliance with the required education, experience, and eligibility.

Based on the personnel records available in this Office, the educational background of the current designee does not appear to fall within the specific degree requirements for the position. Verification of other qualification components is ongoing, and any appropriate recommendations shall be submitted to the proper authority in accordance with applicable rules.

With respect to the grant of Representation and Transportation Allowance (RATA), this Office respectfully clarifies that it is not the office responsible for the certification or authorization of payroll disbursements. The participation of this Office in payroll preparation is limited to the submission of attendance and leave data based on Daily Time Records. Matters pertaining to the grant and payment of allowances fall within the functions of the appropriate financial and accounting offices, subject to applicable auditing rules and regulations. Nonetheless, it may be noted that entitlement thereto is generally contingent upon lawful occupancy of a position in accordance with existing laws and Civil Service Commission rules.

This Office respectfully notes that the designation of personnel is an act of the appointing authority. The role of the Human Resource Management Office is limited to maintaining personnel records and ensuring that qualification standards are properly documented and reported in accordance with applicable laws and Civil Service Commission rules. Any assessment made by this Office is thus based solely on available records and in faithful compliance with such governing standards.

This Office remains committed to ensuring that all personnel actions are undertaken in accordance with governing legal and regulatory standards.

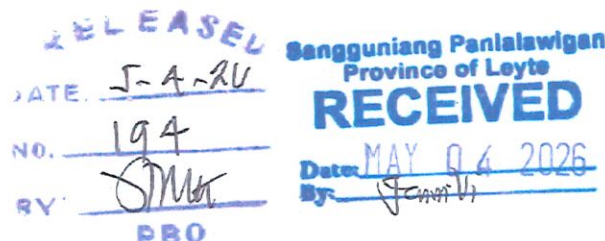

Gentlemen and Ladies:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), our preliminary review of the **General Fund Annual Budget FY 2026** of the **Municipality of Dagami, Leyte** duly enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through **Appropriation Ordinance No. 01 Series of 2026** with a total appropriations in the amount of **PHP246,673,270.32** reveals compliance with the same law and its implementing Rules and Regulations.

It is therefore recommended for approval subject to the following conditions:

1. That the grant of the following allowances/benefits shall be made pursuant to the corresponding guidelines relative thereto:
 - 1.1 PERA – Circular No. 2009-3
 - 1.2 Clothing Allowance – Budget Circular No. 2024-1
 - 1.3 RATA – Local Budget Circular No. 157
 - 1.4 Subsistence Allowance – RA 7305 and AO No. 170
 - 1.5 Mid-Year Bonus – Budget Circular No. 2017-2
 - 1.6 Year-End Bonus and Cash Gift – Budget Circular No. 2016-4
 - 1.7 Overtime Pay– CSC & DBM Joint Circular No. 1 s. 2015, dated November 25, 2015
 - 1.8 Monetization of Leave Credits – CSC Guidelines and Budget Circular No. 2016-2
 - 1.9 Hazard Pay – establishment of this benefit/incentive shall be based on the conditions enumerated under the Magna Carta for Public Health Workers and Magna Carta for Public Social Workers and payment shall likewise strictly adhere to the said requirements
 - 1.10 Terminal Leave Benefits – CSC Guidelines and Budget Circular No. 2016-2
 - 1.11 Medical Allowance - Budget Circular No. 2024-6 dated December 12, 2024
2. That the appropriation for salaries to officials and employees implementing the Second Tranche Compensation Adjustment for Local Government Personnel is in accordance to the provisions of Local Budget Circular No. 165 dated July 18, 2025 and the authorized rates thereof under Annex "A-1 & A4".
3. That LGU Dagsami is hereby reminded that the updated Salary Grade allocation of Midwife II is SG 11 in accordance to the provisions of Local Budget Circular No. 137 dated July 13, 2021 and the Salary Grade allocation of Nurse II is SG 16 in accordance to the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2021-2 dated August 25, 2021;
4. That all positions in the plantilla are incorporated in the Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern of the LGU as approved by the Sangguniang Bayan;

