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ORDINANCE NO. 2026-009

**AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING A DRUG - FREE WORKPLACE IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE
IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF**

WHEREAS, the Constitution mandates the State to ensure the well-being of its citizens and to pursue a balanced approach in addressing the national drug problem;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 66, series of 2018, institutionalizes the Philippine Anti-Illegal Drugs Strategy (PADS) and directs all government offices, including local government units, to strengthen the campaign against illegal drugs;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the said Executive Order requires LGUs to adopt and implement their respective Drug-Free Workplace Programs, including the conduct of authorized drug testing for local officials and personnel, pursuant to Republic Act No. 9165 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Calubian recognizes the imperative need to ensure that all public officers-elective, appointive, casual, job order, and contract of service personnel-maintain a drug-free lifestyle;

WHEREAS, Regulation No. 13, Series of 2018 issued by the Dangerous Drugs Board mandates the creation of drug – free workplace policies in all government offices, especially local government units, including the conduct of authorized drug testing, to ensure that all public officers remain drug free and that the general public be assured of effective and efficient service from the government;

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2025, the Municipal Mayor Hon. Marciano A. Batiancela, Jr. issued Executive Order No. 66, series of 2025, Institutionalizing a Drug-Free Workplace Policy in the Local Government of Calubian, Leyte and Providing Guidelines for its Implementation in relation to the Dangerous Drug Board (DDB) Regulation No. 13, series of 2018 pursuant to Section 60 of the Local Government Code;

On motion of Hon. Ralph Anthony George D. Martinez, duly seconded by the Majority of the SB Members present;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE, in a session assembled, **THAT**:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Drug-Free Workplace Policy of the Municipality of Calubian, Leyte."

SECTION 2. OBJECTIVE. This Ordinance aims to ensure that all municipal officials and employees remain drug-free in order to uphold integrity, professionalism, and efficiency in the delivery of public service.

SECTION 3. COVERAGE. This Ordinance covers all elective and appointive municipal officials and employees, as well as contract of service and job order workers.

Barangay officials and personnel shall likewise be covered in accordance with guidelines set herein.

The Local Chief Executive shall ensure that this Ordinance shall be properly disseminated to all offices of the local government unit, including all the barangays in the municipality.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are hereby adopted and shall mean as follows:

- a. **Authorized Drug Testing** - the testing done by any government forensic laboratory or a drug testing laboratory accredited by the Department of Health. It shall employ, among others, two (2) testing methods: the **screening test**, which will determine the positive test result as well as the type of drug used, and the **confirmatory test**, which shall confirm a positive screening test.
- b. **Challenge Test** - a drug test conducted as a result of a challenge filed by a public officer who tested positive for drug use in a confirmatory test in an authorized drug testing activity.
- c. **Confirmatory Test** - an analytical test using a device, tool or equipment with a different chemical or physical principle that is more specific which will validate and confirm the result of the screening test.

- d. **Dangerous Drugs** - include those listed in the Schedules annexed to the 1961 Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the 1972 Protocol, and in the Schedules annexed to the 1971 Single Convention on Psychotropic Substances as enumerated in the attached annex which is an integral part of Republic Act No. 9165 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, as amended.
- e. **Drug Dependency Examination** - refers to the examination conducted by a physician accredited by the DOH to evaluate the extent of drug use of a person and to determine whether he/she is a drug dependent or not. It includes history taking, intake interview, determination of criteria for drug dependency, mental and physical status, and the detection of dangerous drugs in body specimens through laboratory procedures.
- f. **Employee Assistance Program** - a program that offers assistance to government officials or employees who have alcohol or drug-related issues and problems that may affect work performance. It shall be jointly implemented by the agency, the employees, and the employees' union.
- g. **Mandatory Drug Testing** - compulsory submission of a public officer or prospective employee to drug testing as mandated by this Ordinance.
- h. **Random Drug Testing** - drug testing where the selection process results in equal probability that any employee from a group of employees will be tested, and without any prior notice of the date and venue.
- i. **Screening Test** - a rapid drug test performed to establish potential or presumptive positive result. It refers to the immunoassay test to eliminate a "negative" specimen, i.e., one without the presence of dangerous drugs, from further consideration and to identify the presumptively positive specimen that requires confirmatory test.