5. That the utilization of confidential fund of Php441,750.00 shall be made in accordance with COA-DBM-DILG-GOCC-DND Joint Circular No. 2015-01 dated January 18, 2015 prescribing Guidelines on the Entitlement, Release, Use, Reporting of Confidential/Intelligence Fund;
6. That the appropriation for Performance Enhancement Incentive (PEI), in the amount of P640,000.00 shall be disallowed due to suspension of the implementation of Administrative Order (AO) No. 25 (s.2011) and Executive Order (EO) No. 80 (s.2012), and all relevant issuances related thereto wherein PEI is part of the Performance Based Incentive System(PBIS), as adopted in the latter issuance. As of date, no guidelines has been issued allowing the grant of PEI for 2026;
7. That there are ten (10) unfunded vacant positions under the Municipal Government of Dagami. The same should be abolished if the Municipality has no intention of providing funds, pursuant to Local Budget Circular No. 98 dated October 14, 2011 which provides that vacant and newly created positions shall be adequately provided with appropriations for salaries, allowances and benefits, and fixed personnel expenditures to back up their legal existence;
8. That the Municipal Planning and Development officer is hereby reminded to affix the required signatures on the Local Budget Preparation Forms No. 1, 2, 4 and 6 in accordance to the procedural guidelines of Local Budget Memorandum No. 92 dated June 9, 2025;
9. That the procurement of Goods, Supplies, Equipment, Civil Works and related services shall be made pursuant to the provisions of RA 9184 and its implementing Rules and Regulations and to the recent procurement guidelines;
10. That the utilization of 20% Development Fund (DF) shall strictly adhere to DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 and that the preparation of the Annual Investment Program(AIP)shall be in accordance with Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 of DILG-NEDA-DBM and DOF dated November 18, 2016;
11. That the allocation and utilization of the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund shall conform with the provisions of NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 213-dated March 25, 2013; and
12. That disbursement of funds shall be for the specific purposes for which they have been appropriated pursuant to Sections 335 &336 of RA 7160.

The LGU is hereby reminded to follow the Budget Calendar in the preparation of the Annual Budget and the Budget Authorization thereafter provided in the provisions of the Local Government Code and in the Budget Operation Manual.

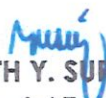
It is understood that this review action does not authorize any item of appropriation that is specifically prohibited by or inconsistent with the provisions of law.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-850

A RESOLUTION APPROVING **GENERAL FUND ANNUAL BUDGET FY 2026 OF DAGAMI, LEYTE,** GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 02 FY 2025 OF JULITA, LEYTE, GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 CY 2026 OF TUNGA, LEYTE, GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 3 FY 2025 OF MATALOM, LEYTE, GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 CY 2026 OF TABANGO, LEYTE, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE PROVINCIAL LOCAL FINANCE COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, Section 327 of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991, mandates the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to review the ordinance authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities, in the same manner and within the same period for the review of other ordinances;

WHEREAS, submitted to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte are Annual Budget of Dagami, Leyte, and the Supplemental Budgets of Julita, Leyte, Tunga, Leyte, Matalom, Leyte and Tabango, Leyte for approval, to wit:

1. **General Fund Annual Budget FY 2026 of the Municipality of Dagami, Leyte** in the amount of **Php246,673,270.32** under **Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, Series of 2026** together with **Amended Annual Investment Program (AIP) CY2026** in the amount of **Php2,281,665,943.00**;
2. **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 02 FY 2025 of the Municipality of Julita, Leyte** in the amount of **Php2,067,000.00** under **Appropriation Ordinance No. 2025-12**;
3. **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 01 FY 2026 of the Municipality of Tunga, Leyte** in the amount of **Php8,450,883.00** under **Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, Series of 2026**;
4. **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 3 FY 2025 of the Municipality of Matalom, Leyte** in the amount of **Php6,762,910.00** under **Appropriation Ordinance No. 04, Series of 2025**;
5. **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 1 FY 2026 of the Municipality of Tabango, Leyte** in the amount of **Php16,507,114.43** under **Appropriation Ordinance No. 2026-01**, together with **Supplemental Investment Program No. 1, Series of 2026** amounting to **Php133,919,803.49**;

WHEREAS, the subject Annual and Supplemental Budgets were referred to the Provincial Local Finance Committee for preliminary review, pursuant to Section 316 (f) and Section 475 (7) of R.A. 7160;

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Committee recommended for approval of said Annual and Supplemental Budgets, subject to certain conditions stated in the Assessment Reports, copies of which are hereto attached and made integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the August Body, upon review, finds the subject Budgets to be in compliance with the Local Government Code of 1991 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

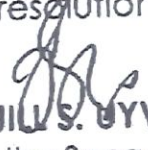