SECTION 5. CREATION OF THE DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE COMMITTEE. A Drug-Free Workplace Committee (DFWC) is hereby created to oversee and ensure the implementation of this Ordinance. The Committee shall be composed of:

- a. Local Chief Executive or authorized representative;
- b. Human Resource Management Officer or representative;
- c. Municipal Health Officer or representative;
- d. Employees' Union President or representative;
- e. MADAC Action Officer / Focal Person.

SECTION 6. CREATION OF AN ASSESSMENT TEAM. An Assessment Team is hereby constituted to conduct substance-abuse awareness programs, facilitate the Employee Assistance Program, and assist personnel who seek intervention. The Team shall be composed of staff trained in medicine, psychology, social work, and human resource management.

SECTION 7. COMPONENTS OF THE DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE POLICY.

- a. Pre-Employment Drug Testing- All applicants for municipal government service shall undergo mandatory drug testing. Those testing positive shall be disqualified.
- b. Awareness and Prevention Programs- The Assessment Team shall conduct regular advocacy, education, and training activities on substance abuse prevention.

- c. Authorized Drug Testing- The DFWC shall implement a confidential, random selection process for drug testing.
- d. Employee Assistance Program (EAP)- Before any authorized drug testing is conducted, personnel may voluntarily seek help under the EAP, including referral for drug dependency examination and intervention services.

This does not apply to those who already tested positive in a confirmatory test.

SECTION 8. GUIDELINES ON CONDUCT OF AUTHORIZED DRUG TESTING.

- a. The Local Chief Executive, in consultation with the DFWC, shall determine the frequency and schedule of drug testing activities. All information shall be treated with strict confidentiality.
- b. For barangay personnel, the LGU shall determine whether the municipality will shoulder drug testing expenses or whether barangays shall allocate their own funds.
- c. Personnel selected for drug testing must immediately report to the DFWC/Assessment Team. Failure to report without valid reason shall merit sanctions.
- d. A positive confirmatory test result shall be immediately reported to the Local Chief Executive. The affected personnel shall have fifteen (15) days to file a written request for a challenge test, using the same specimen, at their own expense.
- e. A positive result in the challenge test, or failure to file within the prescribed period, shall be deemed final.

SECTION 9. SANCTIONS.

- a. Appointive Officials and Employees- Refusal to undergo authorized drug testing without valid reason, or a confirmed positive result, constitutes Grave Misconduct.
- b. Elective Officials- Refusal or a confirmed positive result shall constitute misconduct in office, subject to Section 60 of the Local Government Code and Article 124(3) of its IRR.
- c. Tampering and Interference- Any personnel who tampers with drug test results, interferes with drug testing procedures, or violates confidentiality rules shall be charged with Grave Misconduct, without prejudice to criminal liability under RA 9165.
- d. Violation of RA 9165- Any personnel found violating provisions of RA 9165 shall face administrative sanctions and possible criminal prosecution.

SECTION 10. FUNDING. The Local Chief Executive shall ensure that adequate funds are allocated for the full implementation of this Ordinance. Barangays shall likewise provide necessary appropriations for their respective personnel, as required.

SECTION 11. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The Local Chief Executive shall ensure that a copy of this Ordinance shall be communicated to the Dangerous Drugs Board and the Department of the Interior and Local Government for information. Thereafter, the Local Chief Executive shall also report to said agencies the conduct of authorized drug testing and provide data as to the number of persons who were subjected to drug testing, the number of persons found positive for drug use, and the action undertaken by the Local Chief Executive on persons found positive for drug use.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules, and regulations, other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days from posting and publication, immediately upon approval of the Municipal Mayor and the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte.
